STELLAR UPSET: BEHOLDER GAME IN DEFEAT

Kosta Hronis played a bit coy earlier in the week about Stellar Wind's chances in her second try against Beholder.

He gushed about the honor of being able to run against the three-time champion in the \$300,000 Clement L. Hirsch (gr. I), but showed no interest in ducking her on their home turf. The owner also made sure to stress one point.

"Don't get me wrong," he said. "We like our horse."

Now everyone knows why.

The two champions went head-to-head from the five-sixteenths pole to the final strides July 30 in the Hirsch at Del Mar, but 4-year-old Stellar Wind outdueled her rival to the wire to win by a half-length, ending an eight-race win streak for 6-year-old Beholder.

Beholder stumbled slightly at the start under jockey Gary Stevens, but the 1-9 favorite was still able to secure the lead with relative ease breaking from the

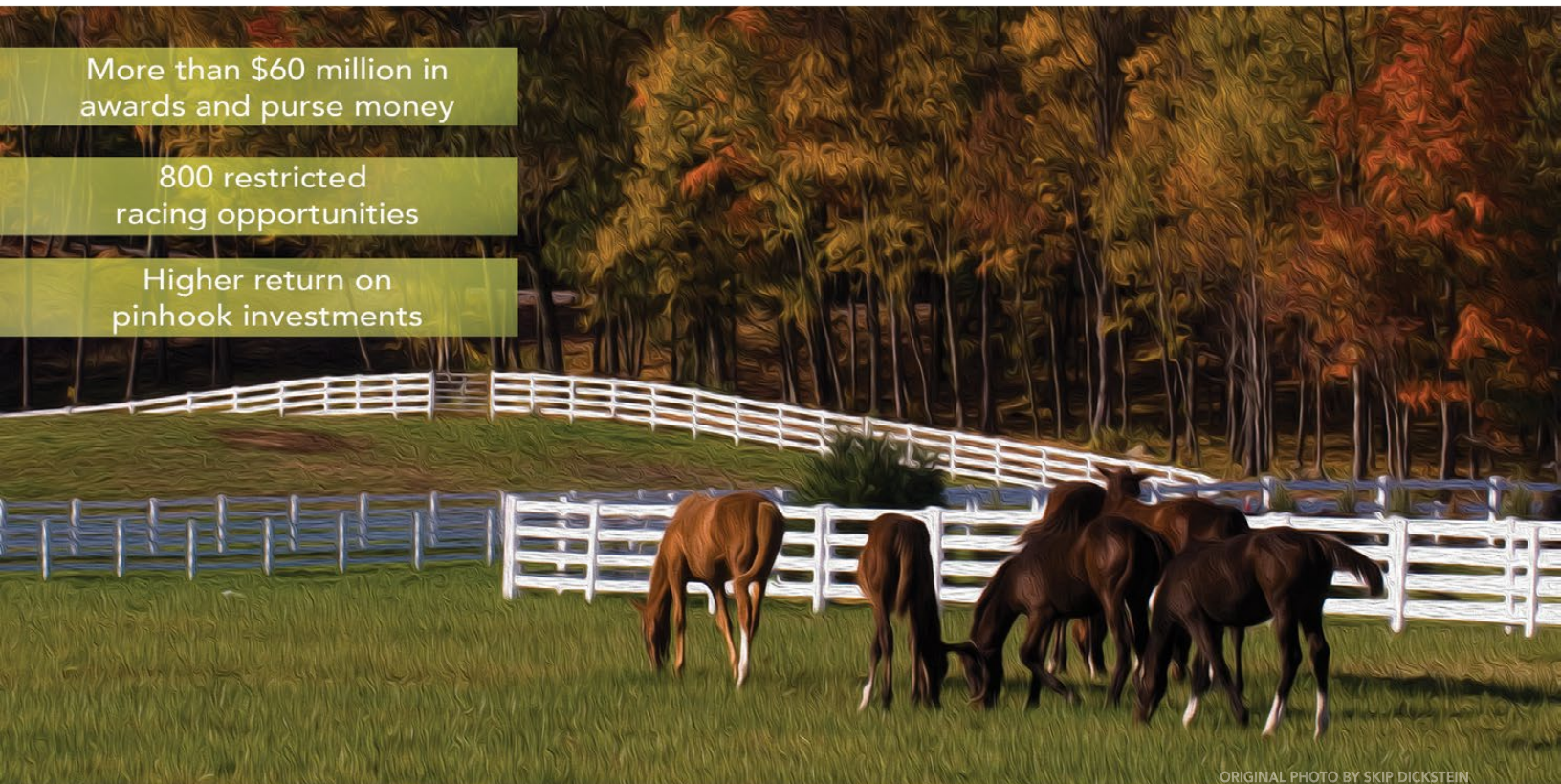

inside post. She set fractions of :23.63, :47.38, and 1:10.70 through six furlongs, while 9-2 second choice Stellar Wind and jockey Victor Espinoza raced about a half-length behind.

Stellar Wind made her move in the final turn and put a head in front at the top of the stretch, but Beholder was not done. The 10-time grade I winner dug in on the inside and retook the lead inside the eighth pole, but could not put her younger rival away.

"At the three-furlong pole, I saw that shadow and I knew we might have a race," Stevens said. "She hit another gear at the three-sixteenths pole, but (Stellar Wind) stayed right with us. I was surprised that she was staying with us. All credit to them. They were ready and they ran great."

The daughter of Curlin completed 1 1/16 miles in 1:41.24. Third-place Divina Comedia was 9 3/4 lengths behind the top pair.

It was the first victory for Stellar Wind since the Torrey Pines (gr. III) at Del Mar last August. Between she ran hard-earned seconds in the Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I)—en route to champion 3-year-old filly honors—and to Beholder in the June 4 Vanity Mile (gr. I).

"The last time, she needed the race," Espinoza said. "This time she was ready. This was exciting. ... I had a lot of confidence in her. ... She's a special filly. She showed it today."

