## POSTPONED CLEAR ARC DE TRIOMPHE FAVORITE

Favorite Postponed will start from an ideal post 7 in the Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Fr-I), in which he will try for his fifth win from as many starts this year in Europe's richest race and premier middle-distance contest Oct. 2 at Chantilly.

The Arc, run at 2,400 meters (about 1 1/2 miles) carries a €5 million (\$5,620,425) purse. The event will be staged at Chantilly through 2017 as the race's traditional home, Longchamp, is undergoing a redevelopment.

Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum's son of Dubawi is one of 16 runners for the Arc, the field also including Tokyo Yushun (Jpn-I, Japanese Derby) victor Makahiki, Epsom Derby (Eng-I) and Irish Derby (Ire-I) winner Harzand, and the Aidan O'Brien-trained trio of Ascot Gold Cup (Eng-I) winner Order of St George, U.S. grade I winner Highland Reel, and last year's Breeders' Cup Turf (gr. IT) victress Found.

## POSTPONED CLEAR ARC DE TRIUMPHE FAVORITE

Based in Newmarket with trainer Roger Varian, Postponed's four wins this year include three at the highest level in succession: the Juddmonte International over Highland Reel Aug. 18 at York, Queen Elizabeth II Coronation Cup (Eng-I) over Found June 6 at Epsom, and the Dubai Sheema Classic Presented by Longines (UAE-I) March 26 at Meydan. The 5-year-old horse is tabbed the 7-4 favorite.

"The horse is very well and I feel he's in very good condition," Varian told England's Press Association. "It doesn't look like there's going to be the volume of rain that would make the ground testing, which is what we didn't really want, so we're happy."

"We've had a very good run of it since York. I think it's fair to say he didn't have the ideal preparation for the Juddmonte International, but he's had a very good preparation for Sunday. I don't think you can ever go into a race like the Arc confident, but I'm confident he's in peak condition and hopefully he has every chance."

Makahiki, the 13-2 second favorite who is drawn post 14, is Japan's latest hope to win the Arc, a quest ignited in 1969, when Speed Symboli was the first Japanese-trained horse to compete.

Kaneko Makoto Holdings' 3-year-old son of Deep Impact captured his Arc prep with Christophe Lemaire Sept. 11 in the Qatar Prix Niel, defeating Midterm in

his first outing since his nose victory in the Japanese Derby May 29. Lemaire, who has the return call for the Arc, told England's Press Association that the colt as "a very clever and relaxed horse."

"He knows his job. He really does what you ask him to do and he preserves himself. He's a typical mile-and-a-half horse—a big stride and then nice acceleration."

The Aga Khan's Harzand will start from post 6 with Pat Smullen. The son of Sea The Stars comes off an unplaced effort in the QIPCO Irish Champion Stakes (Ire-I) Sept. 10 at Leopardstown. He was found to have an injury after being struck in the race, but his connections hope for a rebound.

Jockey Frankie Dettori, who has won the Arc four times, will be aboard the stayer Order of St George. Drawn widest in post 16, he is unproven at the Arc's distance.

Highland Reel will break from post 11 with Seamus Heffernan and Found will depart post 12 with Ryan Moore.

Highland Reel, winner of the 2015 Secretariat (gr. IT) at Arlington International Racecourse, led all the way in the 1 1/2-mile King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Eng-I) in July at Ascot before finishing 1 1/4 lengths behind Postponed in the Juddmonte International Aug. 17.

The 4-year-old filly Found will try to snap a skein of five runner-up finishes at the highest level. **BH**

## AMBITIOUS BREW FIRES IN EDDIE D

Two-thirds of Ambitious Brew's victories entering racing Sept. 30 came on Santa Anita Park's unique downhill turf course and the Pamela Ziebarth home-bred thrived again during the trip Friday in the first of two Eddie D Stakes (gr. IIIT) divisions.

