SEEKING THE GOLD EUTHANIZED AT AGE 31

he legacy of multiple grade I winner Seeking the Gold, who was euthanized July 28 at the age of 31 due to infirmities from old age, may be felt most through his daughters.

"He was without question one of our top sires, but he also turned out to be an exceptional broodmare sire," said Bernie Sams, bloodstock manager at Claiborne Farm, where the son of Mr. Prospector stood since 1990. "In a lot of ways that's more important because it keeps the breeding program strong and helps an operation like Claiborne, where a considerable number of our clients breed to race."

As a broodmare sire through July 28, Seeking the Gold has been represented by 13 champions, 60 (continued on page 2)

graded/group stakes winners, and 144 black-type stakes winners. His best runners to date have been Japanese group winner Seeking the Dia and multiple grade I winner Riskaverse along with promising sires Blame, who was bred and raced by Claiborne with Adele Dilschneider and now stands at the farm, and Point of Entry, a Phipps Stable homebred who stands at Adena Springs Kentucky.

At age of 5, Seeking the Gold entered stud at Claiborne where he soon became one of the most influential sires of his generation. Crowned leading freshman sire of 1993, Seeking the Gold rose as high as number two on the general sire list behind Storm Cat in 2000.

Among his 91 stakes winners were five champions—Dubai Millennium, Seeking the Pearl, Heavenly Prize, Flanders, and Catch the Ring—and three Breeders' Cup World Championship winners—Flanders, Cash Run, and Pleasant Home.

As a sire, he's produced four champions, 47 graded/group winners, and 91 black-type winners (9%) and has total progeny earnings of just over \$95 million. His runners averaged a robust \$124,024 in earnings, which equates to a 2.21 Average Earnings Index.

A son of Mr. Prospector, out of the Buckpasser mare Con Game, Seeking the Gold was foaled at Claiborne near Paris, Ky., in 1985. Shug McGaughey trained the colt for breeder/owner Ogden Phipps, winning eight times in 15 starts. His victories included the Super Derby (gr. I), Dwyer (gr. I), Peter Pan (gr. II), and Swale Stakes. He was the runner-up to eventual Horse of the Year Alysheba in the 1988 Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) and was second in four other grade I stakes. His career earnings exceeded \$2.3 million.

In November 2008, he was pensioned from stallion duty at the age of 24. During his career, Seeking the Gold stood for stud fees as high as \$250,000.

"We're saddened by the loss of this magnificent racehorse and stallion," said Daisy Phipps Pulito, granddaughter of the late Ogden Phipps. "He meant so much to my grandfather and the Phipps Stable breeding program." BH

CONNECT HOLDS OFF STABLEMATE FOR **CURLIN WIN**

onnect and Gift Box, stablemates trained by Chad Brown, matched strides down the stretch in the \$100,000 Curlin Stakes but pacesetter Connect dug in and edged away to win by a length June 29 at Saratoga Race Course.

While Paul Pompa Jr.'s Connect dictated a relaxed tempo in the 1 1/8-mile race for 3-year-olds, Gift Box tracked just off the pace in second, then third, on the inside through a half-mile in :48.43 before challenging on the turn. The pair entered the stretch on nearly even terms and dueled down the lane, but Connect had power in reserve to get the victory under John Velazquez.

Connect, a son of race namesake Curlin, twotime Horse of the Year who stands stud at Hill 'n' Dale Farms near Lexington, finished the distance in 1:48.69 for his third successive win and first stakes triumph in his stakes debut. The Curlin is a prep for the \$1.25 million Travers (gr. I).

Connect grabbed control from Rachel Alexandra's half brother Dolphus to lead before the first turn. He was clear by 1 1/2 lengths for an easy :24.06 opening quarter with Gift Box in closest pursuit among six rivals. Getting more pressure from Gift Box and Javier Castellano nearing the far turn and midway around the bend, Connect entered the stretch with only a neck ahead of his stablemate. The pair commenced a stirring stretch battle before Connect kicked clear in the final 70 yards.

