EXAGGERATOR SETTLES IN AT BELMONT

After an uneventful four-hour van ride from Pimlico Race Course in Maryland, Preakness Stakes (gr. I) winner Exaggerator arrived at Belmont Park at 12:10 p.m. EDT May 29 for his next assignment, the \$1.5 million Belmont Stakes (gr. I) June 11.

Upon exiting the horse trailer, which was driven by trainer Keith Desormeaux's assistant and girlfriend, Julie Clark, Exaggerator was greeted by about two-dozen people, mostly members of the media and New York Racing Association personnel.

Exaggerator, led by his groom, Victor Vargas, made a quick pit stop into stall 15 in Barn 29, his home for the next two weeks, before coming out for a stroll in the barn's spacious courtyard. The road trip on a warm spring day evidently didn't take much, if anything, out of the son of Curlin, as he threw in a few playful bucks and pawed at the ground.

"That's him (being) mellow," Clark, who was sporting an "I Love New York" t-shirt, said with a laugh.

Speaking to Exaggerator's light training schedule since winning the Preakness by 3 1/2 lengths May 21, Clark said it is nothing out of the ordinary for the horse or the stable.

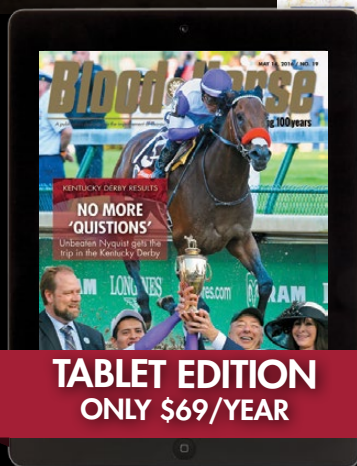

"That is very normal for him," Clark said. "They usually walk two days after a race and then walk on Thursdays and Sundays, and then we fit in another walk day—just to be make it more exciting for the hotwalkers."

Clark echoed the sentiments of Desormeaux, who said after the Preakness that the quick recovery time Exaggerator exhibits in the aftermath of his races is one of things that makes the horse so special.

"By Sunday (the day after the Preakness), he was squealing and on his toes. By Monday, he was a handful, so he doesn't notice when he runs. He is the same," Clark said.

"The first day back (to train on May 24), he was actually pretty strong, and the second time, (May 28), he was very relaxed," she continued. "We have a different rider, Peedy (Landry), who just has a way of putting the horses to sleep and we love that. He went on a loose rein and was happy to go whatever speed Peedy wanted him to, without trying to dictate."

Unless there is a downpour during training hours, Clark said Exaggerator will gallop on the Belmont Park main track May 30. Heavy rain is in the forecast, starting early Memorial Day. **BH**

WEKEELA HEADS WEST FOR GAMELY

Trainer Chad Brown nominated four runners for the \$300,000 Gamely Stakes (gr. IT) May 30 at Santa Anita Park, but only Martin Schwartz' Wekeela will make the trip west.

The 4-year-old Irish-bred daughter of Hurricane Run could be the one to beat, considering the way she ran in her U.S. debut and who defeated her April 16 at Keeneland.

In her first start stateside and the first under Brown's care, Wekeela ran second, five lengths behind champion turf female Tepin in the Coolmore Jenny Wiley (gr. IT).

Prior to joining Brown, Wekeela ran eight times in France for three wins and two seconds, and \$172,587 in earnings.

The Jenny Wiley was not the first time Wekeela was runner-up at racing's highest level—in 2015 she finished behind Queen's Jewel (Pivotal) in the Pour Moi Coolmore Prix Saint-Alary (Fr-I) at Longchamp.

That race has since proved a valuable form guide in the United States. Queen's Jewel later finished third behind Stephanie's Kitten and Legatissimo in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf (gr. IT), while Prix Saint-Alary third-place finisher Olorda (Lord of England), also now trained by Brown for Schwartz, has won two grade III turf races this year: The Very

One Stakes at Gulfstream Park March 5 and the Bewitch Stakes at Keeneland April 29.

Wekeela will have the services of top jockey Javier Castellano, who will also ship in from the East Coast.

Wekeela will face five graded winners in the nine-horse field, headed by last-out Royal Heroine (gr. IIT) victress Nancy From Nairobi. The John Sadler-trained Sixties Icon mare has won three straight races on the Santa Anita grass, including two allowance races before the Royal Heroine.

The speedy Fanticola, who showed a different dimension in the Royal Heroine, stalking early before putting a head in front and eventually finishing third, earned her graded credentials for trainer Phil D'Amato in the 2015 Royal Heroine and was just a neck behind Hard Not to Like in the 2015 Gamely last year.

