#### LUCKY FOLIE STEALS THE SHOW AT DEL MAR

wo-time grade II winner Pretty N Cool may have headlined the \$100,000 Desi Arnaz Stakes for 2-year-old fillies at Del Mar Nov. 15, but another hot prospect stole the show.

Alain and Gerard Wertheimer's homebred third-time starter Lucky Folie shot to the lead under Hall of Fame jockey Gary Stevens, set blazing fractions (:22.48 and :44.99), and did not relent in the seven-furlong test, hitting the wire in 1:23.86.

Pretty N Cool, winner of the Matron Stakes (gr. II) at Belmont Park last time out for trainer Bob Baffert, made a move on the turn but tired in the stretch to finish last of five at odds of 3-5. Baffert stablemate Treasuring finished a game second, a half-length back, after stalking the early pace.

Trained by Richard Mandella, Lucky Folie finished second but was disqualified to third last time out in the Surfer Girl Stakes at one mile over the Santa Anita Park turf Oct. 10. The Distorted Humor filly won her debut sprinting 5 1/2 furlongs on the Del Mar dirt Sept. 6. BH

#### MISS MISCHIEF GETS HER WOODBINE WIN

proved herself on synthetic surfaces with five wins, two seconds, and two thirds in 10 starts. But she hadn't broken through in three previous starts on Woodbine's Polytrack—until Nov. 15 when she won the \$200,000 Bessarabian Stakes (Can-II) for fillies and mares.

Trainer Dale Capuano shipped the 5-year-old Into Mischief mare from Laurel Park off a victory in the one mile and 70-yard H.B.P.A. Stakes on Presque Isle Downs's Tapeta surface. She easily won the seven-furlong stakes in a sharp 1:21.72 as the 5-1 fourth choice under Eurico Rosa da Silva, who won his fourth race of the afternoon in the Bessarabian.

Capuano said the mare, who now has nine wins in 23 starts, excels on synthetic surfaces, so he capitalizes on any available opportunity.

The Bessarabian is named for the mare who won 14 stakes, many of them at Woodbine, in the 1980s. Overall, she won 18 races in 37 starts for earnings of more than \$1 million. **BH**

#### REPORT SHOWS ADW REVENUE ADVANTAGES

Advance deposit wagering companies have enormous and insurmountable pricing advantages over brick-and-mortar racetracks, as vividly depicted by the 2015 financial disclosures of Churchill Downs Inc.

The company's share of betting revenue at CDI-owned racetracks was 10.3% in 2012, 9.8% in 2013, and 10.8% in 2014; however, the share from CDI's advance deposit wagering system, TwinSpires.com, was 19.6% in 2012 and 19.2% in 2013 and 2014.

The company's aggregate pari-mutuel handle and resulting share of revenue come from three sources: on-track, import, and export wagers. Export simulcast revenue comes from bettors at racetracks and ADWs not owned by CDI who wager on races at CDI tracks.

The export simulcast fee is much lower than the fee earned on wagers (on live and imported races) by customers within CDI facilities, and that gap

brings down the average rate of revenue compared with TwinSpires.com, which receives a higher return on bets made only by its own customers.

The rates racetracks charge ADWs for their signals have in general increased in recent years, but ADWs don't have the costs associated with operating live racing. **BH** 

## TAPIT, MEDAGLIA D'ORO TOP COVERING SIRES

If odds had been available on leading covering sires ahead of this year's Keeneland November breeding stock sale, a look at the final sale results reveals a rather chalky outcome.

On his way to a second straight season as leading sire, Tapit finished as the top covering sire by average (three or more sold) at \$1,183,333, led by grade III winner Colonial Flag, a half sister to Breeders' Cup Filly

and Mare Turf (gr. IT) winner Shared Account who sold for \$1.6 million to Reynolds Bell, agent for Alpha Delta Stables.

Medaglia d'Oro finished as leading covering sire by gross, with eight broodmares combining for \$5,355,000. Uncle Mo, currently atop the leading freshman sire list, ranked second by gross with 41 sold for \$5,299,000.