The 6-year-old Tizbud gelding trained by Marty Jones tracked the early leaders in fourth under jockey Mike Smith and surged by Richard's Boy in the stretch to win by 1 3/4 lengths.

Justin Squared set fractions of :21.79 and :43.86 through a half-mile, and Ambitious Brew hit the wire in 1:11.57 for about 6 1/2 furlongs. An allowance optional claiming race earlier in the card also had a swift finishing time at 1:11.96 on the new Santa Anita turf course.

"I was in a great spot from the word 'go' and able to get to the outside smoothly without losing any ground," Smith said. "I've been blessed to ride him a lot and win on him a few times, but I have to say this was his best race, by far.

"If I can get him to do that coming down the hill in the Breeders' Cup (Turf Sprint, gr. IT), that would

be awesome."

The win was Ambitious Brew's fifth from nine starts down the hillside course, including his last victory May 28 in the Lennyfromalibu Stakes for California-breds.

"He loves the hill and he trains like it," Jones said. "We know he's good and he's a professional. I was a little nervous in the stretch, but Mike had him in a great spot."

Richard's Boy finished a length clear of second choice Hunt. Eleven-time stakes winner and 3-2 favorite Lady Shipman finished a nonthreatening sixth, 6 1/4 lengths behind the winner, after she broke from the trying post 1.

The winner paid \$13.20, \$5.40, and \$4.20 across the board. Richard's Boy delivered \$6.40 and \$4.40, and Hunt brought \$2.40.

Clever Royal closed from ninth to finish fourth, followed by Justin Squared, Lady Shipman, Iron Rob, War Envoy, La Berma, and Mrazek to complete the order of finish.

Ambitious Brew, out of the Forest Wildcat mare Kathwen, has seven wins and seven seconds from 20 starts, and \$499,225 in earnings.

Class Racing Stable's Holy Lute (\$23.40) took the second division by 1 1/4 lengths in 1:11.23 to close out the nine-race opening-day card. It was the 6-year-old Midnight Lute horse's first graded stakes win. Trainer James Cassidy was confident in his charge.

"I knew if this horse had a good break, a clean trip, he'd run well," Cassidy said. "It was a little awkward at the start, the way he broke, but it turned out very well. More than likely I'd say the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint is where we're headed." **BH**

## TEPIN WORKS BULLET, TO KEENELAND NEXT

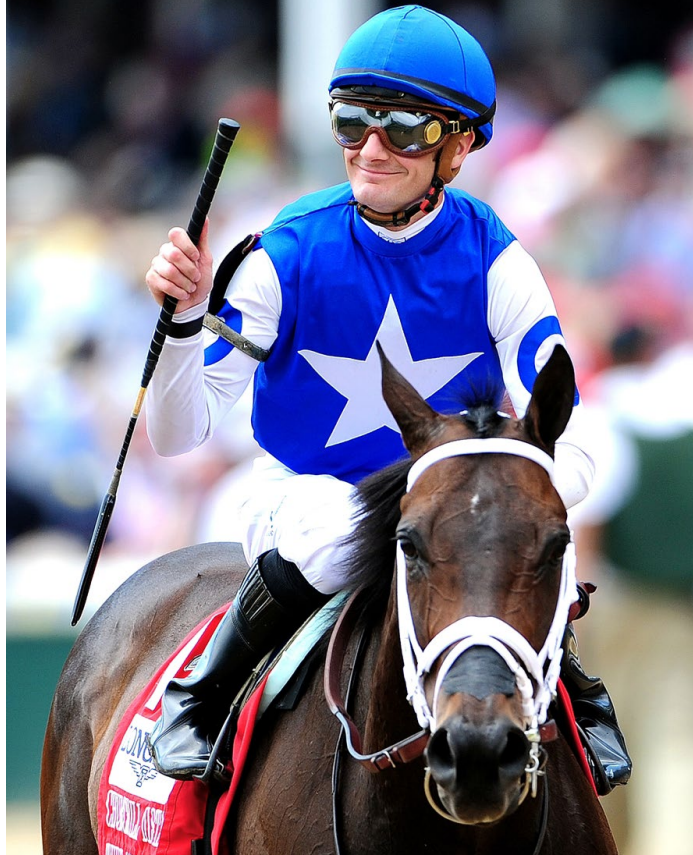
Robert Masterson's champion turf female Tepin continues to march toward the Breeders' Cup as the 5-year-old mare worked a half-mile in :49.01 Sept. 30 over the turf at Saratoga Race Course. The move was the fastest of 24 on the day's tab at the Spa.

