SUNLAND PARK DROPS DERBY, OAKS IN 2016

Kentucky Derby (gr. I) and Kentucky Oaks (gr. I) hopefuls may have one fewer chance each to earn 50 points toward starts in the big races with the effective cancellation of this year's Sunland Derby (gr. III) and Sunland Park Oaks.

Two 3-year-old races will still be run March 20 at the New Mexico track, which has been affected this year by an equine herpesvirus outbreak, but they will be run under different names. The race for males will have its purse dropped from \$800,000 to \$415,000—and won't be graded—and the fillies' race retains a \$200,000 purse.

Neither race offers qualifying points for the Kentucky Derby or Kentucky Oaks.

It's unclear whether Churchill Downs will add another race to either the Road to the Kentucky Derby or the Road to the Kentucky Oaks. Both races were scheduled to be worth points on a 50-20-10-5 schedule to the top-four finishers. Churchill officials were unavailable for comment March 6.

Sunland Park still expects to lift its quarantine March 9. The track began quarantine procedures Jan. 21. **BH**

OBS RESTRICTS PAYSON PARK HORSES

Ahead of its upcoming March sale of 2-year-olds, Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. says it won't allow any horses on its grounds that have been at the under-quarantine Payson Park Thoroughbred Training Center since Feb. 22.

The effect on OBS's March 15-16 sales is expected to be minimal, said OBS sales director Tod Wojciechowski, who is unaware of any consignor that usually has horses at Payson Park, in Indiantown, Fla., prior to the OBS sale.

The Payson Park quarantine went into effect Feb. 29 after a horse that shipped there from Virginia tested positive for equine herpesvirus.

Also, OBS has reminded all consignors and horsemen of the company's standard requirements of veterinarian certification of EHV-1 vaccination and veterinary health certificate for any horse shipping to the Ocala, Fla. facility.

"Realizing that we have a lot of horse movement in (Marion) county and not just the fact that something may have come from Payson, we just wanted to be more proactive," Wojciechowski said. "It isn't anything out of the ordinary for us. We ask for every horse to have an EHV-1 vaccination." **BH**

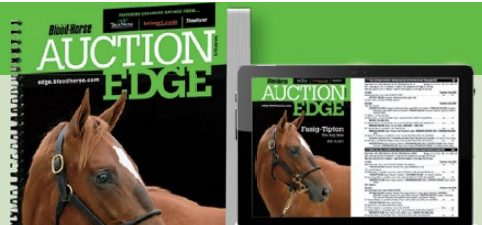

CANDY RIDE'S HOT TRIO OF SONS

With a Derby trail contender in Risen Star (gr. II) winner Gun Runner and ranked fourth on the general sire list, Candy Ride is pretty hot as he works through his 12th year at stud, and eighth at Lane's End.

Also making an impact are his sons—Candy Ride has three sons among the top 10 leading second-crop sires.

Lanes End's Twirling Candy is second with 12 winners and two stakes winners, including Iron Rob, in 2016.

WinStar Farm stallion Sidney's Candy ranks ninth on the list, and his Converge was an impressive winner Feb. 27 of Gulfstream Park's Palm Beach (gr. IIIT). Hill 'n' Dale Farms stallion Misremembered, eighth on the list, has five winners and more than \$260,000 in progeny earnings.

A number of the top performers this year by Candy Ride and his sons have extra lines of Storm Cat in their pedigrees. Gun Runner and Iron Rob are out of Storm Cat-line mares. Sidney's Candy is out of a Storm Cat mare, and Converge is out of a Stormy Atlantic mare, making him 3x3 to Storm Cat.

Burning Sands Stable's homebred 3-year-old Awesome Gent may have disappointed in his career debut at Saratoga Race Course, but since

then he has done nothing but win.

The latest victory—the Jimmy Winkfield Stakes March 6 at Aqueduct Racetrack—marked the first in open company for the New York-bred son of Awesome Again.

