EXAGGERATOR SPLASHES HOME IN HASKELL

Big Chief Racing, Head of Plains Partners, and Rocker O Ranch's Exaggerator showed his affinity for off tracks with a sweeping, off-the-pace victory in the \$1 million Betfair.com Haskell Invitational (gr. I) July 31 at Monmouth Park.

Ridden by Kent Desormeaux for his brother, trainer Keith Desormeaux, Exaggerator got away last in the six-horse field but gained on the backstretch through fast fractions on a main track rated sloppy. An early pace battle between favored Nyquist and American Freedom laid the groundwork for the Curlin colt to reel in the leaders and pull away to win his third grade I stakes.

Exaggerator survived a claim of foul from jockey Rafael Bejarano aboard American Freedom. The Bob Baffert trainee put away Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I) winner Nyquist in the lane and appeared to check briefly when Exaggerator blew by on the outside.

American Freedom ran on for second, 1 1/2 lengths behind Exaggerator, with New Jersey-bred Sunny Ridge another two lengths back in third and Nyquist fourth. Exaggerator, who won the Preakness (continued on page 2)

Stakes (gr. I) on a sloppy surface but finished 11th as the favorite in the Belmont Stakes Presented by NYRA Bets (gr. I), covered the 1 1/8 miles in 1:48.70.

Nyquist, who broke from the rail, was sent early as was Awesome Slew, American Freedom, and Gun Runner. The leaders bunched together through an opening quarter-mile in :22.78, and by the time they clocked a half-mile in :46.62, the battle was left to Nyquist and American Freedom.

Gary and Mary West's American Freedom edged past Nyquist on the backstretch and had the lead after six furlongs in 1:11, but Nyquist, who hadn't raced since his gritty third-place finish in the Preakness, fought back along the inside. American Freedom finally got past Nyquist soon after the field turned for home, but Exaggerator ran past both before one mile was covered in 1:35.96.

"When he came around me, he crossed me a couple times," Bejarano said. "I had to change my course in the stretch and then let him run again. I'm completely disappointed. We are hoping everyone had a clean race, in such a prestigious race, and he

definitely crossed my lane and I had to change my course."

Despite the incident, Baffert indicated he's pleased with the Pulpit colt's effort.

"He was stuck outside (in post 5) and I told (Bejarano) to ride his race," Baffert told TVG from Del Mar. "I'm proud of the fact American Freedom can run with those big horses. He's doing well and moving forward."

"I think I'm leaning toward the Travers with him right now. I like that race, but I'll feel more comfortable bringing him home first. I really like what I saw today."

Jockey Florent Geroux suggested Gun Runner, winner of the Louisiana Derby (gr. II), may not care for an off track.

Exaggerator, who now has six wins, three seconds, and one third in 13 starts, finished behind Nyquist three times before his victory in the Preakness. Nyquist skipped the Belmont, and Kent Desormeaux blamed himself for the colt's off-the-board finish at Belmont Park. **BH**

SADLER RELISHES 'STELLAR' WIN

If there was ever a time to celebrate, July 30 was the day for trainer John Sadler, who saddled Stellar Wind to an upset victory over Beholder in the Clement L. Hirsch Stakes (gr. I) on his 60th birthday.

That doesn't mean he didn't feel it the day after. Some good food and drink post-race with owner Kosta Hronis and only a couple hours of sleep for a full slate of workers can do that.

"I was so geared up last night, it was a little hard to sleep," the trainer said with a smile July 31 in the Del Mar barn area. "I'm feeling 60-years-old today."

Sadler hesitated to report on the condition of the 4-year-old daughter of Curlin the morning after arguably the best effort of her career, but did say she ate up well after the race.

"It's still early, so you can't tell really yet, but she ate up real well last night," Sadler said. "A day after, a lot of times they still have some adrenaline going."

As for Stellar Wind's plans for the future, Sadler is sticking to the program he laid out for the 2015 champion 3-year-old filly and is not tempted by the Pacific Classic (gr. I). Up next will likely be the Zenyatta Stakes (gr. I) at Santa Anita Park in late September, with another run the Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I) to follow.

"I like the spacing. Sixty days and then 30 days, that's fine with me," he said. "Last year, when I gave her that good spacing, with the Torrey Pines (gr. III), I think she ran her best race in the Breeders' Cup. The spacing is good for us. I love it even more after a hard race, to give her extra time."