Trainer Mark Casse plans to ship Tepin to Keeneland Oct. 1, where the trainer will have his choice of prep races in either the one-mile First Lady Stakes (gr. IT) where she could meet Miss Temple City and Cash Control, or the Shadwell Turf Mile (gr. IT) against males with Ironicus and Grand Arch expected. Both races are scheduled for Oct. 8.

The daughter of Bernstein won last year's First Lady, defeating a solid field of 11 by seven lengths.

Tepin's work comes less than two weeks after her score in the Ricoh Woodbine Mile (gr. IT), her first start since taking Royal Ascot by storm in the Queen Anne Stakes (Eng-I) in June.

Winner of last year's Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) at Keeneland, Tepin is unbeaten in five starts this

year and is riding an eight-race win streak that dates back to last year's First Lady. **BH**

## EXAGGERATOR TO REST AT WINSTAR

Future plans are on hold for Santa Anita Derby, Preakness Stakes, and betfair.com Haskell Invitational Stakes (all gr. I) winner Exaggerator, who finished seventh in the grade II Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 24.

"He's on his way to WinStar (Farm near Versailles, Ky.) as we speak," trainer Keith Desormeaux said Sept. 30 at Santa Anita Park. "He's going there for a freshening and we'll huddle up with their people to see if the (Breeders' Cup) Classic (gr. I) is still under consideration, but we're not sure yet. He's in WinStar's hands now."

The 3-year-old Curlin colt has had an up and down season. Beginning with the Santa Anita Derby, he won every other race until he finished off the board in consecutive starts in the Travers Stakes (gr. I) at Saratoga Race Course and the Pennsylvania Derby at Parx Racing.

In nine starts this year, Exaggerator has more

than \$2.5 million in earnings with a 3-2-1 record.

In April, WinStar announced it had entered into an agreement to acquire the breeding rights to Exaggerator and will syndicate him upon his retirement from racing. **BH**

## SALES UPDATE

### CHARLTON'S ABBOTTS RETIRE ON OWN TERMS

Anyone of a certain age knows that forced retirements are no fun—it's always better to leave on your own terms. That is exactly what Rick and Dixie Abbott are doing as they wind down after nearly 40 years of operating Charlton Bloodstock in eastern Pennsylvania.

The couple will have their final sale consignment at the Oct. 4 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic yearling sale in Timonium, Md. They have sold their 160-acre farm near Coatesville, Pa., and Nov. 4-5 they are holding a sale of farm equipment and supplies, as well as equine art and household furnishings.

The Abbotts, who were both active in show horses and hunting when they met and married in the early 1970s, earned a reputation as conscientious, honest horse people with a strong work ethic.

"One of the nicest guys you will ever meet," one sales company executive said of Rick Abbott.

Among the horses bred, raised, and/or sold by Charlton over the years have been graded stakes winners Miss Union Avenue, Palmeiro, and Afleet Again.

The couple's retirement is a culmination of a five-year plan the Abbotts, both now 68, hatched during a rare weekend away from the farm four years ago.

"We decided we needed to go off and figure out what we're going to do for the rest of our lives," Rick Abbott said. "(At the time) we said we were happy doing what we were doing now, but not sure we were going to be happy doing this when we're 70. So we came up with this five-year exit strategy."

Abbott said running an operation like Charlton is a 365-day, round-the-clock endeavor, which has been rewarding, but left little time for anything else.

