GULFSTREAM TO HOST TOP CARIBBEAN RACE

Gulfstream Park will host the 2017 Clásico Internacional del Caribe, the Caribbean's premier Thoroughbred race, the Confederation of Caribbean Racetracks announced July 1 at its mid-year meeting at the Florida track.

Representatives of The Stronach Group and the Confederation met Friday afternoon to work on further details of hosting the December 2017 event.

Gulfstream will become the first pari-mutuel facility outside Latin America and the Caribbean to host the Clásico Internacional del Caribe since its inception in 1966. The event includes five races with total purses of \$600,000, including the \$300,000 Caribbean Derby.

"Gulfstream has been approved to host the Clásico here in 2017," said Confederation president Hugo Albarran through an interpreter Friday. "It's historical. It's the first time in 50 years the race will be held (continued on page 2)

in a country that's not a member (of the Confederation). We're very happy with The Stronach Group. We'll make Florida part of Latin America.

"This will help us grow and guarantees the Clásico is successful. It started as a \$30,000 race, then \$50,000, then \$100,000. Now all five races are at \$600,000. It's the biggest purse for any day of Latin America racing."

Albarran, along with The Stronach Group's Mike Rogers and Tim Ritvo, said quarantine issues and travel logistics have been worked out with the United States Department of Agriculture.

During the Confederation's meeting, Rogers and Ritvo spoke about The Stronach Group's passion for horse racing and its ability to hold world-class events at its venues, Gulfstream media officials said. They also spoke of their desire to showcase Latin American racing to a wider audience.

"We believe the opportunity to showcase your product is something that will be beneficial to all the countries involved," Ritvo said. "We believe running this world-class event, along with our passion for horse racing and the dedication to the international Thoroughbred industry by our founder, Mr. Frank Stronach, will enhance and entice people to watch and bet on your product.

"Rest assured, The Stronach Group will be 100% committed to throwing a world-class event and showing off your horse racing to the entire world." **BH**

PENALTIES QUESTIONED AS BORELL RELEASED

A case in Central Kentucky resulting in 43 charges of second degree animal cruelty against trainer Maria Borell and her father, Charles "Chuck" Borell, has brought the laws in the state governing acts such as abandonment to the fore, with some recommending that those laws be stiffened.

Charles Borell was taken into custody earlier this week after 43 horses were apparently abandoned in early June. Charges against Borell, scheduled to appear in District Court July 5, and his daughter, not yet located, were filed after a Kentucky Department of Agriculture investigation determined they were the persons responsible.

Charles Borell was released from the Boyle County Detention Center July 1 after posting a \$4,300 cash non-refundable bond.

Since the horses' plight was first reported in an article by Margaret Ransom at USRacing.com as well as a subsequent visit to the farm and a posting that included photographs on Facebook by Victoria Keith of Fox Hill Farm, there has been an outpouring of support.

In Kentucky second degree animal cruelty is a Class A misdemeanor, punishable by a fine up to \$500 and/or imprisonment up to a year. Since it is a misdemeanor, officials would not be able to extradite an alleged offender if they were to relocate out of state.

In a subsequent Facebook post, Fox Hill Farm owner Rick Porter said they have retained Lexington attorney John Roach to assist in evaluating and possibly getting changes made to Kentucky's animal cruelty laws.

"The Borell horse situation shined a light on the best and the worst of the racing industry," the posting stated. "The worst were the owners who abandoned horses, leaving them without the resources

for proper food, veterinary, and farrier care, resulting in over 40 abused horses. The best was the response of the racing community. The donations and offers for care were overwhelming.

"It appears that the Borell horses are on the path to good health. Less certain is that they will ultimately go to new and loving homes. What could prevent this from happening are the current laws in Kentucky regarding animal welfare."

The Facebook post recalled another incident in which a horse owner in Central Kentucky was found guilty and served time under the cruelty statute in a case in which one horse died. Upon the horse owner's release, they went to court and successfully reacquired possession of the other two horses that had been removed.

