## FILLIES CAN'T BE SEPARATED

Not one but two 4-year-old fillies secured their first stakes wins May 28 at Churchill Downs when Diva Express and I'm a Looker earned the dead-heat victory in the \$100,000 Winning Colors Stakes (gr. III).

I'm a Looker and jockey Robby Albarado appeared to get the advantage on Diva Express in deep stretch as those two duelled to the line, but the latter, under Julien Leparoux, rallied back on the inside in the final strides to earn the dead-heat win.

"I thought he (Albarado) beat me. He got in front of me in the stretch," Leparoux said. "The only thing I knew is that she put her head down at the wire, and when it takes that much time to look at the photo you always hope for a dead-heat."

Albarado liked how I'm a Looker ran as she rallied from sixth early as 4-5 favorite Enchanting Lady completed a quarter mile in :21.26 and a half mile in :44.28 before fading to fifth.

"She ran super. I loved the pace up front and I had a really, really, really good trip," Albarado said. "She brought her patented run like she always does; you've got to time it good with her."

The six-furlong race for fillies and mares marked the stakes debut for John Oxley's Diva Express, while Glenmare Farm's I'm a Looker previously finished third in last year's Lexus Raven Run Stakes (gr. II) at Keeneland and Azalea Stakes (gr. III) at Gulfstream Park. Diva Express is trained by Mark Casse and Patrick Dupuy conditions I'm a Looker.

"We're very excited about the win," said Casse assistant Norman Casse. "I was under the impression that we got beat but we got our nose down at the right time. It's great to finally get a stakes victory with her."

The dead-heat winners completed six furlongs in 1:09.49.

"She ran a great race and Robby rode a great race on her. He saved ground on her. I'm tickled to get the dead-heat. It looked like she won, but I'll take it," Dupuy said. "She's a nice filly. She trained great since the last race and she's never looked this good. Hopefully she's got one or two more in her like this."

Bred in Kentucky by Martin Cherry, Diva Express is a daughter of Afleet Express—Phi Beta Diva, by Mr. Greeley. I'm a Looker was bred in Kentucky by Emilie Gerlinde Fojan and Bona Terra Stud. She's a daughter of Henny Hughes—Our Mariella, by Victory Gallop.

Casse went to \$260,000 to land Diva Express for Oxley at the 2014 Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. spring sale of 2-year-olds in training from the Eisaman Equine consignment. Chester Miller of Glenmare Farm landed I'm a Looker for \$4,500 at the 2013 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky winter mixed sale from the Bona Terra Stud consignment. **BH**

## FLIPCUP ADDS TO SYNTHETIC TRACK RECORD

Flipcup, who takes things to another level when racing on all-weather surfaces, held off a stretch challenge from favorite No Fault of Mine to win the \$100,000 Arlington Matron Stakes (gr. III) by a neck May 28 at Arlington International Racecourse.

With the win in Saturday's 1 1/8-mile race for fillies and mares 3 and older, Team Penney Racing, Wachtel Stable, and Brous Stable's Flipcup improved her record on synthetic tracks to 5-1-1 from seven career starts. In winning her 5-year-old season debut, the daughter of Milwaukee Brew has won her past three Polytrack starts, all stakes.

With Christopher Emigh aboard Saturday, Flipcup saved ground while racing fourth through a half-mile in :49.29 set by by longshot Tiz Lately. Emigh angled Flipcup out three wide in the far turn where she surged to the lead in early stretch.

"I had the inside post, so I just kept her relaxed and found a good spot, and I got lucky that I got outside on the far turn," Emigh said. "She was just relaxed, so easy. I knew I had some horse left and it was a good horse race down the lane."

Racing about four wide through the stretch, Flipcup was challenged to her outside in the upper stretch by Lothenbach Stables' No Fault of Mine and jockey Carlos Marquez Jr., but the 9-5 favorite couldn't get past a determined Flipcup, who angled out a bit in the stretch in securing the narrow win. In grabbing her second grade III victory, Flipcup completed 1 1/8 miles in 1:51.32.

"I had the best trip," Marquez said. "The horse was drifting in front of me and kept coming out, and I got beat a big head. I think if (the winner) had run a straight course my horse would have won, but they kept drifting under a left-handed whip and I ended up in the eight path. I thought I had more horse but she hung a little bit. She tried hard and I can't take anything away from her. That's horse racing."