"You usually don't get what you want on your birthday, but this year, I did," said trainer John Sadler, who turned 60 Saturday. "She's been training well. And if you think about it, she probably was the best in the Breeders' Cup Distaff. ... She had a prep race that was a good race. Victor got off her and said 'You know, I think we can beat (Beholder) next time.'

"I kept my mouth shut, because I didn't want to look like an idiot, but we thought we had a chance."

Despite the loss, trainer Richard Mandella was still happy with Beholder's effort.

"It was a good race for my horse," Mandella said. "That other mare ran a hell of a race." **BH**

HI-HO GUILLOT! TAKES JIM DANDY WITH LAOBAN

McCormick Racing and Southern Equine Stable's maiden Laoban secured his first win in dramatic fashion July 30, scoring a gate-to-wire victory in the \$600,000 Jim Dandy Stakes (gr. II) at Saratoga Race Course.

"My partner and I, we don't dance to elevator music, we dance to zydeco," Cajun trainer Eric Guillot said of himself and Southern Equine's Mike Moreno. "Who wants to run in a maiden?"

Laoban twice placed in grade III races but never won in seven previous starts. The son of Uncle Mo entered off a fifth in the Dwyer Stakes (gr. III) July 9 at Belmont Park and took down a field that included Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (gr. I) winner Creator, Belmont runner-up and grade II winner Destin, multiple grade II winner Mohaymen, and stakes winner Governor Malibu. The latter was making his first start since a fourth in the final leg of the Triple Crown, while favored Mohaymen—who stumbled at the Jim Dandy start—entered off a fourth in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I).

But after posting sensible early fractions of :24.56 for a quarter-mile and :49.07 for a half-mile under Jose Ortiz, Laoban withstood stretch challenges from

both Destin, who tracked throughout and would finish third; and Governor Malibu, who moved between horses to get second but couldn't get to the winner. Mohaymen was fourth, and Creator ran last of six without response to urging from rider Irad Ortiz Jr.

