## BELMONT 148: EXAGGERATOR GETS OUTSIDE DRAW

Preakness Stakes (gr. I) winner Exaggerator drew post 11 in a field of 13 and was tagged the 9-5 morning-line favorite for the June 11 Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (gr. I) during the race's post position draw June 8 in New York.

The two-time grade I winner is inside Brody's Cause (post 12, 20-1) and Creator (post 13, 10-1).

Trainer Keith Desormeaux wasn't thrilled with the potential of drawing wide after the Curlin colt—owned in partnership by Big Chief Racing, Head of Plains Partners, and Rocker O Ranch—jogged Wednesday morning.

"The gates here are placed around the wire, which means there's not that much of a run-up," Desormeaux said. "It's not as inconsequential as it is in the other two races, so I'd prefer not to be on the outside, because we have to take back and drop in. Three-sixteenths (to the turn) is a decent run, but not enough—not enough to say that the gates don't matter."

Desormeaux's brother and Exaggerator's rider

wasn't as concerned with the draw.

"I think it's a wonderful post position," Kent Desormeaux said. "I can't see any horses that will cross over on him. (We should be) able to establish position, preferably, without getting a grain of sand in his face."

Stradivari, fourth in the Preakness, was labeled the 5-1 second choice on the morning line and drew post 5. Fellow Todd Pletcher-trainee Destin, who sat out the Preakness after a sixth-place run in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I), is the 6-1 third choice and will break from post 2.

"I think Destin ran a sneaky-good race in the Derby," Pletcher said. "He didn't get away from the gate the way we wanted to. We didn't get to the position that we wanted to. He had to work to kind of get to the top of the stretch.

"Stradivari, I think you can make a case that he was behind schedule a little bit leading into the Preakness and sometimes a race like that will move him forward."

Cherry Wine, who edged Nyquist for second in the Preakness, drew post 3 and is the 8-1 fourth choice, while Japanese-based Lani, the only horse other than Exaggerator scheduled to participate in all three legs of the Triple Crown, drew post 10 at 20-1.

Dale Romans, who trains both Cherry Wine and Brody's Cause—a multiple grade I winner—likes his chances.

"I would say Brody is the more talented, but Cherry Wine is on the improve," Romans said.

Newcomers Governor Malibu (second in the grade II Peter Pan at Belmont Park May 14) and Gettysburg, who could be the race's early leader, drew posts 1 and 6, respectively. **BH**

## SALES UPDATE

### OBS UNDER TACK SHOW CONTINUES

The under tack show for the June 14-17 Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s 2-year-olds in training and horses of racing age sale continued June 8 with seven juveniles sharing the day's fastest eighth-mile time of :10 and three getting a quarter-mile in :21 1/5.

After four days of workouts, the fastest furlong so far is :09 4/5 turned in by a Gemologist colt on Monday, with the best quarter-mile time of :20 4/5 coming from an Into Mischief colt during Sunday's first session.

Two of the co-fastest quarter-mile workers June 8 came from the consignment of Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stables. Hickstead Farm bred Hip 615, a Colonel John filly out of the Red Bullet mare Mystery Bullet, in Florida. Hip 744, a Horse Greeley colt named Crack On from the family of grade I winner Perfect Drift, was bred in Kentucky by Lavin Bloodstock and Leroy S. Close and was a \$5,000 purchase by David E. Hager at last year's Keeneland September yearling sale.

Wavertree also was represented by one of the one-furlong bullet workers, with Hip 715, a Hansen filly, bred in Kentucky by John R. and Frank Penn and from the family of grade I winner Summerly.

"We knew going in (to the breeze session) that we had some fast horses, and they were the horses we knew would do that," Dunne said.

Noting the OBS track was consistent throughout the four under tack sessions despite weather conditions that changed from three inches of rain to heat and humidity—all of which impact OBS' all-weather Safetrack surface—Dunne

praised track superintendent Tim Colbert.

"In situations like this the synthetic track really stands out," Dunne said. "I'm not sure that with a dirt race track we would have been able to breeze yesterday (after three inches of rain the previous day) or it wouldn't have been as consistent as it has been over the last four days with the different weather conditions."

