Lea returns to grass in the Sept. 13 Woodbine Mile

MILERS SEEK TO FILL POWER VACUUM

The Sept. 13 Ricoh Woodbine Mile (Can-IT) may not include Wise Dan following the two-time winner's retirement last week, but runners who dwelt in his shadow will have a chance to shine.

Last year's Donn Handicap (gr. I) winner Lea, respectively second and third to Wise Dan in the 2013 Firecracker (gr. IIT) and Fourstardave (gr. IIT), returns to the grass for the first time in more than two years as the 5-2 morning-line favorite off a sixth in the Aug. 8 Whitney (gr. I).

Grade I winner Obviously, the 3-1 second choice on the morning line, makes his first start since a fifth in last year's Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT); he ran third behind Wise Dan in the 2012 Breeders' Cup Mile.

Za Approval—second to Wise Dan in both the 2013 Woodbine Mile and Breeders' Cup Mile—also seeks a return to winning ways, as does Kaigun, runner-up to the champ in the 2014 Maker's 46 Mile (gr. IT) and second in last year's Woodbine Mile. Grand Arch, another who once faced Wise Dan, has recently come into his own with a powerful score Aug. 15 in the Fourstardave. **BH**

Regulation would give tracks option to card Lasix-free races

STATUS OF KY LASIX-FREE RULE UNCERTAIN

The status of a proposed regulation that would permit Kentucky tracks the option of carding races free of the anti-bleeder medication furosemide, or Lasix, is uncertain after action by a legislative subcommittee that found it "deficient."

During the Administrative Regulation Review Subcommittee meeting, Kentucky Horse Racing Com-

mission representatives were asked whether they wanted consideration of the regulation deferred, pending an opinion from the office of state Attorney General Jack Conway. The KHRC did not request a deferral, leading to the 6-2 vote that the regulation is deficient. The national and Kentucky Horsemen's Benevolent

and Protective Associations have requested an opinion from Conway on its constitutionality. Conway, who is running for governor, has yet to rule.

According to a KHRC spokesman, why the subcommittee found the regulation deficient is unknown. The regulation can still be sent to Gov. Steve Beshear, who can determine if the regulation should be withdrawn, withdrawn and amended to address the deficiency, or put into effect notwithstanding the deficiency finding. **BH**

FINAL DRAFT FOR HARLAN'S HOLIDAY

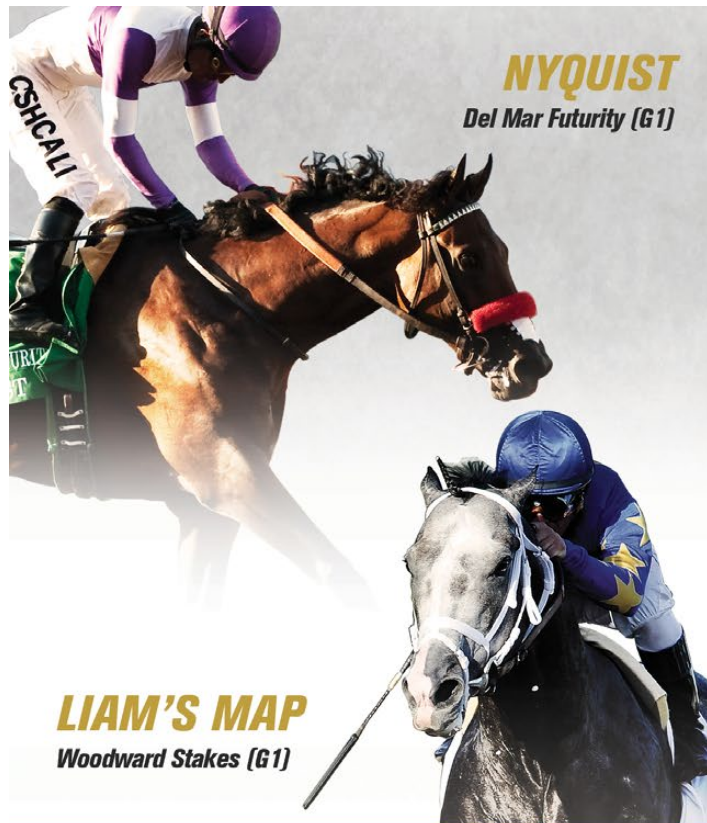

When the final crop of the late WinStar stallion Harlan's Holiday goes through the sales ring at Keeneland's September sale, Starlight Racing's Jack Wolf and the partnership's agent, Frankie Brothers, will be looking closely.