"I've never been able to imagine lying in bed while a mare was being foaled," Abbott said. "We have good people who work for us, but we have attended every foaling that has happened on our farm. The farm is relentless. It never sleeps."

Once they decided on their five-year plan, the Abbotts thought the biggest challenge would be selling the property because of the tepid market for farmland. They were right, since it took four years to sell. On Dec. 1, they will turn over the deed to Meghan and Dan Cowan and move into a home in Unionville, Pa.

The Cowans purchased the farm for their non-profit operation Lasata, a therapeutic horseback riding, equine-assisted

psychotherapy and learning center with summer camps for riders, with and without disabilities, founded in 2008.

"We couldn't be happier with the outcome," said Abbott, adding that Dixie plans to volunteer at Lasata.

Abbott said any emotions attached to retirement is associated with the farm, and not the business.

"The emotion is not about giving up the business as much as it is about giving up the farm," he said. "We have been there 36 years. We raised our children there. It's a beautiful place and we love it, but it really needs to be a business. We're sentimental about the farm, but I'm ready to give up the business. We've been doing it for 40 years."

Abbott said one of the biggest changes he has seen in the industry over the last 40 years has been the emergence of "the mega-consignors who want to scoop up every horse that is available. My philosophy of the horse industry has always been, if you try to do everything, you don't do anything very well. So we've tried to concentrate on our own little niche in the market and have been very happy with it."

Free from the confines of the farm and business, the Abbotts plan to travel more. Abbott also hopes to hone the woodworking skills he developed over the last five years, perhaps even selling some of his homemade furniture.

"If you own a farm you have to be one-half a carpenter, one-half a plumber, one-half an electrician, and one-half a mechanic," he said. "I always enjoyed the carpenter part more than the other parts. I'm mostly doing stuff for family, but have sold a few things. I haven't found a way to market it."

Once everything is sold, the couple will still have two broodmares, including Christmas Strike, an 18-year-old daughter of Smart Strike who has been Charlton's blue hen mare.

Christmas Strike descends from a rich Edward P. Evans family and was purchased privately for \$10,000 after failing to meet her reserve as part of the Lane's End consignment to the 2001 Keeneland November sale. Produced from multiple grade III winner Christmas Gift, Christmas Strike is a half sister to grade I winner Christmas Kid, who was sold for \$4.2 million at the Evans dispersal.

Among the 12 offspring of Christmas Strike have been Double Down Vinman, a 20-race winner who earned nearly \$450,000 and four stakes-placed runners, including Holy Christmas, the dam of grade III winner Holy Lute. Also, one of her yearlings topped the 2010 Midlantic October yearling sale when sold for \$250,000.

For Charlton's final consignment at this year's auction, the Abbotts have a solid consignment on behalf of their clients, including some whom have worked with Charlton for a long time.

Included among the 19 cataloged by Charlton are a Tapizar filly, a Pioneer of the Nile filly, and colts by Eskendereya, Sidney's Candy, and Tale of the Cat. **BH**

## HALF TO GREENPOINTCRUSADER TO DEBUT

Ava Knowsthecode did not set the track on fire during her four-year racing career, but her progeny have more than made up for that.

Her latest colt to race, Jon Knowsthecode, is set to debut in a 1 1/16-mile maiden special weight for 2-year-olds Oct. 1 at Churchill Downs.

Jon Knowsthecode is a Giant's Causeway half brother to grade I winners Greenpointcrusader and Justin Phillip, to grade II winner and sire Keyed Entry; and to grade III winners Successful Mission and Algorithms, a promising first-crop sire.

Bred by Oakbrook Farm, Jon Knowsthecode is Ava Knowsthecode's 13th foal and first by Giant's Causeway.

Set at 10-1 morning-line odds in the sixth race, the colt will be ridden by Calvin Borel for owner Rigney Racing and trainer Philip Bauer.