Also breezing :10 flat Wednesday were Hip 648, a Drosselmeyer—Our Eleanor filly consigned by C & J Stable; Hip 654, a Successful Appeal—Pacific Jewel colt (Eisaman Equine, agent); Hip 660,

a Trappe Shot—Passion Overflow filly (Woodford Thoroughbreds, agent); Hip 678, a colt by First Defence—Platinum Bride (Brick City Thoroughbreds, agent); Hip 745, Thisone'sfor Ang, a filly by Cool Coal Man—Raphaella (Top Line Sales, agent); and Hip 776, a colt by Sky Mesa—Royal Corredor (Crupi's New Castle Farm, agent).

The additional :21 1/5 quarter-mile worker was Hip 789, a Gemologist—Ruthian colt consigned by Thoroughbred Champions Training Center.

The under tack show resumes at 7:30 a.m. June 9. **BH**

## FROSTED RETURNS TO NEW YORK

A year after running second to American Pharoah in the Belmont Stakes (gr. I), Frosted returns to New York for his first U.S. start this year in the \$1.25 million Mohegan Sun Metropolitan Handicap (gr. I) June 11 for older horses on the Belmont Park undercard.

Frosted did his running in Dubai this year, winning the Al Maktoum Challenge Round 2 (UAE-II) before finishing fifth in the Dubai World Cup (UAE-I).

As a 3-year-old last season Frosted took the Wood Memorial (gr. I) and Pennsylvania Derby (gr. II). He carries a bankroll of better than \$2 million into the Met Mile, and has trainer Kiaran McLaughlin in his corner, who knows better than anyone how to bring a horse back to U.S. racing after Dubai. McLaughlin trained for many years in the Emirates for Sheikh Mohammed.

"Frosted couldn't be doing any better. This race could be a little short for him, but we're excited about it and I think there will be a lot of pace," said McLaughlin.

Stanford is likely to find himself on the lead. He is shortening up from a nine-furlong score in the Charles Town Classic (gr. II) after rolling a pair of seconds in the Gulfstream Park Handicap (gr. III) and Fred Hooper (gr. III). He brings earnings of more than \$1.1 million into the race.

"Stanford has done very well this year," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "He also did well at 3 but seems to have broken through to a different level this year. His Charles Town race was a great performance and was fun to watch, so we're excited about him."

Upstart failed to hold his form from early last year when he won the Lambholm South Holy Bull Stakes (gr. II) and finished second in the Besilu Fountain of Youth (gr. II) and Besilu Florida Derby (gr. I). He did come back to take the Razorback Handicap (gr. III) in March before coming home fifth in the Oaklawn Handicap (gr. II) at nine furlongs.

Noble Bird has enjoyed a solid season thus far, checking in second in the Ben Ali Stakes (gr. III) before winning the Pimlico Special Handicap (gr. III). He also has the Stephen Foster Handicap (gr. I) from last season. His form should stand him in good stead here. Ami's Flatter is another who could jump up at

solid odds. He is stretching out from a seven-furlong score in the Commonwealth Stakes (gr. III) in April.

The remainder of the field is made up of 2015 Godolphin Mile (UAE-III) winner Tamarkuz and runner-up Sloane Avenue, the consistent Calculator, Westchester Stakes (gr. III) winner Anchor Down, lightly-raced sprinter Marking, and El Kabeir, winner of last year's Gotham and Jerome Stakes (both gr. III). **BH**

## LANI THRIVING AT BELMONT PARK

If trainer Mikio Matsunaga had it to do over again, he would prepare group II winner Lani at Belmont Park for the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I) instead of Churchill Downs.

Matsunaga said UAE Derby (UAE-II) winner Lani has found the 1 1/2-mile Belmont track, the sandy surface, and the expansive backstretch more to his liking.

While Matsunaga can't change his initial decision to prepare for the Derby at Churchill, he has seen his Tapit colt settle into a rhythm since arriving at Belmont May 9 to prepare for the Preakness Stakes (gr. I)—in which he ran fifth after a Derby ninth—and looks forward to his start in the June 11 Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (gr. I).

"He likes his surroundings here at Belmont Park," Matsunaga said through an interpreter June 8. "He's been having a good time in New York and we're looking forward to running Saturday.

"Since we've come here, he's been doing very well. The surroundings are nice and quiet. Before the Derby, if I knew we would have had these kind of surroundings, I would have brought the horse straight from Dubai to New York. I didn't expect those (backstretch) crowds before the Derby during the training."

