DANZING CANDY SPEEDS TO VICTORY

Almost as if he heard his detractors immediately after the race, jockey Mike Smith shrugged off any suggestion Danzing Candy got away with an easy lead in the San Felipe Stakes (gr. II) at Santa Anita Park March 12.

"He didn't get away with anything," Smith said following the colt's two-length score ahead of grade I winner Mor Spirit to earn 50 Kentucky Derby (gr. I) qualifying points. "If you go :22 on this track today, you're smokin'. And for him to hold off the caliber of horses he held off—(that) was very impressive."

Danzing Candy clicked off fractions of :22.96, :46.11, and 1:11.04 through six furlongs and finished off the 1 1/16 miles in 1:43.04.

He became the first graded stakes winner, and third stakes winner overall, for Lane's End sire Twirling Candy (Candy Ride), whose oldest crop are 3-year-olds.

A maiden winner at second asking in December and a mile allowance optional claiming victor in February, Danzing Candy will stay home for his final Triple Crown prep, the April 9 Santa Anita Derby (gr. I).

"He's three-for-three on this track," trainer Cliff Sise said. "Why would we change now?"

Halo Farms bred Danzing Candy in Kentucky and owns him with Jim and Diane Bashor. **BH**

Destin masters Outwork after a tough stretch battle to win the grade II Tampa Bay Derby

PLETCHER 3-YEAR-OLDS THRIVE AT TAMPA

Racing at Tampa Bay Downs proved to be a good fit for Todd Pletcher trainees Destin and Outwork, who finished first and second respectively March 12 in the \$350,000 Tampa Bay Derby (gr. II).

Destin registered a hard-fought victory after dueling with his stablemate in early stretch and gradually building his advantage close to the line. The son of Giant's Causeway set a track record for 1 1/16 miles in the process, 1:42.82 on a fast track, with Outwork just a length back at the wire.

The top two finishers entered Saturday's race off wins on the same Feb. 13 Tampa Bay Downs card. Destin earned a clear victory in the Sam F. Davis Stakes (gr. III), and Outwork (Uncle Mo) cruised to a 4 1/4-length score in an allowance optional claiming race.

Pletcher said Destin has figured out how to finish races, benefitting from five career starts and three straight graded stakes tries. The trainer said Outwork ran an impressive race in his stakes debut and earned a spot in one of the final classic prep races.

Destin was bred by James C. Weigel and Taylor Made Stallions in Kentucky and was sold for \$400,000 at the 2014 Keeneland September yearling sale. **BH**

MELATONIN CAUSES BIG 'CAP STUNNER

One of the weaker Santa Anita Handicap (gr. I) fields in recent memory seemed to beg for an upset, and Tarabilla Farms' Melatonin delivered in the \$1 million race.

Off at 16-1, the gelded son of Kodiak Cowboy set the pace and pulled away from the field in the stretch to win by 4 1/4 lengths, ahead of grade I winners Hard Aces and Effinex, the 7-5 favorite.

In his prior outing, the lightly raced 5-year-old (he participated in 10 races before the Big 'Cap and made his debut in 2013) shined in his first two-turn race. Going 1 1/16 miles in a Feb. 5 allowance optional claiming race at Santa Anita Park, the David Hofmans trainee cruised to a 3 3/4-length victory.

He also ran second in his only other graded try, the Oct. 15 Eddie D (gr. IIIT), sprinting down the Santa Anita hillside turf course.

It was the first Big 'Cap victory for both Hofmans and jockey Joe Talamo and the first grade I winner for Kodiak Cowboy. **BH**

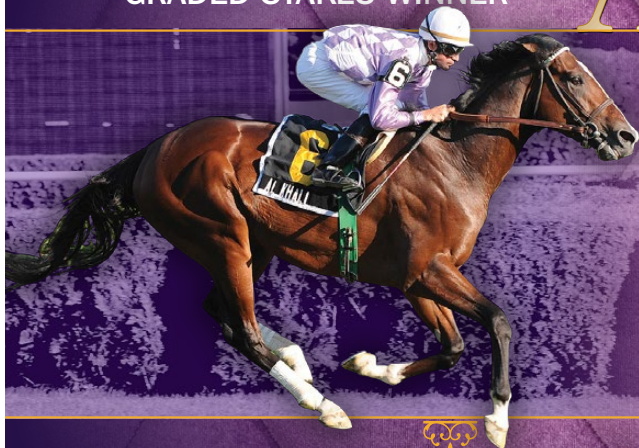

BIG BOOST FOR CA SIRE VRONSKY

With What a View's wire-to-wire tour de force in the March 12 Frank E. Kilroe Mile (gr. IT) at Santa Anita Park, the gelding became the first grade I winner for his well-related California sire Vronsky.

Vronsky, who stands at Old English Rancho near Sanger, Calif., was ranked fifth among California's leading sires heading into the Kilroe Mile. What a View is one of nine black-type winners and the newest of three graded winners for his sire, who has 157 foals from eight crops racing age 3 and older. Overall, his offspring have earned more than \$7 million.

A 17-year-old son of Danzig who stands for \$6,500, Vronsky is a half brother to multiple graded winner and sire E Dubai and Del Mar Oaks (gr. IT) victress No Matter What, dam of European champion Rainbow View and multiple grade I-placed Just as Well.

What a View's win was bittersweet for

co-owner and breeder Judy Johnston, who operated Old English Rancho with her husband, E.W. "Buddy" Johnston, a state industry stalwart who died last May.

