## MELATONIN COMES OFF VICTORY WELL

Tarabilla Farms' Melatonin, now three-for-three at Santa Anita Park in 2016 after his second grade I win of the year June 25 in the Gold Cup, came out of the 1 1/4-mile race in good order, according to trainer David Hofmans June 26.

"So far he looks good," Hofmans said. "He ate up last night, which is a key thing, because horses that run as hard as he did sometimes don't eat up.

"I was very proud of him. That was his best race. He ran two seconds faster than his last race at a mile and a quarter (1:59.79 for the Gold Cup, 2:02.01 for the Santa Anita Handicap, gr. I, March 12). I was very pleased with his effort yesterday.

"I don't have a race in mind for him right now. I've got to give him time, because he's not that big (of) a horse. Maybe the Awesome Again (gr. I) here (Oct. 1). I don't know. We'll see."

The Kodiak Cowboy gelding had more than two months off before the Gold Cup, after finishing second to Effinex in the Oaklawn Handicap (gr. II) April 16.

east that will likely include the Alabama Stakes (gr. I) at Saratoga Race Course Aug. 20, worked four furlongs under regular rider Mike Smith in :49 1/5 for trainer Jerry Hollendorfer, who won six races Saturday—three at Santa Anita and three at the Oak Tree meet at Pleasanton. "It was just a real nice work," the Hall of Fame trainer said. "She went off slow and finished up good. We were all happy afterwards."

Champions Beholder and Stellar Wind, first and second in the Vanity Mile (gr. I) June 4, each worked Sunday at Santa Anita for a possible rematch in the Clement L. Hirsch Stakes (gr. I) at Del Mar July 30. Beholder went five furlongs in :59 flat for Richard Mandella, while Stellar Wind ran the same distance in 1:00 4/5 for John Sadler, who called the drill "perfect." Said Mandella: "It was a little faster than I wanted, but it was a nice five-eighths."

San Felipe Stakes (gr. II) winner Danzing Candy worked six furlongs in 1:13 flat for Bob Baffert, who has the son of Twirling Candy set for the July 2 Affirmed Stakes (gr. III).

Multiple graded stakes winner Om, back with trainer Dan Hendricks after being turned out, worked three furlongs in :38 flat.

Firing Line, second to American Pharoah in the 2015 Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I), worked five furlongs in 1:00 1/5 for Simon Callaghan, who has the son of Line of David on course for a meeting with California Chrome in the San Diego Handicap (gr. II) July 23. **BH**

## EUROPEANS HEAD INTO BELMONT OAKS, DERBY

Thoroughbreds from Ireland, Great Britain, and France will be travelling to Belmont Park to face some of the top 3-year-old turf colts and fillies in the United States for the \$1.25 million Belmont Derby (gr. IT) and the \$1 million Belmont Oaks (gr. IT), respectively, July 9.

The 1 1/4-mile turf races will highlight an 11-race card at Belmont Park.

Trainer Aidan O'Brien and owners Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier, and Michael Tabor will be represented in the Derby by Beacon Rock, most recently second as the favorite in the King Edward VII Stakes (Eng-II) June 17 at Royal Ascot, and Bravery, 10th on a soft course at Chantilly in the Prix du Jockey Club (Fr-I) June 5. The connections also will send out Alice Springs, third last time out in the Coronation Stakes (Eng-I) at Royal Ascot, in the Oaks.

Completing the European invitees to the Derby is Chelsea Thoroughbreds Saint Tropez's Humphrey Bogart, sixth behind Across the Stars and Beacon Rock in the King Edward VII last time out and winner of the Betfred Derby Trial Stakes in May at Lingfield.

The Aga Khan's colors will be carried in the Oaks by the Dermot Weld-trained Simannka, who will be making her first start of the year. The Irish-bred daughter of Mastercraftsman made two starts as a juvenile—finishing second first time out and then defeating 11 others to break her maiden at seven furlongs.

Also invited to the Oaks are May Hill Stakes (Eng-II) winner Turret Rocks and the Fabrice Chapet-trained Magnanime, fifth last out in the Prix Saint-Alary (Fr-I) in May at Deauville.

Trainer Chad Brown will spearhead the American contingent with four possible entrants in the Derby, led by Ken and Sarah Ramsey's Camelot Kitten, a winner in two of his three 2016 starts, including the American Turf Stakes (gr. IIT) at Churchill Downs and the Pennine Ridge Stakes (gr. IIIT) June 4. Call Provision, third in the Pennine Ridge; the

Ramsey's Billy's Kitten, who will make his stakes debut; and American Turf runner-up Beach Patrol round out Brown's Derby runners, with Last Waltz and Priced to Perfection heading to the Oaks.