"We will work to strengthen Kentucky's laws to protect defenseless animals. We also plan to look within the industry to areas such as licensing and registration that could provide solutions. We may decide to set this up as a nonprofit as this could be an ongoing effort indefinitely.

"We thank everyone who stepped up and played a part in the Borell horses being properly cared for. You made us proud to be part of the racing community." **BH**

'FOREST' GOES FOR BACK-TO-BACK GRADE I WINS

German-bred Wake Forest, who has done little wrong in two starts for trainer Chad Brown this year, chases his second grade I victory in a row in the \$300,000 United Nations Stakes (gr. IT) July 3 at Monmouth Park.

The 6-year-old son of Sir Percy earned his first U.S. stakes victory and first grade or group I with a powerful rally in the May 14 Man o' War (gr. IT), in which he defeated stablemate Money Multiplier by three-quarters of a length. Money Multiplier also returns in this spot as one of three entries for Brown; the 4-year-old son of Lookin at Lucky is in pursuit of his first stakes score.

The 1 3/8-mile Man o' War—ran at the same distance as the United Nations—was the first grade I outing for Wake Forest under Brown's supervision. He ran sixth in the 2015 Arlington Million (gr. IT) for his former owners Klaus Allofs and Stiftung Gestut Fahrhof (also his breeder) and trainer Andreas

Wohler, and was then purchased by Michael Dubb, Sheep Pond Partners, and Bethlehem Stables. He made his debut for his new connections in the April 2 Pan American (gr. IIT) at Gulfstream Park with a head loss to Kaigun before winning the Man o' War.

Grade III winner Mr Maybe, who races for Dubb, Head of Plains Partners, and Highclere America, completes the Brown trio. The 5-year-old son of Ghostzapper was third last time out behind Grand Tito and Kaigun in the March 5 Mac Diarmida (gr. IIT) at Gulfstream.

Can'thelpbelieving, third in the Man o' War, will start from the inside when he takes another shot at his rivals. In his first step into grade I company, trainer Graham Motion's 5-year-old Duke of Marmalade gelding earned his first graded stakes placing with that Man o' War run. Joe Bravo, who won the 2013 and 2012 editions of the United Nations, rides for the first time. Motion took the United Nations in 2014 with Main Sequence, who earned champion grass horse and champion older horse honors that season.

Multiple grade III winner World Approval has been knocking on the grade I door for trainer Mark Casse

in his past two starts, with a third in the Manhattan and a runner-up finish by a neck to Divisidero in the May 7 Woodford Reserve Turf Classic (gr. IT) at Churchill Downs. Triple Threat looks to get back on track after bad racing luck in both of those events; he jumped a fallen foe and lost his rider in the Turf Classic, then ran seventh after breaking slowly in the Manhattan.

Completing the field are allowance winners Cement Clement, Noble Road, Bigger Picture, and Riviere Du Loup. **BH**

ACCOMPLISHED DUO GO HEAD-TO-HEAD IN SALVATOR

Mr. Jordan, a 4-year-old Kantharos colt bred by Philip and Karen Matthews, and Green Gratto, a 6-year-old by Here's Zealous, are the most accomplished runners entered in the July 2 Salvator Mile (gr. III) at Monmouth Park.

Mr. Jordan won the Juvenile Sprint Stakes and the Smooth Air Stakes in 2014, and earned his first graded victory in the Pegasus Stakes (gr. III) at Monmouth last year. The colt is trained by Edward Plesa Jr. and owned by David Melin, Leon Ellman, and Laurie Plesa. The Salvator Mile will be his first start since he finished third in a handicap at Tampa Bay Downs in February.

Green Gratto, from the barn of trainer Gaston Grant—who owns him along with Anthony Grant—is sending out his charge in an attempt to find his way to the winners' circle for the first time in 2016. Five of Green Gratto's six victories have come at Aqueduct Racetrack, including his grade III win in the Fall Highweight Handicap last November, the highest class level he's been victorious in. Last year, he

placed second in the Carter Handicap (gr. I), also at Aqueduct. He went on to win the Gravesend Stakes at the same track a month after his victory in the Fall Highweight.

