ROOM FOR ME KEEPS DELIVERING RETURNS

Room for Me has proved to be a clever claim, having been picked up for \$12,500 at Santa Anita in February.

The 5-year-old Harlington mare won the \$100,000 Garland of Roses Stakes by 3 3/4 lengths at Aqueduct Dec. 5 for owner/trainer David Jacobson after finishing seventh in the Oct. 31 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (gr. I).

"She banged her head on the gate in the Breeders' Cup," Jacobson said. "But she still ran a really good race, getting beat five lengths after coming from dead last."

Room for Me, a \$1,200 weanling at the 2010 Keeneland November mixed sale, also took the Regret Stakes and galloped by 13 1/2 lengths in the Videogenic Stakes. From 10 starts in her 10 months with Jacobson, she has five wins along with a third in the Ballerina Stakes (gr. I) and a second in the Vagrancy Handicap (gr. II).

"You always hope they'll turn out to be this good when you claim them, but this has been a pleasant surprise," Jacobson said. "The intention was to bring her back for the Claiming Championship here in March." **BH**

ROYAL POSSE, CASTELLANO TOP 'CROWN'

Royal Posse seized the lead on the far turn and was never seriously threatened again in winning the \$200,000 Claiming Crown Jewel Stakes Dec. 5 at Gulfstream Park.

Jockey Javier Castellano guided Royal Posse to victory in the 1 1/8-mile Jewel, capping a big day for the two-time reigning Eclipse Award winner. Castellano won four of the nine Claiming Crown races on Saturday's card; he also scored with Runs With Bulls in the Iron Horse, Stallwalkin' Dude in the Rapid Transit, and Moonshine Promise in the Glass Slipper.

Looch Racing Stables owns Runs With Bulls and Moonshine Promise, both trained by Peter Walder.

Michael Dubb, Bethlehem Stables, and Gary Aisquith's Royal Posse delivered in the Jewel for trainer Rudy Rodriguez, who gave the 4-year-old Posse gelding six weeks off after a strong runner-up finish in the Empire Classic for New York-breds. Since the current connections claimed Royal Posse May 31 for \$20,000, he has won three races including two stakes. **BH**

HALL OF FAME JOLLEY BACK IN ACTION

Fans could be forgiven for doing a double take on the scene in Tampa Bay Downs' winner's circle following the fifth race at the Florida track Dec. 4.

Accepting the trophy for the maiden claiming event winner, Hot Scot Racing Stable's 2-year-old colt Marrakech, was Hall of Fame and two-time Kentucky Derby-winning trainer LeRoy Jolley, who has been mostly absent from racing the last couple of years. It was the first winner for Jolley—who won the Derby with Foolish Pleasure in 1975 and again with Genuine Risk in 1980—since 2010.

Jolley, 77, has had only a handful of starters since 2010 and none in 2013-14.

"It's always nice to be back in the business," said Jolley, who first met Hot Scot Racing owner Bev Hendry at the Adena Springs Farm stallion show last winter. "It's nice to be doing something worthwhile."

Jolley, who resides in Franklin Square, N.Y., and winters in Florida, estimates he "read about 400 books" during his break from training, **BH**

MALONES STRIKE AGAIN AT ARQANA

John O'Connor was tipped to be a leading buyer at the Tattersalls December mares sale, but he played a circumspect game, taking three mares for a total of 845,000 guineas.

It seems he was keeping something in reserve, for on Dec. 5, at the premier session of Arqana's breeding stock sale, he purchased top lot Embellishment—in foal to Kingman—for €900,000 (\$979,915), and spent another €1,500,000 (\$1,632,525) on four other purchases.

Even a leading vet like O'Connor would struggle to fund that level of investment, but the Ballylinch Stud he manages in County Kilkenny was bought 12 months ago by Liberty Media Corp. chairman John Malone, who with his wife, Leslie, had recently purchased Florida's Bridlewood Farm.

Malone's message to O'Connor was: "Keep doing what you've been doing." And so he did, though

4-year-old Embellishment, a daughter of Galileo out of Coronation Stakes (Eng-I) winner Sophisticat (by Storm Cat), fitted Bridlewood's wish list, so she heads to the states.

The clearance rate on Day 1 was 78%. Seventeen fewer horses contributed to a 5% drop in gross to €15,349,000 (\$16,705,085), but the average price of €103,709 (\$112,871) was up 0.5% from 2014. **BH**

LAWSUIT SHINES LIGHT ON CONTEST SITES

If a decision is made in the lawsuit filed by The Stronach Group tracks Dec. 2 in federal court against daily racing contest site DerbyWars, it could reshape the current landscape in which such businesses operate in a gray area.

The lawsuit against DerbyWars claims the website operates unlawfully by using races controlled by TSG for its contests without compensating the tracks. TSG tracks argue DerbyWars is hurting their business; they're seeking monetary damages in an amount to be determined at trial.