"He's in the skybox, up there cheering for us," Johnston said. **BH**

MIGHTY TEPIN ROLLS TO HILLSBOROUGH WIN

Watch out boys, Tepin is coming to town. The 5-year-old racemare—who will again target males in the April 15 Maker's 46 Mile (gr. IT) at Keeneland—set herself up for a big run in Lexington with a powerful victory as the 1-5 favorite in the \$200,000 Hillsborough Stakes (gr. IIT) March 12 at Tampa Bay Downs.

Helped by sizzling pacesetter Isabella Sings, Robert Masterson's daughter of Bernstein broke the course record, running 1 1/8 miles in 1:46.26.

Isabella Sings opened an 18-length advantage by the first half of the Hillsborough in her first start off the bench since a Nov. 14 Mrs. Revere (gr. IIT) win. But Tepin and jockey Julien Leparoux ran her down for a one-length score, closing from third.

"She is older, smarter, and more relaxed," Masterson said. "She can sit back and pick her spot ... she's got the biggest turn of foot you'll see in the last eighth."

Bred by Machmer Hall in Kentucky, Tepin was a \$140,000 Masterson buy at the 2012 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select yearling sale. She is one of two stakes winners out of Life Happened (Stravinsky). **BH**

GOLDEN LEGACY SEEKS TO BUILD ON '15 SUCCESS

Speed at the under tack show isn't the most important thing for Golden Legacy Stable manager Blas Perez heading into the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s March 15-16 sale.

None of the 14 horses consigned by de Meric Sales on behalf of Ocala, Fla.-based Golden Legacy Stable were among the fastest workers at the under tack show March 9-11.

"My main concern is keeping my horses healthy," Perez said, adding that he does not push Golden Legacy's horses to work before sending them to de Meric and the sale of 2-year-olds in training.

"I never squeeze because I don't want to break them down. I want to get them to races. I don't want them to have the fastest eighth of a mile and not show up again."

That said, Perez was pleased with how well some of the Golden Legacy horses worked, especially a Lookin At Lucky filly, consigned as Hip 237, who breezed an eighth in :09 4/5, the co-second fastest time.

"She did not surprise me," Perez said, adding that the filly had shown quickness in her works at the farm even though he had not asked for much.

Noting that 10 of the 14 Golden Legacy offerings are the "real deal," Perez said he believes Hip 57, a Gemologist colt who worked in :10, is fast and will prove popular with buyers. Perez noted another Gemologist colt, Hip 50, who worked in :10 2/5, is a two-turn horse and not expected to have a fast under tack breeze.

A former assistant to Nick de Meric, Perez manages Golden Legacy for

Juan Andres Rodriguez, a former leading trainer in Venezuela who started the operation in 2014. Rodriguez now owns it in partnership with two partners from Spain.

Perez, also an assistant to leading consignor and former trainer J. J. Crupi when he was on the racetrack, said Golden Legacy is quickly establishing itself as a contender in the pinhooking trade.

Among the horses in Golden Legacy's first 2-year-old consignment in 2015 were stakes winners Hollywood Don, Golden Pirate, and Jam N Addy. One of its 2015 OBS offerings, a Street Cry colt, sold for \$750,000.

Perez said Golden Legacy, which has also expanded into breeding and now has 22 broodmares, is consigning its horses through de Meric until it can produce sufficient results to instill buyer confidence.

"We did not want to go on our own until we could build our reputation. We chose Nick because we wanted to go with someone we could trust." **BH**

BREEDING TO FIRST-YEAR STALLIONS

I have a colleague who is a longtime horseman who loves first-year stallions. Each fall he visits farms looking for big, strong first-year stallions with outstanding conformation to match with good-bodied mares, hoping for outstanding foals. Though I point out that 85% of unproven stallions will ultimately prove themselves mediocre at best, his approach has one overarching plus: foals of first-year stallions sell well.

A study I published in the 1990s showed yearlings by first-year stallions selling for substantial premiums over yearlings by the same group of stallions in their second, third, and fourth years. I just checked sales of yearlings from leading freshman sires of 2015 and found similar results when I compared their first and second-year sales.

Why first-year stallions sell well is not altogether clear, though I suspect there is an "advertising effect" derived from their recent racetrack heroics. This effect dissipates over time as new heroes retire to stud. Jamie LaMonica explained to my equine finance class that "blue sky" sells. An academic economist would interpret LaMonica as saying that yearling buyers are risk-lovers.

First-year stallions sell well, though part of this is promotional. Many farms standing these young sires will go to some lengths to protect the value of their first crops of sale horses, and sometimes that means buying selected offerings. This practice is akin to that of publicly traded companies buying back blocks of their own stock to boost stock prices they feel are too low. The influence of such price-protection policies has probably diminished in recent years, however, because larger books have reduced the potential impact a handful of key sales

may have on the averages.

A second factor that causes first-year prices to do better than those from a stallion's later crops is the quality of mares bred to first-year stallions. In most cases the comparable earnings indices and other measures of quality for mares bred to first-year stallions are higher than for the following three years. This is probably the result of a circular reasoning phenomenon: First-year stallions have historically sold well, so why not breed better mares to first-year stallions.

I favor sires whose foals have shown success on the track. But I will breed to the "right" unproven sire. As mares get older, the need to "make" your mares becomes less important. Their remaining useful breeding lives decrease, and the advertising advantage conveyed by one more quality runner decreases as the number of likely future sales horses from a mare decreases. Especially if my mare has produced a good stakes runner, why not climb aboard the "unproven sire" bandwagon and grab some blue sky? **BH**

Melatonin provided a 16-1 shocker, leading all the way to win by 4 1/2 lengths, then withstanding an inquiry over alleged interference to seventh-placed Donworth. Hard Aces ran his best race since winning the Gold Cup at Santa Anita last June, shading Effinex, third in his first start since November.—A.B.