Out of four starts at Monmouth, his best finish was a second in the John J. Reilly Handicap in May. He comes into the Salvator Mile seeking to move forward from that effort and an 11th-place finish in his last race, the Jaipur Invitational Stakes at Belmont Park, which was his only off-the-board finish out of three starts this year.

Nonna's Boy and Res Judicata are the other stakes winners in the field of six.

Nonna's Boy, owned and bred by Repole Stable and trained by Todd Pletcher, won the Lamplighter Stakes at Monmouth last July and has been winless since. He tried grade III company twice, both times finishing fourth and comes into the Salvator off two allowance optional claiming races. He finished fifth in his last start in early June at Belmont.

Res Judicata, bred by Patricia Chapman and owned by Someday Farm, is a two-time stakes winner going postward for trainer John Servis.

Allowance winners Allied Air Raid, owned by Ten

Strike Racing, and Comfort, owned by Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners and also from the barn of Todd Pletcher, round out the field. **BH**

DANZING CANDY LOOKS TO REGROUP IN AFFIRMED

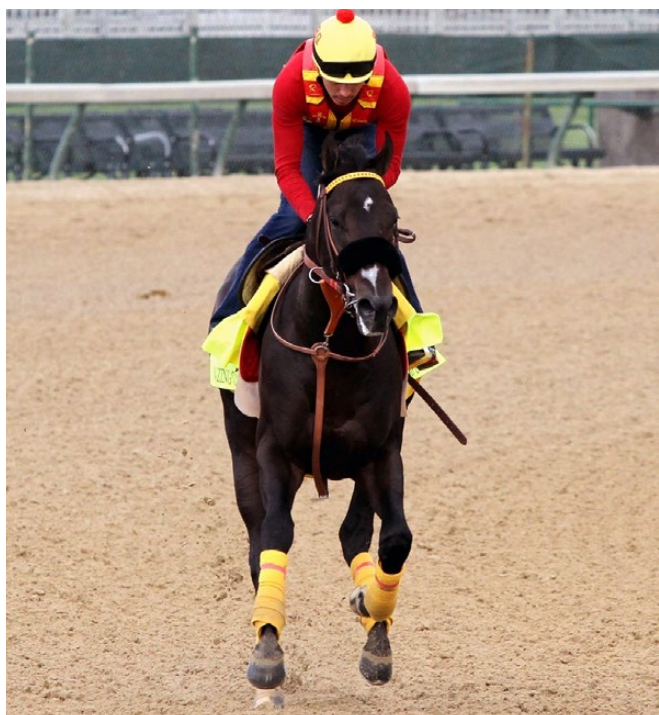
Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I) pacesetter Danzing Candy, who moved to Bob Baffert's barn after he finished 15th on the first Saturday in May for trainer Cliff Sise, will make the first start for his new trainer July 2 in the \$100,000 Affirmed Stakes (gr. III) at Santa Anita Park.

The son of Twirling Candy defeated Santa Anita Derby (gr. I) and Preakness (gr. I) winner Exaggerator three starts back in the San Felipe Stakes (gr. II), but will drop significantly in class for the 1 1/16-mile Affirmed.

Only one other entrant in the five-colt field, last-out allowance winner Dalmore, has won a race outside of the maiden ranks. Danzing Candy has three wins from six starts, with earnings of \$358,650 while Dalmore, the only other entrant with six-figure earnings, checks in at \$127,302, with a 2-3-0 record from 10 starts.

The field does, however, feature horses with potential to show early speed, but it remains to be seen whether Beaumarchais, who won a \$75,000 maiden claiming event in gate-to-wire fashion last time out, or Curlin Rules, who ran third to Dalmore May 29, can challenge Danzing Candy on the front end.