The Hirsch had significant context, according to Sadler. In their previous meeting, the June 4 Vanity Mile (gr. I), Stellar

Wind drew the less-than-ideal inside post with Beholder to her outside, but the roles were reversed Saturday.

"Last time, we had the one (post) and we got stuck inside with a slow pace and still ran a good race," Sadler said. "For something like that, the little things have to go right, and yesterday we were outside."

"This race might really help Beholder, too," Sadler said. "Don't count her out. Certain people think she's done. I'd expect her to battle back. The overreaction to one run is too much."

As for Beholder's immediate future, her Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella firmly had a wait-and-see attitude regarding an attempt to defend her title in the Pacific Classic.

"She's a little tired this morning. She always is the morning after a race and that lasts about a day," Mandella said. "She ran her heart out. I didn't train her for her life for this race, but I didn't think she'd have to run for it, and (Stellar Wind) made her run for it."

"She came up a little short. It was probably more my fault than anything." **BH**

LORD NELSON SPEEDS TO BING CROSBY WIN

Spendthrift Farm's Lord Nelson got a perfect trip and made the best of it July 31 to collect his second straight grade I score in the \$300,000 Bing Crosby (gr. I) at Del Mar.

The 4-year-old Pulpit colt trained by Bob Baffert broke best, but settled off the speediest of fractions under jockey Flavien Prat, moved by the front-runners three wide in the turn, and pulled away to win by four lengths.

"(Baffert) just told me to get him a good break, then sit up close to the speed," Prat said. "It worked out well. This horse was special today. He ran huge. He might be as fast a horse as I've ever sat on."

After stablemate Justin Squared and Subtle Indian dueled to fractions of :21.16 and :43.73 through a half-mile, Lord Nelson took over to run five furlongs in :55.73 and finished off the six furlongs in 1:07.65, breaking a stakes record that

stood at Del Mar since 1962. He was also 0.05 seconds off the track record of 1:07.60 set by King of Cricket in 1973, but that was timed in fifths.

"He's become a serious sprinter," Baffert said. "I was worried about the cutback to six furlongs, but he has been training so well. He's getting better and better. He was pretty close to the fast splits and he still had kick left."

Indexical, the second longest shot on the board at 42-1, had a similar stalking trip but was never a threat to the winner. He finished 3 1/4 lengths ahead of Alsvid, who was followed by Kaabraaj, Home Run Kitten, Justin Squared, Dream Saturday, and Subtle Indian to complete the order of finish.

Off as the even-money favorite, Lord Nelson paid \$4, \$3.20, and \$2.20 across the board. Indexical paid \$19 and \$7, and Alsvid brought \$3.60 to show.

The win moved Lord Nelson to three-for-three on the year, following scores in a June 3 allowance and the June 25 Triple Bend (gr. I), both at Santa Anita Park. **BH**

CURLIN'S RED LETTER WEEKEND

If Exaggerator's emphatic victory in the Betfair.com Haskell Invitational Stakes (gr. I) at a muddy Monmouth Park July 31 were not enough to cement his sire's place among the top of the elite North American stallions, perhaps Curlin's daughter Stellar Wind's upset of the Queen B, Beholder, in the grade I Clement L. Hirsch Stakes the previous day at Del Mar might lend more credence to the claim.

Or if there are still some naysayers and fault-finders among the crowd, how about Curlin's daughter Curalina winning the July 31 Shuvee Handicap (gr. III) at the Spa or the apt July 29 victory of his 3-year-old son Connect in Saratoga's Curlin Stakes (his sire's 27th stakes winner).

Truly, the weekend was the brightest for the 12-year-old son of Smart Strike.

Bred in Kentucky by Joseph Murphy's Stoneleigh Farm, Exaggerator is out of the Vindication mare Dawn Raid, a stakes-placed Canadian-bred lass whom Murphy purchased in foal to Any Given Saturday for \$50,000 at the 2008 Keeneland November mixed sale.

Murphy's wise decision to breed his Seattle Slew-line mare to Stonestreet's two-time Horse of the Year winner is borne out by Curlin's overall success with Seattle Slew-line mares.

