



Mohaymen puts away his rivals easily in the grade II Holy Bull

ALVARADO'S QUICK THINKING AIDS MOHAYMEN

ockey Junior Alvarado has ridden Mohaymen to four straight victories, and his confidence in the undefeated Tapit colt shows.

A smart ride by Alvarado in the Jan. 30 Holy Bull Stakes (gr. II) guided the Shadwell runner to a geared-down 3 1/2-length victory in a solid 1:42.07 for 1 1/16 miles on a fast track.

Kiaran McLaughlin-trained Mohaymen sat third as longshot Perfect Saint crept the first quarter in :24.64 with Greenpointcrusader to his outside. Sensing the tempo, Alvarado sent his mount between horses to take control as the half went in :49.06.

"He didn't break as well as I wanted him to, but I knew it wasn't going to be a problem. Mentally, he's so mature," Alvarado said.

"I just waited and waited to see what Johnny (Velazquez aboard Greenpointcrusader) was going to do. He left me a little room... he didn't come inside and the horse in front was backing up, so I said, 'I've got the best horse. It's time to make my own move.' After that, it was pretty much over." BH

CATHRYN SOPHIA BOOSTS 2YO ELASTICITY

athryn Sophia's 5 1/2-length victory in Gulfstream's \$200,000 Forward Gal (gr. II) Jan. 30 gave a nice boost to her second dam's 2-year-old filly, Elasticity.

Through Bobfeld Bloodstock, Machmer Hall Farm bought Elasticity (Paddy O'Prado), a daughter of the grade II-winning Unbridled mare Belterra, for \$10,000 from breeder Robert Manfuso's Chanceland Farm at the 2015 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic fall yearling sale.

Cathryn Sophia, a Street Boss filly now 3-for-3 with a combined win margin of 34 1/2 lengths, is out of Belterra's daughter Sheave (Mineshaft).

"It's such a beautiful female family," said Machmer's Carrie Brogden. "This filly had an infection in her knee at the yearling sale, but she's really good-looking. After we brought her back to Kentucky, she responded very well to antibiotics and within 30 days her knee was back to normal.

"I bought her to be a long-term broodmare for Machmer Hall, but now with the update she's slated for the Maryland 2-year-old sale." BH

CAL-BRED SMOKEY IMAGE ON DERBY TRAIL

homebred California-bred chestnut wearing blinkers and with Victor Espinoza in the irons, broke away from the field to win the \$250,000 California Cup Derby Jan. 30 at Santa Anita Park.

Sound familiar?

But Irvin Racing Stables' Smokey Image—who set the pace and cruised to an 8 1/2-length win in the 1 1/16-mile dirt test—has something over California Chrome, who emphatically announced his presence with a 5 1/2-length score in the 2014 edition. Smokey Image is undefeated.

Following his two-turn debut Saturday, the son of Southern Image is scheduled for the March 12 San Felipe (gr. II)—with Road to the Kentucky Derby points on the line. However, some of his connections can't help but think toward the first Saturday in May.

"We have the Kentucky Derby on our minds," said Diane Irvin, daughter of owner Betty Irvin.

SUNNY RIDGE, SASSICAIA SCORE AT AQUEDUCT

aving finished second in a pair of graded stakes last year, Sunny Ridge would not be denied in the \$250,000 Withers Stakes (gr. III) Jan. 30 at Aqueduct Racetrack. The son of Holy Bull outlasted Vorticity after an extended duel in the 1 1/16-mile race for 3-year-olds.

A homebred for Dennis Drazin, an adviser to the operators of Monmouth Park, Sunny Ridge nailed down 10 Road to the Kentucky Derby points although trainer Jason Servis said he has not locked the New Jersey-bred on a path to the Louisville classic.

"The Derby is the Derby," Servis said after Sunny Ridge wore down front-running Vorticity by three-quarters of a length. "But it is not engraved in stone."

