GUN RUNNER SHOOTS TO TOP OF DERBY BOARD

un Runner nabbed his first stakes in the Feb. 20 Risen Star (gr. II) at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots, shooting him to the top of the Kentucky Derby (gr. I) points standings.

Owned by Winchell Thoroughbreds and Three Chimneys Farm, Gun Runner settled behind the leaders in his 2016 debut, made his move when asked, and held off the late charge of Forevamo.

"It looked like the track was playing a little bit more inside-favoring. I kept him down there until I asked him to go and he ran a great race," said jockey Florent Geroux.

Lecomte (gr. III) winner Mo Tom closed strongly for third after checking sharply with a tiring Bistraya. Favorite Airoforce didn't take flight and finished 10th.

Gun Runner now has three wins from four starts and co-owner Ron Winchell said the Louisiana Derby (gr. II) is next.

The Candy Ride colt—the first foal of Quiet Giant (Giant's Causeway)—gave his sire a second graded stakes on the Fair Grounds card following Chocolate Ride's Fair Grounds Handicap (gr. IIIT) victory. BH



VENUS VALENTINE PUTS IT TOGETHER

Based on her race record, Venus Valentine appeared overmatched in the Rachel Alexandra Stakes (gr. II)—she was sent off at 74-1—yet trainer Tom Amoss was encouraged by what he was seeing in the mornings.

Amoss said the daughter of Congrats' morning works were better and she had overcome some physical issues.

In the Feb. 20 Rachel Alexandra at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots, Venus Valentine and jockey Corey Lanerie, rallying from last of nine along the rail, registered a one-length victory in her graded stakes debut.

"She's been a bit of a guessing game. She won her first start for us, and we knew she had great raw talent. She was tying up and cramping up a lot muscle-wise," Amoss said.

"We solved this problem...we felt she had a real chance based on how she was coming into the race."

A Kentucky homebred for Rosemont Farm, Venus Valentine is the first starter out of two-time stakes winner Valentine Fever (Stormin Fever). BH

ZICONIC LOOKS A BIT LIKE MOM IN DEBUT

ary Stevens has seen plenty in his long career, but he experienced a first when he rode Ziconic, the son of Zenyatta, in his Feb. 20 debut at Santa Anita Park.

As the Hall of Fame rider brought the 3-year-old Tapit colt back into the stretch after the seven-furlong race people cheered. It caught him off guard because Ziconic didn't win.

"I've never been cheered for finishing third in a maiden special weight before," Stevens said.

But it wasn't a run-of-the-mill third. Reminiscent of his famed dam, Ziconic was 15 3/4 lengths back—last in the seven-horse field—through a half-mile and rallied furiously.

"We knew he was going to break slow and it took him a little while to get wound up," Stevens said. "I was at the three-eighths pole and was so far back. I said, 'Buddy, your mama could win from here, can you?' "

Trainer John Shirreffs said Ziconic will likely land in a two-turn maiden event in his next race. BH

'MAJESTIC' MAKES ALL IN MINESHAFT

allant Stable's Majestic Harbor, an 8-year-old half brother to grade I winner and new Spendthrift stallion Danza, took the lead several steps out of the gate and hung on to repel the resolute Eagle for a head victory in the Mineshaft Handicap (gr. III) Feb. 20 at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots.

"I figured I was the only speed, but he did break a little slow today and it took him a few strides to get himself together," said winning rider Corey Lanerie. "Once he got up front he was comfortable. ...He has a great deal of heart and was very gutsy."

By deceased Rockport Harbor, Majestic Harbor completed 1 1/16 miles in 1:42.86 to improve to 9-8-6 from 39 starts while snapping a seven-race winless streak.

Majestic Harbor's dam, Champagne Royale, was a \$40,000 Keeneland November purchase by breeders Brandywine Farm and Liberation Farm.

Following Danza's 2014 Arkansas Derby (gr. I) win and Kentucky Derby (gr. I) third, and Majestic Harbor's 2014 Gold Cup (gr. I) triumph, the mare sold at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky November sale for \$825,000. BH

STAKES DOUBLE FOR HIDDEN ASSETS' **DAUGHTERS**

idden Assets was already a distinguished broodmare, but she reached new heights Feb. 20, with her progeny winning two turf stakes races in two states.

