JOHN NERUD DID IT HIS WAY

Along with his failing eyesight and hearing, John Nerud's heart finally gave out Aug. 13. The Hall of Fame trainer, breeder, owner, and outspoken advocate for the sport died at his home in Old Brookville, N.Y. He was 102.

Nerud was instrumental in putting Ocala, Fla., on the Thoroughbred map while turning William McKnight's Tartan Farms into one of the most powerful outfits in the country. He developed Dr. Fager, No. 6 on The Blood-Horse's "Top 100 Racehorses of the 20th Century," into a three-division champion and Horse of the Year in 1968, conditioned four other champions, and sent eventual classic winner Codex to a young D. Wayne Lukas.

An early believer in the Breeders' Cup, he promoted the sport as the first chairman of the marketing committee and won the 1985 Mile (gr. IT) with home-bred Cozzene.

Nerud wrote his own epitaph at 100: "I'm old and I've traveled a long ways and have seen a hundred years. And the way I'd like to be remembered is, 'I did it my way.'" **BH**

UPSTART'S HALF SISTER OPENS NY SALE

Following a successful Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select sale, consignors are confident in the market for New York-bred preferred yearlings. The two-day auction begins Aug. 15.

"The people here are the same people that were at the select sale and will be at Keeneland," said Francis Vanlangendonck of Summerfield Sales. "It's a very good sale and has great participation from all the major buyers."

Summerfield consigns the first horse cataloged, Hip 301, a Majestic Warrior—Party Silks filly who is a half sister to Upstart, who was third in the grade I Haskell and is pointing to the Aug. 29 Travers (gr. I). Summerfield also sold Upstart at this sale in 2013.

"Party Silks throws good foals," Vanlangendonck said. "They're all athletic and precocious. Upstart was a big, good looking horse. He was very popular."

Vanlangendonck anticipates similar interest in the filly.

"Everyone is going to see her," he said. "Might as well just take a number; she's going to be out quite a bit." **BH**

GALLAGHER'S STUD READY FOR ROUND II

The Gallagher's Stud crew is walking tall heading into this weekend's Fasig-Tipton New York-bred sale. Through Denali Stud, the farm sold a pair of New York-bred fillies for \$570,000 and \$500,000, respectively, during the Saratoga select sale.

"It's very gratifying; you don't realize people think so much of them," said Mallory Mort, manager of Marlene Brody's Gallagher's Stud and a board member of the New York Thoroughbred Breeders. "We don't have the fire power we had in the select sale and maybe not what we've had in years past, but we've got some nice horses heading into the New York sale."

Gallagher's has three on offer, including colts by Freud and Girolamo and a Spring At Last filly.

"The New York-breds have sold well in the open sales so far," Mort said. "I expect a pretty aggressive market."

Last year's record average was up 11% over 2013, and the median, \$65,000, was also a record. The average and median for New York-breds at this year's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July sale outperformed the sale average. **BH**

PA TRAINER FACES FEDERAL CHARGES

When veterinarians and trainers violate medication rules at Penn National Race Course, U.S. Attorney Peter Smith believes they are breaking federal laws.

On Aug. 12 the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Middle District of Pennsylvania announced a Harrisburg grand jury had charged Penn National trainer Murray Rojas with wire fraud and conspiracy in a five-count indictment.

The indictment follows federal charges earlier this year against four Penn National vets who entered guilty pleas and agreed to cooperate with investigators. In 2013 three trainers were indicted under federal charges with two of those cases moving to state court. One trainer received jail time and another probation, but one case was dismissed.

In previous cases Smith has emphasized that when out-of-state bettors wager on the event, fraud occurs

beyond state boundaries—making it a federal crime. In the current case Smith points out that purse payments to Rojas were wired from a San Francisco bank to a Pennsylvania bank. **BH**

EXPATRIATE SIRES ON TOP

The results from last weekend's races in South America illustrate examples of stallions that are closely related to North American standouts succeeding at the highest level in the Southern Hemisphere.

In Uruguay, War Front's half brother Ecclesiastic (Pulpit—Starry Dreamer, by Rubiano), produced another graded stakes winner when his 4-year-old son Fletcher won the Clasico Asamblea de la Florida (Uru-III) at Maronas Race-track, thus keeping Ecclesiastic atop the Uruguayan sire list.

Ecclesiastic, a former shuttler who now permanently resides at Don Alfredo Farm in San Jose, Uruguay, led the Uruguayan sire list in 2014 and was also Uruguay's leading sire of 2-year-olds. He currently leads the 2015 general sire list by a good margin over fellow U.S.-breds Mogador and Subordination.

Another sire excelling in South America is Argentina-based Key Deputy (Deputy Minister), whose dam is a half sister to Common Hope, the dam of Shared Belief. This past weekend Key Deputy had his reputation enhanced when his daughter Amy B Key won the Clasico Luis Maria Campos (Arg-II) at Palermo. **BH**



WAR FRONT NOT GOING ANYWHERE

If you've ever attended Thoroughbred sales, you know they are rumor mills. "Did you hear they're going to move War Front to Ireland?" That was one rumor making its way around Fasig-Tipton Saratoga earlier this week. So we asked Joseph Allen, War Front's breeder who still owns a 30% stake in the stallion, whether there was any truth to that.

"No way," Allen said. "He'll stay at Claiborne. They've done a wonderful job with him and that's where he belongs."

And what if someone came to you with a big offer to buy out your shares?

"There's no way. It's too much fun for me," Allen said. "I've sold off some of my position, but I still own a very large piece of the horse. I had 40% and last year sold off 10%—I sold four shares. So I own 30%. Between myself, Coolmore, and Claiborne, we own over 70% now. There are a total of 12 individual shareholders, and it's a who's who list in racing."

Allen said War Front's rise over the past several years has been incredible but not without its challenges.

"At first he wasn't that exciting a stallion," he said. "He was a very fast horse but had won (only) one graded stakes, so he wasn't the easiest horse in the world to find a home for. But Seth (Hancock) liked him, liked what he looked like, and agreed to stand him."

"As always with stallions, the first couple of crops are very difficult until (the progeny) get onto the racecourse. I think they were lucky to

get \$7,500 (stud fee) in the fourth year; it was like pulling teeth. He had just enough numbers to get some runners, and now, well, you know what's happened. It's not a big secret.

"You have to be very lucky to get a good horse, especially a colt. And you have to get the right pedigree so at least you can give him a chance to stand. And then, how many stallions go to stud and don't make it? This is where I think John (Magnier) at Coolmore and Seth at Claiborne have been so smart—it's what they do. They try to get their own stallions if they can, and they'll even buy into stallions when they don't have their own. Seth has bred some wonderful horses that are nice stallions, and the same with John Magnier. I mean, how many great stallions has he bred?"

"Seth has done such a good job with War Front—he has protected him. And he is really in the right place right now. I've always been a great fan of Claiborne Farm. They started this horse from the beginning and they've just done a very special job. I couldn't be more pleased." **BH**