Churchill's eighth race also has some well-bred juveniles. Among the longer morning-line prices in the 6 1/2-furlong maiden special weight race for fillies is Ashbrook Farm's Bodes Well, a daughter of freshman sire Bodemeister.

Bred by Summer Wind Farm, Bodes Well is a half sister to grade I winner Wicked Style out of the Tremplino mare Deviletta.

Among the top choices in the race is Farrell, making a second start for trainer Wayne Catalano.

The Coffee Pot Stable homebred is out of Rebridled Dreams, dam of Dixiana Breeders' Futurity winner J. B.'s Thunder and Claiborne Breeders' Futurity and Toyota Blue Grass Stakes (all gr. I) winner Carpe Diem.

In total, eight siblings to grade I winners are scheduled to run at Belmont, Churchill, and Santa Anita.

**B**attling almost the entirety of the 5 1/2-furlong maiden special weight Sept. 30 at Churchill Downs, Floroplus wore down Dilettante to score in his career debut.

One of two juveniles highlighted in the Sept. 29 Races to Watch, Floroplus went into the race as the 4-5 favorite. Dilettante broke smartly and led along the rail, with Floroplus pressing him for the first two furlongs. Floroplus turned up the pressure and soon stuck his head in front. The two matched strides in a prolonged stretch drive, but Floroplus prevailed in a final time of 1:04.56. Speightstime finished 7 1/4 lengths back in third.

Randy Morse trains Floroplus, a City Zip colt, for owner Tom Durant, who picked him up for \$585,000 from Hal Hatch's Halcyon Hammock Farm consignment to the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s March sale of 2-year-olds in training. Bred by Carl Pollard's CFP Thoroughbreds in Kentucky, the colt is out of the Stroll mare Cap's Legacy, a half sister to the grade I winner and sire Albert the Great.

Floroplus had posted two bullet works in September prior to his debut at the Louisville track.

Glacier, a son of Broken Vow who topped the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. spring sale of 2-year-olds in training at \$1.2 million, got off slow from the gate and didn't fire throughout to finish last. **BH**

## HOPE FOR PENNSYLVANIA BREEDERS

**I**n a letter to its members, the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association reported an encouraging legislative development that could lead to long-delayed breeder awards being paid out in October.

An amendment was unanimously added to a House Bill 2303 that would allow the payments to go forward. The bill is scheduled for a final House vote Oct. 17. The PHBA has talked with the Senate Agricultural Committee about the House bill and the committee agreed to do all it could to expedite it.

"We expect, therefore, that HB 2303 would be approved and on the governor's desk for signing the week of Oct. 24," PHBA president Roger Legg said in the letter to members. "We have also asked the racing commission to input the awards into its system so that they can be quickly transferred to the Treasury Department for distribution once House Bill 2303 becomes law. They have agreed to do as much preparation as possible."

The Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission has not paid breeder and stallion awards since early this year because of ambiguous language in a new horseracing reform law.

In the letter, the PHBA said all awards will be paid retroactively, according to the traditional program, from Feb. 23. Non-Pennsylvania-sired horses will again be eligible for all program awards and benefits. As of Jan. 1, 2017, however, the Pennsylvania-sired Breeder Award will increase from 30% to 40%. Further, if at any time the Breeder Fund should receive additional funds over a certain threshold, 50% of that money would be used for races for Pennsylvania-sired horses. **BH**

## HISTORICAL HELP FOR KEENELAND

This year's Keeneland fall meet will welcome purse boosts fueled by the historical racing operation it runs in partnership with The Red Mile in Lexington.

Bob Elliston, vice president of racing and sales, reports that for the spring and fall meet Keeneland will see about an \$800,000 purse boost from Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund purse money generated by the historical horse racing operation. He said that translates to about \$25,000 a card for the spring and fall meets.

