What's on the line for the first Triple Crown winner in 37 years?

BC CLASSIC WIN WOULD SOLIDIFY LEGACY

American Pharoah's owner Ahmed Zayat says the Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) is for American Pharoah's legacy.

What's on the line for the first Triple Crown winner in 37 years? A victory in America's richest race would move American Pharoah into fourth all-time in purse earnings among North American-based horses, behind only Curlin, Cigar, and Skip Away. The son of Pioneerof the Nile already has earned \$5,900,300.

He would complete the most lucrative 3-year-old season ever registered by a North American-based horse, passing current leader Smarty Jones who, thanks in large part to a \$5 million bonus, earned \$7,563,535 in 2004.

American Pharoah is going for his first win against older horses in the Classic and his second grade I win since sweeping the Triple Crown. Of the three 1970s Triple Crown winners, only Secretariat won a grade I race in his 3-year-old season after the classic sweep, the Man o' War Stakes on the Belmont Park turf. **BH**

LANE'S END BUYS INTEREST IN LIAM'S MAP

Lane's End has acquired an interest in Teresa Viola Racing Stables and West Point Thoroughbreds' Liam's Map, the Versailles, Ky., farm announced Oct. 28.

A grade I winner in his last start, the Woodward Stakes at Saratoga Race Course, Liam's Map is the even-money morning-line favorite for the upcoming Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (gr. I) at Keeneland.

A runner-up to Honor Code in the Whitney Stakes (gr. I), Liam's Map returned less than a month later to win the 1 1/8-mile Woodward. He broke his maiden by 9 1/2 lengths at Belmont Park last year.

"We're thrilled to be involved with a horse of the quality of Liam's Map." Lane's End owner Will Farish said. "The Woodward is a very important race and we've been very lucky with past winners like Quality Road, Saint Liam, and Lemon Drop Kid that have gone on to be very successful stallions. His speed figures are unbelievable. His ability to go that fast that far is uncanny." **BH**

FEW STUD PROSPECTS STILL ON THE MARKET

While many of this year's Breeders' Cup contenders have stud plans, significant stallion prospects are still available.

Though expected to remain in training after

the Sprint (gr. I), Runhappy is arguably the hottest prospect on the market. The brilliantly fast, grade I-winning son of promising sire Super Saver is sure to garner attention from breeders. No plans have been announced for fellow multiple grade I-winning sprinter Wild Dude, a son of Wildcat Heir.

Lane's End announced Oct. 28 it will stand Dirt Mile (gr. I) even-money favorite Liam's Map. Fellow Dirt Mile contenders Lea (Claiborne), Tapiture (Darby Dan), and Wicked Strong (Spendthrift) also have stud plans.

Most of the Classic (gr. I) starters have been obtained for stud duty—American Pharoah (Ashford), Frosted (Darley), Gleneagles (Coolmore), Honor Code and Tonalist (both Lane's End)—leaving only Effinex, Hard Aces, and Keen Ice as available prospects.

In Turf events, Golden Horn (Dalham Hall), Big Blue Kitten (Calumet), Bobby's Kitten (Ramsey), Karakontie (Gainesway), and Make Believe (Aga Khan) are taken, leaving plans for grade I winners Mshawish, Mondialiste, and Slumber undetermined. **BH**

BC ODDS DIFFER FROM EUROPEAN BETTING

Because Americans are typically less familiar with European form, the morning lines for Breeders' Cup races often diverge from the European market.

Turf (gr. IT) contender Found (8-1 morning line) is a general 3-1 with European betting companies. Golden Horn (4-5), the heavy favorite in both markets, is short as 1-2 with bookies.

Juvenile Turf (gr. IT) favorite Cymric (7-2) is second choice with bookmakers at 5-1 behind Hit It a Bomb (9-2). American favorite Harmonize (7-2) is third choice at 5-1 in the Juvenile Fillies Turf (gr. IT) with most betting groups. Alice Springs (6-1), favored in Europe at 3-1, is fourth choice.

Markets align for the Filly & Mare Turf (gr. IT), where Legatissimo (8-5) is favored with Miss France (6-1) second choice. In the Mile (gr. IT), Esoterique (7-2), Make Believe (3-1), Time Test (6-1), and Impassable (8-1) top both markets.

Classic (gr. I) entrant Gleneagles (20-1) is a general 14-1 with betting groups. **BH**

BC TICKET REVENUE CONTINUES TO GROW

Already the largest revenue-grossing Breeders' Cup in history, the Oct. 30-31 event at Keeneland took in about another \$40,000 Oct. 27 when some desirable tickets being held for horsemen were put on the market.

The tickets were for about 30 of the some 1,500 total boxes, as well as some indoor dining options. Boxes were priced at \$400-\$500 per seat per day, and the Phoenix Room seating ranged from \$725-\$825 per seat per day.

Breeders' Cup chief operating officer Bob Elliston said when personnel began fulfilling orders based on the final fields, there was excessive inventory because some who had reserved tickets no longer had horses running.

"Those tickets were in the prime spots because they were for participating horsemen," Elliston said. "We wanted to get them on the market as soon as possible."