Making her Belmont debut in the Oaks for trainer Mark Casse will be 2015 Canadian Horse of the Year Catch a Glimpse, who has won seven straight, including six consecutive graded stakes. The City Zip filly defeated males last time out in the Penn Mile (gr. IIIT), and previously ticked off wins in the Natalma Stakes (Can-IIIT) and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (gr. IT) last year, and the Herecomesthebride Stakes (gr. IIIT), Appalachian Stakes (gr. IIIT), and Edgewood Stakes (gr. IIIT) this spring.

Casse also will send out multiple graded stakes winner Airoforce, runner-up to Catch a Glimpse in the Penn Mile, in the Derby. **BH**

## PRINCESS ROONEY A POSSIBILITY FOR SHEER DRAMA

Harold Queen's homebred Sheer Drama galloped at Gulfstream Park June 26, but remains on the fence for the \$250,000 Princess Rooney Stakes (gr. II) July 2 at the Florida racetrack.

Trainer David Fawkes scheduled an "open gallop" for the 6-year-old Burning Roma mare, who finished fifth in the grade I Ogden Phipps Stakes at Belmont Park June 11 in her most recent start. Sheer Drama, a winner of \$1,688,540 in 23 starts, has won grade I stakes from seven furlongs (the Madison at Keeneland in April) to 1 1/4 miles (the Delaware Handicap at Delaware Park last year).

The Princess Rooney, at seven furlongs, is part of the \$1.125 million "Summit of Speed" program at Gulfstream. The winner earns an automatic berth in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (gr. I).

"She ran a little bit down the lane," Fawkes said. "She went (:26) down the lane. I just didn't want to do much with her. She just ran. I didn't see any point in breezing her.

"I haven't decided yet (on the Princess Rooney).

Sheer Drama finished fourth in last year's Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I). The \$750,000 Delaware Handicap July 16 isn't a Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" race. **BH**

## PRECOCIOUS HALF TO LIAM'S MAP TO START

Trainer Dale Romans will be sending out the highly regarded 2-year-old Not This Time, a son of Giant's Causeway who is a half brother to last year's Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (gr. I) winner Liam's Map, June 30 at Churchill Downs in the third race, a six-furlong maiden special weight on the main track.

"He's a horse with a bright future that's doing things that a Giant's Causeway 2-year-old isn't supposed to do this time of the year," Romans said. "He's very precocious. He looks like the type that can really win early on. He reminds me of (multiple grade I winner) Brody's Cause. They're both very forward and smart horses."

Not This Time's dam, Miss Macy Sue (Trippi), is a grade III stakes winner with two winners from three starters, including Liam's Map and stakes winner Taylor S.

Romans has high expectations for Albaugh Family's homebred Not This Time, who he says is more ready to run early on than some of his 2-year-olds in the past.

"In my experience, I haven't had many that were as precocious as him and Brody's Cause," Romans said.

"He's had some spectacular works and time-wise I like the way he looks doing it. With this kind of pedigree and the way he's been working you would have to think that he's one of the top dogs."

Not This Time posted a bullet five-furlong breeze in 1:00 flat, the fastest of 38 timed moves at the distance, June 18 at Churchill. **BH**

## EAGLE SPIRIT NAILS DOWN MAIDEN VICTORY

Highlighted in the June 26 Races to Watch, morning-line second choice Eagle Spirit was sent off the 6-5 favorite and pulled off a debut victory for trainer Wesley Ward in the seventh race at Gulfstream Park June 26.

Eagle Spirit, a son of Kitten's Joy, won the \$55,000 maiden special weight by 1 1/2 lengths after staying with the leader and making a surge to the front in the stretch under jockey Rafael Hernandez.

The final time was :57.66 for the five furlongs on firm turf after pacesetter Jax set fractions of :22.51 for the quarter and :45.43 for the half.

Harry's Gone Gray was up to grab second by a neck from Jax. Skinflint, the morning-line favorite, finished fourth in the field of 12.

Racing for Gabriel Duignan and Bruce Pieratt, and bred by Duignan and Crosshaven Bloodstock & Vision Thoroughbreds, Eagle Spirit is out of the winning Fusaichi Pegasus mare Eagle Sound and is a full brother

to 2014 Hagyard Fayette (gr. II) winner Pick of the Litter. Eagle Sound is the dam of three other winners from six to race.

Eagle Spirit's sire, Kitten's Joy, currently the nation's leading turf sire, stands at Ramsey Farm near Nicholasville, Ky., for a 2016 fee of \$100,000. **BH**

## ALBUQUERQUE SEES BENEFIT IN NIGHT RACING

A switch to night racing helped produce large business gains for Albuquerque Downs Racetrack & Casino in New Mexico for the first program of its 2016 meet June 25.