The Affirmed will not only be Danzing Candy's first start for Baffert but also his first with perennial Santa Anita leading jockey Rafael Bejarano. **BH**

DQ GIVES WHAT NOW HIS FIRST WINNER

Maybe not the way the connections wanted but Red Hot Rumor became Indiana freshman sire What Now's first winner in her first start July 1 at Indiana Grand Racecourse following a disqualification.

Red Hot Rumor, a filly out of unraced Streaking Rhonda (Could Be Me), is a homebred racing for Don and Pepper Wright. Trained by Joseph Davis, she was one of two first-time starters for the stallion—Bar Rag was the other in the same race.

In the third race at Indiana Grand, Red Hot Rumor stalked the pace in fourth place as Whistle Stop took the field through fractions of :22.78 and :47.30. Whistle Stop then blew the turn, bolted toward the outside rail, and cut in front of Justiceonthebeach, who was at her flank. Whistle Stop got straightened out and hit the wire six lengths in front but got taken down for interference.

Jockey Mario Rodriguez gave Red Hot Rumor a steady ground-saving trip and was second past the wire. The final time for the five-furlong \$34,000 maiden special weight was 1:00.20.

What Now is a winning son of Distorted Humor out of Tizamazing, the dam of Preakness Stakes (gr. I) winner Oxbow. He stands at R Star Stallions for \$1,500. **BH**

MASTERCRAFTSMAN COLT TOPS RECORD ARQANA SALE

A winning Mastercraftsman colt named Dance of Life was bought for a sale record €400,000 (US\$445,061) July 1 on the final day of the Arqana summer sale, which closed with record sales.

Total receipts broke €7 million for the first time, at €7,128,000 (\$7,931,500), up 30% from the 2015 auction. The average settled at €31,401 (\$34,940), a 22% increase. For the first time, fillies in and out of training as well as broodmares were added to the catalog, which featured breeze-up 2-year-olds, horses in training, and National Hunt store horses.

The sale-topping Mastercraftsman colt, a 3-year-old who won going about 1 5/16 miles June 16 at Saint-Cloud, will ship to Australia to Ballymore Stables and trainer Mike Moroney following his sale to Robert Nataf of Horse France—bidding on behalf of Moroney's brother Paul Moroney.

"He has the ideal profile to succeed in Australia as a progressive 3-year-old who combines speed and the ability to stay a mile and a half," Nataf said of the colt offered by trainers Carlos and Yann Lerner.

He is out of the stakes-placed Exceed And Excel mare Above Limits. Second dam Cin Isa Luv, by Private Account, is a half sister to U.S. grade I winner Script Ohio and grade III winner Young Daniel.

The addition of fillies and broodmares in the catalog proved a success with 50 of the 62 (81%) females on offer changing for an average price of €23,670 (\$26,341). Three of them commanded prices in excess of €100,000, including Wadyhatta, a 4-year-old daughter of Cape Cross offered by Haras du Mézeray

in foal to Authorized. Nataf landed her for €275,000 (\$306,058), the highest price among them.

A half sister to two listed performers, 4-year-old Wadyhatta won twice in 10 starts for Sheikh Hamdan. She is out of the Anabaa mare Thamarat, a stakes-placed juvenile and half sister to the dual group I-winning miler Tamayuz. The family traces back to one of the most influential mares in the stud book in Allegretta—Urban Sea, Sea The Stars, Galileo, Born To Sea, King's Best, and Anabaa Blue all feature on the catalog page.

"You only need to look at her pedigree to understand why I wanted her," Nataf said. "She will foal down in France before shipping to America to be covered by one of Coolmore's stallions."

Arqana president Eric Hoyeau was pleased with the record-setting sale.

