Into Mischief colt Conquest Enforcer wins the Cup and Saucer Stakes Oct. 11 at Woodbine

'ENFORCER' MAKES MAIDEN WIN COUNT

On his second stakes try in as many starts, Conquest Stables' 2-year-old colt Conquest Enforcer found a hole in a closely bunched field and kicked clear to break his maiden Oct. 11 in the Cup and Saucer Stakes for Canadian-breds at 1 1/16 miles on the Woodbine turf.

Fourth in in the Sept. 12 Summer Stakes (Can-IIT), his career debut for trainer Make Casse, Conquest Enforcer had a stalking position under jockey Patrick Husbands before the lukewarm 3-1 favorite came off the rail for his winning move.

Full House Stables bought the 2-year-old son of Into Mischief for \$210,000 from Warrendale Sales, agent for the colt's breeder Tall Oaks Farm, at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton July yearling sale.

On the same card Colebrook Farms' homebred 6-year-old Niigon gelding Seen It All Before won a stretch duel with Kingsport and survived a stewards' inquiry for a photo-finish victory in the Buntly Lawless Stakes, also for Canadian-breds. **BH**

UNDER TACK SHOW KICKS OFF OBS OCTOBER

The Ocala Breeders Sales' Co. will hold its fall mixed sale Oct. 13-14 at 10:30 a.m. EDT daily. For the second year the final session is devoted to horses of racing age.

The under tack show for a 98-hip mix of 2-year-olds, lightly raced 3-year-olds, and older horses of racing age will be held Monday, Oct. 12, at 10 a.m. More than half the entries are unraced 2-year-olds. Among juveniles with experience is first-out Gulfstream Park winner Final Encore, by Scat Daddy, consigned by Eddie Woods.

Among the 3-year-olds is Boutte Sales' stakes winner Pyrite Blue Magna (by Magna Graduate). The Ohio-bred filly has won three of four starts.

In 2014 OBS' inaugural October horses of racing age session sold 51 head for an average of \$25,814. The \$370,000 sale-topper was Stardom Found, a Tapit full brother to champion Stardom Bound bought by brothers Jerry and Ron Frankel. The colt finished third in an Oct. 4 maiden special weight at Keeneland. **BH**

Charitable Annuity wins the Oct. 10 West Virginia Breeders' Classic at Charles Town

STALLION, RACEHORSE WITH UPSIDE IN WV

Midway through the West Virginia Breeders Classics program at Charles Town Races Oct. 10, trainer James W. Casey, who also owns Taylor Mountain Farm, sang the praises of Charitable Man, who began stud duty at the farm in 2011. Thus far the son of Lemon Drop Kid, who stood for \$3,500 this year, has sired 81 foals, 40 starters, and 20 winners.

"I'm really pleased with him as a stallion," Casey said. "The horse is really doing well."

Less than two hours later it got much better when the Casey-trained Charitable Annuity, a 3-year-old Charitable Man gelding, impressively won the \$450,000 West Virginia Breeders' Classic over older horses at 1 1/8 miles for owner Mark Russell. Viewed by his connections as a racehorse with plenty of upside, Charitable Annuity has six wins in nine starts.

It was also a big night for Donald Duvall. Charitable Annuity, out of the Luftikus mare Early Annuity, is the first horse he ever bred. **BH**

LIAM'S MAP, I'M A CHATTERBOX ON TARGET

Teresa Viola Racing Stables' Liam's Map and Fletcher and Carolyn Gray's I'm a Chatterbox remain on course for their Breeders' Cup appearances with strong works Oct. 10 at Keeneland, host for the Oct. 30-31 World Championships.

Woodward Stakes (gr. I) winner Liam's Map worked five furlongs in 1:00 1/5 in preparation for the Oct. 30 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (gr. I). Trainer Todd Pletcher called it a "good stamina-building breeze" to keep the 4-year-old Unbridled's Song colt on target for his next engagement.

Cotillion Stakes (gr. I) winner I'm a Chatterbox, who is expected to run in the Oct. 30 Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I), traveled four furlongs in a bullet :47 1/5. Trainer Larry Jones said the work, her first since the Sept. 19 Cotillion at Parx Racing, was about "just getting her back in the motion."

The 3-year-old Munnings filly has Keeneland racing experience—a maiden win in her career debut last October. **BH**

MARKETWATCH: FRANKEL DELIVERS AT TATTS

Last week we saw Frankel's progeny compete in their Super Bowl, Book 1 at Tattersalls October yearling sale.

Expectations for Frankel's progeny were extremely high, and why shouldn't they be? For the last three seasons, Frankel has commanded a stud fee of £125,000 (\$190,000-\$200,000 depending on conversion rates). So how did Frankel measure up against other first-crop yearling sires?

During Book 1, 20 first-crop sires were represented by 102 yearlings. Frankel achieved the highest-priced yearling in Book 1—750,000 guineas, or \$1,204,875—as well as the highest average, \$714,892. However, Frankel also had four hips fail to meet their reserves during the sale. These numbers are useful, but the uniqueness of the Frankel scenario requires a higher order of assessment.

Let's examine the net profit generated for the majority of breeders who used Frankel relative to other first-season sires with a minimum of three yearlings sold in Book 1. In this case, net profit has been calculated by subtracting the 2013 service fees of each first-season sire from his Book 1 median price, which is used instead of average to avoid skewing by outlier prices. This calculation gives the minimum return generated by at least 50% of stock sold during the sale. Production costs—assumed to be constant—are not taken into consideration.

The table at right shows that Frankel delivered the goods. Even though his fee as a proportion of his median price was the highest of all first-season sires at 28%, for the hips that sold the net gain was a staggering \$520,425. The next-best figure was generated by Bated Breath (Dansili),

another Juddmonte stallion, with \$308,340. This is another outstanding result given Bated Breath had a lowly 2013 service fee of £8,000 (\$12,960).

The lowest return for Book 1 came from Sir Prancealot (Tamayuz), who still managed to generate \$92,546 above his stud fee for breeders.

Obviously Frankel can be deemed a roaring success for the breeders who sold his Book 1 yearlings. The return on investment generated by his stock is even more significant given the magnitude of his service fee over the last three years, as these breeders took on significant risk and were rewarded for their faith. While the sales results likely will justify Juddmonte maintaining his stud fee for 2016, to maintain the fee beyond next season will require his progeny to step up and perform on the racetrack. **BH**