Awesome Gent landed a perfect trip just off the dueling leaders in the six-furlong stakes for 3-year-olds but glided up to engage them on the far turn. Though he was under urging from jockey Manuel Franco at the top of the stretch, the Todd Pletcher trainee easily pulled clear to win by four lengths over previously undefeated Quijote in a quick 1:10.60.

Out of the Sir Richard Lewis mare Pawnee Patti, Awesome Gent is a half brother to graded stakes winner Comedero.

Awesome Gent was gelded after his first start last year but since his return in December has won three straight races, two of them versus New York-breds and all on the inner dirt track.

"Hopefully his success over the inner (dirt) continues to the outer track," assistant trainer Byron Hughes said. **BH**

FILLIES GIVE VAR A FEATURE DOUBLE

Former Prix de l'Abbaye (Fr-I) winner Var is enjoying a great run of success, and the son of Forest Wildcat had a notable feature race double at Turffontein March 5.

Currently South Africa's leading sire of 2-year-olds by stakes, Kentucky-bred Var was further boosted when his unbeaten 2-year-old daughter Exquisite Touch made it two from two by winning the Ruffian Stakes. Bred by the Waterford Stud, Exquisite Touch beat winners on debut and she duly followed up at Turffontein, giving champion trainer Sean Tarry one of five winners on the day.

The second Var daughter to oblige was the Wilgerbosdrift-bred Easy Game, who caused a 25-1 upset when she landed the Bauhinia Handicap.

In the process, the 5-year-old mare,

whose dam is by former Irish Derby (Ire-I) winner Desert King, continued the remarkable success Var fillies have enjoyed in the listed contest—Var daughters have won the Bauhinia in 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2016.

Var came close to siring three feature-race winners on the card when his son Rivarine finished a close second in the Storm Bird Stakes. **BH**

CURIOUS CONTRAST BETWEEN SIRE BROTHERS

Stallion brothers will never perform identically at stud. But the difference between Kentucky residents Flatter and Congrats—both by A.P. Indy out of the Mr. Prospector mare Praise—is startling in terms of the distribution of stakes talent between their respective colts and fillies.

There have been numerous stallions that have sired better fillies than colts, or vice versa. But few have shown the gender variation in their stakes-winning progeny than WinStar Farm's Congrats. Of his 26 stakes winners, 22 are fillies.

In 2016, Congrats is third on the sires list with earnings of more than \$1.72 million. He's had six stakes winners this year, all fillies, headed by two that are ranked third on the Road to the Kentucky Oaks leaderboard: Polar River, winner of the UAE Oaks (UAE-III), and Rachel Alexandra (gr. II) heroine Venus Valentine.

In terms of winners to foals, Congrats colts are performing similarly to fillies (35% to 38%). But now with seven Congrats crops of racing age, buyers have shown a preference.

The yearling sale averages of Congrats' first three crops of colts and fillies were close. But between 2012 and 2014, Congrats' colts averaged \$59,751 and his fillies \$78,868.

Last year the difference was relatively minor worldwide, but that's largely because his Southern Hemisphere colts outsold his fillies. In the Northern Hemisphere, 33

yearling colts sold at auction averaged \$48,364, and 19 yearling fillies averaged \$70,474.

All of this is made more remarkable by the fact that Claiborne Farm's Flatter has a relatively balanced profile in terms of the gender of his stakes winners. He has 20 male stakes winners (about 6% of his foals of racing age) and 17 female stakes winners (4%).

Flatter has had very good colts, such as Flat Out, Upstart, and Kobe's Back, and very good fillies, like Tar Heel Mom, Classic Point, and Taris. The yearling market has generally preferred his colts (averaging \$58,000 over his career) to his fillies (\$41,000).

Two brothers whose progeny did show gender differences were Graustark and His Majesty. Graustark had 30 male stakes winners (9% of foals) and 22 female (7%), whereas His Majesty had 38 male stakes winners (13% of foals) and 21 female (6% of foals—still an impressive percentage).

It's possible Congrats' numbers will even out a little over time, something that has happened to a number of sires previously. But the contrast between him and Flatter at present is remarkable. **BH**