Fellow weekend grade I winner Stellar Wind, last year's champion 3-year-old filly, is also bred on this same pattern. She is out of a daughter of Seattle Slew's grandson Malibu Moon.

Two other stakes winners are bred on this cross, including a third grade I winner Off the Tracks (out of a Boston Harbor mare), and grade II winner Moulin de Mougins (from an Avenue of Flags mare).

Statistically, Curlin has four black-type stakes winners from 32 starters (12.5%) out of Seattle Slew-line mares. Of Curlin's six grade I winners, three (50%) are from Seattle Slew-line mares.

Stoneleigh sold Exaggerator at the 2014 Keeneland September yearling sale to Big Chief Racing for \$110,000, and the sturdy dark bay colt races for Big Chief in partnership with Rocker O Ranch, Head of Plains Partners, et al.

Dawn Raid, third in the Fanfreluche Stakes at Woodbine is from a long line of Canadian-bred fillies

that first planted roots for the family tree when noted Canadian businessman E.P. Taylor acquired a French-bred filly Orchestra, who won several stakes in Canada, for his fledgling broodmare band.

Embur Sunshine, the granddam of Exaggerator, is by Canadian leading sire and broodmare sire Bold Ruckus who, like Seattle Slew, is a direct descendant of multiple North American leading sire Bold Ruler through Boldnesian, giving Dawn Raid a 4x3 cross to the 1966 Santa Anita Derby winner and short-lived sire.

Dawn Raid has an unraced Pioneer of the Nile filly, Rose Garden, and a weanling full sister to the Haskell winner.

Currently fourth on the general sires list, Curlin is the sire of nine 2016 stakes winners. He stands at Hill 'n' Dale Farms near Lexington where his 2016 fee was \$100,000. **BH**

LAOBAN TO TRAVERS, MOHAYMEN POSSIBLE

McCormick Racing and Southern Equine Stable's Laoban, who earned his first victory with a 27-1 upset in the July 30 Jim Dandy Stakes (gr. II), will be pointed to the Aug. 27 Travers Stakes (gr. I) at Saratoga Race Course.

"Everything's good," trainer Eric Guillot said the morning of July 31. "It's the horseracing business. You've always got to go day-to-day with these animals, but (the Travers) is my long-term plan."

The Uncle Mo colt made his first two starts as a 2-year-old in maiden company, but since then has competed in six graded stakes. Before the Jim Dandy, his best finish was a second in the Gotham Stakes (gr. III) at Aqueduct Racetrack in early March.

Meanwhile, Shadwell Stable's Mohaymen, the Tapit colt who stumbled at the start of the Jim Dandy and finished fourth as the favorite, could also go in the Travers, trainer Kieran McLaughlin said.

"(Shadwell vice president Rick Nichols) said as long as he looks OK, we can look at the Travers," McLaughlin said. "But he has to be OK and keep going. He has just been a little disappointing and a bit of a puzzle for us to try to figure out. That's what we're going to try to do. He looked good this morning." **BH**

CURALINA ROMPS IN SLOPPY SHUVEE

Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners' Curalina ran away to a 9 1/4-length triumph in the slop July 31 at Saratoga Race Course after shaking clear of Carrumba in early stretch in the \$200,000 Shuvee Handicap (gr. III).

The race predictably unfolded as a two-horse contest between three-time grade I winner Curalina and Carrumba, the only other graded winner in the four-horse field, and both at nearly equal odds of 9-10. The pair sprinted away together leaving the gate, with Curalina eventually settling about a half-length behind Carrumba, who set a leisurely tempo throughout the 1 1/8-mile event. But entering the stretch, Curalina exploded to the front and opened an insurmountable lead in the matter of just a few commanding strides to get the win.

Ridden by John Velazquez for trainer Todd Pletcher, Curalina covered 1 1/8 miles in 1:49.85 as the 122-pound highweight.

Carrumba held on for second, 3 3/4 lengths ahead of Sweetgrass, with Joint Return finishing another 10 1/4 back in fourth.

Curalina paid \$3.80 and \$2.10 and Carrumba returned \$2.10. There was no show wagering.

Carrumba and Jose Ortiz ticked off early fractions

of :24.28, :48.59, and 1:12.75 for six furlongs with Curalina stalking a half-length back. The winner was alongside Carrumba as the pair drew away from the Sweetgrass and Joint Return on the far turn. The top two entered the lane together, but at the three-sixteenths pole Curalina kicked away unchallenged.