Ticket revenues of about \$19 million this year exceed the previous record of \$10.1 million at Churchill Downs in 2010. About \$5 million has been spent to retrofit Keeneland for the Cup crowd. **BH**

THROWBACK: UNBRIDLED WINS THE CLASSIC

When American Pharoah steps into the Keeneland starting gate for the 2015 Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I), he is burdened by more than just the 122-pound weight assignment. He also carries a 25-year-old family mantle passed down from his great-grand sire Unbridled.

Should American Pharoah win, he will match Unbridled—who on Oct. 27, 1990, at Belmont Park won the seventh running of the Classic—to become the third 3-year-old to take the World Championships' showpiece and the Kentucky Derby in the same year.

As a stallion, Unbridled sired Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I) winners Anees and Unbridled's Song. Unbridled's Song has continued the Unbridled line by adding three Breeders' Cup winners of his own. Unbridled is also the broodmare sire of Tapit, who already has five Breeders' Cup champions.

Unbridled's son Empire Maker sired Royal Delta to back-to-back Distaff (gr. I) titles. Empire Maker's grandson American Pharoah could complete the generational link in the Classic chain come late afternoon All Hallows' Eve. **BH**

FUNDS SOUGHT FOR PA RACING REGULATION

Racing stakeholders in Pennsylvania are working with Gov. Tom Wolf's administration to devise a funding plan for regulation in the wake of ongoing declines in pari-mutuel wagering in the state.

A little more than a year after a top state official said funding for the regulation of horse racing was dangerously low, Wolf said racing could be halted as early as Oct. 31. Meetings, however, were held Oct. 26-28, and industry officials are optimistic about finding a solution.

"We're going to solve the problem and get it done," Todd Mostoller, executive director of the Pennsylvania Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, said Oct. 28. "We've already made substantial progress."

Pennsylvania has separate racing commissions for Thoroughbred and Standardbred racing. Their operations rely on a share of revenue from pari-mutuel wagering.

In 2014 a report by Auditor General Eugene De-

Pasquale said the future of racing and breeding "risks a catastrophic shutdown" if the revenue formula isn't fixed. The racing commissions fall under the state Department of Agriculture. **BH**

WINX LIFTS LATE SIRE ATOP STANDINGS

The Oct. 24 Cox Plate (Aus-I) produced a spectacular winner in 4-year-old filly Winx (Street Cry), who shattered a long-standing course record for 2,040 meters held by former Australian Horse of the Year Might and Power. The Chris Waller-trained Winx utterly dominated in recording her fifth consecutive win. The victory propelled her late sire to the top of the Australian general sires list by earnings.

The focus now turns to Flemington for the Derby Day meet that features four group I events: Victoria Derby (2,500 meters), Mackinnon Stakes (2,000 meters), Coolmore Stud Stakes (1,200 meters), and Myer Classic (1,600 meters).

The most exciting runner of the day is Godolphin's superstar colt Exosphere (Lonhro), who will make his Melbourne debut. If successful against his own age group in the Coolmore Stud Stakes, he may well return seven days later to challenge older sprinters in

the Darley Classic (Aus-I) at 1,200 meters.

The Victoria Derby features a full field of 16 with race favorite the New Zealand-bred colt Tarzino (Tavistock). **BH**

BREEDERS' CUP SECURITY MATTERS

Post-event assessment of the Breeders' Cup World Championships each year entails much more than attendance, pari-mutuel handle, revenue, and the number of winners that go on to garner Eclipse Awards. Much goes on behind the scenes in regard to safety, security, and integrity programs.

Three years ago Breeders' Cup began holding security briefings for the media a few days before the World Championships, and each year officials have made additions or improvements to the overall protocol.

"One of the things Breeders' Cup prides itself on is maintaining the safest and most secure racing environments possible," Breeders' Cup president and chief executive officer Craig Fravel said. "It reminds me how indebted we are to the host track and the community, but many of our examining veterinarians are on loan from racing commissions around the country. It's a privilege that all these people look at the World Championships as their own."

On a normal racing day, Kentucky has six vets, but there are up to 13 for Breeders' Cup as well as a board-certified surgeon on race days. Six members of a veterinary panel oversee the proceedings.

Regarding security, Breeders' Cup has seven investigators working together with Kentucky Horse Racing Commission personnel. In addition to regular Keeneland staff, members of the National Guard will be on hand to assist with security.

In a change this year, out-of-competition testing was expanded to begin much earlier than the customary two weeks before the event,

not only to test more horses but also to meet the spirit of its purpose: "The most effective testing is done on a surprise basis," Fravel said.

Breeders' Cup expects about 50% of the horses competing in the 13 grade I stakes will have been tested out of competition.

This year's biggest change came by virtue of the host site's layout. Keeneland is using its nine-barn Rice Road annex exclusively for Breeders' Cup horses to create a compound of sorts that makes security easier. Keeneland also installed 72 high-definition cameras, eight in each barn, for additional monitoring.

At other host sites, Breeders' Cup horses are scattered around the barn area. Logistics at other host sites make a similar setup problematic, but certainly this year's arrangement is food for thought going forward, especially at a time when safety and security practices in horse racing are undergoing increased scrutiny.

"It's the best possible scenario for security," said Dora Delgado, senior vice president of racing and nominations for Breeders' Cup. **BH**
