



## ANOTHER STAR FOR BAFFERT: ARROGATE

After giving Travers Stakes winner Arrogate a complete check up, trainer Bob Baffert gives a thumbs up

On the morning following Arrogate's record-smashing performance in the Travers Stakes (gr. I), Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert had nothing but accolades for his new stable star.

"I watched the race again a couple of times and I still can't believe the way he kept on rolling. It was just incredible," Baffert said. "You're always hoping that they're that good. I knew he was good, but I didn't know he was really, really that kind of good."

Arrogate, whom Baffert picked out of the Keeneland September yearling sale and was purchased by Juddmonte Farms for \$560,000, was asked to step up from the allowance ranks into grade I competition against top-notch rivals in a crowded field of 13 Aug. 27.

The son of Unbridled's Song responded with bril-

liance. He carved out blistering fractions under Hall of Fame rider Mike Smith and charged down the lane to win by a dominating 13 1/2 lengths.

His final time of 1:59.36 for the 1 1/4-mile distance eclipsed General Assembly's Travers and track mark of 2:00 that had stood for 37 years.

Baffert, who recently ran older horses Dortmund and Hoppertunity in the Pacific Classic (gr. I) against champions California Chrome and Beholder, said he originally planned to enter Arrogate in that race, but the colt developed a mild virus forcing him to change course. Arrogate then joined stablemate American Freedom, who finished second in the Travers under Rafael Bejarano, on the trip to Saratoga to take on fellow sophomores.

Even though the four-time Eclipse Award-winning trainer has won 14 Triple Crown races, 12 Breeders' Cup events, the 2001 Travers with Point Given, and 2,680 races overall, he said he felt like any other spectator watching Arrogate's exceptional effort.

"After he ran like that, I was like everybody else, and thought 'Wow!' I was like a fan, thinking 'Wow! What did we just witness?'" he said.

Nevertheless, Baffert stopped far short of saying that Arrogate's record-setting performance made up for American Pharoah's loss—the only loss in his Horse of the Year campaign—in the 2015 Travers.

"A lot of people are saying this is redemption for last year, but I don't feel that way. I just came here to win a horse race," said Baffert, who also won the King's Bishop (gr. I) with sprinter Drefong Saturday. "I also came in here to win the King's Bishop and to see how good these horses are. Last year was more about showing off American Pharoah to Saratoga and letting the fans see him run. He's such a great horse. When we got beat, I felt like we let down the town—the crowd, and the horse. I felt bad for the horse. We still miss him."

He also wasn't ready to elevate Arrogate, now a winner in four of his five starts, into American Pharoah's class.

"Maybe this horse will take the sting out of not having him around. What we saw yesterday—at least it gave us a little hope," Baffert said. "Every time I have a horse like Pharoah, when he leaves, I think, 'Damn, I'll never have anything again close to him at all,' and then this horse goes out and does that. I'm not going to crown him yet, but at least he's got us

excited and something to think about. But there will never be another Pharoah."

Arrogate is on course to replicate American Pharoah's path from the Travers straight to the Breeders' Cup and Baffert has an embarrassment of riches for the \$6 million Classic (gr. I). Arrogate, Dortmund, Hoppertunity, American Freedom, and Cupid could also represent the barn.

"I don't know yet what I'm going to do with American Freedom. I'll go back and figure it out," he said. "I've trained all of these horses and I know where I stand with all of them. I can tell. I knew (Arrogate) was a really, really good horse, but we had never set him down. He can run with those other horses (in the Classic)."

Baffert was also high on Drefong's win in the King's Bishop.

"Drefong came back great. He smoked out of there and did his thing," he said. "That was pretty neat to watch him run. The plan for him is the Breeders' Cup Sprint (gr. I)."

Arrogate, American Freedom, Jazzy Times, and Drefong all head back to Baffert's barn at Del Mar Aug. 29.

Also exiting the Travers, Gun Runner came back well from his third-place finish and now will be pointed toward the Pennsylvania Derby (gr. II) Sept. 24 at Parx Racing, according to Scott Blasi, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen.

"(Arrogate) ran a freak race, and we're very proud of our horse to run third," Blasi said. "Gun Runner ran a super race. He got stopped at the quarter pole a little bit and had to come around. He wasn't going to win, but it probably cost him second."

Asmussen's other Travers entrant, Belmont Stakes (gr. I) winner Creator, failed to rebound from his last-place finish in the Jim Dandy (gr. II) and ran seventh in the Travers.

