CALIFORNIA CHROME SHINES IN DUBAI

California Chrome shone brightest of all in Dubai March 26, winning the \$10 million Dubai World Cup (UAE-I) in dominant fashion at Meydan.

It took all of jockey Victor Espinoza's athleticism to stay aboard the 5-year-old son of Lucky Pulpit heading down to the line after California Chrome's saddle slipped badly. But the duo crossed the wire without a mishap, 3 3/4 lengths ahead of 2015 UAE Derby (UAE-II) winner Mubtaahij, who edged Hoppertunity by a neck.

"I was just trying to keep my balance and not move my body," Espinoza said. "I kept looking forward and thinking 'where's the wire?' It was not coming fast enough.

"Today proves how he can run when he's 100 percent ... He won easy."

With the victory—redemption for his 2015 Dubai World Cup loss to Prince Bishop—California Chrome became the richest North American racehorse of all (continued on page 3)

time. The \$6 million winner's share pushed the chestnut's earnings to \$12,532,650, eclipsing 2008 Dubai World Cup winner Curlin's \$10,501,800.

"He's a once-in-a-lifetime horse for me," trainer Art Sherman said. "I'm just elated. I've always wanted to run this horse as a 5-year-old, because that's the best year a horse can have. And in our world right now, we don't have the handicap horses any more ... I'm just so happy that it gives racing a big boost to have a horse like that."

California Chrome, who stopped the clock in 2:01.83 (a track record on the dirt course installed for the 2015 meeting at Meydan), won't rest on his laurels. The Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) at the end of the year lies ahead, perhaps even followed by a run at the \$12 million Pegasus World Championship in January, should that race materialize as envisioned by Frank Stronach.

"The big target is the Breeders' Cup, and we've already been contacted about the race in January, the \$12 million race, and if they put that together, we'll go for that," co-owner Perry Martin said.

Sherman mentioned the Pacific Classic (gr. I) is a possibility as well.

California Chrome is set to retire to stud at Taylor Made Farm when his racing days are done, as the Kentucky operation along with multiple shareholders owns 30% interest. He will depart Dubai March 31 for quarantine in Chicago, and will van from there to Taylor Made for some R&R. He is expected to return to California in about 30 days. **BH**

LANI KENTUCKY BOUND AFTER UAE DERBY WIN

Add one more son of Tapit to the list of contenders for this year's Kentucky Derby (gr. I).

Bred in the Bluegrass and trained in Japan, Lani picked up 100 points on the Road to the Kentucky Derby with his March 26 UAE Derby (UAE-II) score in Dubai. Yoko Maeda's colt is Kentucky bound for the Run for the Roses.

"Of course, we will go to the Kentucky Derby, and I'd like to get the first prize," said Koki Maeda, son of owner Yoko Maeda, after Lani recovered from stumbling at the start to gallop last-to-first, a half-length winner over Polar River. The final time for the 1,900-meters (about 1 3/16 miles) was 1:58.44.

Lani is the second runner to target the Kentucky Derby for Japan. In 1995 Ski Captain finished 14th under jockey Yutaka Take, who was aboard Lani in the UAE Derby and who will pilot the gray colt in Louisville. Trainer Mikio Matsunaga said Lani should leave for Kentucky around March 30.

AUSSIE VETERAN TAKES AL QUOZ SPRINT

After a couple of years chasing undefeated champion Black Caviar, hardy Australian veteran Buffering has become a world-beater.

The 8-year-old beat a quality field in the 1,000-meter (about five-furlong) Al Quoz Sprint (UAE-I), getting

up by three-quarters of a length ahead of Ertijaal and Hong Kong Sprint champion Peniaphobia. Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (gr. IT) runner-up Lady Shipman finished seventh.

Buffering took 18 attempts to win a group I race—but his placings include three behind Black Caviar and four behind her toughest opponent, Hay List.

Once they were gone, however, he shone, winning seven group I races.

"He's such a popular horse back home. I think it is part of our Aussie psyche as he was an underdog for so long," trainer Rob Heathcote said of the gelding by Mossman, a son of Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I) winner Success Express.

"He has taken on the best in the world today, and I'm just damn proud of him."

A great bargain, Buffering was a Aus\$22,000 (\$15,241) 2009 Magic Millions March yearling sale purchase. He's earned \$6,425,478 after winning 20 of 52 starts. **BH**

GUN RUNNER EXPLODES IN LOUISIANA DERBY

Gun Runner put himself into serious Kentucky Derby (gr. I) contention with an easy victory in the Louisiana Derby (gr. II) at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots March 26.

Having trailed pacemaking Candy My Boy, he took over at the top of the stretch, powering away to win by 4 1/2 lengths from Tom's Ready.

"He is so easy to manage and has so many gears," jockey Florent Geroux said. "Hopefully we can make a nice run the first Saturday in May."

Dazzling Gem finished third, ahead of Mo Tom, who for the second consecutive race suffered interference while seeking a path on the rail.

Gun Runner, by Candy Ride, is out of the grade II stakes-winning Giant's Causeway mare Quiet Giant from the family of Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) winner Saint Liam.

Bred by Besilu Stables, Gun Runner was acquired by Three Chimneys Farm in August 2014. Three Chim-

neys later sold a half share to Winchell Thoroughbreds via EA Bloodstock.

LAND OVER SEA ROLLS IN FAIR GROUNDS OAKS

After finishing behind Songbird in five straight races, Land Over Sea found the going easier away from the champion filly, surging past Adore to win the \$400,000 Fair Grounds Oaks (gr. II) March 26.