Gift Box, the even-money favorite, stayed on for second, withForever d'Oro third, three lengths back.

Connect, the 8-5 second choice, paid \$5.50, \$2.80, and \$2.40. Gift Box returned \$2.50 and \$2.10, and Forever d'Oro delivered \$5 to show.

Ready Dancer finished fourth, followed by Dolphus, Majesto, and Swipe.

Connect had one outing as a 2-year-old in December at Aqueduct Racetrack, broke his maiden in his sophomore debut May 7 at Belmont Park, and then captured a one-turn 1 1/16-mile allowance race June 11 at the Elmont, N.Y., track. The two previous margins of victory were a combined 7 3/4 lengths.

Bred in Kentucky by Fox Straus KY, Connect is out of the unraced Holy Bull mare Bullville Belle, also the dam of a Cherokee Run half sister in multiple stakes winner Tani Maru. The colt was a \$150,000 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July yearling sale purchase in 2014 for Pompa via Xavier International Bloodstock. VanMeter Sales consigned. The mare is a half sister to grade III winner and sire Native Regent. BH

TEPIN TO SKIP FOURSTARDAVE

Reigning champion turf female Tepin will bypass the Aug. 13 Fourstardave Handicap (gr. IT) at Saratoga Race Course and is now possible to face fellow grade I winner Lady Eli in the Aug. 27 Woodford Reserve Ballston Spa (gr. IIT).

Trainer Mark Casse said the 5-year-old daughter of Bernstein was "fine" physically but had a couple "blah days" this week and they opted not to breeze her as planned this weekend.

The one-mile Fourstardave was slated to be Tepin's first start since becoming the first U.S.-based horse to capture the Queen Anne Stakes (Eng-I) at Royal Ascot on June 14.

"We said all along that everything had to go perfect for us to (make the Fourstardave)," Casse said. "When we went to Royal Ascot, we never planned on bringing her back that quickly. Then when we got to looking at it we said 'well, maybe' but everything had to go right.

"She had a couple blah days this week, enough so we didn't get to lead up to this weekend the way we wanted. We had planned on breezing her tomorrow (July 30) which would have been a big work for her. And we just felt she wasn't ready to do that yet. So now we'll just kind of sit back and we're still looking at the Ballston Spa."

Tepin raced in the 1 1/16-mile Ballston Spa last season when she was caught right on the wire and beaten a head by Chad Brown-trained Dacita. Brown also trains unbeaten Lady Eli, who is under consideration for the Ballston Spa as her comeback race after being stricken with laminitis last summer following her victory in the Belmont Oaks Invitational Stakes (gr. IT).

Casse said the Sept. 17 Woodbine Mile (Can-IT) remains a target for Tepin.

"If there is a way to get there, that is a big target," Casse said. "In the beginning, we never even planned on the Ballston Spa, then we put that on the map. There could be a possibility if we pass the Ballston Spa that we got right into the Mile."

Owned by Robert Masterson and bred by Machmer Hall, Tepin has won seven straight races since her defeat in the Ballston Spa last summer, including her victory in the 2015 Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) at Keeneland last Oct. 31. The bay mare has won 12 of 20 career outings with earnings of \$3,563,838. BH

BRADESTER AIMS TO FURTHER **MONMOUTH SUCCESS**

radester has many factors in his corner coming into the July 31 Monmouth Cup Stakes (gr. II) going 1 1/16 miles with a field of six older horses signed on for the event.

Millionaire Bradester not only won the Monmouth Cup a year ago, he seems to thrive at Monmouth Park with three wins and three seconds from his six starts there. He is also the lone grade I winner in the field, with a wire-to-wire victory in the Stephen Foster Handicap last time out. In May he took the Majestic Light Stakes at Monmouth.

Bradester should be on or just off the lead, and towers over this field.