Cash Control (Pioneerof the Nile) began the double, earning her second stakes when she won the Daisy Devine over 1 1/16 miles at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots.

A few hours later, 3-year-old filly Cash Back (Congrats) took her unbeaten record to three, winning an incident-packed five-furlong Melody of Colors at Gulfstream Park.

Richard, Elaine and Bertram Klein bought Hidden Assets (Mt Livermore) for \$230,000 at Keeneland's 1999 April 2-year-old sale. A grade III winner, she has produced nine winners from nine runners, five of them stakes winners. In addition to Cash Control and Cash Back, Due Date (El Prado), Country Day (Speightstown), and Good Deed (Broken Vow) have won stakes.

Cash Back's sire Congrats also had a spectacular day, with three daughters winning stakes races. The other two were Rachel Alexandra (gr. II) winner Venus Valentine, and Spring Fever winner Haveyougoneaway. BH

FIRST STAKES VICTORY FOR PAULINA'S LOVE

nenefitting from a seven-week layoff, Paulina's Love held off Stormy Lucy to win the one-mile Buena Vista (gr. IIT) at Santa Anita Park Feb. 20.

Racing for the first time since winning a Santa Anita allowance Dec. 30, Paulina's Love settled close to the pace, took the lead turning for home, and stole enough of a break to earn her first stakes victory.

"She's special at this distance and even better when she gets a little time between races like we did here," said David Meah, assistant to trainer Richard Baltas. "Seven, eight weeks is a huge thing for her."

Bred in Louisiana by Jason Hall, Paulina's Love was a \$100,000 Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s April sale purchase.

The 4-year-old daughter of Mizzen Mast is the first stakes winner for her dam, Electric Cove (Spinning World), who is out of a sister to multiple grade I-placed Looie Capote.

Stormy Lucy finished second in her third consecutive graded stakes race since her victory in the Matriarch (gr. I) in November. BH

TOUGH TIME FOR SOME AT **FASIG-TIPTON FEBRUARY**

ount me among the whiners rather than the winners after Fasig-Tipton February. The hammer prices on all three broodmare prospects I claimed exceeded their claiming prices, but carrying/sales expenses meant negative cash flow. Most galling was that the best looking, a big, strong Flatter filly from a great old family, was a buy-back.

Fickle fate always plays a role in a horse trader's finances. Five other fillies my connections

or I lost shakes on (Hips 176, 268, 337, 408, and 488) cost a total \$52,500 at the claiming box and grossed \$206,000 at the sale; no whiners in those camps. After expenses I estimate these five generated a 200% ROI—if you ignore the value of the 500 or so manhours invested in these claims.

An especially good thing was Hip 337, a

2010 Giant's Causeway mare claimed for \$5,000 at Golden Gate Fields and sold at Fasig-Tipton February by Paul Tackett for \$82,000. When she appeared in the Golden Gate entries, I suggested to my trainer that she surely must be a rat. He rated her physically a "must claim" prospect and dropped on her, joining 12 other hopefuls. I can only imagine what possessed the original owner to put her in for a nickel.

More than the usual number of potential sellers joined me in the whining category after the Fasig-Tipton February median fell 21% and buy-backs ticked up from 17.6% to 22%, this on a smaller catalog. Increased selectivity has been cited as a trend going back to at least September Keeneland, and it continued to affect prices at Fasig-Tipton February.

This one sale doesn't necessarily reflect the bigger picture, but then again it might. The explanation for "increasing selectivity" is more complicated than a mere change in basic buyer preferences. Since late 2014 the U.S. dollar index has risen by approximately 20%, making it more expensive for non-U.S.-based buyers of American horses. Since the start of this year, the U.S. stock market has dropped 12% while many

> major foreign markets have dropped further and over longer periods of time.

The U.S. economy has been the strongest Western economy, but that's not saying much, given its modest growth in recent even gotten back to prerecession levels Eastern economies

years. Europe hasn't of output. Most Far

have grown slower than usual. Low oil prices erode the buying power of a significant group of both U.S. and foreign-based buyers, especially from Russia and the Middle East. Thankfully, the U.S. foal crop is not expanding, so we don't have supply-side pressures. Unless some of the negatives turn positive in 2016, I expect bloodstock markets to be more likely to wane than wax.