Both Fanticola and fellow Gamely entrant Elektrum—who won the 2015 John C. Mabee Stakes (gr. IIT) after finishing fourth in the 2015 Gamely—are on four-race winless streaks since their graded scores. The final grade II winner in the field, Nashoba's Gold, hasn't visited the winner's circle in six starts since her victory in the 2014 Honeymoon (gr. IIT).

The final graded winner in the field is Keri Belle, who finished eighth in the Royal Heroine but won the Megahertz Stakes (gr. IIIT) three starts back. Grade I-placed Illuminant and allowance winners Evo Campo and Dressed to a T complete the field. **BH**

WHITTINGHAM FALLS TO SI SAGE

Red Baron's Barn, Rancho Temescal, and Vayacon-suerte's Si Sage has sure taken a liking to the 1 1/4-mile distance at Santa Anita Park.

After winning the 2015 Last Tycoon (gr. IIIT) at the distance by 3 1/4 lengths at odds of 42-1, the 6-year-old son of Sageburg wowed again at 10 furlongs May 29 in the \$200,000 Charles Whittingham Stakes (gr. IIT).

With jockey Mike Smith aboard for the first time, Si Sage set the pace with swift fractions of :23.15, :47.02, and 1:11.23 through six furlongs, and was pressed by 7-5 favorite Bal a Bali in the backstretch. He put that rival away through a mile in 1:35.36 and showed no signs of stopping in the stretch. Bal a Bali moved alongside Si Sage in the final turn, but could not put a head in front.

"We went a bit quicker than I wanted to go, but in doing so, he was well within himself, was comfortable, very relaxed, and sometimes you've just got to let a fast horse be fast," Smith said.

Off at 11-1, Si Sage hit the wire in 1:59.48 on firm turf, 2 1/2 lengths ahead of longshots Patentar and Montego Bay, to complete the \$3,812.70 trifecta.

"That :47 half made me think we might be in trouble," winning trainer Jim Cassidy said. "If he didn't impress anybody today, shame on them. He certainly impressed me."

The winner paid \$25, \$11.80, and \$9.40 across the board. Patentar brought \$25.40 and \$11.80, and Montego Bay delivered \$10.60 to

show.

Bal a Bali tired to finish fourth, followed by grade I winner Finnegans Wake, Royal Albert Hall, Quick Casablanca, Blingo, A Red Tie Day, and Play Hard to Get to complete the order of finish.

Bred in France by Ecurie D, Si Sage now has a 5-6-2 record from 26 starts and \$381,795 in earnings. Since relocating to the U.S. from France in 2013, Si Sage is 0-for-12 in his races that aren't 1 1/4 miles on the Santa Anita turf.

"I don't think there's any problem with him, no matter the distance," Cassidy said. "He's just a very honest horse."

"I couldn't believe the morning line today (of 15-1)," added Red Baron's owner Jed Cohen. "He won a race here last year at the same distance and I thought he beat a better group of horses than he was facing today.... It's nice to have a nice horse, and for him to be able to show it."

It was Cassidy's first victory in the Whittingham.

"It brings tears to your eyes to win a race named after such a great man, Charlie Whittingham," the trainer said. "It brought a tear to my eye." **BH**

LEXIE LOU TOO STRONG IN NASSAU

Gary Barber's 2014 Canadian Horse of the Year Lexie Lou returned to the winner's circle for the first time since that breakout year in the May 29 \$200,000 Nassau Stakes (Can-IIT) at Woodbine.

After stalking the pace in third through most of the one-turn-mile turf test with jockey Patrick Husbands aboard, the Mark Casse-trained 5-year-old daughter of Sligo Bay outfinished stablemate Mississippi Delta in the final sixteenth to win by three-quarters of a length.

Strut the Course, the Canadian champion older female of 2014, closed from sixth to finish third, a neck back.

Off at 12-1 in the field of nine, Lexie Lou finished off the mile in 1:32.98 on firm turf.

"She's a funny filly," Husbands said. "You've got to play with her mind. You've got to let her do what she wants to do. Last time when I rode her, nobody wanted the lead, and she took the lead and quit. She's happy to be back home."