"It is very satisfactory to see the summer sale set two historical records for turnover as well as highest price," he said. "The challenge with horses in training sales is to gather the horses who match the criteria of the global market. As we could see over these two days, every horse with the right profile sold well. The new breeding stock section also returned positive results, with a high clearance rate." **BH**

CHANGES TO PA BREEDING FUND IN QUESTION

The head of the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association said July 1, legislation that would alter the Thoroughbred breeding fund isn't workable because the proposed percentages could greatly reduce restricted races and owners' bonuses.

The bill, which passed the state House of Representatives June 30 on a 143-2 vote, was sent to the Senate Rules and Executive Nominations Committee as the 2016 regular session neared an end. Breeders' awards haven't been paid for months because language in a horseracing reform bill that became law in late February was deemed problematic by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, which oversees racing and breeding in the state.

A department spokeswoman said payment of the awards hinges on action by the state General Assembly.

PHBA president Brian Sanfratello said language as amended by the House would require a shift of about \$5.2 million to breeders' awards, which would leave "little or no money" for more than 400 state-bred races and owners' bonuses.

Under the bill that passed the House, awards to breeders of Pennsylvania-breds sired by Pennsylvania stallions that finish first, second, or third would jump from 30% to 50% of the purse. Similar awards for Pennsylvania-breds by out-of-state stallions would increase from 20% to 30% of the purse. Bonus money for the owners of Pennsylvania-based sires whose progeny finish first, second, or third would remain at 10%.

"We already receive about \$13 million (each year) for the Pennsylvania-bred program from both horsemen's organizations in the state," Sanfratello said. "They cannot put out any more money; they can't absorb that \$5.2 million. They'd have to cut purses. The bottom line is if we have to pay that \$5.2 million,

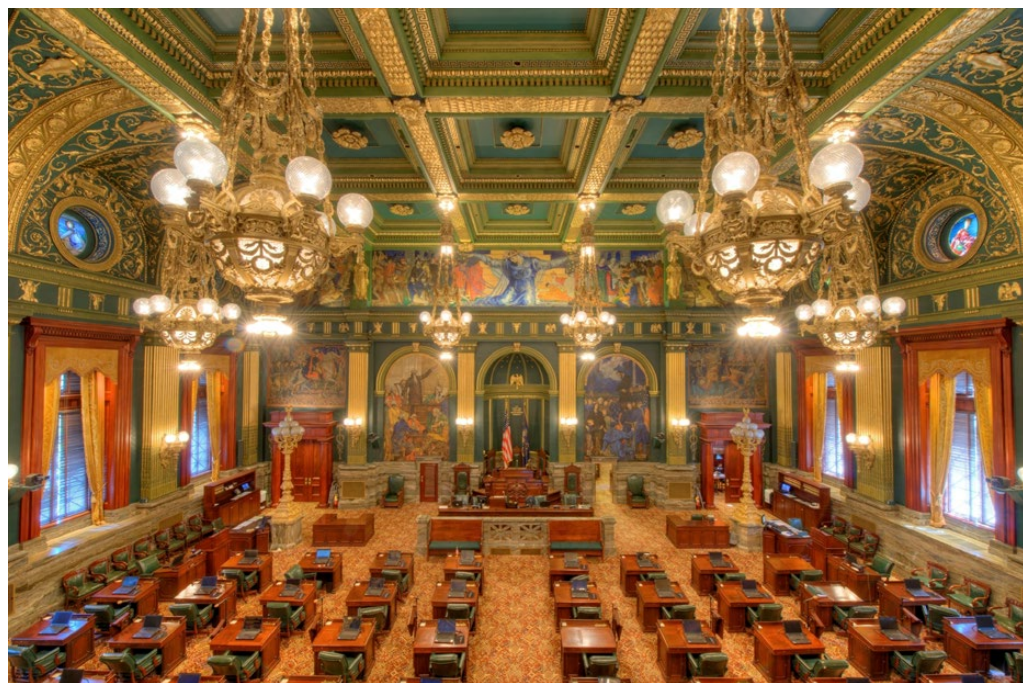
there would be no money left for restricted races and owners' bonuses."