Both of the two most expensive in-foal mares sold at Keeneland November were 4-year-old daughters of Galileo. Terrific sold for \$1.9 million in foal to War Front, and Wonderfully—one of five mares bred to Smart Strike in his final season—brought \$1.8 million. BH

## MEMORABLE CONSIGNMENT FOR HILL 'N' DALE

reaking down the results of the recently completed Keeneland November sale by book shows which consignors succeeded at each book's level.

Looking at consignors with at least three horses sold, Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency easily outperformed the Book 1 competition, averaging \$1,085,227 from 22 sold. The consignor sold eight of the 14 seven-figure hips during Session 2, including \$6 million sale-topper Take Charge Brandi.

Three Chimneys Farm—its figures bolstered by the Regis Farms dispersal—had a strong sale as leading consignor by average for Book 2 (\$243,444) and Book 5 (\$88,308). Excluding the Regis dispersal, Summerfield Sales (\$230,000) topped Book 2.

Bluewater Sales (\$116,333) led Book 3, more than doubling the overall \$54,534 average, and Mike or Pat Freeny (\$116,667) led Book 4 with three sold, registering four times the average.

Excluding the Regis Farms horses, Shawhan Place (\$73,500) topped Book 5 while Upson Downs led the final book with \$42,000, well over Book 6's \$7,930 average. BH

## CANADA WELCOMES FRAC DADDY, SILVER MAX

In a country that conducts three of its classic races on different surfaces—synthetic, dirt, and turf—it seems appropriate that two of the promising new 2016 stallions for Ontario should be the versatile Silver Max and Frac Daddy.

Both Silver Max and Frac Daddy won races on all three surfaces, with Silver Max winning stakes on all three while Frac Daddy won graded stakes on synthetic and dirt and placed in graded stakes on turf.

The speedy Silver Max, a 6-year-old son of Badge of Silver, won 10 stakes including the grade I Shadwell Turf Mile (moved to Polytrack) where he defeated Wise Dan. He'll stand for Can\$4,000 at Adena Springs North.

Frac Daddy, who scored his biggest victory on the Woodbine Polytrack in the Eclipse Stakes (Can-II), will stand at Park Stud, also for Can\$4,000. Frac Daddy is a 5-year-old son of Scat Daddy, this year's second-leading sire of 2-year-olds who ranks in the top 10 on the general sire list and boasts six 2015 group/grade I winners. BH

#### LEVELS OF THE MARKET

ow that the Keeneland November breeding stock sale has ended, it is once again time to reflect on results. Key indicators for the sale were very encouraging: gross increased by more than \$13 million relative to the 2014 edition and average price for each session also increased. Even with these positives, however, the message throughout the sale from those on the grounds was that competition at the top was fierce while competition in the remainder of the marketplace was only fair because of a selective buying bench.


To investigate this claim, results from the last five Keeneland November sales were broken into three categories: the top market (prices in the upper quartile, i.e. the top 25% of prices), the middle market (prices in the middle two quartiles, i.e. prices within the 25%-75% range), and

the bottom market (prices in the lower quartile, i.e. the bottom 25% of prices).

The chart below gives a year-to-year comparison of these figures and shows that gross sales at the top end of the market (as a proportion for the entire sale) increased by 3.4% relative to 2014. Obviously this figure is inflated given the \$6 million paid for Take Charge Brandi, the highest Keeneland November price since Royal Delta's \$8.5 million purchase in 2011. Even with this outlier removed from the data, however, the top end of the market still enjoyed a 2.8% increase in 2015.

Contrary to this result, the middle market decreased 3.1% relative to 2014. Overall, the middle market as a proportion of the entire sale made up 20% of total sales. The bottom end of the market-place also decreased, though less severely, with spending in this range down 0.3%. The bottom end of the market as a proportion of the entire sale recorded a three-year low, contributing only 1.6% of total sales.

So what does this all mean? While total sales increased in 2015 relative to 2014, the majority of these increases occurred at the top end of the market. It is interesting to note the relative increases and decreases observed in all three markets this year are very similar to those seen in 2011. Given the significant performance of the top end of the market in 2015, it would be surprising if this were replicated in 2016. **BH**
