## **KEEN ICE GETS BEST OF CHAMP**

Donegal Racing's Keen Ice confirmed the "Graveyard of Champions" moniker still applies at Saratoga Race Course, running down Triple Crown winner American Pharoah in the final strides of the Aug. 29 Travers Stakes (gr. I).

Keen Ice, a son of Curlin who has been steadily improving all year—third in the Belmont, second in the Haskell—finally got the best of American Pharoah, who had been softened up by determined third-place finisher Frosted. Briefly at the top of the stretch, the aggressive strategy from Frosted's camp looked as if it would pay off, but American Pharoah put him away, only to be passed by 16-1 shot Keen Ice, who relished the 10-furlong trip.

The 2015 Saratoga meet has been a coming-out party for sire Curlin. Keen Ice's win follows graded stakes victories by Curalina, Exaggerator, and Off the Tracks earlier in the meet, not to mention the popular maiden win of Jess's Dream. Lane's End has already indicated Curlin's fee will increase for 2016. **BH**

### 'PHAROAH' HARDLY TARNISHED IN DEFEAT

Triple Crown winner American Pharoah did little to tarnish his image in his Aug. 29 Travers Stakes (gr. I) defeat, given the circumstances. Even the best of horses lose races now and then, and extended pressure by Frosted from the far turn through early stretch provided the perfect scenario for Keen Ice to nail the favorite near the finish.

Trainer Bob Baffert noted the colt has flown about 18,000 miles this year and won all but one of seven starts.

"I feel bad for the horse, getting beat like that," Baffert said. "He dug in today; he just didn't bring his A-game."

Owner Ahmed Zayat said he would consider retiring American Pharoah after the loss, but as of now, anyway, the colt is penciled in to finish the racing season in the Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) at Keeneland. Whether he races between now and then remains to be seen; if he does, staying home in California may be the preferred option after all that traveling. BH



## SHEER DRAMA BLOSSOMING WITH AGE

Sheer Drama has blossomed at age 5. A little more than a month after running down a lone front-runner to win the Delaware Handicap for her first grade I victory, the Burning Roma mare reeled in the dueling pair of Untapable and Stopchargingmaria in the stretch to capture the Aug. 29 grade I Personal Ensign Stakes at Saratoga.

The race is a Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" event, and trainer David Fawkes said Sheer Drama is headed to Keeneland in October for the Distaff (gr. I).

"It worked out perfectly," Fawkes said of jockey Joe Bravo's ride aboard Sheer Drama. "She's getting better as she's getting older. She's maturing. She does everything right. Hopefully, we're on our way to Keeneland now."

Fawkes acknowledged the possible presence of multiple champion Beholder in the Distaff, but her connections could opt for the Classic (gr. I).

"Do I hope Beholder goes against the boys? Absolutely," Fawkes said. "But If I've got to (beat) her, too, I'll do it." **BH**


### **RUNHAPPY ROMPS IN KING'S BISHOP** By Tom LaMarra

When Jim McIngvale's Runhappy won his debut as tons the best after a terrible start in a maiden special weight event Dec. 28, 2014, at Turfway Park, those who saw the race figured the Super Saver colt had a future. He proved them correct Aug. 29 at Saratoga with a powerful score in the seven-furlong King's Bishop Stakes (gr. I) for 3-year-olds under Edgar Prado.

Trained by Maria Borell, Runhappy shipped to the Spa off of a second-level allowance win at Ellis Park and won the King's Bishop in a stakes-record time of 1:20.54, just shy of the track record.

"We wouldn't have spent the money to come up here if we thought he couldn't win," Borell said.

Runhappy gave Super Saver his second grade I winner in a week, as the filly Embellish the Lace took the Alabama Stakes Aug. 22. As for the other two grade I sprints on the card, Unbridled Forever won the Ballerina Stakes and Private Zone the Forego; both are Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" events. **BH** 



## FLINTSHIRE ENJOYS CLASS RELIEF

Maybe it was Saratoga's summer air. Or new rider Vincent Cheminaud. Or, just maybe, it was some welcome class relief. In any event, in his second stateside race Juddmonte Farms' Flintshire won the grade I Sword Dancer impressively—and in fast time of 2:23.77. He was runner-up in last year's Longines Breeders' Cup Turf (gr. IT).