Blasi said Creator will be given an extended break at WinStar Farm in Kentucky. **BH**

## CAVORTING ON TO BC; MOHAYMEN TO GET TIME OFF

The morning after Cavorting added another impressive Saratoga Race Course victory to her resume in the Aug. 27 Personal Ensign (gr. I), trainer Kieran McLaughlin lavished praise on the 4-year-old filly.

Stonestreet Stables' Cavorting rallied from last to first to win the 1 1/8-mile test by a half-length over favored Curalina, to keep her perfect Saratoga record intact. She won the Adirondack (gr. II) in 2014 and the Test (gr. I) and Prioress (gr. II) in 2015.

"She's a top filly. She's definitely one of the best fillies I've ever trained, if not the best filly," said McLaughlin, whose three filly champions include Lahudood, the top turf female of 2007, and Questing, the top 3-year-old filly of 2012. "To win graded stakes at 2, 3, and 4 is quite impressive."

McLaughlin credited jockey Javier Castellano for his ride on the daughter of Bernardini. Castellano rode her only once before, a win in the Ruffian (gr. II) May 14, and was able to settle her into a comfortable rhythm before swinging outside for the winning stretch drive.

"She broke on the lead, and he grabbed her and got her back, and saved ground around the first turn. It was an excellent ride," the trainer said. "He helped us from the beginning taking her back in the Ruffian. It was a great race."

The Personal Ensign was a Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" qualifier for the Distaff (gr. I), and gave

Cavorting an all-fees-paid trip to Santa Anita Park in November. McLaughlin said the Beldame Invitational (gr. I) Oct. 1 at Belmont Park and the Spinster (gr. I) Oct. 9 at Keeneland may be options.

"We'll probably just go to the Breeders' Cup. We're not sure," he said. "The Beldame is there and the Spinster is there, but probably just to the Breeders' Cup."

McLaughlin continues to be mystified by Shadwell Stable's multiple grade II winner Mohaymen, who finished 11th of 12 as the second choice in the Ketel One King's Bishop (gr. I). The seven-furlong King's Bishop represented a cutback in distance for the 3-year-old Tapit colt, who has lost four straight starts after opening his career with five consecutive victories.

"I really feel bad for the horse, because he's a top horse and one of my favorites. Since the Florida Derby, it just seems like it's gone not so well," McLaughlin said. "He can't talk, but I feel a burden on my shoulders, as I really love the horse. He's a quality animal—great pedigree, great mind. He can't talk to me, but he's always not looked like I want him to look, like something isn't quite 100%. All of our horses carry more weight than that."

Mohaymen will be sent to Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Farm near Lexington and likely get the rest of the year off before returning as a 4-year-old.

"(Shadwell vice president and general manger) Rick Nichols asked me to send him home as soon as we could," McLaughlin said. "I think that'll be huge, to just give him a break. We'll go over him good and then the break will help him a lot." **BH**

## BELVOIR BAY IMPRESSES IN TORREY PINES

The scratch of odds-on morning-line favorite Enola Gray opened the door of opportunity in the \$100,000 Torrey Pines Stakes (gr. III) Aug. 28 at Del Mar and Belvoir Bay shot right through it.

In her first start on dirt after eight races on grass, the English-bred Equiano filly owned by Team Valor International and Gary Barber broke best on the outside in a scratch-shortened field of five, moved to the front, and never relented to win the mile event.

After a poor start for speedy longshot Nine Point Nine, the Peter Miller-trained Belvoir Bay opened up a clear lead with heavily favored Bellamentary in a stalking position.

The front-runner set fractions of :23.63, :47.03, and 1:11.13 through six furlongs, but the favorite put the pressure on and moved alongside Belvoir Bay in the turn. Under steady handling from jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr., however, Belvoir Bay never let Bellamentary by and kicked away in the stretch to win by 1 1/4 lengths. She's a Warrior came in third, another two lengths back, and Nine Point Nine and Kay Kay completed the order of finish.

"We were going to lay back a little bit, but she broke so well that I just let her go on with it," Arroyo said. "I worked her twice recently and the last time, she was really impressive. She ran to that work today."

The winner hit the wire in 1:36.56 and paid \$17.60, \$4.80, and \$3.20 as the 7-1 fourth choice. Bellamentary, off at 3-5, paid \$2.60 and \$2.10, and She's a Warrior

delivered \$2.40 to show.

"I was going to scratch her today," Miller said. "I thought Enola Gray was unbeatable. When (Enola Gray was scratched), that was enough."