On June 8 Lani breezed five furlongs in 1:00.43 at Belmont and spent his usual extended time on the track, which Matsunaga said is similar in size and surface to Tokyo Racecourse, which features a 2,100-meter (1.3-mile) dirt oval.

"He was very controllable, according to the rider. And he showed good acceleration coming out of the turn and he had great strides," Matsunaga said. "I couldn't be any happier with that."

Matsunaga said Lani appears to be moving forward, noting it's been a dramatic change since the gray colt's pre-Derby morning antics made headlines.

"I was very happy with his condition before the Preakness but I'm even happier going into this," Matsunaga said. "He's had

two races in the United States now, so he's used to the race style in the States. This race is the ideal trip for Lani so if he were to win it—no surprise."

Lani certainly has the breeding to run well at the Belmont distance. He is a son of two-time leading sire Tapit, who has already sired 2014 Belmont winner Tonalist. Lani is out of Heavenly Romance, a group I-winning daughter of dual-classic winner and Japan's 13-time leading sire Sunday Silence. Heavenly Romance, who defeated males in the 2,000-meter (about 1 1/4-mile) Tenno Sho Autumn (Jpn-I), also has produced stakes winner Amour Briller (Smart Strike) and group III winner Awardee (Jungle Pocket).

After the Belmont, Lani will spend time in quarantine before shipping back to Japan where Matsunaga plans to continue racing the colt in top dirt races. **BH**

## O'NEILL SENDS OUT TAPIZAR FILLY

Trainer Doug O'Neill sends out the highest priced juvenile by Tapizar, with Tap It All entered in a June 9 maiden special weight at Santa Anita Park.

Owned in partnership by Reddam Racing and ERJ Racing, the filly was an \$800,000 purchase by O'Neill's brother Dennis O'Neill and Erik Johnson out of Crupi's New Castle Farm consignment at this year's Fasig-Tipton March select 2-year-olds in training sale.

Tapizar, who won the 2012 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (gr. I) on his second attempt, was retired to Gainesway Farm shortly after that race. The son of Tapit is currently ranked seventh on the leading first-crop sire list—his first winner, Draft Beer, came May 26.

The first foal out of the stakes winning Grand Slam mare Yawkey Way, Tap It All finished second in her only start after dueling for the lead with the eventual winner throughout the 4 1/2-furlong race at Santa Anita.

Grand Prix, another of note making her debut in the same race for trainer Gary Mandella, is a half sister to Great Lady M Stakes (gr. II) winner and Vanity Mile Stakes (gr. I) third-place finisher Finest City.

The filly is an HnR Nothhaft Racing homebred from Pennsylvania by Tale of the Cat, out the Lemon Drop Kid mare Be Envied.

The \$56,000 maiden, the second race on the Santa Anita card, drew a field of nine fillies for the five furlong contest. **BH**

## THE MET MILE, BELMONT STAKES, AND CHAMPIONS

Before there was a Belmont Park, there was a Belmont Stakes, and there was a Metropolitan Handicap.

The Metropolitan Handicap first ran in 1891 at Morris Park, the track horseman John A. Morris built upon the closure of Jerome Park, the previous home of the Belmont Stakes, whose inaugural 1867 running was won by Morris' father's filly Relentless.

In 1898 the seventh running of the Metropolitan Handicap for 3-year-olds and up was contested over the one-mile Withers course, and the 32nd installment of the Belmont Stakes was run over the track's 1 1/2-mile outer main course.

Bowling Brook, bred in England by John Morris and owned by his sons Alfred and David, won the Met against older horses on May 7 and 19 days later added the Belmont Stakes. This was the first use a 3-year-old made of the Metropolitan Handicap as a Belmont Stakes prep.

Both races were transferred to Belmont Park when that facility opened in 1905, but it was not until 1959 that another horse accomplished the Met Mile/Belmont Stakes double. Trainer Elliott Burch used the Memorial Day feature (May 30) Met Mile to catapult Sword Dancer to a Belmont Stakes (June 13) victory for Brookmeade Stable. Later, Sword Dancer was named 1959's Horse of the Year.

Ten years down the road, Burch repeated with Rokeby Stable's Arts and Letters, training Paul Mellon's homebred to win the May 30 Met and the

Belmont Stakes eight days later. Arts and Letters was also named Horse of the Year.