Completing 1 1/8 miles in 1:48.30 on a fast track, Laoban registered a strong finish, going the third quarter-mile in :23.39, the fourth quarter in :23.64, and the final furlong in :12.29.

Guillot said with many top 3-year-olds going in the Betfair.com Haskell Invitational Stakes (gr. I) July 31 at Monmouth Park, he thought there might be an opportunity for his early runner in the Jim Dandy, Saratoga's prep for the Aug. 27 Travers Stakes (gr. I). The top three from the Jim Dandy are expected back for that event.

"I thought, 'All the speed's across town tomorrow, in the Haskell. I'm going to take a shot.' He was doing good, worked in :46 3/5, galloped out in a minute flat. ... Why not take a chance?" Guillot said.

"The trainer had a lot of faith in the horse. I'd never previously ridden the horse, but he broke great and they let me go easy enough," Ortiz said. "He was relaxed, pulling me a little bit with his ears prickling and when I asked him to go by the quarter-pole he really took off. I was really confident by the half-mile pole."

In about the only thing that went wrong for Laoban

Saturday, he unseated Ortiz when returning to the winner's circle—but an outrider caught him quickly, and the unscathed rider was back aboard for the post-race celebration.

Bred in Kentucky by Respite Farm, Laoban is the first starter out of the stakes-placed Speightstown mare Chattertown. He was a \$240,000 purchase by GEM Stables at the 2014 Keeneland September yearling sale from the Legacy Bloodstock consignment. HASKELL CONTENDERS COMPLETE PREPARATIONS

With little more than 24 hours to go until Monmouth Park's signature event, contenders for the \$1 million Betfair.com Haskell Invitational (gr. I) finished up their final preparations the morning of July 30 on the Jersey Shore.

Reddam Racing's Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I) winner Nyquist jogged a mile over the main track with good energy under exercise rider Jonny Garcia at 7:30, according to trainer Doug O'Neill. The champion son of Uncle Mo will again face Preakness (gr. I) winner Exaggerator, who snapped his eight-race win streak with that victory in Baltimore May 21. Nyquist, who drew the rail for the 1 1/8-mile Haskell, makes his first start since the Preakness after missing the June 11 Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (gr. I) due to an elevated white blood cell count.

Exaggerator, looking to rebound off a Belmont 11th for trainer Keith Desormeaux, jogged about a mile with the pony Saturday morning at 7:45. Big Chief Racing, Head of Plains Partners, and Rocker O Ranch bypassed the Jim Dandy (gr. II) at Saratoga Race Course to target this spot with the Curlin colt instead. The only other horse besides Lani to contest all three Triple Crown races, Exaggerator was second to Nyquist in the Kentucky Derby before winning the Preakness.

Gun Runner, third in the Derby and winner of the June 16 Matt Winn Stakes (gr. III) last time out, galloped a mile earlier than the designated time for Haskell horses (7:30-7:45), assistant

trainer Scott Blasi said. The son of Candy Ride chases his first grade I for trainer Steve Asmussen and co-owners Winchell Thoroughbreds, Three Chimneys Farm, and Besilu Stables.

Dennis Drazin's grade III winner Sunny Ridge was also out early, galloping a mile and a half around 6:00 for trainer Jason Servis. Live Oak Plantation's Awesome Slew also galloped a mile and a half over the main track.

During that training time for Haskell participants only, Gary and Mary West's grade III winner American Freedom was the first onto the track. He galloped a strong mile and three-eighths under the supervision of Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert's main assistant, Jimmy Barnes.

The Haskell, with a scheduled post time of 5:47 p.m., will be telecast live on NBC. It is a Breeders' Cup Challenge "Win & You're In" event for the Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I), and is one of five graded stakes on Sunday's program at Monmouth. The past two Haskell winners, Triple Crown winner American Pharoah and fellow Baffert trainee Bayern, went on to win the Classic.

