STORMY LUCY POSTS MATRIARCH STUNNER

Steve Moger's Stormy Lucy fired a throwback performance Nov. 29 at Del Mar, stunning a stout field in the \$300,000 Matriarch Stakes (gr. IT).

Blocked by a wall of five horses exiting the final turn, Stormy Lucy and jockey Kent Desormeaux found room to the outside and just got up to catch Recepta at the wire to break an eight-race winless streak. Her last winner's circle appearances came in the spring of 2014 when she won the Santa Ana Stakes (gr. IIT) and Santa Barbara Handicap (gr. IIIT) back-to-back.

Favored Filimbi, coming off an allowance win following a second in the Longines Just a Game (gr. IT) at Belmont Park, finished third. Hard Not to Like, seeking her fourth grade I win at a fourth different track, nearly fell out of the gate and was so far back early she was never seriously involved.

The Ed Moger Jr.-trained Stormy Lucy, off at odds of 65-1 as the longest shot in the field of 14, paid \$132.80 to win. The 6-year-old Kentucky-bred Stormy Atlantic mare was bred by Mercedes Stable. BH

SHONAN PANDORA CASHES IN BIG TIME

I hile the quality overseas runners had no Impact and the local favorite ran well but fell short, fourth-choice Shonan Pandora, a 4-year-old Deep Impact filly, hit the line first in the ¥640,000,000 (\$5.2 million) Japan Cup (Jpn-I) Nov. 29 at Tokyo Racecourse.

Shonan Pandora, who won Kyoto's Shuka Sho last fall for her only previous group I success, finished a neck ahead of Last Impact, who was a neck in front of favored Lovely Day in a blanket

Fifth in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Fr-I), Erupt, a 3-year-old colt, finished sixth Sunday. Trip to Paris, trained by Ed Dunlop to a second in the Caulfield Cup (Aus-I) and fourth in the Melbourne Cup (Aus-I), was 14th. German contenders Nightflower and Ito checked in 11th and last of 18, respectively.

The poor showing by the shippers could impact the Dec. 13 Longines Hong Kong Vase (HK-I). Ito, Trip to Paris, and Erupt are among the 14 entered for that 2,400-meter event at Sha Tin Racecourse. BH

TRADITION CONTINUES FOR GLEN HILL FARM

or Leonard Lavin's Ocala, Fla.-based Glen Hill Farm, the Thanksgiving holiday has been especially savory. On Nov. 28 Glen Hill homebreds won two of three graded races at Del Mar, a testament to the longevity of a breeding program begun nearly 50 years ago.

Family Meeting won the grade III Jimmy Durante Stakes for 2-year-old fillies. The daughter of Sky Mesa comes from a long line of Glen Hill homebreds that are rooted in Convenience, a \$32,000 Saratoga yearling Fleet Nasrullah filly Lavin purchased in 1969.

For Glen Hill, Convenience became the Queen of the West, winning California stakes. A stakes producer, she is separated from Family Meeting by four successive generations of stakes-producing mares.

Hollywood Derby (gr. IT) winner Chiropractor is a product of a breed-to-race outfit's continuing search

for excellence. The 3-year-old son of Kitten's Joy is out of Eversmile, a \$275,000 Keeneland yearling purchase in 2002. Though not a stakes winner, Eversmile has started a grade I stakes-producing tradition. She is also the dam of multiple grade I winner Coil. BH



\$1.15M TAPIT FILLY WINS CAREER DEBUT

The 2-year-old Tapit filly Royal Obsession, who sold for \$1.15 million at the Keeneland November sale, won her career debut at Churchill Downs Nov. 29

The then-unraced 2-year-old Tapit filly Royal Obsession made a splash Nov. 4 when she sold as part of the Regis Farms dispersal for \$1.15 million at the

Keeneland November breeding stock sale to Stonestreet Stables. Less than one month later she stood in the Churchill Downs winner's circle after her career debut.

Bred in Kentucky by Marbat out of the Tiznow mare Rote, Royal Obsession didn't break well in the 7 1/2-furlong maiden special weight test for 2-year-old fillies and trailed through the first quarter-mile. She gradually gained ground while wide under Ricardo Santana Jr. and entered contention midway through the far turn.

Outjumped by the Speightstown filly Speightstastic who opened a two-length lead, Royal Obsession kept grinding away and collared the leader with a sixteenth of a mile to run. She won by 1 1/4 lengths in 1:32.11 for the odd distance on a fast track.