Supporters of the language passed by the House said the impact wouldn't be that dramatic because the number of Pennsylvania-breds has declined substantially in recent years, so breeders' award money that is paid has dropped in tandem. They also said there would be sufficient funding for owners' purse bonuses.

Roughly \$17 million for the Thoroughbred breeding incentive program, which totals about \$30 million when contributions from purse accounts are included, comes from slot machine revenue at the state's casinos as mandated by the 2004 law that authorized gaming in Pennsylvania. Lawmakers on multiple occasions have dipped into racing's share to cover other budget needs and have questioned whether a large percentage of the program's money is going out of state rather than being used to grow Pennsylvania breeding and agriculture.

Sanfratello also said any program that would lower the 40% owners' bonus for Pennsylvania-breds that finish first, second, or third in races at Parx Racing—the percentage is lower at the state's other two tracks—would impact the value of state-bred racehorses.

"If there are no owners' bonuses, what about the 50% of the people who sell horses?" he said. "We look at the total and complete program." **BH**

New Mexico's new rule has strong support from racing and state agencies

NM CREATES RULE TO SUSPEND HORSES

Horses testing positive for some substances in New Mexico, effectively will be suspended for at least 60 days through use of the state's stewards' list.

As of June 29, horses face suspension if tested positive for substances:

- listed in Penalty Class A category of the Association of Racing Commissioners International's uniform classification guidelines for foreign substances;
- any prohibited androgenic steroid or any anabolic steroid in excess of permitted concentrations;
- clenbuterol or other beta-agonist drugs with significant anabolic effects;
- other drugs designed to promote muscle growth, including but not limited to growth hormones, somatotropins, insulin growth factors, and;
- gene-modifying agents, and cobalt in excess of allowable concentrations.

New Mexico Racing Commission medical director Dr. Scot Waterman, the former executive director of the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium, wrote the new rule.

"In all my time spent regulating horse racing in other jurisdictions, never have I experienced such unity amongst all stakeholders in creating an environment that is best for horse racing and the horse itself," NMRC executive director Ismael "Izzy" Trejo said.

Horses that test positive would stay on the stewards' list for a minimum of 60 days, after which the owner or trainer of the horse must present the horse to the test barn for an official veterinarian to obtain a blood sample.

If the sample is positive for any of the prohibited substances previously mentioned, the horse will remain on the stewards' list for an additional 60 days. If negative, the horse will be removed from the stewards' list and permitted to run in races. **BH**

NEW BONUS PROGRAM LAUNCHED FOR VA-BREDS

An owners' bonus program for Virginia-bred runners that win overnight races at tracks in the Mid-Atlantic region will begin July 1 and run through Dec. 31.

The program, offered by the Virginia Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association and Virginia Thoroughbred Association and approved by the Virginia Racing Commission June 21, will provide a bonus of 25% of the purse to any Virginia-bred racehorse that wins an overnight race in Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, or West Virginia.

There will be a cap of \$10,000 on any single award, officials said.

VTA executive director Debbie Easter said owners whose horses are eligible for bonuses must contact the VTA and submit a W-9 form. Checks will be mailed at the end of each month; the VTA must be contacted by the 20th of each month for payment to be received; otherwise it will be processed for the following month.

"We hope this new program will help current owners of Virginia-breds while we rebuild our race program in Virginia," Virginia HBPA executive director Frank Petramalo said in a release. "Virginia breeders have always produced a quality product. This new regional owners' bonus program, added to our nationwide breeders' program, will help boost the appeal of Virginia-breds in the marketplace."

Since the closure of Colonial Downs, Virginia stakeholders have worked to identify new racing venues in the state and re-open off-track betting parlors. Virginia-bred stakes have been held at Laurel Park and Pimlico Race Course in neighboring Maryland; the first round for this year was held June 16 at Pimlico. **BH**

COURTS NEED TO CONSIDER PUBLIC TRUST

Fortunately we live in a country where it is difficult to sanction someone before they are convicted of a crime. That carries over to horse racing, where it's difficult for regulators to sanction a license holder until administrative and court hearings have been completed.