Gates will open early on Haskell Day at 10 a.m. with the first race scheduled for noon. **BH**

FLINTSHIRE NEEDS NO EXCUSES IN BOWLING GREEN

Juddmonte Farms' homebred Flintshire had plenty of excuses not to win the \$250,000 Bowling Green Stakes (gr. IIT), but didn't use any as he overcame all of them to win impressively July 30 on the inner turf at Saratoga Race Course.

Saving ground throughout under Javier Castellano, the 6-year-old Dansili horse found himself in trouble in a short field of four turning for home after tracking slow pacesetter Grand Tito. Last in early stretch, he was finally able to run after straightening away, and pulled away in-hand to a three-quarter-length victory. Grand Tito held second behind a final time of 2:18.24 for 1 3/8 miles on firm turf, followed by Twilight Eclipse.

Flintshire improved to 2-for-2 on the season and now owns a pair of graded victories over the Saratoga lawn. He opened the year winning the June 11 Woodford Reserve Manhattan (gr. IT) at Belmont Park for trainer Chad Brown, and last year won Saratoga's Sword Dancer Invitational Stakes (gr. IT).

A winner of the 2014 Hong Kong Vase (HK-I) among his three grade I/group I triumphs, Flintshire has finished second in many top-level races, including the past two editions of the Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Fr-I), the 2014 Breeders' Cup Turf (gr. IT), and last year's Hong Kong Vase. He is out of group II winner Dance Routine, by Sadler's Wells. **BH**

A. P. INDIAN CONTINUES UPWARD CLIMB

Green Lantern Stables' homebred A. P. Indian continued his upward trajectory July 30 with a game victory in the \$350,000 Alfred G. Vanderbilt Handicap (gr. I) at Saratoga Race Course.

The score was his fourth straight victory and first grade I for trainer Arnaud Delacour, who also earned the first top-level win of his career.

The 6-year-old Indian Charlie gelding stalked the early pace of Delta Bluesman, behind a :22.26 first quarter-mile. He then took over through a :44.63 half-mile and outdueled fellow stalker Holy Boss in the stretch to win by 1 1/4 lengths. Catalina Red made mild gains to finish third.

Holy Boss appeared to get the jump on A. P. Indian when he put a neck in front in the turn, but the winner gamely rallied back inside to finish off six furlongs in 1:08.25.

The win pushed A. P. Indian's 2016 record to 4-for-4, following a score via disqualification in the May 14 Decathlon at Monmouth Park, a three-length victory

in the Donald Levine Memorial at Parx Racing, and his first graded win last time out in the July 9 Belmont Sprint Championship (gr. III).

Bred in Kentucky out of the A.P. Indy mare Ender's Sister, A. P. Indian now has \$737,434 in earnings. **BH**

RACETRACK PLANNED FOR SAINT LUCIA

An affiliate of the China Horse Club has signed an agreement with the government of Saint Lucia to develop a \$2.6 billion resort and lifestyle complex on the Caribbean island, including a racetrack.

The "Pearl of the Caribbean," slated to begin construction in 2017, is under the banner of DSH Caribbean Star Ltd., an affiliate of Hong Kong-based Desert Star Holdings Ltd. Desert Star also includes the China Horse Club, which since 2012 has grown rapidly in international racing.

China Horse Club is particularly focused on the development of racing in mainland China and will hold a race meeting Aug. 21 in Ordos, Inner Mongolia, in conjunction with the China Equine Cultural Festival there.

The planned Saint Lucia facility, to occupy a 700-acre site to the south of the island, according to a joint announcement from the government and Caribbean Star, will have facilities for 1,000 horses and the capability to handle racing festivals, "establishing Saint Lucia as a racing and entertainment center in the Caribbean."

The signing ceremony capped three years of negotiations and followed the creation in January of the Saint Lucia Citizenship by Investment Program. It also provides for upgrading of the island's international airport, which is located about a mile from the "Pearl of the Caribbean" site. **BH**

MINDING OVERCOMES FOR NASSAU SCORE

Minding tallied her sixth win at the top level July 30 at Goodwood when she took the Qatar Nassau Stakes (Eng-I), Europe's richest race for fillies and mares, by 1 1/4 lengths from 16-1 shot Queen's Trust.