Later in the day sprinters took center stage in the \$150,000 Toboggan Stakes (gr. III) where Sassicaia and jockey John Bisono courageously split horses late to secure the neck victory in the six-furlong test. Robert LaPenta's Sassicaia, a son of Bernardini, topped the 2013 Fasig-Tipton Florida sale, fetching \$1.6 million, BH

CONSIGNORS HOPE NEW DATE PROVES PROFITABLE

onsignors are hoping they will profit from Fasig-Tipton's decision to move the Midlantic Winter mixed sale to late January.

The sale in Timonium, Md. was previously held in December but after consulting consignors, the sale company moved it to Jan. 31.

"The thought was that it would be closer to the start of breeding season and there might be some increased demand for broodmares and broodmare prospects as the breeding season approaches," said Fasig-Tipton president Boyd Browning.

The original 167-hip catalog is smaller than the December 2014 catalog's 202. Eventually 165 horses went before buyers at the 2014 sale (110 of which sold for a gross of \$954,800), with the average falling 24% from 2013.

As of two days before this year's auction, 135 horses from the original 167 are still scheduled for sale. The sale begins with 59 broodmares and broodmare prospects, followed by 45 yearlings (including one by Curlin), and 31 horses of racing age. BH

ZABEEL KEEPING SIR IVOR LINE ALIVE

ne of the greatest European runners of the 1960s, Sir Ivor was also an excellent stallion with 94 stakes winners (45 group or graded) from 904 foals. Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Fr-I) victress Ivanjica; the brilliant U.S. filly Optimistic Gal; and champion older male, Bates Motel were among the best.

Sir Ivor was a much better fillies sire—Bates Motel was his only truly top-class son—and with Bates

Motel a disappointing stallion, the Sir Ivor sire line rapidly vanished in the Northern Hemisphere.

The line would have died out completely had it not been for Sir Tristram. In an era before shuttle stallions became routine, it was common for Southern Hemisphere countries

to import stallions with good pedigrees, if less than imposing race-records. Thus, Sir Ivor's stakesplaced son Sir Tristram arrived in New Zealand and became not only the dominant Australasian sire of the era but one of the all-time best.

Sir Tristram's leading stallion son, Zabeel, carried on the good work, earning multiple sire championships in Australia and New Zealand. Zabeel died last September aged 29, but his sire line has been on fire in the last few weeks.

Zabeel's best racing colt, Octagonal, didn't live up to the highest expectations but he did sire Australian Horse of the Year Lonhro. Champion sire in Australia for 2010-11, Lonhro shuttled to the U.S. from 2012 to 2014, and from his first crop—newly turned 3—he's already had two stakes winners, including Pilgrim Stakes (gr. IIIT) scorer Isotherm. Lonhro, whose stock includes Australian champion 2-year-old Pierro, was represented by another

smart youngster when Cohesion took the Blue Diamond Preview Stakes Jan. 26.

Zabeel's heir in New Zealand is the Cox Plate (Aus-I) and Spring Champion Stakes (Aus-I) captor Savabeel. He has already been represented by four stakes winners this January, including Kawi, who captured the Thorndon Mile (NZ-I) at Trentham Jan. 23.

The third Zabeel-line stallion whose progeny has been in good form is the U.S.-born Greys Inn, champion 3-year-old colt in South Africa, where

> he now stands. This year Greys Inn has been represented by Legal Eagle, who took the Jan. 9 Queen's Plate (SAf-I), and Forries Waltz, who prepped for the Dubai World Cup meet with a win in the Al Rashidiya Stakes (UAE-II) on Jan. 28.

Interestingly, Lonhro, Savabeel, and Greys Inn have all benefitted from some speedy and pre-

cocious U.S. elements in the distaff side of their pedigrees. Lonhro's dam was a 2-year-old graded winner by the Mr. Prospector horse, Straight Strike; Savabeel is out of multiple grade I winner Savannah Success, by the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I) captor Success Express; and Greys Inn's second dam is by champion English 2-year-old

Crowned Prince, a brother to Majestic Prince. BH