But contest sites, which have flourished in recent years, believe they're operating legally under the same federal law and subsequent court decisions that opened the door for daily fantasy sports, which is also under legal scrutiny. DerbyWars has some amount of industry approval in that it sends players to the National Handicapping Championship.

Without explanation, TSG in the suit limited itself to one contest site when several currently operate. Oddly, a wide-ranging court decision in the case could even impact contests offered through advance deposit wagering companies like TSG-owned XpressBet.com. **BH**

UPDATE: SEVEN-FIGURE YEARLINGS OF 2014

As 2015 nears an end, Mohaymen continues at the top of the list of 2014 yearlings that sold for seven figures in North America and have raced this year.

In all, 16 yearlings sold for \$1 million or more last year in North America, three at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select yearling sale and 13 at the Keeneland September yearling sale.

Mohaymen, a \$2.2 million purchase at Keeneland September by Shadwell Estate Co., has been the star of the select group. The Tapit—Justwhistledixie colt is undefeated in three lifetime starts with two grade II victories in the Nashua and Remsen stakes. Coolmore partners' Air Vice Marshal, a War Front—Gold Vault colt who also sold for the co-sale topping \$2.2 million at Keeneland September, is group II-placed in England.

Four others have raced thus far, including two debut winners. Shadwell's Tathqeef (Tapit—Foxy Danseur), who sold for \$1.1 million at Keeneland September, won at Wolverhampton Oct. 23. Royal Obsession (Tapit—Rote), who sold for seven figures as a yearling and a 2-year-old, won Sept. 29 at Churchill Downs for Stonestreet Stables. **BH**

A.P. INDY TIES RUN DEEP

It's no great secret that Tapit and Bernardini have had very good years in 2015, and last weekend pointed toward that trend continuing in 2016.

Tapit's representatives included Cigar Mile (gr. I) winner Tonalist, who remains in training at 5 next year; undefeated Remsen Stakes (gr. II) victor Mohaymen; and Rafting, another promising 2-year-old who took the Smooth Air Stakes.

Bernardini, already blessed with grade I-winning 2-year-olds Greenpointcrusader and Rachel's Valentina in 2015, added Lewis Bay, who took the Demoiselle Stakes (gr. II).

Tapit and Bernardini, both A.P. Indy line horses, are bred along similar lines: Tapit is by A.P. Indy's son Pulpit out of an Unbridled mare, while Bernardini is by A.P. Indy out of a mare by Quiet American, who, like Unbridled, is a son of Fappiano. The trio of graded winners—Tonalist, Mohaymen, and Lewis Bay—all own rather interesting pedigrees, and ones that reinforce the background of A.P. Indy.

At first glance Tonalist is quite an outcross as he has no inbreeding closer than a 5x4 duplication of Northern Dancer. There are, however, strong connections among the pedigrees of A.P. Indy, Pulpit, and Tonalist's granddam, Toll Fee, who also features as second dam of Horse of the Year Havre de Grace and multiple grade I winner Riskaverse.

Toll Fee is by Topsider, a son of Northern Dancer out of champion Drumtop (by Round Table out of a Nasrullah mare). A.P. Indy's sire, Seattle Slew, is out of a mare by Poker, like Drumtop, a Round Table-Nasrullah cross; and Pulpit's third

dam, State, is bred somewhat like Topsider, as she is by a son of Northern Dancer out of a sister to Round Table. Toll Fee's dam, Toll Booth, is by Buckpasser out of Missy Baba, which makes her a three-quarters sister to A.P. Indy's granddam, Lassie Dear (by Buckpasser out of Missy Baba's

daughter, Gay Missile).

So, while Tonalist is ostensibly an outcross, in reality, 15 of the 16 ancestors in the fourth generation of his granddam, Toll Fee, are repeated in the pedigree of his grandsire, Pulpit.

Toll Booth is also in the pedigree of Lewis Bay, through her champion sprinter son, Plugged Nickle, the sire of Lewis Bay's third

dam. Lewis Bay's pedigree has a closer link to A.P. Indy, however. Her dam is by A.P. Indy's half brother, Summer Squall, giving her a 3x3 cross of their dam, Weekend Surprise.

Mohaymen is out of a mare by Dixie Union, whose dam is by Capote, and is a parallel Seattle Slew-Mr. Prospector cross to Pulpit. For good measure, his second dam is by Honour and Glory, whose sire, Relaunch, is a brother to Tapit's third dam, Moon Glitter. The Moon Glitter-Relaunch combination is already found in seven Tapit stakes winners, as well as Royal Obsession, who greatly impressed in her Churchill Downs debut win Nov. 29. **BH**

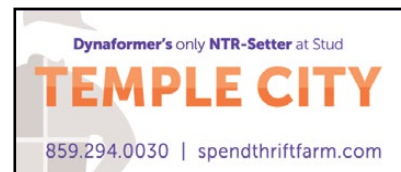