Rated along the rail, the 1-5 choice tracked just off the pace in the early stages. Ryan Moore attempted to move her to running room three furlongs out, but had to snatch up when shut off by Beautiful Romance.

Shuffled back to last, the daughter of Galileo and group I winner Lillie Langtry rebroke and surged to victory, recording a workmanlike success as trainer Aidan O'Brien's third Nassau winner.

"She is a great traveler. She quickens very well. She stays very well," said O'Brien. "She looks after herself when she gets to the front. She is thriving and she has a great mind. She is an unusual filly who can cruise, relax, and quicken."

Minding completed 1 1/4 miles in 2:05.05 on good to firm turf for her seventh win from 10 starts for Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier, and Michael Tabor. Those include her classic double this year in the Investec Epsom Oaks and QIPCO One Thousand Guineas (both Eng-I). She was a dual group I winner last year at age 2 and was Europe's champion of her division. **BH**

TRIPLE CROWN WINNER'S SISTER SET TO DEBUT

The highly anticipated start of Bob Baffert's American Cleopatra, full sister to last year's Triple Crown winner American Pharoah, makes Race 3 at Del Mar July 31 a must-watch.

But the \$63,000 maiden special weight has seven other juvenile fillies entered to run 5 1/2 furlongs, and Zayat Stables' American Cleopatra is the co-third choice at 4-1 on the morning-line.

The filly's training has been followed closely by many, and the her first start comes after seven consistent timed works at Santa Anita Park and Del Mar. Her last three-furlong work July 26 at Del Mar for Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert earned a "breezing" tag in a time of :35 3/5.

By Pioneerof the Nile, American Cleopatra is the third foal out of the Yankee Gentleman mare Littleprincessemma to start.

While all eyes will be on Pharoah's sister, Baffert will also send Jeweled (Sidney's Candy—Coffee) who posted a bullet July 25, running the fastest five furlongs of the day out of 52 in :58 4/5.

Also making her first start, for owners Karl

Watson, Mike Pegram, and Paul Weitman, Jeweled sits at 5-2 on the morning line.

Jerry Hollendorfer-trained She's My First, 3-1 on the morning line, will make her second start after finishing third July 1 at Santa Anita. **BH**

EVANS' NEW WAR FRONT FILLY READY FOR START

Robert Evans was afraid Hip 99, a War Front filly bred by Breffni Farm out of the unraced Mr. Greeley mare Azzedine, would go for a pretty penny from Lane's End consignment to opening day of the 2015 Keeneland September yearling sale.

But he loved the female family and is partial to War Front's offspring, so he buckled down and spent \$1 million to bring the filly home.

On July 31 at Saratoga Race Course, that purchase—a bay Kentucky-bred now named Warrior Hall—will debut in Race 7 for trainer Christophe Clement. Her dam is a daughter of multiple graded stakes winner Atelier (Deputy Minister) and a half sister to stakes-placed Alaazo, from the same family as champion Althea.

Clement has put a solid foundation into Warrior Hall with a series of moves at Saratoga over the

Oklahoma training track, including a three-furlong bullet four works back June 28 in :36.47, fastest of 32 at the distance on the day. Following that speedy move Clement sent her to a trio of four-furlong works, the latest in :49.44 July 23.

Warrior Hall is 7-2 on the morning line in a field of 11 for the \$83,000 maiden special weight for 2-year-old fillies, and will have jockey Joel Rosario in the irons from post 7. All runners carry equal weights of 119 pounds. **BH**

SOUTHERN PHANTOM BRINGS GOOD FORTUNE

A kind deed was rewarded July 30 at Saratoga Race Course.