Trained by Racing Hall of Famer Bill Mott, Flipcup closed out 2015 with a fifth-place finish in the Bay Ridge Stakes for New York-breds on the Aqueduct Racetrack inner track. That effort followed wins in the Classy 'n Smart Stakes and Maple Leaf Stakes (Can-III), both on the Woodbine Polytrack.

Flipcup returned \$12.20 to win, \$5.40 to place, and \$3.20 to show while No Fault of Mine returned \$3.60 and \$2.60. Recent Hilliard Lyons Doubledogdare Stakes (gr. III) winner Brooklynsway raced last of nine early after stumbling at the start before rallying to finish third. She paid \$2.60 to show.

Bred in New York by Team Penney Racing, Flipcup is out of the Touch Gold mare Dream Affair, who has produced three other starters, all winners. **BH**

## ALGORITHMS OFF THE MARK IN U.S.

Impressive Pimlico Race Course maiden special weight race winner Recruiting Ready is the first North American winner for Claiborne Farm's first-season stallion Algorithms.

Jockey Edgar Prado took the 2-year-old colt directly to the front in the 4 1/2-furlong race and he never looked in danger. He had an eight-length lead at the top of the stretch and wasn't ridden out to win by 10 1/4 lengths.

He is his sire's second winner following Storm of Race, a winner in Russia earlier in May.

Bred by Claiborne Farm, Recruiting Ready is out of Need (Strong Hope), a daughter of the multiple grade III-winning mare Trip (Lord At War).

Bought by agent Jack Hester at the 2015 Keeneland September yearling sale for \$110,000, Recruiting Ready was a \$240,000 RNA at the Fasig-Tipton Florida sale in March.

Algorithms, by Bernardini, was undefeated in three starts. He was considered a colt of classic

potential after winning the Holy Bull Stakes (gr. III) by five lengths, but an injury ended his career.

A full brother to grade I winner Greenpointcrusader and a half brother to four other stakes winners, including grade I winner Justin Phillip, Algorithms stands for a 2016 fee of \$5,000. **BH**

## ENOLA GRAY MAINTAINS UNBEATEN RECORD

Stepping up into stakes competition off a standout debut score, Nick Alexander's homebred Enola Gray didn't disappoint in the \$200,000 Melair Stakes May 28 at Santa Anita Park.

The 3-year-old daughter of Grazen trained by Phil D'Amato broke from the rail and took command early in the 1 1/16-mile dirt test for California-bred or -sired 3-year-old fillies—her first try at two turns—and was never seriously challenged en route to a 2 1/4-length victory under jockey Tyler Baze.

"She did it in hand, I thought," D'Amato said. "Tyler rode her very confidently and we did what we needed to do."

Enola Gray, who won her 6 1/2-furlong debut April 10 by 16 1/4 lengths, went off at 1-9 and finished the 1 1/16 miles in 1:42.64.

"Today she was about seeing if she could go the mile and a sixteenth and it was about getting here out there, getting her to relax and take some breaths," Baze said. "She did. She learns so fast and she only continues to get better."

## SECOND ECLIPSE FOR ARE YOU KIDDING ME

**B**ack home at Woodbine, Ronald Kirk, John Bates, and Michael Riordan's Are You Kidding Me thrived like it was 2015 in the \$200,000 Eclipse Stakes (Can-II) May 28.

In his second start of 2016, last year's champion Canadian older horse set the pace with pressure through almost all of the 1 1/16-mile race over the synthetic main track and pulled away late to win the Eclipse for the second straight year. His first start of the year was an eighth-place finish in the Maker's 46 Mile Stakes at Keeneland (gr. IT).

Under jockey Alan Garcia, the Roger Attfield-trained 6-year-old son of Run Away and Hide set fractions of :25.51, :50.50, and 1:14.91 through six furlongs, with Melmich within a half-length. Melmich moved up, head-to-head with the leader in the final turn, and the two battled into the stretch, but Are You Kidding Me found more on the inside and prevailed to win by two lengths, ahead of closing Breaking Lucky, who came in 1 1/4 lengths ahead of Melmich. The winner hit the wire in 1:44.95.

It was Are You Kidding Me's fourth graded stakes win at Woodbine since June of last year, when he won the Eclipse for the first time. He now has a 7-3-6 record from 26 starts, with earnings of \$755,190.