By Juddmonte stallion Dansili, Flintshire spent the first half of his 5-year-old season running second and third in international group I races. He was second at Meydan, third at Royal Ascot, and most recently second to dual Arc winner Treve in France. There were no Treves in the Sword Dancer.

Sent off at even-money and never more than a few lengths off the pace, Flintshire took the lead entering the stretch and rolled to a comfortable 2 1/2-length victory over Red Rifle. **BH** 

Flintshire was the second horse on the card to win a grade I without Lasix. Flintshire has never run on the anti-bleeder drug; neither has King's Bishop winner Runhappy. **BH**

## IN HONG KONG, ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Pari-mutuel wagering on Hong Kong Jockey Club races increased 34% over a five-year period to HK\$107.9 billion (US\$13.9 billion) in 2014-15. But another metric—one not valued much anymore in United States racing—also is up, and the HKJC hopes it continues to grow when its 2015-16 racing season begins in September. Officials said on-track attendance topped two million during the last racing season, and is up about 8% from five years ago.

"The attendance metric is perhaps one of the most incredible relative to our performance," HKJC chief executive officer Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges said Aug. 29. "The competition for attention in a crowded personal entertainment marketplace is remarkable. We have more devices, more ways to be connected, and more distractions in our daily lives than at any other time in history."

Meanwhile, the HKJC continues to work on developing its Conghua Training Center in mainland China; the facility, with more than 700 stalls, is designed to alleviate pressure for stabling at Sha Tin racecourse. BH

## **DIALING IN ON STAMINA**

A mong the laments regarding the lack of stamina in the North American Thoroughbred, one mare has quietly been establishing herself as an outstanding source of high-level distance-running ability.

In stark contrast to the aptitude of her best descendants, Dial a Trick's pedigree suggests out-and-out speed. Her sire, the powerful, heavily muscled Phone Trick, was one of the fastest horses of the 1980s. Dial a Trick's dam, Ice Fantasy, recorded her most notable triumph in the 5 1/2-furlong Debutante Stakes.

Whether Dial a Trick would have conformed to her pedigree's expectations as a runner is unknown. Purchased by John Gunther of Glennwood Farm for \$85,000 as a yearling, Dial a Trick never ran. She started her broodmare career modestly, and Glennwood initially sold her at Keeneland January in 2002 for \$13,000, at which point her best runner was the Ellis Park Debutante Stakes third-place finisher Expanse (by Distant View).

Despite the "sale," Glennwood retained ownership of the mare and less than three years later put Dial a Trick back in the Keeneland ring. In foal to Mineshaft, she realized \$630,000. That remarkable increase was due to her 2000 and 2001 foals, Eye of the Tiger and Wildwood Flower. Eye of the Tiger—a son of the sprinter/miler American Chance—was the trendsetter for his later relatives, his most notable triumph being the 9 1/2-furlong Washington Park Handicap (gr. II). Wildwood Flower, by Canadian sprint champion Langfuhr, won stakes at six furlongs and was graded-placed at 8 1/2 furlongs.

Dial a Trick's subsequent foals have achieved little, but her daughters have bred on spectacularly. Wildwood Flower is dam of Materiality, who recorded a 115 Equibase Speed Figure taking this year's Florida Derby (gr. I) at nine furlongs. Her Unbridled's Song filly My Miss Sophia won the nine-furlong Gazelle Stakes (gr. II) and was runner-up in the Longines Kentucky Oaks (gr. I).

Expanse has done even better: She already had Travers Stakes (gr. I) victor Afleet Express and nine-furlong stakes winner/graded-stakes performer Reporting for Duty. Last weekend her Super Saver daughter, Embellish the Lace, led from pillarto-post to take the 10-furlong Alabama Stakes (gr. I).

How the sprint-bred Dial a Trick became such a source of elite distance runners is something of a mystery, but perhaps a little credit belongs to some of the lesser-known horses in the distaff side of her pedigree: Her dam is by It's Freezing, a graded winner at 9 1/2 furlongs, and grade I-placed at 10; her second dam is by Bold Ruler's brother, Nasco, a stakes winner at 8 1/2 furlongs and runner-up in the Dwyer Handicap at 9 1/2 furlongs; her third dam is by Errard King, who defeated champion High Gun and Preakness Stakes winner Hasty Road in the nine-furlong American Derby. **BH**