Adirondack King finished second in the Majestic Light, 2 1/4 lengths behind Bradester. He's banked more than a half-million in his 40-race career and won the Challenge Stakes earlier this year. He's versatile enough to be close up or in mid-pack.


Encryption enters off a win in the Turning Home Stakes, and won the Bayern Stakes last season. He's a classy type but was third in the Majestic Light and

has to make up for the 8 3/4 lengths he finished behind Bradester.

Blofeld won the Futurity and Nashua stakes (both gr. II) as a 2-year-old but hasn't maintained the form. Scuba and Mr. Jordan round out the field. BH



CURALINA GETS SHUVEE CLASS RELIEF

clipse Thoroughbred Partners' Curalina takes a class drop and looms a standout in a four-horse field for the \$200,000 Shuvee Handicap (gr. III) July 31 at Saratoga Race Course.

Curalina will be ridden by Hall of Fame jockey John Velazquez as the 122-pound highweight, conceding from five to eight pounds to her challengers.

The 4-year-old daughter of Curlin opened her 2016 season for trainer Todd Pletcher impressively May 6 at Churchill Downs, where she drew off to a 7 1/2-length victory in the \$300,000 La Troienne (gr. I). This was her third win in top company; she also took the grade I Acorn and Coaching Club American Oaks in 2015.

In her latest outing, the filly who has won half of her 10 career starts for earnings of over \$1.25 million, held a brief lead as the 9-5 favorite in the Ogden Phipps (gr. I) at Belmont Park, but was overtaken to finish fourth, 3 3/4 lengths behind winner Cavorting.

Also returning from the Ogden Phipps is thirdplace finisher Carrumba, the only other graded winner in the Shuvee by virtue of her facile victory in the

Top Flight Invitational (gr. III). She will break from the rail as the 117-pound second highweight.

Morning Line Racing Stable's Joint Return and 114-pound lightweight Sweetgrass complete the lineup. BH

ORTIZ SECURES WIN 1,000 IN JOHN MORRISSEY

ew York-based Jose Ortiz secured his 1,000th victory when he guided Albert Fried Jr.'s homebred Moonlight Song to a three-quarter-length win in the \$100,000 John Morrissey Stakes July 28 at Saratoga Race Course.

Moonlight Song secured the John Morrissey for a second straight year, completing 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:15.99.

Ortiz, who began riding races in his native Puerto Rico in 2011, gave a shout-out to his older brother and fellow rider, Irad Ortiz Jr., when discussing his milestone.

"This means a lot. It's a big goal in my career,"
Ortiz said in the winner's circle. "I want to thank every single owner and trainer who gave me the opportunity. My family, and my fiancee (Taylor Rice) who support me every day, my brother, who taught me a lot when I first started riding."

Ortiz, 23, began riding in the U.S. in 2012 and already has six grade I wins. He was the regular rider on last year's champion female sprinter La Verdad. He has earned three straight meet riding titles at New

York Racing Association tracks, finishing atop the Aqueduct Racetrack inner track standings for 2015-2016 and taking the Aqueduct spring meet, then running away with the recently completed Belmont Park spring meet with 78 wins to outfinish his runner-up brother by 21 victories. He also won the 2014-15 Aqueduct inner track and spring meets. BH

LITTLE MIKE ARRIVES AT OLD FRIENDS

ld Friends president Michael Blowen saw an unfamiliar character standing in the driveway of the Georgetown, Ky., farm during his morning rounds July 29.

Blowen was expecting the arrival of four-time grade I winner Little Mike Friday morning, but he was unsure of whom the man was. After a quick inquiry he discovered it was Carlo Vaccarezza, the owner, breeder, and trainer of the incoming retiree.

"I usually go around about 7 o'clock and try to stay out of the way of people doing real work," Blowen said. "There was a strange man in the driveway. Carlo flew all night from Florida, just to get the horse off the van. I was totally flabbergasted."