Track officials said total pari-mutuel handle of \$335,668 was up 45% from the 2015 opening-day card, and on-track handle of \$125,795 jumped 107% from last year. The reported attendance of 3,417 was more than three times the attendance for opening day in 2015, officials said.

The Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse meet will span 60 days, with racing Wednesday, Friday, and

Saturday evenings and Sunday afternoons. There is a special Monday program June 26 with first post time at 6:05 p.m. MDT.

Along with the lighting system, the grandstand and track apron were also renovated. Albuquerque officials said June 25 marked the first night racing program in New Mexico since the 1980s.

In the opening night feature, the \$60,000 O.D. McDonald Stakes for New Mexico-bred 3-year-olds and up, UKUSA Stables' Citizen Geller established a track record of 1:20.81 for seven furlongs and paid \$42 to win. Trained by Vance Mikkelson and ridden by Alfredo Sigala, the 4-year-old homebred Pro Prado gelding has five victories and increased his career earnings to \$172,914 from 21 starts. **BH**

## SILVANO'S INFLUENCE CONTINUES

The 2001 Arlington Million Stakes (gr. IT) winner, Silvano, is in a strong position to maintain his influence on South Africa's most famous horse race, the Vodacom Durban July (SAF-I), which takes place July 2.

The son of Lomitas has no fewer than three runners in the 4.25 million rand (\$282,000) contest, with each considered to have a strong chance.

Silvano's representatives include talented 3-year-olds Black Arthur and Marinaresco, as well as the Betting World 1900 (SAF-II) runner-up St Tropez, one of three runners in the race for owners Ingrid and Markus Jooste.

Silvano made history in the July last year when his sons Power King, Punta Arenas, and Tellina gave the sire a remarkable trifecta. He is also the sire of previous Durban July winners Bold Silvano (2010) and Heavy Metal (2013).

Former July winner Dynasty, who like Silvano stands in the Western Cape, is another well-represented sire in the 2016 Durban July, with four runners, including Investec Cape Derby (SAF-I) winner It's My Turn, Betting World 1900 hero Solid Speed and star filly Bela-Bela. **BH**

## MINDING ACCELERATES CLEAR IN PRETTY POLLY

Coolmore and partners' dual English classic winner Minding ran down pacesetter Bocca Baciata and drew away to an easy win in the Sea The Stars Pretty Polly Stakes (Ire-I) June 26 at the Curragh.

The daughter of Galileo scored by 4 1/2 lengths as the 1-5 favorite in the 1 1/4-mile race. Bocca Baciata held for second, five lengths ahead of Lucida.

Bocca Baciata, an Irish group III winner, was out in front early and opened a six-length advantage, with Minding rating in third.

Jockey Ryan Moore urged Minding to go after the leader with a quarter-mile to run, but still had five lengths to catch the front-runner. She accelerated impressively, however, and wore down the runner-up in the final eighth and drew clear.

Lucida, runner-up in the One Thousand Guineas, went to third late after racing in last halfway through.

The final time was 2:09.95 on turf rated as yielding.

Minding earned a fifth group I victory, including the One Thousand Guineas and Investec Epsom Oaks (both Eng-I) this spring, and was runner-up in

the Irish One Thousand Guineas (Ire-I). Never off the board in nine starts, she also has wins in the 2015 Moyglare Stud Stakes (Ire-I) and Dubai Fillies Mile (Eng-I).

"She is a great filly," winning trainer Aidan O'Brien said. "She loves her racing and is getting very relaxed. Ryan was delighted with her, and we will look at something like the Nassau (Eng-I). She has two options really for her next run, the Irish Oaks (Ire-I) and the Nassau, and we are eyeing the Irish Oaks with Even Song."

Moore said Minding was geared down through the final eighth.

"She picked up to get there, and then we shut down in the last furlong and coasted," he said. "There's more there again if we need it. She's a high-class filly and she's adaptable. She's gone on a variety of ground."

"It's some performance from a filly that's had two Guineas and an Oaks to come here. It's a tough schedule and to keep her still progressing is a magnificent achievement."

Minding was bred in Ireland by Orpendale, Chelston, and Wynatt from Coolmore and partners' group I winner Lillie Langtry, also the dam of Kissed by Angels, a full sister to Minding. **BH**

## DURAMENTE UPSET BY MARIALITE, INJURED

U. Carrot Farm's Marialite upstaged heavy favorite Duramente and became only the third female to capture the Japan Racing Association's spring all-star race, the Takarazuka Kinen (Jpn-I), June 26 at Hanshin Racecourse.

With her neck victory in the race, first run in 1960, the 5-year-old Deep Impact mare also earned an automatic starting position in the \$4 million Longines Breeders' Cup Turf (gr. IT) Nov. 5 at Santa Anita Park through the Breeders' Cup Challenge series.

