AIROFORCE 'HIGHLY UNLIKELY' FOR DERBY

As the 8-5 favorite, Airoforce's tenth-place finish left trainer Mark Casse suspicious.

When Airoforce backed up in the stretch of the Feb. 20 Risen Star (gr. II) at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots, Casse was worried something may have gone wrong, but when the Colonel John colt got back to the barn area, everything seemed fine.

The effort still likely knocked Airoforce off the Kentucky Derby (gr. I) trail.

"The (Kentucky) Derby just doesn't seem like an option," Casse said. "It's highly unlikely."

A debut winner on turf at Kentucky Downs, Airoforce followed with a score in the Dixiana Bourbon Stakes (gr. IIIT) and ran second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (gr. IT).

He announced his Triple Crown candidacy when he took the Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes (gr. II) in the slop at Churchill Downs in late November, where he defeated highly regarded prospects Mor Spirit and Mo Tom. **BH**

WORKS BEGIN FOR I'M A CHATTERBOX

Fletcher and Carolyn Gray's homebred I'm a Chatterbox, second to Stellar Wind in the voting for 2015 champion 3-year-old filly, is back on the track.

Preparing for her 4-year-old debut, she could race in the April 15 Apple Blossom Handicap (gr. I) at Oaklawn Park.

Trainer Larry Jones, who won the 2011 Apple Blossom with Horse of the Year Havre de Grace, said the Munnings filly is a candidate for this year's race.

Based at Fair Grounds with the Jones string, I'm a Chatterbox has posted two three-furlong works.

"She runs good fresh, so we're not so much worried about having to have a prep (before the Apple Blossom)," said Jones, who noted either I'm a Chatterbox or Fox Hill Farms' 5-year-old Tapit mare Cassatt could ship to Arkansas.

I'm a Chatterbox won the Cotillion Stakes (gr. I) last year and would have had another grade I if not for a disqualification in the Coaching Club American Oaks. She finished eighth in last year's Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I) after a troubled trip. **BH**

CONGRATS BOOSTED BY DISTAFFERS

Venus Valentine's 74-1 shock win in the Rachel Alexandra Stakes (gr. II) Feb. 20 at Fair Grounds should have come as no surprise to those watching the offspring of WinStar Farm's sire Congrats.

The 16-year-old son of A.P. Indy already had six stakes winners in 2016, including two at the graded level, and all are females. He had two additional stakes winners Feb. 20: Haveyougoneaway at Oaklawn Park and Cash Back at Gulfstream Park.

Congrats, who stands for a \$20,000 fee, currently ranks second by progeny earnings among North America's general sires, with \$1,363,109 through Feb. 20, but he ranks first by stakes winners.

His top earner with \$195,000 is unbeaten Polar River, winner of the UAE One Thousand Guineas. His other graded winner this year is Santa Ynez (gr. II) victress Forever Darling.

Congrats' top 20 runners from six crops age 3 and older are dominated by 16 females, topped by grade I-winning millionaire Turbulent Descent. All seven of his graded winners are female, including grade I winners Wickedly Perfect and Emma's Encore. **BH**

JAPANESE GRADE I SUCCESS FOR NY-BRED MOANIN

New York-bred Moanin won Japan's February Stakes (Jpn-I) in record time.

Japan's racing industry cards only 15 graded dirt races annually, including the grade I February Stakes, at Tokyo Racecourse won this year by Moanin, one of only two U.S.-bred horses in the 16-horse field.

Bred in New York, the 4-year-old Henny Hughes colt, trained by Sei Ishizaka for owner Yukio Baba, tracked the leaders, checked briefly leaving the second turn, and unleashed a powerful move to defeat race favorite Nonkono Yumi by 1 1/4 lengths over a muddy track in record time of 1:34 for the mile.

"I'm glad that he stretched well in spite of losing concentration a bit after taking the lead rather early in the straight," said jockey Mirco Demuro.

Bred by Empire Equines, Moanin was sold by Hidden Brook to Bradley Thoroughbreds for \$90,000 at the 2013 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga August yearling sale.