The quintessential parlay of the Met Mile with the Belmont Stakes, however, belongs to trainer Woody Stevens. In 1982 the veteran hardboot saddled Henryk de Kwiatkowski's Conquistador Cielo for the May 31 Met Mile.

Over a fast track, the speedy son of Mr. Prospector burned a field of 13 predominantly older horses by 7 1/4 lengths and set a track record.

In an unfathomable move for today's times, Stevens rested his charge four days before tackling the rigorous test of the Belmont.

Parceling his speed across the 12 furlongs, Conquistador Cielo relished the sloppy footing and annihilated Kentucky Derby winner Gato Del Sol by 14 lengths. Preakness Stakes winner Aloma's Ruler finished ninth.

At year's end Conquistador Cielo became the third Horse of the Year to have won the Met Mile and the Belmont Stakes the same year.

The victory was the first of five consecutive Belmont Stakes wins for Stevens. He added Caveat, Swale, and Crème Fraiche. His string ended in 1986 with de Kwiatkowski's Danzig Connection.

In 2014, to make for a power-packed day at the races, the Met Mile was moved to the Belmont Stakes day card, along with other high-profile events. **BH**

## SERVIS RAISES CONCERN OVER POSITIVES AT PARX

John Servis, trainer of recent Longines Kentucky Oaks (gr. I) winner Cathryn Sophia, is questioning three clenbuterol positives from his horses in April and May at Parx Racing—including one for a 3-year-old filly he said was never administered the medication.

It's the latest in what has been a tumultuous period for racing regulation in Pennsylvania, where there hasn't been a racing commission meeting in almost six months, in part because of statutory changes.

Servis told the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, which first reported the situation June 7, that he was notified of the positives shortly after test results came back. When he heard a sample from Main Line Racing Stable and Joshtylane Farm's Miss Inclusive was positive for clenbuterol after her win in the \$100,000 Parx Oaks May 7, he "got scared" because she never had been treated with the bronchodilator.

The cut-off time for administration of clenbuterol in Pennsylvania is 14 days, as it is in many other racing jurisdictions in the United States. Servis told the *Inquirer* the other two horses that tested positive—Hearty Jones, who won April 4, and Some-day Jones, who finished second April 16—had been treated with the medication but under the standard regimen.

The *Inquirer* reported Servis requested increased security at his barn at Parx; a track official told the newspaper he understands the trainer's concerns and is waiting for the racing commission to act. Servis spent part of April and May in Kentucky preparing Cathryn Sophia for the Central Bank Ashland Stakes (gr. I) at Keeneland and the Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs.

Servis was scheduled to race Miss Inclusive in the Our Mims Stakes at Delaware Park.

In response to questions from *Blood-Horse*, Brandi Hunter-Davenport, communications director for the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, under which the racing commission falls, said June 8: "The matters in question have not yet been adjudicated. I am unable to provide any further information at this time."

It's unclear whether there are rulings in the matter; whether a hearing for Servis has been scheduled; what the levels are for the three horses that tested positive; whether the commission is actively investigating the matter in light of Servis' concerns; and the status of purse money for the three races.

Sources said the connections of Eighth Wonder, who finished second in the Parx Oaks, had already been told the purse would be redistributed—but a hearing hasn't been held.

Pennsylvania for many years had two racing commissions—one for Thoroughbred racing and one for

Standardbred racing. Legislation passed earlier this year, combined them into one nine-member commission to oversee both breeds.

The Thoroughbred racing commission hasn't met since Jan. 13 of this year. **BH**

"Not only is he a talented racehorse with tremendous potential, Creator is already a grade I-winning colt by Tapit, which makes him an exciting stallion prospect. It's a rare opportunity to partner with a first-class racing and stallion operation like WinStar, and I want to thank Kenny and Lisa Troutt and Elliott Walden. I look forward to many thrilling moments at the races with Creator, and then down the line with Creator's progeny."

"Bobby is one of the most passionate owners and advocates we have in the industry," WinStar president, CEO, and racing manager Elliott Walden said. "He's a tremendous spokesperson for horse racing, and his energy and dedication are things this industry needs more of. ## OAKS ADDED TO SUPER BRISBANE CARD

Wet weather forced the postponement of the Treasury Casino and Hotel Queensland Oaks (Aus-I) June 4, with the final fillies classic of the season now added to a stellar program at Eagle Farm June 11.