Bred by Vaccarezza in 2007, the Spanish Steps gelding out of the Wavering Monarch mare Hay Jude is now a 9-year-old and made the final start of his career July 10 at Gulfstream Park, where he set the

pace and tired to fifth in a 1 1/16-mile turf allowance. It was his first start off a more than twoyear layoff.

Blowen said Vaccarezza called 10 minutes after the race to arrange Little Mike's retirement plans at Old Friends. Almost three weeks later, the gelding settled in well during his first day at his new home.


"He walked off the van, Carlo gave him some mints, I gave him some carrots, he rolled a couple times, ate his hay, and settled right in," Blowen said. "He's been to

Dubai—he's been all over. He's seen everything, so nothing bothers him."

Little Mike's trips abroad—he also travelled to Hong Kong—never resulted in a victory, but his resume ranks with the best of the 107 horses at Old Friends. According to Blowen, Little Mike ranks third by earnings of the superstars on the farm—behind Silver Charm and Game On Dude, and in front of War Emblem.

An earner of more than \$3.5 million, Little Mike won 14 of his 30 starts, including four turf grade I victories for trainer Dale Romans—the Woodford Reserve Turf Classic, Arlington Million, and Breeders' Cup Turf in 2012, and the 2013 Joe Hirsch Turf Classic. If not for the presence of Wise Dan, he almost surely would have been an Eclipse Award winner in 2012.

"It's so thrilling to have him here," Blowen said. "I'm star-struck around all these horses and he fits right in with the best we have here." BH

DAUGHTER OF SCAT DADDY CRUISES IN MAIDEN

//esterday's Races to Watch highlighted Race 5 at Ellis Park, where Daddys Lil Darling, a half sister to grade I winner Mongolian Saturday, split rivals to pull away in the stretch and win by eight lengths.

Originally a 12-horse field, six horses entered the gate for the one-mile maiden special weight event.

Youngest Daughter set moderate fractions with the field bunched up behind. Clearly Claire tracked her in second to the outside, keeping Daddys Lil Darling on the rail. Boxed in, the eventual winner waited in traffic but dashed between horses entering the stretch.

A Kentucky homebred for Normandy Farm out of the graded stakes-placed Houston mare Miss Hot Salsa, the daughter of Scat Daddy won impressively in her second start for trainer Kenny McPeek. Declan Cannon rode her to victory.

"Really special filly for Nancy Polk. Pocahontas Stakes (gr. II) at Churchill is next in early September," McPeek stated on Twitter.

Clearly Claire and Youngest Daughter battled for second, with Clearly Claire—half sister to Indiana Oaks (gr. II) winner Family Tree—prevailing by a head.

Mongolian Saturday won last year's TwinSpires Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (gr. IT) after finishing second in three other graded stakes. Since, he contested the Longines Hong Kong Sprint and the Chairman's Sprint Prize (both HK-I) at Sha Tin before traveling to Royal Ascot and Newmarket for group I events. BH

FIRST WINNER FOR LOUISIANA'S TIGHT GRIP

ouisiana freshman sire Tight Grip got his first winner July 28 at Evangeline Downs when Onefor Thegripper won at first asking by a length in a five-furlong maiden claimer. The final time was 1:01.65

Onefor Thegripper is out of the winning Erlton mare Mt. Quincy, who was raced by I.L. Lange, the breeder of Onefor Thegripper. The Louisiana-bred is now owned by Bobby Dupree and trained by Carl Deville.

Tight Grip is a winning son of Distorted Humor—Roman Song (Sultry Song) who was bred in Kentucky by Charles Nuckols & Sons. Gary and Mary West bought the colt for \$300,000 as a yearling and earned nearly \$274,000 with him at the track.

Unraced Roman Song, who died in 2006, was out of stakes-placed Roman Heiress, who produced multiple stakes winner Lady of Peace. Tight Grip's third dam Sweetest Roman is the dam of Sweetest Lady, who produced 2002 Kentucky Derby (gr. I) winner War Emblem along with stakes winner and stakes producer Pretty Gale.