A daughter of Hill 'n' Dale Farms resident sire Curlin, Curalina improved to 6-2-2 from 11 starts that include grade I wins in La Troienne this spring, and 2015 Acorn and Coaching Club American Oaks. **BH**

AMERICAN CLEOPATRA ROLLS ON DEBUT

American Pharoah's little sis got one up on her brother July 31.

Unlike her Triple Crown-winning sibling, Zayat Stables' homebred American Cleopatra won her debut at Del Mar.

Off at a 7-1, with Bob Baffert stablemate Jeweled taking heavy betting action at 4-5 in the field of eight, the 2-year-old daughter of Pioneerof the Nile out of Littleprincessemma, stalked early leader War Factor, blew by in the turn, and pulled away in the stretch to win by two lengths in the 5 1/2-furlong maiden special weight event.

"Those are good genes there," Baffert said after the race.

War Factor ran the first quarter in :21.87 as American Cleopatra raced about a half-length off on the outside in second. The bay filly took over to run the

half in :45.17 and finished in 1:03.87 under jockey Stewart Elliott.

"We never really turned her loose in the morning, that's why I thought she might (start slow) but today, Stewart is really good out of the gate," Baffert said.

"He can really get them away from there and once he got rolling—that was pretty impressive."

Baffert, who said "she's a little shorter-legged" than American Pharoah, compared her favorably to her brother in demeanor.

"She's got a beautiful way of moving and she's got a pretty good mind," Baffert said. "She's a sweetheart at the barn. She's very sweet and he was sweet. It was a good step forward. She ran pretty fast."

As for the filly's odds, the Hall of Fame trainer admitted he was a bit surprised at the price.

"I was sitting there with (my wife) Jill and said, 'I can't believe that (filly) is 7-1. What's going on here?' " Baffert said. "The other filly did work really fast. See, if you don't brag on them, they go off at 7-1." **BH**

GENRE'S MOLLY PITCHER MILESTONE FOR SIRE

Stablemates Genre and Eskenformoney battled down the stretch in \$100,000 Molly Pitcher Stakes (gr. III) July 31 at Monmouth Park before Genre thrust out her neck for the victory.

With two previous stakes placings this year, Genre broke through for her first stakes win while stopping the teletimer in 1:43.10 for the 1 1/16-mile event on a sloppy track.

Guided by Paco Lopez, Genre becomes the 50th black-type winner for Bernardini, a 13-year-old son of A.P. Indy who stands at Darley near Lexington. He was champion 3-year-old male of 2006 after wins in the Preakness, Travers, and Jockey Club Gold Cup (all gr. I). Genre is one of 36 graded or group winners from his seven crops racing.

The 4-year-old filly paid \$7.60, \$3.80, and \$2.40, while Eskenformoney returned \$3.80 and \$2.20, and Birdatthewire paid \$2.40 to show.

With Eskenformoney off the pace in third, Genre stalked pacesetter and 9-5 favorite Super Majesty from second, two wide and about a length back, before pressing that opponent through a half mile in :47.19. She grabbed a slight lead on the turn, then carried out Eskenformoney a bit wide turning into the lane. Eskenformoney got her head in front of her stablemate briefly in early stretch but Genre fought back for a game neck victory.

"She's all heart," said Anthony Sciametta, assistant to Pletcher. "She was headed in the lane and fought back all the way to the wire. We wanted to be sitting second early, but she looked to be

real keen today. I think she really liked the off going this afternoon."

Grade I winner Birdatthewire, trying to halt a five-race winless streak, was third with a mild rally after she was reluctant to load into the starting gate then stepped out a bit slow.

Genre, campaigned by Cheyenne Stables, has four wins and four seconds from 10 career starts. In her two starts prior to the Molly Pitcher, she was second, two lengths behind Angela Renee, in the Lady's Secret Stakes July 4 at Monmouth and runner-up to I'm a Chatterbox in the Obeah Handicap June 11 at Delaware Park.