The Nassau was Lexie Lou's first victory since October of 2014, six starts back, when she won the Autumn Miss Stakes (gr. IIIT) at Santa Anita Park. That same year, she won the Woodbine Oaks Presented by Budweiser, the Queen's Plate Stakes, and the Wonder Where Stakes, all at Woodbine, to earn Canadian Horse of the Year honors. **BH**

SIRES BY STAKES WINNER PERCENTAGE

In the good old days, the top stallions sired 10% stakes winners from foals. The exceptional ones, such as Northern Dancer, scored above 20%—he sired 147 black-type stakes winners from 646 foals, for 22.8%.

Also in the good old days, a stallion's book hovered around 40. Northern Dancer's largest crop of foals came in 1974 with 36 foals (his 10 stakes winners constitute 27.8% of that group). The books of today's leading sires are a lot higher and their named foals from a given year can reach well above 100. What does that do for their percentages?

None among the 2016 leading active sires have more than a 10% black-type stakes winners percentage from named foals, but it's close. Too Much Bling, who stands at Lane's End Texas, is the leader at 9.73% from his 185 foals. Atop the commercial sires is Distorted Humor, whose 127 black-type winners from 1,385 named foals hits for 9.17%.

HOW SOLID WAS THE 2016 MIDLANTIC SALE?

The recent Fasig-Tipton Midlantic 2-year-olds in training sale at Timonium had the good fortune of watching another million-dollar horse—an Uncle Mo—Dream Street filly—pass through the auction ring. That's two consecutive years of selling a seven-figure horse.

The upside of such a sale-topper is obvious; it shows sellers this sale attracts enough attention that marquee prices are attainable. Million-dollar sales, however, are not a good indicator of the overall health of a market. By broad comparisons, the 2016 sale was not as strong as the 2015 sale: the average was down 22.7% to \$68,654. The auction sold 82 more horses in 2016 than a year ago, which would assist a drop in average, but the median was down, too, by 28.9% to \$32,000.

MarketWatch dug into the details of the 2016 sale, subdividing the results for this sale and those of 2015 and 2014 in deciles to see if any segment of the market fared better than others.

The 2016 results only reinforce that the 2015 sale was exceptionally good, even beyond last year's gross of \$22,659,000 and record average of \$88,859. The average and median in nine out of 10 deciles for the 2016 sale lagged behind the compara-

ble results of 2015. Only the bottom decile of 2016 eked out a gain over last year's sale.

The 2016 results were affected in part by a more aggressive stance among sellers, who had higher expectations for their consignments. Driving these expectations may have been the ongoing renewal of Maryland racing fueled by a string of casino openings or simply from the robust results of 2015. Whatever the reason, a significantly higher number of horses failed to find new homes in 2016. The overall RNA rate was 25.9%, up from 21.5% in 2015.

Even more telling, the number of RNAs that brought fall-of-the-hammer prices of \$100,000 or more rose to 10 from six a year ago with the total value of those RNAs up 97.6% compared with the value of 2015's RNAs. A colt by Tapit was bought back at \$700,000 at this year sale, compared with the top RNA price of \$440,000 at the 2015 sale.

The 2016 sale looks better compared with the 2014 Midlantic sale, when a similar number of horses were offered and sold. Six out of 10 deciles by median for 2016 outperformed the comparable medians from 2014. In particular, the medians for the top three deciles of 2016 were substantially higher.

Catalog quality varies from year to year, and it is a tall order to follow a record-breaking year with another record breaker. Comparing results from 2016 with those from 2014 shows that despite the overall metrics, real growth in the market was realized. **BH**

SUDDENBREAKINGNEWS BREEZES FOR BELMONT

Samuel Henderson's Belmont Stakes (gr. I) hopeful Suddenbreakingnews was recently discovered to be a ridgling, but his new status did not curtail his preparations for the \$1.5 million classic, as he breezed six furlongs May 29 at Churchill Downs.

With Joe Rocco Jr. in the irons, the son of Mineshaft was timed in 1:12 2/5. Churchill clockers caught him in splits of :24 2/5, :36 3/5, :48 3/5, and 1:00 1/5 before galloping out to seven furlongs in 1:25 1/5.

Henderson paid \$72,000 for Suddenbreakingnews at the 2014 Keeneland September yearling sale, where he was cataloged as a colt, and he has been listed as a gelding throughout his racing career. Henderson ordered the colt be gelded, but when the farms where he was raised and got his early foundation corresponded as he became a classics candidate, it was discovered the operation never occurred, the Louisville *Courier-Journal* reported.

Suddenbreakingnews was discovered, through an ultrasound, to have two undescended testicles in his abdomen. He will be listed as a ridgling when he runs in the Belmont Stakes June 11.

"He looks like a gelding, he acted like a gelding, and that's the way it was," trainer Donnie Von Hemel said. "The ultrasound revealed that he had two undescended testicles, so he looks like a gelding and we never had any other reason to think otherwise.