Are You Kidding Me hadn't led early in a race since the 2014 Durham Cup (Can-III) at Woodbine, where he finished third, but did win in frontrunning fashion in the 2013 Kent Stakes (gr. IIIT) at Delaware Park.

"He won in Delaware wire to wire and I saw in the program that there was no speed, so Roger (Attfield) said 'You know the horse very well, so go ahead,' " Garcia said. "It worked out good. It was a slow pace. It was comfortable, and turning for home I asked him to go, and he took off.

"When I was feeling my horse so comfortable after the first quarter, I thought I was home free. He was so happy to be up there and I only had to wait to the quarter pole to let him run."

Florida Won finished an even fourth, followed by Peyton and Ami's Holiday to complete the order of finish.

The winner paid \$4.60, \$3.20, and \$2.50 across the board. Breaking Lucky brought \$4.80 and \$3, and Melmich delivered \$2.40 to show. **BH**

## EXAGGERATOR TEAM PLEASED WITH GALLOP

After two days of walking, Preakness Stakes (gr. I) winner Exaggerator returned to the track with an easy morning gallop at Pimlico Race Course May 28.

Julie Clark, assistant to California-based trainer Keith Desormeaux, said the multiple grade I winner went just more than a mile on the main track, a venue where a week earlier he upset Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I) winner Nyquist.

"He's fabulous. He's his usual self. He was actually very relaxed on the track," Clark said. "He's gotten a little more comfortable out there and galloped around easy, came back, and came out here to graze after he cooled out.

"He's pretty happy. It's nice and quiet, so I think he really enjoys it here. It's a nice break before we hit Belmont and gear back up."

Morning temperatures were in the 70s in Baltimore, where the high was expected to approach 90 degrees. Clark said Exaggerator has handled the heat well.

"He was maybe blowing a little more than normal

but wasn't sweaty. It was just starting to get warm," Clark said. "The horses before and after him came back a little more sweaty than he was, but I think he's a lot more fit than them, so it doesn't affect him as much."

Clark said the plan is for Exaggerator to walk May 29 before leaving around 7 a.m. for Belmont Park, where he is scheduled to make his next start in the last and longest leg of the Triple Crown, the 1 1/2-mile Belmont Stakes (gr. I) June 11.

While in New York, Exaggerator will be stabled with trainer Mark Casse's horses.

"I went and checked it out while I was over there, and it's great. They've redone all those barns and there's a jogging track in there," Clark said. "It's secluded and quiet, so I think he'll like it."

Meanwhile, Reddam Racing's Nyquist walked the shedrow at Pimlico's Barn D Saturday morning and will continue to do so until his scheduled June 5 return to California.

Nyquist exited a third-place finish in the Preakness, his first loss in nine starts, with an elevated white blood cell count that has forced him to miss a planned run in the Belmont. **BH**

## ROMANS PAIR IN GREAT SHAPE FOR BELMONT

**T**rainer Dale Romans invoked the name of Hall of Fame trainer H. Allen Jerkens the morning of May 28, a fitting move considering he had just gone old school in preparing his two Belmont Stakes (gr. I) hopefuls.

Romans worked both multiple grade I winner Brody's Cause and Preakness Stakes (gr. I) runner-up Cherry Wine at Churchill Downs, declaring each ready to go for the Triple Crown's final leg June 11.

With assistant Tammy Fox in the irons, Brody's Cause clocked a mile in 1:42, posting splits of :37 3/5, :49 4/5, 1:02 2/5, and 1:28 4/5, with a gallop out to 1 1/8 miles in 1:56 2/5.

Moments earlier Cherry Wine showed he had bounced out of his classic effort in good form when he clocked a four-furlong move in :49 3/5, posting splits of :12 3/5 and :37 2/5 with a gallop out to five furlongs in 1:03 with exercise rider Faustino Aguilar aboard.

That Romans worked Cherry Wine back a week after his Preakness run is a sign of just how good the trainer feels about the son of Paddy O'Prado. And while Brody's Cause is coming off a seventh-place finish in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I), Romans said his confidence hasn't waned where the son of Giant's Causeway is concerned.

"I wanted to have a lot of the heavy lifting done before we got up (to New York)," Romans said. "Brody was seventh out of 20 (in the Kentucky Derby) and I'm proud of him. I've been training him like he wants to go a mile and a half and

trying to teach him to do it. Today's work was spectacular. He went around just as easy as could be at every pole.

