ICONIC NORMAN CASSE MEMORIALIZED

conic Florida sales and industry figure Norman E. Casse was remembered as a hard-working dealmaker whose efforts on behalf of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co., various Ocala-area charities, and his family were tireless.

Several hundred members of the Ocala and national equine industries attended a March 13 memorial held in the OBS pavilion.

An Indianapolis native, whose lifelong love affair with the Thoroughbred industry began with annual trips to the Kentucky Derby, Casse died March 6 at age 79.

"Norman was a true character, a pioneer, visionary, gambler, bullheaded horseman, breeder, trainer, seller... he was irascible, he was mischievous, but most of all he was steadfast," longtime OBS auctioneer Ryan Mahan said. "Norman loved the entire art of the deal. He loved to win the deal and close the deal."

His sons—John, Mark, and Justin—reflected on their father's life, and Michael O'Farrell, who succeeded Casse as OBS chairman, also spoke.

Casse, who operated the successful Cardinal Hill Farm and a van company, helped start the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. in 1974 and served as the organization's chairman until his retirement in 2006. **BH**

Generosidade wins the San Luis Rey at 71-1

GENEROSIDADE BREAKS THROUGH AT SANTA ANITA

Generosidade was 71-1 for a reason in the San Luis Rey Stakes (gr. IIT) but did have back class—way-back class.

Never better than sixth in three starts since relocating to the U.S., the 7-year-old Uruguayan-bred daughter by Nedawi won a 2013 allowance nine starts back in Brazil and raced in France before moving stateside.

But Generosidade was also a Brazilian group I winner in 2013, 12 starts before her San Luis Rey score, and she looked the part March 13.

Under jockey Tiago Pereira, she raced in eighth the first time through the stretch in the 1 1/2-mile event, began moving up in the backstretch, and improved to fourth entering the final turn.

Racing on the rail, Generosidade took aim at front-runner Havanna Belle—who had defeated her by 5 1/2 lengths in the Jan. 17 Astra Stakes and angled out at the top of the lane. She took command in the stretch and pulled away to win by 1 1/2 lengths.

Quick Casablanca at 10-1 and 30-1 Energia Fribby completed the \$6,197 trifecta. **BH**

AMPLE REASON FOR OPTIMISM AT OBS

Prospective buyers size up 2-year-olds days prior to the March 15-16 OBS sale

ike most sales company executives, Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. president Tom Ventura is reluctant to make bold pre-sale predictions, but he acknowledges all signs point to a robust 2-year-olds in training auction March 15-16.

"You don't want to get too overconfident because you never how financial markets and other factors affect the market, but we're feeling pretty good about what's going to happen," Ventura said. "We're looking forward to the sale. The consignors have stepped up again and have brought us top horses, and they showed up during the under tack shows."

Ventura is justified in having positive vibes for his sale based on performances by recent OBS March sale graduates, solid workouts during the safely run three-day under tack shows, and the amount of activity at the barns well before the sale begins.

Recent grade I winners offered during previous

years' March sales include Stopchargingmaria, Carpe Diem, Jack Milton, and Secret Circle. Acapulco, a group Il winner at Royal Ascot trained by Wesley Ward, and Gomo came out of last year's sale.

Some of the March sale momentum stems from a decision by management and board members to expand the offerings beyond the select label, wherein significantly fewer horses were offered but at much higher average prices.

During the first expanded sale in 2015, 325 horses brought gross receipts of \$55.4 million, compared with 2014 when 201 sold for \$37.6 million. However, with more horses offered at all price ranges, the average fell to \$170,560 from \$187,201.

Ventura said that decision stemmed from the reality that a good horse can come in virtually any price range. There is an appetite for good horses that can run in many different venues, rather than elite racing circuits where most of the select-type horses compete.

"What this sale offers is a large enough group of horses that a lot of buyers can come here feeling comfortable they can buy a good horse that can go out and run, and not just at the top end," Ventura said.


Ventura cited purse increases in middle-market racing circuits such as Maryland, Kentucky, and Arkansas as a reason for demand of OBS 2-year-olds that previously would not likely have been in the sale.

"(Buyers) know they can come here and look at those (2-year-olds by) top sires, but also horses by those sires flying under the radar with good physicals," he said, referring to well-conformed sale prospects by first-year sires. **BH**

TURCO BRAVO AGAIN EXCELS IN STYMIE

Chilean-bred Turco Bravo finished third behind Valid in the 2014 Eight Miles West Stakes—his first start in the U.S.

In his 15 starts since, the 7-yearold gelding has won only twice—both victories coming in the Stymie Stakes at Aqueduct.

Turco Bravo won last year's 1 1/8mile Stymie at 9-1, and March 13 he again captured the \$125,000 stakes, this time at 20-1, the only member of the six-horse field at odds of more than 6-1.

