## RAMSEYS SWEEP OWNER, BREEDER AWARDS

Ken and Sarah Ramsey are on a remarkable run. For the third time in four years, the Central Kentucky couple has swept both national breeder and national owner of the year titles as recognized Sept. 11 by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association.

In 2014 the Ramseys led the breeder and owner categories by earnings, with more than \$10.4 million acquired as breeders and more than \$10.5 million in earnings as owners. In January they collected their second consecutive set of statues at the Eclipse Awards as outstanding breeder and outstanding owner.

The Ramseys had eight graded stakes winners in 2014, three of them grade I winners who were homebreds by their homebred stallion Kitten's Joy—Bobby's Kitten, Stephanie's Kitten, and Real Solution. They raced 13 stakes winners overall, including Vicar's in Trouble, who won the LeComte Stakes (gr. III) and Louisiana Derby (gr. II).

As of Sept. 11, the Ramseys are the third-leading owner by earnings at \$5.3 million (22% winners) and the fifth-leading breeders at \$5.3 million. **BH**

## BAYERN TO HILL 'N' DALE IN 2016

Kaleem Shah's Bayern, last year's Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) winner, will stand at Hill 'n' Dale Farms in 2016, farm president John Sikura announced Sept. 11 at the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association national awards dinner.

A two-time grade I winner for trainer Bob Baffert, the 4-year-old son of Offlee Wild has a career bankroll of just more than \$4.4 million and is still in training for the Hall of Fame conditioner, pointing to the Awesome Again Stakes (gr. I) at Santa Anita Park Sept. 26.

Including the Classic, Bayern won four graded stakes during his 3-year-old campaign in 2014. He also won the Woody Stephens (gr. II), William Hill Haskell Invitational (gr. I), and Pennsylvania Derby (gr. II).

Bayern's 4-year-old season hasn't gone as well. His best finish was a third in the San Diego Handicap (gr. II), but he also has off-the-board results in three other graded tries. He has a 6-1-2 record from 14 career starts.

Details on his stud fee have not been announced. **BH**

## CONSIGNORS FIGHT KENNEL BLINDNESS

When Book 1 yearlings ship in to the Keeneland September sale grounds, it's not only a chance for buyers to compare them, but it's a time for consignors to finally gauge how their horses stack up against the competition.

"I'm on the farm with my horses all the time, and I think I have some nice horses," said Lyn Burleson of Burleson Farm. "But I might have a little kennel blindness because I haven't been able to look at many other horses to compare."

Among the Book 1 offerings from Burleson Farm are yearlings by Speightstown, Tapit, and Unbridled's Song. But Hip 284, a Malibu Moon colt out of French Silk, is already creating some buzz.

"The Malibu Moon colt physically is very special," Burleson said. "He's a very athletic, powerful colt. There's just more of him; more balance, more mass. I don't know who will bring the most money—more than likely the Tapits—but it's just a super-solid set of horses." **BH**

# TRANSPARENCY FOSTERS MARKET CONFIDENCE

With Keeneland's Book 1 yearlings on the grounds and ready for a weekend of showing ahead of the sale's opening session Sept. 14, the mood among consignors is one of confidence.

"We're looking forward to a solid, even market," said Tony Lacy of Four Star Sales Agency. "There's confidence, which was missing in the market for a number of years."

Lacy said the horse industry's downturn and subsequent rejuvenation has created a heightened emphasis on transparency from consignors.

"This game is built on reputation—your word is everything," he said. "Nice horses will sell themselves on any street corner, but higher-end buyers want reassurance from the seller that we're presenting the facts. We're here to provide clarity and create a sense of transparency that allows buyers to invest with confidence.

"Over the years we've lost some good people from the game, but we've also lost some who might not have been as prudent or ethical, too, and I don't think that's a bad thing." **BH**

# WYOMING REVIVED BY HISTORICAL RACING

Wyoming had no horse racing in 2010, the first time no live Thoroughbred or Quarter Horse races had been run in the state since 1967.

Then came historical racing, also known as Instant Racing, in January of 2013, with the first machines operating before the end of the year. In 2014 four racetracks offered 20 days of live racing that generated more than \$1.15 million in total handle. Besides reviving a once-dead racing industry, historical racing is rapidly growing funds for breeders', owners', and stallion owners' incentive awards. The games generated nearly \$454,400 for breeders' awards in 2014 alone.

"This year the Breeders' Fund will be close to \$1.5 million," said Eugene Joyce, president and general manager of Wyoming Horse Racing, which operates three county-owned tracks. "The people who will benefit most will be the ones who stuck it out during the worst of times. They can breed better horses

and buy better stock. It surprised me how elastic this industry is. I could not have believed it would grow this quickly." BH

## HANDICAPPING THE KY DOWNS PICK 4

In this space last week, we talked about the many things Kentucky Downs does well. The Sept. 14 card offers another example of that care, when the track's late Pick 4 will include the day's four stakes races. The track announced late Sept. 11 that the Sept. 12 card would be moved to Monday, Sept. 14.

It's amazing how many tracks will offer four stakes races but not include all four in a pick-four wager. Too many times bettors are asked to wager on three stakes and a maiden-claiming event. But that's not the case today, so no worries.

In last week's column, my Kentucky Downs pick for last Saturday was scratched, which I think gives us reason to fire about a \$50 play this week.

**Race 7:** Closing Bell (4) seems to be the best single in the four-race sequence. Going into the Secretariat Stakes (gr. IT), I had been very impressed with this year's U.S.-based 3-year-old turf runners, but import Highland Reel served as the latest reminder of Europe's turf-running prowess, rolling to a 5 1/4-length victory.

But Closing Bell proved best of the U.S.-based runners that day, edging the accomplished Force the Pass by a nose. The son of Tapit has been improving in each start and even gets in six pounds lighter than second-choice Conquest Pacemaker.

We'll go deeper in the final three legs.

**Race 8:** I think Spring Included (10 and 10-1 morning-line) has a good chance to spring the upset here. The daughter of Include has been running well on dirt lately, but if you look back to her three turf starts, she has a 1-1-0 record with that win coming in a Kentucky Downs second-level allowance race and the runner-up finish coming in a grade III. I'm also including Shrinking Violet (5), Thank You Marylou (6), Theatre Star (7), and Sky Treasure (11) on the ticket.

**Race 9:** This race appears to be the toughest in the sequence. Holy Lute (5 and 3-1 morning-line favorite) is my lukewarm top choice but I'll also include 1, 4, 6, 9, 10, and 11.

**Race 10:** I think the running style of Hyper (2) is a good fit here with some pace to set up his run. He'll be my top pick. I'll also include Bailout-bobby (4) and Da Big Hoss (7).

**The 50-cent Pick-4 play, starting with race 7:** 4 / 5, 6, 7, 10, 11 / 1, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11 / 2, 4, 7 = \$52.50 **BH**