"I think he's got a big shot. And Cherry Wine has a big shot too. We don't normally work back that quick, but he's such a good horse and doing so good. The key is you have to teach them to go a mile and a half. That's what Allen Jerkens told me. You have to try and get them mentally ready to be focused for as long as it takes to run a mile and a half."


Cherry Wine handled the off going in the Preakness with no issue, but he also notched a six-length win in a Gulfstream Park allowance race over a fast surface. His late kick has been the colt's bread and butter, but Romans said both of his charges are capable of being closer to the lead should little pace materialize in the Belmont.

Romans said Brody's Cause and Cherry Wine will likely ship to New York May 31 and have their final works at Belmont Park next weekend. **BH**

## **LEXIE LOU, STRUT THE COURSE CLASH AGAIN**

**L**exie Lou, Canada's Horse of the Year in 2014, and Strut the Course, that year's champion older female, met in an allowance optional claimer over Woodbine's Tapeta April 30 with Strut the Course a decisive winner.

The pair meet again with a lot more on the line May 29 in the \$200,000 Nassau Stakes (Can-IT) at a mile.

They won't be alone, as eight other older fillies and mares have passed the entry box.

Lexie Lou, 5, is one of three in the field trained by Mark Casse. Following a lengthy layoff and an eye injury, she returned this winter at Tampa Bay Downs but had the misfortune of encountering champion Tepin in the grade III Lambholm South Endeavour Stakes prior to finishing third to Strut the Course in the April 30 allowance optional claimer.

John Unger's Strut the Course is 3-2-0 in seven Woodbine turf outings and was a close fourth, beaten two lengths, in last year's E.P. Taylor Stakes Presented by HPIBet (Can-IT) at 1 1/4 miles.

New York-based trainer Christophe Clement has an interesting entry in Stormy Victoria. The 4-year-old filly won her U.S. debut April 29 on the turf going seven furlongs at Belmont Park following an eight-race career in her native France. **BH**

## INTRIGUING CLASH IN CHARLES WHITTINGHAM

**T**rainer Peter Miller was forthright about his intentions bringing grade I winner Finnegans Wake back off a nearly nine-month layoff last time out in the Thunder Road Stakes (gr. IIIT)—it was a prep for bigger and better things.

With that in mind, the 7-year-old Powerscourt horse could be primed for a big run in the \$200,000 Charles Whittingham Stakes (gr. IIT) May 29 at Santa Anita Park.

Finnegans Wake, who won four graded events from late November 2014 to May 2015 capped by a victory in the Woodford Reserve Turf Classic Stakes (gr. IT), made mild gains to finish sixth in the one-mile Thunder Road at a distance he had not raced since 2013, 21 starts prior.

At the 1 1/4-mile Whittingham distance on turf, Finnegans Wake has two graded victories—in the 2015 San Marcos Stakes (gr. IIT) and the 2014 Arlington Handicap (gr. IIIT).

He also has intriguing recent works, including

a one-mile breeze at Miller's San Luis Rey Training Center base in 1:38 1/5.

The likely Whittingham favorite, however, figures to be 2014 Brazilian Triple Crown winner Bal a Bali, who will be making his first U.S. start beyond 1 1/8 miles. In Brazil, the son of Put It Back was a group I winner at 1 1/4 miles and 1 1/2 miles on the grass.

The Richard Mandella-trained runner hasn't won since an allowance score at Del Mar in October 2015, but he has hit the board in his four starts since, all graded events, including a neck third last time out in the San Francisco Mile Stakes (gr. IIIT) April 30 at Golden Gate Fields.

The only last-out winners in the field are Quick Casablanca, who won the 1 7/8-mile San Juan Capistrano Stakes (gr. IIIT) April 10, and Patentar, an allowance victor at Santa Anita in February.

The ones to catch appear to be allowance race winner A Red Tie Day and Si Sage, the 2015 Last Tycoon Stakes (gr. IIIT) winner at 1 1/4 miles.

Completing the field are grade II dirt winner Blingo, former claimer Montego Bay, and allowance winners Play Hard to Get and Royal Albert Hall. **BH**

## 'CHROME' PLEASES IN LOS ALAMITOS BREEZE

California Chrome gave a little toss of the head under regular exercise rider Dihigi Gladney on Los Alamitos Race Course's backstretch May 28, and from across the track, looking through the infield palm trees, trainer Art Sherman knew the chestnut was ready to run.