"He's now an official ridgling. I think on the ultrasound they were rather small, and with both of them being in his abdomen at this point, I don't think they would descend. The part of the testicles descending is the temperature of the sperm that's alive, so they're too hot

right now. A lot of (the) time there's one up and one down, and there's the question of if it's tugging on him and it doesn't seem to be a problem."

Von Hemel said he thought Suddenbreakingnews look good breezing.

"He went real smooth and picked up as he went—galloped out real smooth," Von Hemel said of Suddenbreakingnews, who finished fifth in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I). "Everything seems to be in order; it's just what we're looking for. I realize that the pace won't be :45 in the Belmont, but we also won't be 20 lengths back, either. I just think this horse can run a mile and a half—his pedigree says he can. I think it's our best chance to get a grade I in that race."

Von Hemel said that Suddenbreakingnews would likely ship to Belmont Park June 7. Hall of Fame jockey Mike Smith, a two-time winner of the Belmont Stakes with Drosselmeyer (2010) and Palace Malice (2013), has the mount.

In other Belmont Stakes news, GMB Racing's Mo Tom will bypass the third jewel of the Triple Crown and will point toward the \$500,000 Ohio Derby at ThisleDown June 25. **BH**

JAPANESE DERBY TRIFECTA FOR DEEP IMPACT

Third choice Makahiki bested a strong field of 3-year-olds in the Tokyo Yushun (Jpn-I, Japanese Derby) to claim his first top-level win by a nose May 29 at Tokyo Racecourse.

In front of a crowd of 140,000, the bay colt led in a trifecta for leading Japanese stallion Deep Impact, who sired the runner-up, second-favorite Satono Diamond, and favorite Dee Majesty, half a length farther back in third.

Makahiki is a homebred of Makoto Kaneko, who campaigned Deep Impact to a Tokyo Yushun win in 2005. Kaneko also landed the race in 2004 with King Kamehameha, and is now tied with Sunday Racing Co. for the most Tokyo Yushun wins with three.

Makahiki won his first three races, including the Hoshi Hai Yayoi Sho (Jpn-II) in March. He then finished second, 1 1/4 lengths behind Dee Majesty, in the Satsuki Sho (Jpn-I, Japanese Two Thousand Guineas), closing on the winner with a powerful late charge, before his classic victory Sunday.

Makahiki, with Yuga Kawada aboard, traveled along the rail in mid-division, around eighth from the front-runner, while he eyed Satono Diamond in front.

Rounding the far turn, Kawada steered Makahiki to the outside for a clear path. Although between

horses at the top of the stretch, Makahiki found an opening 300 meters out. He slipped out from the behind Air Spinel around the 200-meter marker, and then accelerated strongly to take command 100 meters out.

He managed to fend off a strong challenge by Satono Diamond nearing the wire for a narrow win, completing 2,400 meters (about 1 1/2 miles) in 2:24 on firm turf.

"The colt broke smoothly, and I was able to race him in good position as planned," Kawada said. "I gradually advanced him while marking Satono Diamond, and he stretched really well after threading through a small opening. The moment we crossed the wire, I felt that we were a margin in front, but I was overwhelmed with joy when the photo-finish result came."

Satono Diamond was rated seventh from the front with Makahiki and Dee Majesty traveling closely behind. Though allowing Makahiki to surge out before him in the straight, Satono Diamond unleashed a powerful late charge under Christophe Lemaire to close in on the leader in the last furlong and just missed.

Odds-on favorite Dee Majesty raced in midfield and made bid from an outside position on the final two turns. The Satsuki Sho winner showed good effort and diligently closed ground behind Satono Diamond to finish third.