Pinhooked to the 2014 Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s March 2-year-old sale, he was bought by Narvick International for \$335,000. **BH**

A spill at Gulfstream Park Feb. 20 will sideline Rosario and Hernandez for at least a month

ROSARIO, HERNANDEZ ON THE SIDELINES

The Melody of Colors Stakes at Gulfstream Park Feb. 20 was marred by a tragic fall involving two horses and three jockeys.

Jockeys Joel Rosario and Rafael Hernandez will be sidelined for at least a month after suffering multiple injuries.

Rosario's agent, Ron Anderson, said it could have been worse. Rosario suffered a fractured wrist and will be out four to five weeks. "We're very lucky it's not worse," Anderson said. "Joel's helmet split right in two, so that helmet did its job and probably saved his life."

Hernandez suffered a broken collarbone and several broken ribs, but there was no damage to his spine, agent Cliff Collier said. Jockey Edgard Zayas, also involved in the accident, has a swollen ankle but expects to ride Feb. 24.

Rosario, Hernandez, and Zayas were unseated when Brandy's Girl clipped heels with More Royalty and fell shortly after entering the stretch. Kandoo, ridden by Rosario, fell over Brandy's Girl and was later euthanized, but the other horses escaped injury, Gulfstream officials said. **BH**

JAPANESE CONNECTIONS HOPEFUL IN LANI

Japanese colt Lani is still being aimed at the Kentucky Derby (gr. I) despite running fifth in the Hyacinth Stakes in Tokyo Feb. 21.

The 3-year-old Tapit colt settled in back of a 14-horse field, made a big move on the far turn, and closed well at the top of the stretch, but tired and was beaten three lengths by winner Gold Dream.

"Things went well by (the) top of the homestretch" said jockey Yutaka Take. "This is the first race since November, and he needed the race."

Bred in Kentucky by Koji Maeda's North Hills Co. and trained by Mikio Matsunaga, Lani won two races from four starts prior to the Hyacinth.

Matsunaga commented after the race that a trip to Dubai for the UAE Derby (UAE-II) is still on the agenda. Connections are hoping to earn enough

points March 26 to get into the Kentucky Derby.

Lani is out of the Sunday Silence mare Heavenly Romance, a multiple graded stakes producer in Japan. **BH**

JUVENILE AVERAGE PRICE PROJECTIONS

The progeny of freshman sires always attract attention at 2-year-olds in training sales. Everyone is eager to see these first foals starting to show their abilities on the track.

Because the first 2016 juvenile sale is only a couple of weeks away, MarketWatch used the 2015 freshman sire results as a preliminary gauge of how this year's first-crop 2-year-olds might sell.

We used two metrics in our assessment: a ratio of yearling average to 2-year-old average; and a multiple of stud fee at conception to 2-year-old average. While current-year stud fee might seem like a better indicator of how the market values a sire now, we actually found greater variability looking at current-year stud fee compared with the fee at conception. We then looked at these metrics by stud fee range (current year): \$25,000-\$15,000 and \$10,000-\$7,500.

Here are the metrics gleaned from last year's juvenile sales: Among the stallions in the \$25,000 to \$15,000 range, their 2-year-old average price was collectively 4.8 times the fee at conception and their yearling average was 89% of their 2-year-old average price collectively. Among stallions in the \$10,000-\$7,500 range, the stud fee multiple was 10.5 and their yearling average equaled 65% of their 2-year-old average.

Looking first at the ratio of yearling average

to 2-year-old average, five freshman sires of 2016 were projected to have six-figure juvenile averages: Bodemeister (\$198,404), The Factor (\$163,665), Union Rags (\$148,581), Jersey Town (\$139,049), and Tapizar (\$107,558).

Most of these averages seem solid when they are compared to the projected 2-year-old average based on stud fee. Of these six stallions, only two have stud-fee estimates that are not six figures: The Factor and Tapizar (both estimated at \$72,000). While stud fee at conception gives buyers a base value and provides some indication of market value, a projection based on yearling average may deserve to be given more weight.

With yearlings, buyers have had the chance to assess the physical make-up of the offspring. Comparing the stud-based price projections and the yearling average-based price projections

does offer additional insight, however.

The stud fee projections are based on actual market results with last year's freshman sires, so there is potential for a few stallions to see their yearling average-based estimates skew upward. To Honor and Serve, Stay Thirsty, and Shackelford all have high stud-based projections underlying solid yearling average-based projections. **BH**


