WISE DAN'S FAIRYTALE JOURNEY ENDS

In 2011, as Charlie LoPresti was preparing his then-4-year-old gelding Wise Dan for the Shadwell Turf Mile (gr. IT), the trainer could hardly contain his excitement over what he was seeing.

"Holy smokes. He's a different horse on grass," LoPresti said of the half-mile breeze at Keeneland in :46 1/5 around the "dogs."

Though Wise Dan would finish fourth in that year's Shadwell, the Wiseman's Ferry gelding would go on to win 10 grade I turf races in his career including a pair of Shadwell Turf Miles. In both 2012 and 2013 he won the Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) and titles as champion turf horse, champion older horse, and Horse of the Year.

The fairytale journey of Morton Fink's homebred came to an end Sept. 7 when LoPresti said Wise Dan, who was nearing his first race in 11 months, had developed a career-ending tendon injury. The great gelding had compiled a 23-2-0 record from 31 starts for earnings of \$7,552,920. **BH**

RALIS ROLLS TO VICTORY IN HOPEFUL

Having eventual Del Mar Futurity (gr. I) winner Nyquist in their hip pocket, Reddam Racing and trainer Doug O'Neill shipped Cal-bred Ralis east, and the bay colt drew clear of the pacesetter Magna Light to win Saratoga's seven-furlong Hopeful Stakes (gr. I) by 5 3/4 lengths in 1:22.30.

Reddam and O'Neill have rolled the same dice unsuccessfully, most famously with I'll Have Another's sixth-place Hopeful finish in 2011.

Sanford Stakes (gr. III) third Magna Light, the 2-1 favorite, set uncontested fractions of :22.79 and :45.46. Ralis under Javier Castellano rallied in the final stages, turning the stretch run into a match race. Second choice Uncle Vinny finished third.

The win capped a monster Saratoga meet for Castellano, who won five grade I's.

Ralis is the third of four foals from Silar Rules, all by Reddam's Square Eddie. Silar Rules is out of grade III winner Morning Meadow, whose dam Morning Mirage is a half sister to blue hen Sultry Sun. **BH**

REDDAM, O'NEILL STRIKE AGAIN

A little more than three hours after watching their second-string colt Ralis romp by 5 1/4 lengths in the grade I Hopeful Stakes at Saratoga Race Course, owner J. Paul Reddam and trainer Doug O'Neill played their ace at Del Mar. Nyquist, a son of freshman sire Uncle Mo, convincingly justified his 1-2 favoritism in the Del Mar Futurity (gr. I), drawing off to win by 3 3/4 lengths—not quite the margin of his stablemate but equally impressive.

Purchased for \$400,000 by the trainer's brother, Dennis, earlier this year at the Fasig-Tipton Florida sale, Nyquist remained unbeaten in three starts and became the first grade I winner for his young sire. Reddam and O'Neill teamed up with

jockey Mario Gutierrez in the Futurity, reuniting the familiar connections of 2012 dual classic winner I'll Have Another.

O'Neill is the first trainer to win both the Hopeful and Del Mar Futurity, the closing Labor Day features of their respective meets, in the same year. **BH**

Ironicus wins Sept. 7 Bernard Baruch Handicap in course-record time

RECORD-SETTING IRONICUS EYES BC MILE

Stuart Janney III's homebred Ironicus showed Sept. 7 that he just might have what it takes to win the Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT).

The son of Distorted Humor was razor-sharp

when unfurling his patented late kick from last to capture the 1 1/16-mile Bernard Baruch Handicap (gr. IIT) in record time of 1:38.54 on Saratoga's Mellon Turf Course. The running style could serve him well in the \$2 million Mile Oct. 31 at Keeneland.

The even-money favorite in the Bernard Baruch, Ironicus settled at the back of the seven-horse field, saving ground while Constitution—making his turf debut—led through six furlongs and then threw in the towel. Angled out at the three-six-

teenths pole, Ironicus began his closing drive and blew past front-runners Vyjack and Grand Tito to win by 1 1/4 lengths, eclipsing Fourstardave's previous record of 1:38.91 set July 29, 1991.

"He's a nice horse," winning rider Javier Castellano said of Ironicus. "I'm looking forward to the Breeders' Cup." **BH**

PLETCHER WINS 12TH SARATOGA TITLE

With 34 wins Todd Pletcher clinched his sixth consecutive Saratoga training title, but not without a challenge from familiar rival Chad Brown (31 wins), who was second for the fifth consecutive year. The race came down to the final afternoon of the 40-day meet, where two winners sealed Pletcher's 12th track title.