Current efforts by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission to immediately suspend trainer Otabek Umarov serve as the latest example of this type of case and, not surprisingly, the Franklin (Ky.) Circuit Court granted Umarov a stay of the commission's penalty—which included a 10-year suspension—until an administrative hearing is conducted.

In the case, the KHRC accuses Umarov of refusing to allow a blood sample to be collected from his horse Looks to Spare April 30 at Churchill Downs. The trainer contends he was only confused and not confident the person requesting the sample was a regulatory veterinarian.

In granting the stay, I don't believe enough weight was given to horse racing's reliance on the economic engine of pari-mutuel wagering. With gambling dollars providing track revenues and horsemen's purses, public trust is of great importance. Umarov's attorney, Justin Fowles, argued that there is no harm if Umarov is allowed to continue to train while the case is adjudicated.

In granting Umarov a stay, Franklin Circuit Court Judge Phillip Shepherd seemed to agree

with that argument as he noted the KHRC, "retains full authority to regulate his conduct and to ensure compliance with its regulation during the pendency of this restraining order."

I would disagree with Fowles' argument that there is no harm in allowing Umarov to continue to train. Should a horse trained by Umarov show up in a race any time soon, horseplayers will shake their head in frustration that a trainer facing a 10-year suspension is able to enter horses in a race that the bettors are now expected to wager their money.

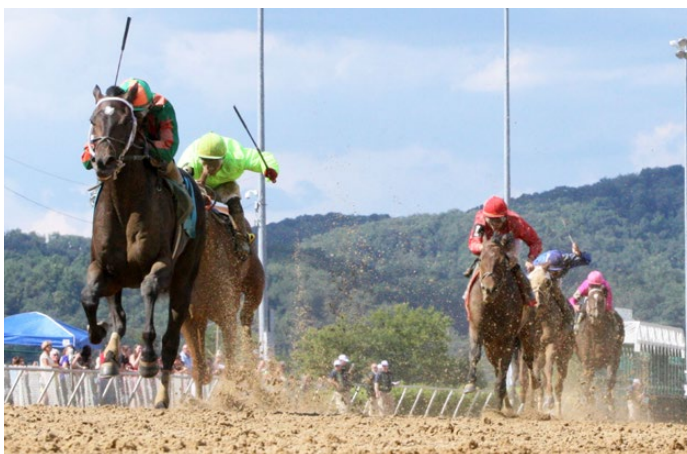
The mistrust and hit to public confidence

that such a scenario would cause would be of great harm to horse racing. And while regulators would be able to test Umarov's horses, those tests—the majority of which are post-race—offer little protection for the horseplayer. When post-race tests result in a disqualification, wagering payouts are not refigured.

Oddly enough, out-of-competition testing affords horseplayers more protection as those tests are conducted before races. Umarov is accused of refusing to allow one of his horses to receive such a test.

It's a high hurdle for regulators to immediately begin a penalty, but make no mistake, if Umarov starts a horse during this stay, it will negatively impact the sport.

A 2011 McKinsey Report on horse racing said just 46% of current fans would recommend the sport to their friends. If those current fans see Umarov enter a horse during this stay, do you think that percentage will be going up or down? **BH**

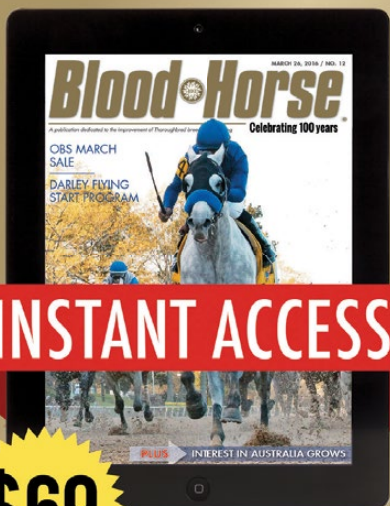