Trained by Doug O'Neill, Land Over Sea entered Saturday's 1 1/16-mile Kentucky Oaks (gr. I) prep off a runner-up Santa Ysabel (gr. I) finish at Santa Anita Park, where the Bellamy Road filly finished 3 3/4 lengths behind.

Having hit the board in four graded stakes, Land Over Sea nailed down her first graded win, completing the 1 1/16-miles at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots for jockey John Velazquez in 1:44.74.

"It did look like Adore wasn't going to give up the lead, so I got a little worried for a second that we were going to run second again to a nice filly," O'Neill said. "Johnny kept after her, and Land Over Sea loved the long stretch and really took advantage of it. There was no quit in her. So grateful to the Reddams for giving me this filly and the opportunity."

Dream Dance finished fast to take second from Adore. **BH**

GULFSTREAM SETS RECORD PICK 6 POOL

North American Pick 6 wagering records were set March 26 at Gulfstream Park, spurred by a scheduled 20-cent Rainbow 6 mandatory payout that yielded a payoff of \$89,456.54 to 147 ticketholders with all six winners.

When betting on the popular multi-race wager concluded prior to the first leg of the Rainbow 6, which spanned races seven through 12, the pool swelled to \$15,285,707, shattering the Pick 6 pool record of \$10,870.852 set at defunct Hollywood Park July 2, 2007, when a three-day carryover of \$3.2 million was at stake.

Gulfstream officials said \$10,782,375 was wagered on the Rainbow 6 Saturday, eclipsing the \$7,596,347 wagered on the \$2 Pick 6 at Hollywood in 2007.

A Rainbow 6 carryover of \$4.5 million served as an incentive for bettors, who wagered \$25.9 million on the 12-race program. Other than Florida Derby (gr. I) day, the total pari-mutuel handle is a record for a single day since the rebuilt Gulfstream opened in 2006.

The past two Florida Derby programs handled \$27.2 million and \$26.8 million, respectively, track officials said. **BH**

STALLIONS & BLOODSTOCK COMMENTARY

ACCURACY OF AVERAGE EARNINGS INDEX

I've often seen the phrase "he moves his mares up" in stallion advertisements reporting that a stallion's AEI (Average Earnings Index) is greater than the CI (Comparable Index) of mares bred.

Some years ago I set out to estimate what a stallion's "true AEI" was, where "true AEI" is defined as the stallion's AEI if he bred mares whose genetics were equal. After all, a stallion rarely "moves up" all the mares in his book.

He moves up many lower-quality mares by giving them his relatively better genes, but he typically "moves down" some higher-quality mares because his genes are inferior to theirs. A stallion's "true AEI" is observed only when his reported AEI equals the mares' CI.

"True AEIs" can be estimated if you have a good data base and ample time to investigate. I used data from 66 commercial or near-commercial late 1990s stallions to plot and analyze each stallion's AEIs for subsets of mares they bred using mare CI deciles arranged from lowest to highest. A representative pattern appears below.

The .16 slope line (estimated using regression analysis) represents the average of the relationship between AEI and CI for all 66 stallions. There were anomalous stallions that produced the highest AEI from the lowest CI decile of mares, and a small number of stallions where the line of best fit was much steeper.

Such outliers are attributable to variable results from one foal to the next, even when holding

constant as many factors as possible. The preponderance of stallions exhibited patterns with slopes similar to that shown in the diagram.

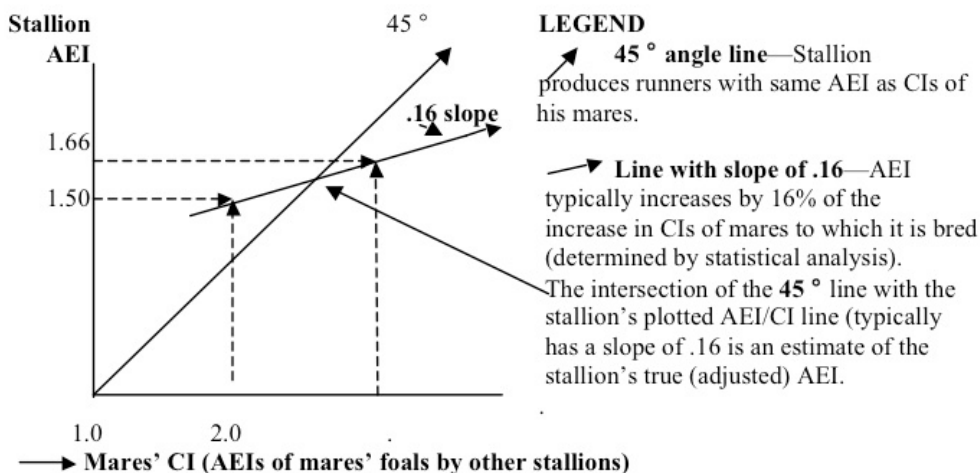
Low, medium, and high-AEI stallions generated no appreciable differences in slopes though their lines of best fit were lower, similar, and higher, respectively, when compared to the level of the line in the diagram.

In 2016, the relationships between AEI and CI have been compressed as both have fallen at the top and middle due to larger stallion books, fewer starts, and fewer wins per runner, especially for top-level runners.

Fewer starts by top runners lower the AEIs of better stallions while larger books move better stallions down the AEI and CI chains. In 2016, the average low-end commercial stallion is almost surely better than 20 years ago because large books have crowded out weaker stallions. More on the implications of this research next week.