"When he gets that way and wants to run off, you know he's getting ready and getting stronger and stronger," Sherman said.

The 5-year-old son of Lucky Pulpit looked plenty strong during his 5:30 a.m. PDT half-mile breeze at the Orange County, Calif., racetrack, all alone under the lights. Sherman timed the four furlongs in :47 4/5 while Los Alamitos clocker Russ Hudak had the 2014 Horse of the Year in :48 4/5 with a gallop out to five furlongs in 1:01 4/5.

Either way, his trainer was pleased after the drill, the third since his victory in the Dubai World Cup Sponsored by Emirates Airline (UAE-I) with a short

layoff at Taylor Made Farm in between.

"I'm just really happy the way everything is going right now," Sherman said of his horse's preparation for the July 23 San Diego Handicap (gr. II) at Del Mar. "Hopefully we can continue on the trail we're going. I can see the difference between this work and last week's. He was gliding. He was blowing a little last week, but now he's getting where he doesn't hardly even blow out a candle. He's getting stronger and fitter."

Sherman said California Chrome put on about 45 pounds at Taylor Made after the World Cup, significantly less than his longer stint at the farm in 2015, which has allowed the trainer to get him in shape more quickly. For his scheduled June 4 work, Sherman said his top trainee will likely stretch out to five furlongs.

Sherman will add blinkers—which California Chrome also wears during races—in about a month when the trainer wants to sharpen him with quicker works.

"When we get a little more serious, we'll slap them on and get a little more focused," Sherman said.

Sherman also beamed when talk turned to running California Chrome as a 6-year-old. Owner California Chrome LLC has already purchased a spot in the gate for the inaugural \$12 Pegasus World Cup at Gulfstream Park in January.

"They were figuring out how much money he could be running for next year—purse money is almost \$37 million," Sherman said of the Pegasus, the Dubai World Cup, Breeders' Cup, and other lucrative stakes that could be on his schedule. "All that's going to be coming up. It's hard to believe, isn't it? I'll let them think about that. It would be great for me. I'd love to have him. They're talking about it. That's what's good." **BH**

## STALLION VALUATION

The American Association of Equine Appraisers trains and certifies qualified individuals seeking to become equine appraisers. Like real estate appraisers, equine appraisers typically apply one of three methods when valuing assets:

1) The "replacement cost" method, which considers the cost of building or breeding the target asset.

2) The "comparables" method, which looks at prices of assets similar to the target asset.

3) The "discounted cash flow" method, which projects future net cash flows and discounts them back to their value in today's dollars.

For many years when I asked one of my partners what reserve we should place on our sales horses, he asked a "replacement cost" question: "What do we have in him/her?" My response was that buyers don't give a hoot about what expenses we've incurred and we need to consider the horse's value to potential buyers. The replacement cost method makes little sense in appraising horses because you can't duplicate a horse like you can a building.

Most equine appraisers use the "comparables" method (real estate appraisers do as well). If you've bought a house, you've probably reviewed an appraisal listing prices of recently sold houses similar to yours. Many horsemen become experts in the "comparables" method with no formal training because they develop the ability

to assess value through years of experience.

The discounted cash flow method is more complicated than the others. DCF is rarely used for valuing racing prospects because cash flow projections are problematical. DCF can be useful in valuing mares—though most appraisers prefer the simpler comparables method. DCF is often the superior approach for valuing stallions, especially proven stallions; and given the high values associated with many stallions, the extra time and expense spent in making DCF calculations can be justified.

A number of factors need to be considered when assessing a stallion's value

There are relatively simple variations on DCF analysis. Thirty years ago a rule of thumb often cited for a young, proven stallion was that a share was worth four times his stud fee. With the larger books today's stallions serve, the multiple is higher. But rules of thumb produce only rough approximations.

When using a valuation method, the first question should be "valuation from what perspective?" Is it Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere, or total valuation? Are we valuing the stallion from a shareholder's perspective or from that of all stakeholders? Factors that affect value include the stallion's fertility, the expected costs of advertising and managing the stallion, the number of breeding rights in the stallion, etc.

The gold standard in using DCF is spreadsheet analysis, which estimates and discounts projected revenues and costs over the useful life of the stallion. I'll provide a spreadsheet analysis of a hypothetical stallion in a future column. **BH**