First Southern Equine Farm's connections gathered in the winner's circle to present a \$5,000 donation to the New York Racetrack Chaplaincy. Then their Uncle Mo colt Laoban went gate to wire to break his maiden—in the \$600,000 Jim Dandy (gr. II) over grade II winner Governor Malibu. (See page 1 for recap).

The donation was the brainchild of owner Mike Moreno, who partnered with *Blood-Horse* to host a naming contest for a unique white-faced Bodemeister colt born at Southern Equine Farm near Midway, Ky., June 5.

"In 35 years in the industry I've never seen a Thoroughbred like this," trainer Eric Guillot said.

Moreno made the donation in honor of Mary Beth Woods of Shreveport, La., who submitted the winning entry.

Woods, a racing fan for more than 30 years, said: "As soon as I saw him I thought of 'Phantom of the Opera,' and since he's from Southern Equine Farm I came up with Southern Phantom."

WISE DAN ACCEPTS ROOD & RIDDLE AWARD

The inaugural Rood & Riddle Comeback Award was presented to champion Wise Dan July 30 during Hats Off Day at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington, Ky.

The award honors an equine athlete who overcame a major health issue and returned to elite competition; two-time Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) winner Wise Dan recovered from colic surgery in 2014 and went on to win the Bernard Baruch (gr. IIT) and Shadwell Turf Mile (gr. IT) before his retirement in 2015. Hats Off Day celebrates the horse industry in Kentucky.

"Wise Dan exemplifies the characteristics of an outstanding athlete who suffered a major health issue and returned to compete successfully," said Tom Riddle, DVM.

Owned by breeder Morton Fink and trained by Charlie LoPresti, the two-time Horse of the Year was cared for throughout his remarkable career by Rood

& Riddle Equine Hospital veterinarians. His primary caretakers were Larry Bramlage, DVM, who attended to Wise Dan's orthopedic needs, and Scott Hopper, DVM, who performed his 2014 colic surgery. Wise Dan, a son of Wiseman's Ferry out of the Wolf Power (SAF) mare Lisa Danielle, won six Eclipse Awards and collected 11 grade I trophies in his 31-start career. He retired with 23 wins, two seconds, and earnings of \$7,552,920.

"Wise Dan is a remarkable athlete and we are excited for him to receive this award. For him to recover from major surgery and come back to the level of competition he did—and in such a short time—is truly remarkable," said LoPresti. "Rood & Riddle played a large part in Wise Dan's success, specifically Dr. Bramlage and Dr. Hopper. We are thankful to the entire Rood & Riddle team."

Wise Dan is a resident of Charlie and Amy LoPresti's Forest Lane Farm outside Lexington, where he lives with his fellow retiree and half brother, grade II winner Successful Dan. **BH**

LADY SHIPMAN CONTINUES GRADED CHASE

Nine-time stakes winner Lady Shipman attempts to secure her first graded win in the \$150,000 Royal North (Can-IIIIT) July 31 at Woodbine.

The 4-year-old Midshipman filly from the barn of Kiaran McLaughlin has won three of her five starts this year, all stakes. She also placed second in last year's TwinSpires Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (gr. IT), her best finish in a graded race to date. Owned by breeder Randall Lowe's Ranlo Investments, she enters off of a fifth-place effort in the July 3 Highlander Stakes (Can-IIT).

Key competition for Lady Shipman could come from Anne Walsh's Cactus Kris, a multiple graded stakes winner from the barn of Ryan Walsh. She has won two graded stakes at Woodbine on the all-weather track, the May 8 Hendrie (Can-III) and last October's Ontario Fashion Stakes (Can-III). She comes in off a second in the Satin and Lace Stakes June 19 at Presque Isle Downs, which she won in 2015.

River Maid is a stakes winner from the barn of Robert Tiller who is on a four-race win streak and has competed exclusively at Woodbine. The 4-year-old filly won the Ballade Stakes in her last start June 4. Stakes winner Mississippi Delta could also rebound for trainer Mark Casse; she has won three of her six Woodbine starts and is grade II-placed. **BH**

BIRDATTHEWIRE RETURNS TO TWO TURNS

Grade I winner Birdatthewire tries to end a five-race skid dating back to her top-level win when she starts in the \$100,000 Molly Pitcher Stakes (gr. III) July 31 at Monmouth Park.