Genre, a \$200,000 purchase from Gaineway's agency at the 2013 Keeneland September yearling sale, was bred in Kentucky by William E. Graves and Gainesway Thoroughbreds. Her dam is multiple graded stakes winner French Park (Ecton Park), a half sister to the dam of multiple grade I winner Palace. Genre is a half sister to restricted stakes winner Parc Monceau. **BH**

TROJAN NATION IMPRESSES IN TURF DEBUT

Julie Gilbert and Aaron Sones' Trojan Nation, second by a head in the April 9 Wood Memorial (gr. I) as a maiden, finally broke through on his ninth try July 31 at Del Mar.

In his first start on turf, the son of Street Cry out of 1996 champion 2-year-old filly Storm Song, raced sixth early, found trouble closing in the stretch, but ultimately prevailed to win the 1 1/8-mile maiden special weight event by three-quarters of a length.

Trojan Nation and jockey Drayden Van Dyke eventually found space between horses and surged to the wire.

"He's always been a nice horse and it looked like he was enjoying the turf," trainer Patrick Gallagher said. "In the back of my mind, there was always some grass pedigree with him."

After the Wood, Trojan Nation came in 16th in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands, then 10th in the Belmont Stakes Presented by NYRA Bets (both gr. I).

Van Dyke, who rode Trojan Nation three times before, said he got a sense the colt took to the grass.

"He loved it," the jockey said. "He's never been on it—never even worked on the turf. I was a little worried about my trip, but in the first turn I could tell he was really getting a hold of it."

Trojan Nation finished the 1 1/8 miles in 1:50.58 on firm turf. **BH**

FRENCH-BRED BLACKTYPE EARNS GRADED WIN

Favored Blacktype, an impressive winner of an allowance race at Belmont Park in his previous start, rallied in the stretch to win the \$158,500 Oceanport Stakes (gr. IIIT) July 31 at Monmouth Park.

It was the first stakes victory for Blacktype, who is owned by Jump Sucker Stable and trained by Christophe Clement. The 5-year-old gelding by Dunkerque out of the Anabaa mare Theorie was bred in France by E.A.R.L. Haras Du Quesnay.

Blacktype, who paid \$7.60 to win, rated in mid-pack under Joe Bravo as Nonna's Boy set fractions of :24.72 for the opening quarter-mile, :49.64 for a half-mile, and 1:14.38 on a course rated yielding after morning and afternoon rain. Kharafa, sixth behind Blacktype at Belmont, sat in fourth most of the way before making a bid for the lead, but he was nailed late by Blacktype, who won by a neck and completed the 1 1/16 miles in 1:45.64.

War Dancer and Captain Dixie rallied for third and fourth, respectively.

Blacktype won two races on synthetic surfaces in France before he was shipped to the United States in 2014. He won three allowance races on turf in New York but finished fifth in two starts in grade III stakes at Belmont in 2014 and earlier this year. **BH**

TENCENDUR SET TO MAKE COMEBACK

Highly regarded 4-year-old colt Tencendur, whose 3-year-old campaign was cut short because of a broken sesamoid near his left front foot, is scheduled to make his first start since last June in an allowance event at Saratoga Race Course Aug. 1.

Owned and bred by Philip Birsh, Tencendur, by Warrior's Reward, is entered in the second race, an entry-level allowance test for New York-breds at 1 1/8 miles.

"It has been a long time off but we figured this is a good place to get him started back, and hopefully he gets back to what we thought he could do before," trainer George Weaver said. "He really is a two-turn horse. Running him seven-eighths of a mile would probably be a little more difficult because he doesn't have that early gate speed. We figured the mile and an eighth fit him better."

Though he has one win in seven starts, Tencendur finished second to Frosted in the Wood Memorial Stakes (gr. I) in April 2015. That effort secured a trip

to Churchill Downs, where he finished 17th in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I).

In his final start before the injury, Tencendur finished second, a nose behind Mr. Z, in the Ohio Derby. He most recently worked six furlongs in 1:13 2/5 at Saratoga July 24. **BH**

QEMAH WINS FRENCH GROUP I WITH EASE

The year keeps getting better for French trainer Jean-Claude Rouget, whose filly Qemah effortlessly quickened away to win the Prix Rothschild (Fr-I) July 31 at Deauville, providing him with yet another group I win this season.

Qemah, the favorite, raced comfortably in midfield early, while stablemate Positive Vibration laid down the early tempo. Gregory Benoist was sitting chilly as he moved her into third with more than a quarter-mile to run. When he finally gave her the cue, she kicked away for an easy 1 1/4 length triumph over Prix de Diane (Fr-I, French Oaks) third-place finisher Volta.

