ACAPULCO READY FOR THE OLD BOYS

Coolmore partners' 2-year-old filly Acapulco runs in the Coolmore Nunthorpe Stakes (Eng-I) at York Friday, facing older rivals in what seems to be an incomprehensible challenge from an American perspective. A dominant winner of the Queen Mary Stakes (Eng-II) at Royal Ascot, the Keeneland-based filly is the favorite for the premier five-furlong sprint.

"Acapulco really is incredible," trainer Wesley Ward told *Racing Post*. "She is only 2, but to look at her you would swear she is 4. She is a huge, monstrous, imposing filly. I really didn't think I'd ever have the right 2-year-old to bring over to take on older horses until now. She is still doing some sensational breezes, just as she was before Ascot."

The only juvenile in the field of 20, Acapulco receives a substantial weight advantage from the older runners: 112 pounds to her nearest competitors' 136.

The Scat Daddy filly lines up against the likes of Sole Power, a two-time winner of this event; King's Stand Stakes (Eng-I) winner Goldream; and Qatar King George Stakes (Eng-II) winner Muthmir. **BH**

CHRB DELAYS ACTION ON LASIX POLICY

After nearly six and a half hours of discussions, the California Horse Racing Board delayed a three-year effort to install third-party race-day administration of furosemide and ended disputes over racing dates in Northern and Southern California.

The proposal requiring non-affiliated veterinarians to administer furosemide (Lasix) was opposed by the California Thoroughbred Trainers and a group of veterinarians in attendance but supported by the Thoroughbred Owners of California. The opposition convinced the CHRB to reconsider the proposal and consider another that would have trainer-hired vets deliver furosemide under supervision. Changes to the current furosemide administration likely won't occur until 2016.

Although stabling issues seem ongoing in both Northern and Southern regions, Northern California eventually settled on a 2016 calendar that essentially keeps its 2015 form.

Southern California's 2016 schedule shifted: Los Alamitos exchanged its July meet for two weeks in April. While Santa Anita's large meet is split by those dates, the Arcadia track takes over Los Al's July dates. Los Al will continue to have short September and December meetings. **BH**

REBOUND UNDERWAY IN MARYLAND

Many of the 145 Maryland-bred or -sired horses entered in 11 races at Laurel Park Aug. 22 were foaled during the years the foal crop was at its lowest point because of both national and local economic issues. Stability, however, has turned around the numbers, which in turn has created some enthusiasm.

"This weekend is a great testament to peoples' commitment (to the breeding program) and to running their horses," said Crickett Goodall, executive director of the Maryland Horse Breeders Association. "These horses were bred when people were really challenged."

The Saturday program, called "Maryland Pride Day," offers purses of \$520,000, a percentage of which comes from video lottery terminal revenue at

Maryland casinos. The Jockey Club statistics reflect how the money has spurred growth in the breeding program. While the Maryland foal crop had dropped from 598 in 2009 to 363 in 2012, it rebounded to 430 in 2013. Last year, according to the latest estimates, the foal crop was just shy of 500. **BH**

DEEP IMPACT HAS FAMILIAR RIVAL IN JAPAN

Deep Impact became the leading sire in Japan for the first time in 2012, taking the distinction from King Kamehameha who had led in 2010 and 2011.

Deep Impact has maintained the top position since, widening the margin to the runner-up King Kamehameha each year.

In 2015 the race has taken a different shape. As of Aug. 20, the leading sire remains Deep Impact with progeny earnings of \$34 million; King Kamehameha is a close second with \$30 million.

Already having surpassed his 2014 numbers, when his progeny won nine graded stakes, King Kamehameha has sired seven graded stakes winners with 11 graded stakes wins in 2015.

King Kamehameha suffered a loss when his 3-year-old dual-Classical winning son Duramente was sidelined, but the son of Kingmambo still has big guns firing. Lovely Day, winner of the Takarazuka Kinen (Jpn-I), is a leading contender for the Nov. 1 Tenno Sho (Jpn-I) and Nov. 15 Japan Cup (Jpn-I). **BH**

Little Red Feather's Gary Fenton hopes Midnight Storm can break through in Pacific Classic

COLT SEEKS 'FEATHER' IN HIS CAP

Today we're chatting with Gary Fenton, managing partner and CEO of Little Red Feather Racing Club, which co-owns Midnight Storm, who runs in Saturday's TVG Pacific Classic (gr. I).

Little Red Feather began 12 years ago and had early success with 2004 Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) winner Singletary. About 120 individual horse partnerships later, Fenton says the biggest change in the racing landscape is the culture of ownership.

"If you look at the program for today at Del Mar, I bet you at least half of the horses are owned by more than one person, whether it's a partnership like ours or just a co-ownership between people who are spreading the risk.

"When we've had a horse win with partners that were not at the racetrack with us, and (LRF founder) Billy (Koch) and I are in the winner's circle, it's kind of boring. It's a lot of fun when you're winning around friends. The other aspect is the spreading of the risk. Horse racing is a very expensive business—it's high-risk, high-reward—and personally I would much rather own 10% of 10 horses than 100% of one horse. Your

odds are just better.

Fenton said securities laws limit the amount of advertising Little Red Feather can do, so growth typically occurs by word of mouth. He said newcomers to horse ownership often are in for a few surprises.

"I think they're most surprised just by how much fun it is," Fenton said. "There really is no better feeling than when your horse takes the lead at the top of the stretch. They don't realize how different it is than just coming to the races and gambling. There's a pride of ownership—something about having an ownership stake that really is kind of life changing.

"We had 13 investors in Singletary; we had guys who owned 1% and some who owned 25%, and the experience was exactly the same for all of them. It wasn't like the guy who owned 25% had more of a life-changing experience than the guy who owned 1%."

On Saturday, Little Red Feather's Midnight Storm will face a tough Pacific Classic field that includes champion mare Beholder. The colt already has a grade II win and a grade I second on turf, and Fenton hopes the Pioneer of the Nile colt can increase his stud value with a good performance.

"Stud implications played a lot into the decision to go into this race as opposed to the Del Mar Mile (gr. IIT), where we'd probably be 2-1 or better. But there's a big reward if we're right.

"We've had conversations with Kentucky farms, really more guidance than anything, and it's us asking questions like, 'If he were to do this, what would his value be then?'

"As exciting as it is being in the race, it's not exciting finishing seventh. As we've learned over the years, we really don't take swings like this unless we think the horse can do well, and everybody is pretty pumped about it." **BH**