Belvoir Bay won her last start of 2015, when she dominated the Dec. 27 Blue Norther Stakes on the Santa Anita Park turf, then set the pace and tired badly to finish 10th in the July 23 San Clemente Handicap (gr. IIT), her 2016 debut.

"Her last race was a complete throw-out," Miller said. "I felt good that she'd run well today, but I didn't know she'd run this well."

The victory is Arroyo's first graded win since relocating to Southern California earlier in the year.

"It couldn't have worked out better, especially to win with Norberto," Miller said. "I've been a big supporter of him since he's come back."

Belvoir Bay was bred by Mrs. R. D. Peacock, out of the Rock of Gibraltar mare Path of Peace. She has a 4-1-0 record from nine starts and \$149,176 in earnings. **BH**

## SALES UPDATE

### ARROGATE BRINGS UP VALUE OF HALF SISTER

Barry Robinette doesn't know the exact value of a Medaglia d'Oro filly consigned by Clearsky Farms to the Keeneland September yearling sale, but one thing he does know is that she is worth a lot more than she was prior to the impressive Aug. 27 romp of Juddmonte Farms' Arrogate in the Travers Stakes (gr. I).

Both the filly, consigned as Hip 226, and Arrogate were bred by Clearsky Farms near Lexington and were produced from the Distorted Humor mare Bubbler, a \$211,622 earner who won six of her nine starts, including four stakes.

"She's certainly worth more today than before the Travers," said Robinette, the general manager of Clearsky. "She looks a lot prettier today."

A late-developing son of Unbridled's Song, who made only his fifth start in the Travers, the Bob Baffert-trained Arrogate and Hall of Fame rider Mike Smith won the Travers by 13 1/2 lengths in final time of 1:59.36 for the 1 1/4-mile distance, which eclipsed General Assembly's Travers and track mark of 2:00 that stood for 37 years.

Winning the Travers in his stakes debut, Arrogate humbled a more accomplished group of 3-year-olds and moved himself into the upper echelon of his division. The colt, purchased for \$560,000 from Clearsky's 2014 Keeneland September yearling sale, has won four straight races after he finished third in his debut.

One of 12 Clearsky offerings at the marathon Keeneland auction, the yearling filly has similar traits to Arrogate at the same point in their development.

"They both are and were kind of gangly and immature," Robinette said. "She has been slow to come around, but she looks like a classic-dis-

tance horse. She has a lot of leg to her. I think she will just continue to get better."

Robinette said he was not surprised by Arrogate's Travers win.

"I wouldn't say I was surprised that he won, because he had been so good in his last three races, but I was surprised with how big he won," Robinette said. "We knew some people at Juddmonte and knew he had some problems early on."

Arrogate is the latest in an elite group of stakes winners bred and sold by Clearsky since being established in 2009 by successful international businessman and horseman Eamon Cleary, a native of Ireland who died in 2012 at age 52.

Following Cleary's mission statement "To breed and raise top-quality Thoroughbred racehorses to compete at the highest level of racing," Clearsky has bred multiple grade I winner Lord Nelson, Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I) winner New Year's Day, four-time grade II winner Mohaymen, and grade III winners Firing Line and Sky Girl.

Cleary purchased Bubbler for \$170,000 from the 2010 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky November sale when consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency. **BH**



## WAR FRONT'S 50TH BLACK TYPE WINNER

Central Kentucky sire War Front, currently the leading sire of juveniles in England and Ireland, and second on the U.S. list, got his 50th black-type winner Aug. 28 when 2-year-old Intelligence Cross captured the Round Tower Stakes (Ire-III) at the Curragh.

A son of Danzig who stands at Claiborne Farm near Paris, Ky., War Front commanded a \$200,000 fee in 2016. His 11 black-type winners this year also include group-winning juveniles in Qatar Vintage Stakes (Eng-II) victor War Decree, Duchess of Cambridge (Eng-II) victress Roly Poly, and Albany (Eng-III) winner Brave Anna. Older offspring with group or graded wins in 2016 are Kent Stakes (gr. IIIT) winner American Patriot, Rose of Lancaster (Eng-III) winner Royal Artillery, and Prix Chloe (Fr-III) winner War Flag.