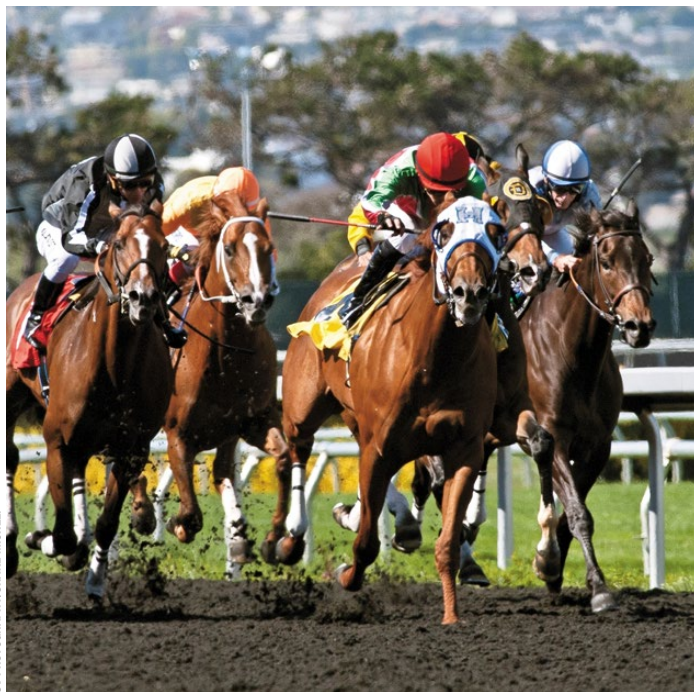

SECOND ALL AMERICAN VICTORY SOUGHT

G. G. Ryder (white blinkers) seeks a second consecutive All American Stakes May 30

George Todaro and Jerry Hollendorfer's G. G. Ryder will seek his second straight All American Stakes (gr. III) victory May 30 at Golden Gate Fields.

The 5-year-old son of Chhaya Dance, trained by Hollendorfer, rallied from off the pace to win the 2015 edition of the one-mile contest over the Golden Gate main track, 1 1/4 lengths ahead of stablemate Outside Nashville, a 6-year-old Broken Vow gelding who will also return for another run in the All American.

HnR Nothhaft Horse Racing's Living The Life, the only female in the field of 12, looms as a potential threat. Eight of the Footstepsinthesand mare's nine victories have been over synthetic footing, including back-to-back victories in the 2014 and 2015 Presque Isle Downs Masters (gr. II).

Poshsky earned his lone graded win on the Golden Gate synthetic back in November when he defeated G. G. Ryder (third by three-quarters of a length) in the Berkeley Handicap (gr. III), but hasn't finished better than fourth in five starts since, all over turf or dirt.

The remaining graded winner in the field is Tamarando, winner of the 2013 Del Mar Futurity (gr. I) on a synthetic track.

Graded stakes placed Blue Tone is the morning-line favorite. **BH**

ROYAL ASCOT CONFIRMED FOR TEPIN

Champion turf female Tepin will ship to England for a start in the Queen Anne Stakes (Eng-I), June 14, trainer Mark Casse confirmed May 29.

Plans to send Tepin to Royal Ascot were being re-evaluated, Casse said May 28, because of concern over the fact the 5-year-old daughter of Bernstein would not be allowed to use a nasal strip in England. After discussing the matter with owner Robert Masterson, the decision was made to press on with the overseas venture, Casse said.

"We're going," Casse said. "It's just something that Mr. Masterson really wants to do. We looked at everything, and as long as she is still happy and healthy, it's a dream of his. Unless we were concerned that it was detrimental to her health—that would stop us. But all looks good, so it's a go."

With multiple group I winner Solow declared out of the Queen Anne earlier in May, Tepin could be the heavy favorite over male rivals in the one-mile contest.

Tepin turned in her typically steady breeze May 28, going five furlongs in 1:01 3/5 at Churchill Downs in her first move since winning the May 7 Churchill Distaff Turf Mile Stakes (gr. IIT). Though both regular rider Julien Leparoux and assistant trainer Norman Casse were pleased with the move, Leparoux did say the bay mare made "maybe a little bit more" breathing noise than normal during the work.

"I talked to Norman and Julien and they were happy with how she breezed. My concern is—a lot of people don't know it—but she has had some breathing issues in the past," Mark Casse said. "In fact, if you go back and look at Del Mar (eighth in the grade I 2014 Del Mar

Oaks) when she ran her one bad race, she nearly collapsed after the race. So, as great as she is, she does have some issues.

Casse said not all his horses use a nasal strip, but it has proved very helpful to Tepin.

Tepin also worked Saturday without the use of the anti-bleeder medication furosemide, also referred to as Salix or Lasix, which she cannot race with in Europe.

Tepin stated her case for going on to England as she appeared to be holding her form in the wake of her sixth straight victory. With Leparoux quiet in the irons, the two clocked splits of :12 3/5 and :36 3/5 galloping out to six furlongs in 1:14 3/5 on a fast Churchill track.

She is likely to have her final work at Churchill June 3.

Bred by Machmer Hall, Tepin has won all four of her 2016 starts, including the Coolmore Jenny Wiley Stakes (gr. IT) at Keeneland. She defeated males by 2 1/4 lengths in the Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) last October and has won 11 of 19 in her career with \$3,078,253 in earnings. **BH**