"He seems to pass on his big heart and ability to try," Wolf said. "Generally speaking, they are more compact individuals, but you will see a scopey one, which would come from the bottom side. They all have good hips and nice shoulders and are well-balanced."

A three-time grade I winner for Starlight in 2002-03, Harlan's Holiday provided Wolf and his wife, Laurie, with a firm foundation for their stable. Starlight supported him at stud and at the sales, buying his top son, champion Shanghai Bobby, for \$105,000 as a 2011 Keeneland yearling.

"We had a limited amount of funds when we started, and I am not sure without him we would still be in the horse business," Wolf said. "It is too bad his stud career came to a premature end." BH

Just Wicked tries the Pocahontas Stakes on Churchill's opening weekend

JUST WICKED FOLLOWS UNTAPABLE'S PATH

Having found a tried-and-true method with Winchell Thoroughbreds' Untapable for a strong 2-year-old season that propelled her to greatness as a sophomore, trainer Steve Asmussen will send that outfit's homebred Tapit filly Just Wicked down the same path in the Sept. 12 Pocahontas Stakes (gr. II) at Churchill Downs.

The first two-turn graded stakes of the season for juvenile fillies, the 1 1/16-mile Pocahontas was Untapable's first stakes score in 2013; Just Wicked has already sealed hers in the Aug. 15 Adirondack Stakes (gr. II) at Saratoga. With the Pocahontas serving as the first of 31 races offering qualifying points for the May 6 Kentucky Oaks (gr. I), Just Wicked's connections hope this is the first step toward claiming back-to-back victories in the nation's premier filly test.

Short term, Just Wicked could perhaps fare better than Untapable in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (gr. I), where her predecessor finished eighth before rebounding to win the 2014 Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I). **BH**

Trainer Mark Casse enters Conquest Enforcer, Conquest Daddy in the Sept. 12 Summer Stakes

'ENFORCER' DEBUT DEPENDS ON GROUND

Trainer Mark Casse is confident enough in Conquest Enforcer to run the unraced Into Mischief colt in the Summer Stakes (Can-IIT) first time out, but he's still somewhat cautious, depending on weather forecasts projecting precipitation for the Sept. 12 turf race at Woodbine. Casse says he won't run the colt if the ground is too soft.

"The intention is this—if the turf is fine, 'Enforcer' is going to run," Casse said. "If I'm not happy with the turf, I'll scratch 'Enforcer.' It's difficult enough to run a first-time starter going a mile with winners, then throw in a yielding surface—that's just not what we want to do."

The team of Casse and Conquest Stables has won the last two editions of the Summer Stakes with My Conquestadory (in her debut) and Conquest Typhoon, but even if the weather does turn soggy, they still have a chance to three-peat with stakes-placed Conquest Daddy, who will run if the Woodbine turf comes up soft. **BH**

China hopes to learn from Hong Kong's strong racing product

STEP FORWARD FOR HORSE RACING IN CHINA

A new strategic alliance announced Sept. 9 is expected to bring China much closer to establishing the foundation to host internationally recognized Thoroughbred racing.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club is partnering with the Chinese Equestrian Association on the final leg of the four-part China Horse Racing Grand Prix, which will be held Nov. 7 at Jinma Racecourse in the south-central Chinese province of Sichuan.