The Oaks will be run alongside three other group I events—the Channel 7 Queensland Derby (2,400 meters, about 1 1/2 miles), BMW JJ Atkins Stakes (1,600 meters, about one mile, for 2-year-olds) and the AAMI Stradbroke Handicap (1,400 meters, about seven furlongs), an open sprint.

A field of 18 will contest the Stradbroke. Seven of the runners are group I winners, including Precious Gem (Econsul), who will have her first run for new owners China Horse Club.

China Horse Club bought the last-start winner of the group I Ubet Robert Sangster Classic Stakes for Aus\$825,000 (\$596,640) at the Magic Millions National broodmare sale last week.

South Australian Derby winner Howard Be Thy Name (Redoute's Choice) is seeking a Derby double, but will face opposition from Etymology (New Approach) and Mackintosh (Pins).

## UNHEALTHY TRENDS IN ILLINOIS RACING

The recently released Illinois Racing Board annual report for 2015 contains some interesting statistics—and in some cases clearly shows why horse racing in the state is struggling and has been for decades.

In 1994, the year before full-card simulcasts were authorized, in-state pari-mutuel handle at racetracks and at off-track betting parlors on Illinois races—Thoroughbred and Standardbred—totaled \$1.18 billion. As has been the case in numerous other jurisdictions when signals were imported from other states, live handle gradually declined; from 1995-97 it was cut in half in Illinois.

In 2015, live handle on Illinois races—granted, there are far fewer racing dates in the state now—totaled \$80.21 million. That's a 93% decrease from 1994.

In order for racetracks to offset revenue losses on live wagering, the full-card simulcast law included a provision for "recapture"—a dirty word in some Illinois racing circles, and arguably with good reason. Recapture is described in the IRB annual report as funds deducted from horsemen's purse accounts and given to racetracks.

In 1995, the first year of imported simulcast signals, in-state tracks were paid \$4.23 million in recapture funds. The number peaked at \$15.48 million in 2001 and through 2014 held steady in the \$13 million range each year.

When the figures for each year from 1995-

2015 are totaled, the amount is staggering: Illinois purse accounts for Thoroughbred and Standardbred racing combined lost \$262.07 million through recapture. It's true the proliferation of casino-style gambling in the state has played a major role, but practices such as recapture haven't helped.

The 10-year trends in Illinois Thoroughbred racing aren't healthy, according to The Jockey Club Information Systems statistics.

In 2005, Arlington International Racecourse paid \$30.43 million in purses for a daily average of \$257,187 over 94 days. Last year total purses came in at \$13.47 million (down 55% from 2005) and averaged \$174,984 (down 32%) for 77 racing days.

Hawthorne Race Course in 2005 offered 125 racing programs for total purses of \$26.96 million and an average of \$215,742 per day. In

2014 the total was \$11.35 million (down 58%), and the average was \$138,432 (a 39% drop) over 82 programs.

The decreases for the most part were just as severe at Fairmount Park, located east of St. Louis, Mo., though purses there weren't high at the outset.

In 2005 the track offered 102 days of racing—that has been cut in half—for \$6.54 million in purses; the figure dropped 56% to \$2.84 million in 2015. Purses averaged \$64,119 in 2005 versus \$54,746, a 14% decline.

So it's no surprise the breeding industry suffered. The number of mares bred dropped from 1,422 in 1995 to 285 in 2015. The foal crop stood at 1,143 in 1995; last year it was 295. **BH**

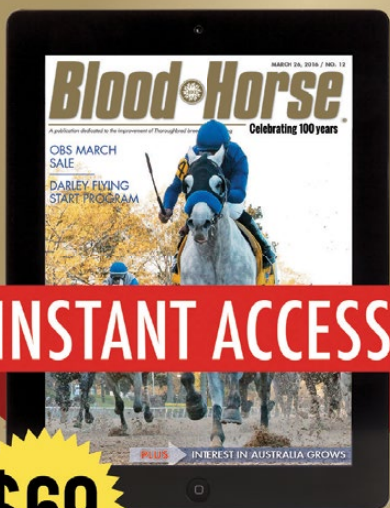