A \$1 million Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling purchase by Regis Farms, Royal Obsession was in training with Steve Asmussen and remained in his barn following the Keeneland sale. **BH**

MR SPEAKER TO LANE'S END FOR 2016

Phipps Stable's grade I winner Mr Speaker will begin his stallion career in 2016 at Lane's End near Versailles, Ky. His first-year fee is set at \$10,000.

Mr Speaker, by Pulpit—Salute, by Unbridled, won four graded stakes and more than \$1.2 million. His record includes the 2013 Dania Beach (gr. IIIT) at age 2. He added two graded wins at 3: the Coolmore Lexington Stakes (gr. III) and Belmont Derby Invitational (gr. IT). This year he captured the Commonwealth Cup (gr. IIT) at Laurel Park.

Mr Speaker's second dam is undefeated champion and 1996 Broodmare of the Year Personal Ensign. Salute is a half sister to four-time grade I winner My Flag, dam of champion Storm Flag Flying; grade I winners Miner's Mark and Traditionally; and grade I-placed winner and sire Our Emblem.

"Mr Speaker has the same kind of class, quality, and ability as the rest of that family," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "It's remarkable how many good horses have developed from Personal Ensign." BH

cheduling stakes on a glutted U.S. racing calendar requires some creative thinking to maximize returns such as pari-mutuel handle and field size. When all-sources wagering at Penn National on a Wednesday night totaled \$2,036,678—at least double the norm it was a sign something is working.

Penn National is one of five tracks in the Penn Gaming Racing Challenge, which links stakes at Penn National Gaming Inc.-owned properties. This year's Challenge, which offered 22 stakes valued at \$5 million, ended Nov. 25 at Zia Park in New Mexico in the afternoon and Penn National at night.

Overall, six "big event" programs—Mahoning Valley Race Course in Ohio was new to the schedule produced total wagering of \$15.7 million, up 25% from 2014. Four of the five PNGI tracks supplement purses with gaming revenue.

This year's winners by points were Fox Hill Farms, owner; Mike Maker, trainer; and Javier Castellano, jockey. Each gets a trip for two to M Resort in Las Vegas. Any Fox Hill-owned or Maker-trained horses won't be subject to fees to run in unrestricted stakes in the 2016 series. BH

AUCTION COMPANIES POST GAINS

ales in 2015 for the four major U.S. Thor-Oughbred public auction companies have rebounded guite well from their levels five years ago when the industry was mired in a national economic malaise.

The sale of the champion racemare Havre de Grace to Mandy Pope for \$10 million at the 2012 Fasig-Tipton November sale was a highlight of the past five years in the U.S. auction market

Keeneland, Fasig-Tipton, Ocala Breeders' Sales Co., and Barretts Equine Sales had gross receipts of \$928,329,700 in 2015, compared with \$713,885,700 in 2011. The \$214,444,000 difference represented an increase of 30%. Interestingly, the number of horses sold fell slightly from 12,564 five years ago to 12,526 in 2015.

Though Keeneland's gross receipts rose from \$468.8 million five years ago to \$535.76 million this year, level sales over the last three years resulted in its market share falling from 65.7% in 2011 to 57.7% in 2015. The company eliminated its April 2-year-olds in training sale during this time, but that had little effect on Keeneland's overall financial picture.

OBS showed the greatest growth, increasing its market share from 10%—when sales totaled \$71.35 million in 2011—to 16.6% in 2015 with gross receipts of \$154.39 million. With the Florida market impacted the most by the recession, the robust OBS numbers show the market also has rebounded over five years.

Fasig-Tipton, which offers a diverse group

of sales in major and regional markets—it has subsequently dropped its Texas sale—had a 2015 market share of 23.8% on sales of \$225.26 million, compared with a 22.6% share in 2011. Along the way, Fasig Tipton's share jumped to 27.2% of gross sales in 2012, the year in which the company sold Havre de Grace for \$10 million.

Meanwhile, Barretts' market share has changed little over five years with its \$12.1 million in sales representing 1.7% of the 2011 total, compared with this year's sales of \$16.9 million, a 1.8% share.

There also have been gains in sale company returns, which can be estimated by applying the industry standard 5% to gross sales and a blended average of 3% on the hammer price for horses that failed to meet their reserves; commissions on those vary by sale and final bid price.

Based on the 3% figure, OBS commissions increased 112% to an estimated \$8.5 million in 2015, with Barretts' \$1.0 million take this year up 53% from 2011. Using those same estimated commission assumptions, Fasig-Tipton took in \$13.0 million in commissions this year, up 42% from 2011, while Keeneland's commission rose 19% to an estimated \$31.0 million. BH