Owned by Winning Move Stable and trained by Gary Contessa, Turco Bravo rallied from last to defeat favored Dontbetwithbruno by a length. Second choice Madefromlucky finished third.

"He trained real well heading into the race," said John Campo, Contessa's assistant. "We took a shot, and it all worked out. Manny (Franco) rode him very well." Turco Bravo (Caesarion—Turkish Queen) entered the Stymie off a third-place finish in an allowance optional claiming race Feb. 20 at Aqueduct. He does, however, also have three seconds and two thirds in ungraded stakes in the U.S. **BH**

RICE LEADS 2015 GRADED WINS BY PERCENTAGE

ooking inside the numbers of the top 20 North American trainers by 2015 earnings, it is interesting to note New York-based trainer Linda Rice led the group by percentage of graded stakes wins per graded stakes starts.

Rice's five graded wins came from 16 starts, good for a strike rate of 31%. Bob Baffert, trainer of Triple Crown winner American Pharoah, was second at 28% (23 wins from 81 starts), and Ramon Preciado third with 25% graded stakes wins from starters (two wins from eight starts).

Training leaders Todd Pletcher (21%) and Chad Brown (20%)—both with much larger stables rounded out the top five.

The statistics come from a feature written by Bob Barry that appears in the MarketWatch section of the March 19 edition of *Blood-Horse*.

Other features in the special section include additional statistics on the top 100 trainers of 2015, a review of the 2015 purses by track, and an analysis on a Thoroughbred's age and performance. **BH**

OHIO CELEBRATES REBOUND OF PROGRAM

The Ohio Thoroughbred industry had reason to celebrate during the Ohio Thoroughbred Breeders and Owners awards dinner March 12 at Darby Dan Farm near Columbus.

Only five years ago the total value of the Ohio Thoroughbred Race Fund was less than \$2 million. This year it's worth a projected \$5.79 million.

OTBO president Dr. Paul Gutheil noted more than 600 mares are registered to be bred this year, about ten times more than before state legislature and Gov. John Kasich authorized video lottery terminals at racetracks. The number of stallions in Ohio has also doubled to about 60 in 2016.

"Farm after farm took off and left Ohio," Gutheil said of the lean years. "Now we're improving racing and the breed in Ohio, but that's not to say we're there yet, because we're not."

The 2015 Ohio Horse of the Year Jac's Fact, owned and bred by Raymond Donald, won seven of 14 starts in 2015, including five Ohio-bred stakes at the state's three Thoroughbred tracks, earning \$303,996.

The 5-year-old son of Ohio Stallion of the Year Kentucky Dane is currently training for his 2016 return. **BH**

TRAINER SUCCESS: 2015 STATISTICAL ANALYSIS

A ssessing the 2015 trainers' statistics quickly reveals that Todd Pletcher had a very successful year.

Not only did his stable earn over \$6 million more than any other trainer—\$26,278,647, well ahead of second-placed Chad Brown's \$20,256,459—his team had more stakes wins, graded stakes wins, and grade I wins.

Pletcher's success wasn't all about the size of the team (only Steve Asmussen and Karl Broberg had more starters and runners). Despite the large-scale operation, Pletcher was fourth among the top 100 in average earnings per runner (his 317 runners averaged \$82,898), and fifth in earnings per start (an average of \$23,380 over 1,124 starts).

Given the size of his team, Brown also did well. With 242 runners, Brown's \$26,376 average earnings per start was second only to Bob Baffert's, whose \$41,809 average was boosted significantly by the \$8 million earned by Amer-

ican Pharoah. Brown's earnings per runner of \$83,704 also shaded Pletcher's.

However, there are many ways to measure a successful season. Average earnings per start is a useful way, and Simon Callaghan and Malcolm Pierce are two trainers who had successful years in this category compared to their position on the total earnings list.

Callaghan, based in California, finished 89th in overall earnings with \$2,073,152. But his team earned the 11th-best average per start of \$15,826. Kentucky Derby (gr. l) runner-up Firing Line and grade III winner Taris, were his best horses.

Pierce's team earned \$2,008,362, making him 91st in earnings, but he was 16th in average earnings per start with \$13,662. He won five grade III races in 2015; two with his Lemon Drop Kid filly Don't Leave Me.

Jimmy Jerkens also performed well in this category, finishing third with \$25,381 despite being 26th in the overall earnings table with \$4,441,629. His average was boosted a great deal by Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) runner-up Effinex, a \$1.7 million earner.

In terms of earnings per runner, Stanley Gold's average is well ahead of his overall position. He was 60th in total earnings with \$2,548,211 but eighth in earnings per runner with \$67,058. Much of this seems due to the durability of his horses last year, which averaged 5.79 starts in 2015, third highest among the top 100 trainers.