Steip Amach came from the back of the field to take third.

The victory marked the second straight win at the top level for Al Shaqab Racing's Qemah, who took the Coronation Stakes (Eng-I) June 17 at Royal Ascot. Rouget also enjoyed group I wins this season with La Cressonniere in the the Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French One Thousand Guineas) and Prix de Diane; Jemayel in the Prix Saint-Alary; Zelzal in the Prix Jean Prat; and Almanzor in the Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby).

"She is really good," Rouget told *Racing Post*, while making it clear he believes his Danehill Dancer filly ranks among some of the Europe's best fillies in the last 10 years. "We have seen other good fillies here in recent years, like Goldikova and Moonlight Cloud, and I think that she is up there in that kind of company."

Qemah covered the Rothschild's 1,600 meters (about one mile) in 1:38.09 on firm turf. She improved her record to 4-2-1 from seven starts. Sunday's win was her third from four outings this year, which also includes a third in the French One Thousand Guineas.

Nicolas de Watrigant's Mandore International Agency selected Irish-bred Qemah for Al Shaqab Racing at auction, signing the ticket for €200,000 (US\$268,000) at the 2014 Arqana Deauville yearling sale. She was bred by Ecurie Cadran Bissons and SAS IEI, and is the first starter from the 2010 Prix Fille de l'Air third-place finisher Kartica, by Rainbow Quest. Her second dam is English highweight Cayman Sunset. **BH**

BEST SIRES FOR DAUGHTERS OF SEEKING THE GOLD

The most successful stallions share a common trait—regardless of their own family lines, the gene pool they need to produce elite runners is deep and wide.

Claiborne Farm's Seeking the Gold is yet another example. The multiple grade I-winning son of Mr. Prospector was euthanized last week at age 31 due to the infirmities of old age. On his passing, the farm noted not only his success as a sire (91 black-type stakes winners) but also his notable and growing stature as a broodmare sire.

With more of his legacy as a broodmare sire still to unfold, *Blood-Horse MarketWatch* compiled a list of Seeking the Gold's 60 graded/group stakes winners through July 29 to see which sire lines were working the best with his daughters.

Three sire lines stood out: Storm Cat and his sons and grandsons (20%), Roberto with his sons and grandsons (18%), and Seattle Slew and sons and grandsons (17%).

In the Storm Cat line, Giant's Causeway was by far the most successful mate. The Ashford Stud stallion was represented by five of the 12 Storm Cat-line graded/group winners and four of those were grade I winners—Take Charge Brandi (out of Charming), Swift Temper (out of Glasgow's Gold), Carriage Trail (out of Manoa), and Internallyflawless (out of Taptina). Giant's Causeway sired the most grade I winners with Seeking the Gold as a broodmare sire than any other sire.

For the Roberto sire line, Dynaformer is the standout. The former Three Chimneys Farm sire, who died in 2012, is represented by five graded/group winners, of whom three are grade/group I winners. His top runners are multiple grade I winners Point of Entry, out of Matlacha Pass, who retired with four grade I wins

and nearly \$2.5 million in earnings; and, Riskaverse, out of The Bink, who won three grade Is and earned more than \$2.18 million.

The other prominent Roberto line sire is Arch, who has two grade I winners among his three grade/group winners. Overall the Roberto line is responsible for siring 11 grade/group winners out of Seeking the Gold daughters.

The third most-prominent sire line belongs to Seattle Slew, who is represented by 10 graded/group winners, most of them—not surprisingly—sired by A.P. Indy with six. What is intriguing is that A.P. Indy is the sire of only one grade I winner, who is Majestic Warrior. Seattle Slew sired the most successful runner among the grade I winners, millionaire and multiple grade I winner Surfside, out of Flanders. A.P. Indy is represented by two other grade I winners through his son Pulpit, sire of Lord Nelson (out of African Jade), and through Pulpit's son Sky Mesa, the sire of Giulia (out of Annika Rules).

Overall, Seeking the Gold's statistics as a broodmare sire are robust with 13 champions and 144 black-type winners. Through July 30, he is this year's 12th-leading broodmare sire with eight stakes winners and more than \$6.6 million in progeny earnings. **BH**