Birdatthewire closed out her 3-year-old season rallying to win the seven-furlong La Brea Stakes (gr. I) Dec. 26 at Santa Anita Park. Forum Racing's late-running daughter of Summer Bird made up some ground to finish third in her most recent effort, the July 2 Princess Rooney Stakes (gr. II) at Gulfstream Park, also at seven furlongs.

Trainer Dale Romans sent Birdatthewire to sprints in her past three starts, but returns her to two-turn racing in Sunday's 1 1/16-mile test for fillies and mares 3 and older. Birdatthewire, who will start from the outside in an expected field of six, won last year's Gulfstream Park Oaks (gr. II) at the 1 1/16-mile distance.

StarLadies Racing's Eskenformoney, runner-up in last year's Gulfstream Oaks, is also set for the Molly Pitcher. Trained by Todd Pletcher, the daughter of Eskendereya will start from the inside. She won an allowance-optional claiming race in March and followed that effort with a third in the Lady's Secret Stakes July 4 at Monmouth. Stablemate Genre finished second in the Lady's Secret and is also entered, along with Iowa Distaff runner-up Super Majesty, allowance winner Royal Jewelry, and stakes winner Stiffed. **BH**

ANALYZING PROVEN STALLIONS

Let's look at stallions a notch below the very best using the methodology explained last week and on RLlosey.com.

Focus on Columns 5 and 6 from the accompanying table, where Column 5 reports a stallion's graded stakes winners (GSWs) as a percentage of "adjusted" horses of racing age (HRA), and "adjusted" HRA are defined as 4-year-olds and up plus a fraction of 3-year-olds. Column 6 weights GSWs higher and is "normalized" to produce the same average as Column 5.

Two stallions, Munnings and Lemon Drop Kid, are "outliers." Munnings generates outsize numbers relative to both his stud fee and his 1.28 comparable index. Munnings' results top Columns 3, 4, and 6. His Columns 5 and 6 results would place him in the middle of the 22 elite stallions analyzed last week.

Some observers will worry that Munnings is a "speed sire." His runners' average winning distance (AWD) is 6.41 furlongs overall and 6.52 this year. Expect his AWD to rise but remain below "classic" levels. But Munnings' runners have proven that speed is dangerous at longer distances. I'm A Chatterbox came from off the pace to win the 1 1/4-mile Delaware Handicap (gr. I). Om widened his lead in the 1 1/8-mile Twilight Derby (gr. IIT).

Lemon Drop Kid is versatility personified. His AWD is classic at 8.08, but he has 13% two-year-old winners and 13 sophomore stakes winners. His runners' grass winnings almost equal their dirt winnings. His Columns 5 and 6 results compare favorably with stallions 50% or so above his \$40,000 stud fee.

English Channel tops the remainder of the \$25,000 to \$40,000 stallions, which seem priced in line with their Columns 5 and 6 results. I suspect that English Channel's turf proclivities explain what looks like a bargain \$25,000 fee. City Zip has earned his standing

the hard way, excelling in early years with modest-quality books. Mineshaft has always been solid, and this year he's making a \$25,000 stud fee look cheap.

Quality Road, Square Eddie, and Blame figures are likely to improve as these young stallions generate better figures over time. Flatter would surely have better numbers if bred to higher-quality mares than a 1.24 comparable index suggests. Tale of the Cat is the personification of a successful Ashford strategy: Breed large books and expect a large numbers of runners whose better performers make buyers and breeders forgive the many modest-quality runners.

If you're looking ahead you might play the "pipeline effect," betting on a stallion's large number of "runners-in-waiting" to make him look good. On this score Midnight Lute ranks highest, averaging 106 foals per year over 2013-2015. **BH**