Brown got out of the gate quickly with two opening-day victories, but by Day 9 he trailed Pletcher 15-5. A dry spell from the Pletcher barn allowed Brown to regain the lead 24-22 after Day 28. Despite five consecutive winless days, Brown held that advantage until Sept. 5, when Pletcher captured grade Is with Liam's Map and Rachel's Valentina, plus an allowance race via disqualification. Pletcher also had Curalina and Uncle Vinny win graded stakes via DQ this meet.

Pletcher was the runaway leader by purse earnings with \$4.6 million to Brown's \$2.7. But Brown had 31 fewer starters and higher rates for wins (22% vs. 20%) and top-three finishes (53% vs. 50%). **BH**

KYLLACHY, PIVOTAL TAGTEAM IN EUROPE

Cheveley Park Stud's Kyllachy enjoyed a stellar weekend. On Sept. 5 his unbeaten son Twilight Son became his fourth group I winner in the Betfred Sprint Cup, and, in Italy, Zapel won the Premio Divino Amore. His Kyllachy Queen ran second in the Sept. 6 Premio Pietro Bessero.

Pivotal, who stands alongside his son, has had a good recent run. March Daisy became her sire's seventh 2015 European stakes winner in Friday's Grand Prix de Fontainebleau. On Aug. 29 Racing History, Godolphin's brother to Champion Stakes (Eng-I) winner Farhh, won the Winter Hill Stakes (Eng-III) and Maarek the Beverley Bullet Sprint Stakes, giving Nureyev's grandson a stakes double.

Pivotal's daughters are also successful, having produced 15 European stakes winners this season, including Sunday's listed winner Lucky Kristale as well as unbeaten 2-year-old Smash Williams, winner of the Round Tower Stakes (Ire-III).

Kyllachy also is making a mark as a broodmare sire. Recent Railway Stakes (Ire-II) winner Painted Cliffs is one of seven career stakes winners out of his daughters. **BH**

RACING COMMENTARY

SEPTEMBER SONGS, AUGUST PLACES

With 40 racing dates and six dark Tuesdays, the Saratoga season—once "the August place to be"—could not possibly be squeezed into a single month.

In recent years, opinion pieces have suggested Saratoga Race Course's cup runneth over into July and September just a bit too much. Other entries typically caution against cooking geese capable of laying golden eggs.

This was not the usual "less is more" nonsense. Rather, the complaints were more, "We have nothing against 'too much of a good thing,' but endless waves of 5 1/2-furlong turf sprints for New York-bred maiden claimers is not our idea of a 'good thing.' "

Based on the 2015 Saratoga meeting that just ended, it's hard to see how anyone but the chronically churlish can make that argument. Yes, today's racing gods seem to be practicing benevolence: sunny days, few off-the-turf races, abundant purses, and generally robust fields. On the racetrack, anyway, complaints were few.

The impact the sprawl of Saratoga's dates has upon Belmont's stakes schedule is an argument with longer legs. Splendid fixtures in what was once called Belmont's Fall Championship Season—such as Saturday's Woodward Stakes—are now blasts of fireworks in Saratoga's near-endless summer. Belmont Park reopens on Friday, Sept. 11; the first grade I race won't be run until Sept. 26.

That the "Championship" meet is now just Belmont's "Fall Meet" is old news; about as old as the Breeders' Cup. The seven grade I races remaining in the 38-raceday

meet are bunched into two Saturdays, four and five weeks out from the Cup, reducing these great events to class prep with very nice trophies.

While I sympathize with those who miss the old NYRA stakes calendars—it was a long and lovely strand of pearls—stacking big races on big days is apparently not without bottom-line merit and is probably here to stay. Even the notoriously fickle racing gods seem to smile upon this strategy.

Twenty-five years ago the Spinaway Stakes was the Spa's closing-day feature. More recently it's home was on Labor Day Sunday. This year it was added to the Woodward undercard. This allowed Rachel's Valentina to become a grade I winner six years to the day after her mother clinched the 2009 Horse of the Year title by bravely holding on in the Woodward. This gentle echo from a six-year-old thunderclap couldn't help but bring a smile to one's face, even for the most churlish among us. **BH**