Historical horse racing machines resemble slot machines but bases payoffs on a pari-mutuel formula and winning combinations are determined by previously run horse races in the games' database. The Keeneland-Red Mile historical gaming operation opened in September 2015 and through July 2016 saw total handle reach nearly \$176 million.

For this year's fall meet, the Keeneland condition book lists maiden special weight purses at \$60,000 (including \$10,800 from KTDF) and first-level allowance races at \$62,000 (including \$10,900 KTDF). The maiden purses, including KTDF funds, are up 7.1% from last year's \$56,000 listed in the condition book and the first-level allowance purses are up 6.9% from \$58,000.

"We're starting to see some real benefit. In a little over a year now that it's been open, and through what we're projecting through this fall meet, we're over \$800,000 in KTDF money that has been added to purses," Elliston said. "I was looking at the math and it's almost \$25,000 extra a card."

The added money would figure to increase in the years ahead.

"The exciting thing about it is it's just a year old. So it's still a startup and the handle is growing each month," Elliston said. "We're on a nice trajectory, a trajectory not unlike what we saw for Kentucky Downs which kept going up and up a little bit month by month. I don't want to forecast what it might end

up being, but if we can generate that much money in the first year, I'm excited about what we're going to see in year four and year five."

For the fiscal year that ended in June, Kentucky reported total historical horse racing handle of \$641.5 million, up 72% from fiscal 2015. That handle was generated at The Red Mile—where Keeneland partners, Kentucky Downs, and Ellis Park.

The historical horse racing handle in fiscal year 2016 generated \$4.2 million for KTDF purse money and \$777,155 for the Standardbred development fund. The Thoroughbred Development Fund receives 0.75% of total handle at Kentucky Downs and Ellis Park and half that rate at Keeneland-Red Mile (the other half there going to Standardbreds.)

Elliston said the money is already making a difference at Keeneland.

"It helps a lot. In October it certainly helps but it's really important in April when we're going against Oaklawn Park's gaming-infused purses. They've done a nice job down there and really put money into the purses; so we have to be able to supplement those maiden and allowance races," Elliston said. "We're expecting to see even a greater percentage growth for the spring than what we're seeing in October. Hopefully our maidens will be \$65,000, \$67,000, something like that. We're very excited about all of that." **BH**

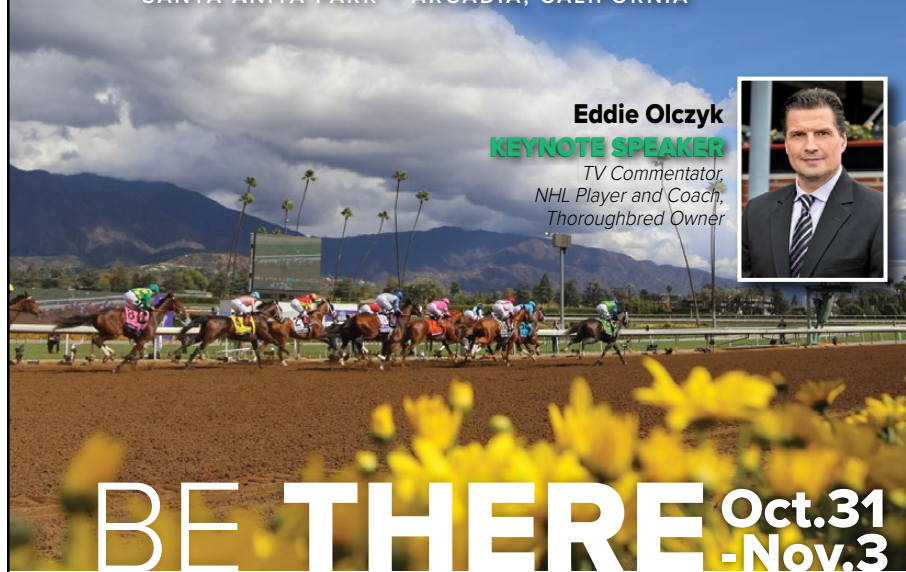