Besides sponsoring the name of the event—the Hong Kong Jockey Club Raceday—the HKJC is providing on-site classes and training for jockeys, racing stewards, and judges as well as aiding in the development of advanced drug-testing protocols. At present, betting on horse racing is not allowed in China.

"Through the sharing of our technical acumen and implementation experience, the Club will work closely with the CEA over the next few years to enhance all aspects of racing control and regulations, with the goal of facilitating China's connection to horse racing sport," said Andrew Harding, the HKJC's executive director of racing authority. **BH**

Ramsey Farm stallion Kitten's Joy had a JRA maiden winner last weekend

KITTEN'S JOY POPULAR IN JAPAN, TOO

Progeny of Kentucky-based sires won two the five maiden races JRA carded for unraced 2-year-olds last weekend, each with a purse of ¥13,400,000 (\$112,615).

King Lion, a Kitten's Joy colt, took the 1,500-meter turf maiden at Sapporo on Sept. 5. Hokkaido-based J S Company bought King Lion at Keeneland September for \$200,000 on behalf of a partnership led by Tokyo-based businessman Toshihiko Tabata. King Lion is the second JRA winner by Kitten's Joy, following 3-year-old colt Dashing Blaze, winner of two races so far. As the Japanese bought four Kitten's Joy yearlings at Keeneland last year, future winners are likely.

Scat Daddy's daughter Chesutoke Lily defeated colts in the 1,200m maiden on Niigata's dirt course Sept. 6. Kenji Ryotokuji bought Chesutoke Lily for \$175,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Florida March sale. Chesutoke Lily is the fourth Scat Daddy winner at JRA.

Eight or more Japanese groups are expected at next week's Keeneland sale, and Kitten's Joy and Scat Daddy are likely to be among their favorite sires. **BH**

Geoffrey Russell discusses the climate going into the Keeneland September sale

A FEW QUESTIONS WITH GEOFFREY RUSSELL

Today's *MarketWatch* interview is with Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales, to discuss the Keeneland September yearling sale beginning Sept. 14.

Blood-Horse Daily: What was the reason behind changing the format of Book 1 from four sessions to three?

Geoffrey Russell: By the last session of Book 1 last year, buyers who were going to buy in Book 1 had already looked at their horses. But the other people didn't have anything to do because not all Book 2 horses were on the grounds yet. Now, having a three-day Book 1 with more horses per day, buyers can start looking at Book 2 horses on Wednesday because all the Book 2 horses will be on the grounds at the same time—there will be constant motion, or at least that's what we're hoping for.

You have to look at the market on a regular

basis and see what works. Time is of the essence for a lot of these people, too. Gone are the days when people could wander in here, sit around, and spend a lot of time to buy a few horses. Now people are very busy, and they want to get their business done in a timely manner.

BHD: Can you describe the process of placing horses that might be in the gray area between Books 1 and 2?

GR: Consignors and sales companies always have discussions about where a horse should be placed. Sometimes we'd prefer to see a horse in Book 1, but they think it should be in Book 2. Sometimes it's the reverse. We have to work with consignors to place yearlings the best way possible. We point out facts we get from *Blood-Horse MarketWatch* that show where the money is for certain horses.

Our goal—sales company and the consignor—is to place them where the horse is going to bring the most amount of money. Some people think they should be a big fish in a small pool, and others think they should be in with all the same-quality horses. But the horse business is an inexact science.

BHD: How might macroeconomic factors such as the recent volatility in stock markets affect returns at the September sale?

GR: We were happy with last year's September sale (returns) being similar to the previous year; you don't want too many years of big growths in a row because that creates the inflation bubble. But nothing since then has changed our opinion on the bloodstock market. All the smart people to talk about financial markets don't seem to be overly concerned about (the volatility) last week.

However, the magic of Keeneland September is that everybody can go home with a horse, so we're not insulated from the economy. We are affected by discretionary income—or lack thereof—as all horse sales are. We can't manipulate the market. Once the sale begins, the market takes over and determines the prices for these horses. **BH**