In addition to his 50 black-type winners, War Front has 28 other offspring who have placed in black-type events. With 483 foals in seven crops racing, his stakes winners-to-foals strike rate is 10.4%

War Front's top progeny overall include 10 grade I or group I winners, including Declaration of War, Air Force Blue, The Factor, Jack Milton, Data Link, War Command, Hit It a Bomb, Summer Soiree, Peace and War, and Lines of Battle. The 14-year-old stallion was among the U.S. leading general sires by progeny earnings in 2013.

A homebred for Joseph Allen, produced from the Rubiano mare Starry Dreamer, War Front had a successful career on the track. He posted a 4-5-1 record from 13 starts, including his victory in the 2006 Alfred G. Vanderbilt Breed-

ers' Cup Handicap (gr. II), and earned \$424,205.

Coolmore and partners' Intelligence Cross appeared a cut above Sunday, when he trounced eight rivals in the Round Tower. He won easily by 4 1/4 lengths in 1:12.06 for six furlongs on turf rated as good. A close-up second behind the pacesetter, the colt struck the front a quarter-mile out and extended his advantage to the finish line.

Trainer Aidan O'Brien indicated the Juddmonte Middle Park (Eng-I) Sept. 24 could be next for Kentucky-bred Intelligence Cross, a stablemate of unbeaten Caravaggio, who might miss that race after he tweaked a muscle in his ribcage about 10 days ago.

A full brother to top Hong Kong performer Warning Flag, Intelligence Cross has placed in all five of his starts, winning twice and placing second in the Arqana July Stakes (Eng-II) at Newmarket and third in the Qatar Richmond Stakes (Eng-II) at Goodwood prior to Sunday's stakes breakthrough. He was bred by Good Vibes Syndicate from the Unbridled's Song mare Good Vibes, who also is the dam of 2014 Oklahoma Derby (gr. III) runner-up Bay of Biscay. **BH**

## BATON ROUGE TO RECEIVE LEXINGTON DONATIONS

Hagyard Equine Medical Institute has coordinated an effort to bring donations to the people and horses of the flooded Baton Rouge, La., area. Along with Brook Ledge Horse Transportation, Castleton Lyons, and various others in the Lexington, Ky., area, Hagyard put together a shipment scheduled to be delivered Aug. 29.

Castleton Lyons supplied 150 bales of hay, and along with significant amounts of medical supplies donated by Hagyard, as well as other donations, a 53 foot trailer offered by Brook Ledge will haul the supplies to Baton Rouge.

"They're in trouble and we know it," said Mark Brown of Brook Ledge. "We are thankful for the people in the industry and want to give back."

Castleton Lyons equine manager Jamie Frost said they heard Hagyard was holding a drive for donations through one of their veterinarians. A good year and 40 acres of their own alfalfa meant the farm had plenty to spare.

"If this isn't a good cause, then what is?" Frost said. "Horses are in need and we were able to do it."

The Louisiana State University School of Veteri-

nary Medicine has set up a hotline and has [created a webpage](#) for horse owners to check weather updates and which areas have available space to evacuate animals.

Even though waters have receded, there is still much need for assistance. According to the LSU website, horses are often greatly affected by flooding. Not only will the animals be under stress, which can lead to gastrointestinal issues, but standing in water can lead to founder, wet hay can lead to colic, and evacuating animals can expose them to disease from other animals, among other issues. **BH**

## CANADIAN-BREDS TO SHOWCASE IN SIX STAKES

Six stakes to showcase Canadian-breds purchased at previous Canadian premier yearling sales are set for Aug. 31 at Woodbine, on a night billed as the Canadian Million Sales Stakes.

The stakes, sponsored by Ontario Lottery and Gaming and worth a combined \$900,000, feature 2-year-olds and 3-year-olds and older in races on both Tapeta and turf.

The 6 1/2-furlong, \$200,000 OLG Muskoka Presented by Ken and Sarah Ramsey's We Miss Artie, has attracted 14 2-year-old fillies. Topping the field is Hopping Not Hoping, a dark bay daughter of Silent Name trained by Barb Minshall for owners Murray Smith, Christopher Chop, and Katharin Von Gavel. Last time out, Hopping Not Hoping captured the 6 1/2-furlong Shady Well Stakes over a yielding course.

The \$200,000 OLG Simcoe Presented by Samuel, Son and Co., for 2-year-old males over 6 1/2 furlongs furlongs on Tapeta drew a field eight, as Lokinforpursemonee and Pachi Cruze will continue their rivalry. Lokinforpursemonee finished second in his debut to Pachi Cruze in the 5 1/2-furlong Frost King Stakes. Pachi Cruze has made his last two starts at Woodbine. He won the Frost King and finished well back last time out in the Vandal on yielding turf.