Tight Grip has eight named foals in his first crop and has one other starter named Good Gosh Gene, who has placed. The stallion stands at Caswick Farm in Louisiana for \$1,000. BH

AUSTRALIAN BREEDERS MULL LEGAL ACTION

t a board meeting last week, the Thoroughbred Breeders of Australia voted unanimously to oppose new rules for foals that owners say are being forced upon them by the nation's racing regulator, Racing Australia.

The TBA said legal action is under consideration. Racing Australia has mandated a foal's acceptance into the Stud Book is conditional on it being registered within 30 days of foaling and that ownership must be declared within a further 30 days. Failure to comply will lead to the foal being barred from eligibility to be registered as a racehorse at a later date.

TBA president Basil Nolan said while his group supports measures that would enhance animal welfare and improve transparency and traceability of ownership, what Racing Australia has proposed would give total control over the breeding industry to bodies established to regulate racing.

"It was clear that breeders across the country have been relaying their opposition to these rules to their state breeding bodies," Nolan said. "TBA has also been overwhelmed by the opposition these rules have caused among our members."

TBA has no formal representation on the Racing Australia board.

"Without meaningful representation we believe this is potentially very damaging for our industry. We are in consultation with our lawyers and we will consider all options available to challenge these new rules."

On June 27, TBA was provided a draft set of rules to review; some of the rules differed significantly from previous drafts TBA was given, Nolan said in early July.

"Among the new regulations was a demand that Principal Racing Authorities (Racing Victoria, Racing NSW, etc.) be informed every time an 'unnamed horse' (i.e. foal or yearling) was moved

from one property to another (for example if going to a veterinary clinic for treatment, being walked out with a mare to visit a stallion farm, etc.). And also that Principal Racing Authorities would have to be informed and give their approval before a dead foal or yearling was 'disposed of,' " Nolan said.

Ned Toffey, general manager of B. Wayne Hughes' Lexington-based Spendthrift Farm, sees valid arguments on both sides. Spendthrift launched an Australian operation last year in Victoria with both stallions and mares.

"It's a little bit concerning; we'd like to see how it will shake out," Toffey said. "We're kind of the new guy—a lot of (Australian) breeders down there have a lot more perspective on this than we do.

"But the argument of trying to get as much transparency and standardization throughout the breeding industry as possible is not a bad thought. Trying to make sure that things are done as ethically as possible—we've certainly seen situations over here where some horses have been abandoned. What (Racing Australia) are doing is looking to give them some repercussions on people who do these kinds of things," Toffey said. "I think there are some valid arguments from that side.

"On the other side of the coin is the concern about the lack of representation; that's a huge concern. Lack of representation is never a good thing. I think we founded this country on that principle. How this is going to play out, I'm not sure. ... But obviously there's a lot of sides to this." BH

OHIO-BREDS COME UP BIG IN 2015

s money from added gaming has arrived in purses at Buckeye State tracks, Ohio-breds reached a new milestone in 2015.

According to Jockey Club statistics, the 608 Ohio-bred runners in 2015 averaged \$20,588 in purse earnings, the first time Ohio-breds have surpassed the \$20,000 threshold. Just five years earlier, Ohiobreds averaged \$8,288 in purses. The 2015 average earnings for Ohio-breds marked a 148% increase since those 2010 numbers.


The next numbers to watch will be the Ohio foal crops. The 608 Ohio-breds raced last year is down 67% since 1996.


Ohio is one of nine states and provinces in 2015 to have runners average more than \$20,000 in earnings last season, joining Kentucky, \$27,897; New York, \$27,467; Ontario, \$24,823; Pennsylvania, \$23,110; New Jersey, 22,553; Maryland, \$22,293; Virginia, \$21,675, and Florida, \$20,588. BH