Overcoming an outside draw, Marialite traveled wide midpack in the 17-horse field before going widest of all on the final turn. Accelerating sharply for jockey Masayoshi Ebina, she overhauled defending winner Lovely Day 100 meters out, then caught front-runner Kitanas Black nearing the finishing line.

Duramente, who closed fastest of all through the final three furlongs, ranged up but just missed, edging second favorite Kitanas Black by a nose for second.

Marialite, who broke from post 16 as the eighth wagering choice, completed the 1 3/8 miles in 2:12.08 on turf listed as good and earned her second group I win. She has a 6-2-5 record from 17 starts, which includes her victory in last year's Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Jpn-I) at Kyoto for trainer Takashi Kubota.

"The somewhat soft going and the draw all worked well for her," Ebina said. "She responded well to my urgings and smoothly advanced

forward from the third and fourth corner. She ran a perfect race. I think that the patience of the connections to wait for her to mature has led to this success."

Sunday Racing's Duramente slipped after crossing the wire and was diagnosed with lameness in his left foreleg. The hope of Japan for this year's Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Fr-I) is now expected to miss the race.

The 4-year-old by King Kamehameha missed last year's Arc due to injury as well. During this year's come back he was victorious in Japan's Nakayama Kinen (Jpn-II) and ran a game second to Postponed in the Dubai Sheema Classic Presented By Longines (UAE-I).

Northern Farm-bred Marialite is the first female to win the Takarazuka Kinen since Sweep Toshio in 2005. She is out of the winning El Condor Pasa mare Chrysoprase, a full sister to Japanese grade I winner Alondite and the dam of multiple stakes winner Chrysolite (Gold Allure) and grade II winner Lia Fail (Zenno Rob Roy). **BH**

## SALTARIN DUBAI TAKES CLASSIC IN ARGENTINA

Saltarin Dubai edged solid favorite Don Inc (Include) to win the 2,000-meter (about 1 1/4-mile) Gran Premio Estrellas Classic (Arg-I), the most important of the six group I races staged at the 26th edition of the Carreras de las Estrellas June 25 at Palermo Racetrack in Argentina.

A son of E Dubai out of the Fitzcarraldo mare Saltarina Fitz, Saltarin Dubai fought strongly with Don Inc through the last two furlongs, eventually overcoming the favorite by a neck in a final time of 1:58 4/5.

Saltarin Dubai's trainer Roberto Pellegatta, also conditions Eragon (Offlee Wild), winner of the Gran Premio Estrellas Mile (Arg-I).

"(Saltarin Dubai) is a very good horse. We ran in the Derby (Arg-I) last year, but he suffered a (slight) fracture in his cannon bone. We gave him time and now he is showing all of his potential," said Pellegatta, who also credited jockey Juan Carlos Noriega. "He knows the horse very good, and his ride was excellent."

The winner of four of his six starts, Saltarin Dubai—undefeated this year—was bred by Juan Carlos Bago's Haras Firmamento and belongs to the same female family of group I winners Saludable Nov (Romanov), Gratinada (Scat Daddy) and Semilleta (Farmer).

Sweet Sorrel and Kononkop won the Juvenile (Arg-I) and Juvenile Fillies (Arg-I) divisions, respectively.

Sweet Sorrel pulled off a big surprise, beating favorite In the Dark (Mutakddim) by four lengths. Undefeated in two starts, he is by

Star Dabbler out of the Kingmambo mare Sweet City Gal, and is a half brother to Peruvian group I winner and U.S. winner Kung Fu Mambo (Giant's Causeway), both bred by Jorge Cardemil's Haras Futuro.

Kononkop (Pure Prize—Korea, Southern Halo) crossed the finish line just a nose in front of Coquetteam (Lizard Island) for owner and breeder Haras La Providencia. A half sister to group stakes winner Koller (Orpen), the filly has won all three of her starts and secured the title as champion 2-year-old of the season. In her previous start she won the Gran Premio de Potrancas (Arg-I) over the turf at San Isidro.

Kiriaki (Catcher In The Rye) gave Alejandro Misserocchi's Haras Santa Ines (breeder of Horse of the Year Invasor) another victory in the 2,000-meter Gran Premio Estrellas Distaff (Arg-I), adding to last year's victory with Kalithea (Exchange Rate). Kiriaki was clearly the best, beating Sing In Holiday (Harlan's Holiday) by four lengths in the hands of Gustavo Calvente.

Calvente, who also rode Eragon in the Mile, suffered an accident in the 13th race and missed the winning ride aboard Santillano in the Gran Premio Estrellas Sprint (Arg-I).

The first winner of the day was Don Mengano (El Corredor), victorious in the Clasico Estrellas Junior Sprint for 2-year-old colts and fillies. **BH**