The \$125,000 OLG Halton Presented by Tipperary Equestrian, for 3-year-olds and older, has attracted a field of seven for the one-mile turf contest. Hampstead Heath will look to win his third straight Halton, but will have to topple a salty group that includes graded stakes winners Dynamic Sky, trained by Mark Casse for John Oxley, and Aldous Snow, trained by Malcolm Pierce for owner-breeder Sam-Son Farm.

The \$125,000 OLG Elgin Stakes Presented by Bear Stables, for colts and geldings 3 and older, will be run at 1 1/16 miles over the Woodbine main track. The five-horse field is headed by Melmich, who was a two-length winner in the Elgin last season. Melmich, a 5-year-old son of Wilko bred in Ontario by Andrew Stronach, won six of his eight starts in 2015 for trainer Kevin Attard and owners Stephen Chesney and Cory Hoffman.

The six-furlong, \$125,000 OLG Kenora Presented by HBPA of Ontario, for 3-year-olds and older, attracted nine starters for the Tapeta stakes, including defending winner Rexton for trainer John Mattine and owners RCC Racing Stable and Rocco Forgione. A talented group includes recent Ballade Stakes winner River Maid, a filly, trained by Robert Tiller for The Very Dry Stable.

Seven fillies and mares will contest the 1 1/16-mile, \$125,000 OLG Algoma Presented by Adena Springs Canada on the Tapeta track. Galina Point will look to avenge her loss in last year's Algoma, when she was defeated by a narrow nose by Brooklynsway. The Saffir bay, trained by Casse for owner Gary Barber, owns a record of 3-8-2 from 19 starts.

First-race post time on the eight-race card is 6:45 p.m. ET.

The 2016 Canadian premier yearling sale is set for Sept. 1 in the Woodbine sales pavilion. **BH**

## LOWER MARKET CORRECTION SHAPES OBS AUGUST

Florida breeding and sales industry executives saw indications earlier in the year that the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. August yearling sale may not go well.

Unfortunately those signs were accurate indicators that the market would be down. How far it fell, however, has been difficult to digest.

The one-day select session took a lesser hit, with its average down 14.3% to \$38,682 and the median off 28.6% to \$25,000. The select buy-back rate was 32.7%. The two open sessions were decidedly grimmer with the average down 38.5% and the median off by 52.6%. The collective open session buy-back was 37.7% compared with 19.8% in 2015.

"At the end of the day, the buyers who typically support the lower end of the market were just not there," said George Russell, president of the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders and Owners Association. "These are the guys who typically buy in the \$5,000-\$10,000 range and put them in the April sale. They not only affect the market with what they buy, but they also end up being the underbidders on a lot of horses."

OBS president Tom Ventura agreed.

"Many of the horses that sold in the open sessions would have been purchased by people who would be re-selling," he said. "So if they didn't have as good a year with those type horses then the demand for those would be less. We had 200 more horses in the sale with probably less demand for those types of horses."

The 2-year-old in training sale season started well and steadily tapered off through the spring. This year's OBS April juvenile sale was even with 2015 but the OBS June sale's average dropped 25.1% and its median was down 27.8%. The rate of return on June pinhooks was a losing 43%.

What Ventura and Russell observed is reflected in the numbers. A comparison of OBS August yearlings sold by price range show an increase in the number of horses sold for \$100,000 or more—reflecting an overall trend of buyers focusing on the top end of the market. Yearlings sold between \$5,000 and \$19,999 took a hit with buying down 21% in the \$10,000-\$19,999 range and off 11% in the \$5,000-\$9,999 range.

The biggest hit occurred among yearlings selling between \$20,000 and \$49,999, with this segment off by 50% compared with 2015.

What people are willing to spend is also indicated by the final bids among horses that are bought

back. The average RNA price of yearlings offered in 2015 was \$18,682 compared with this year's average RNA price of \$11,070.

Ventura said there are other big-picture issues that cannot be quantified but have the potential to erode buyers' confidence.

"We have the decoupling conversation that is constantly going on in Florida; that doesn't give people extreme confidence," he said, referring to a proposal that would eliminate holding a live pari-mutuel event as a requirement to offer electronic gaming.

"Gulfstream Park is doing well. Its purses are up," he said. "But then you have Calder that takes a wrecking ball to its grandstand and a push to have less racing in the state. Anything that puts a seed of doubt in someone's mind about buying horse is not beneficial." **BH**
