





FAREWELL, MONARCHOS

ohn C. Oxley's 2001 Kentucky Derby (gr. I) winner Monarchos died the morning of Oct. 22, after displaying signs of internal discomfort Oct. 21 and undergoing emergency surgery to repair a ruptured intestine. He was 18.

"He made it through the surgery and we were very hopeful for his recovery, however his age was not on his side, and he was just not strong enough to survive," said Charles Nuckols III of Nuckols Farm, where the son of Maria's Mon stood from 2007 to 2016.

From 512 foals and 349 to race to date, Monarchos produced 244 winners (48%) who earned more than \$19 million. He is the sire of 2009 champion female sprinter Informed Decision, 2009 Scandinavian champion 2-year-old colt Aces Star, and 2014 Brazilian champion older mare Estrela Monarchos.

Bred in Kentucky by J.D.

Squires out of the Dixieland Band mare Regal Band, Monarchos was offered at the Fasig-Tipton

Saratoga yearling sale in 1999, but did not sell until his juvenile season when consigned by Murray Smith to the Fasig-Tipton Florida February sale of 2-year-olds in training.

There, Oxley went to \$170,000 for the striking gray and sent him to trainer John Ward.

Unplaced in his 2-year-old debut

at Keeneland, Monarchos was next entered at Churchill Downs, where he ran third to eventual graded stakes winner Dream Run. He did not race again until his 3-year-old season in Florida, reeling off three consecutive wins, a maiden special weight, an allowance, and the Florida Derby (gr. I) by 4 1/4 lengths.

Shipped to New York for the Wood Memorial Stakes (gr. II), Monarchos finished second to Congaree. His game finish set up perfect for a thrilling victory in the Kentucky Derby, where he stopped the clock at 1:59.97 with a 4 3/4 length win—the second-fastest in Derby history. After a disappointing sixth in the Preakness (gr. I), Monarchos returned to run third in the Belmont Stakes (gr. I), won by eventual champion 3-year-old and Horse of the Year Point Given.


Monarchos made one start at 4, finishing third in a Gulfstream Park

allowance, and was retired with earnings of \$1,720,830 to stud at Claiborne Farm near Paris, Ky. Later in his stallion career he moved to Nuckols Farm near Midway, Ky. He stood the 2016 season for \$2,000.

"We are very grateful to John and Debbie Oxley for entrusting their Kentucky Derby winner to our care," Nuckols said. "He was the first horse I saw every morning and the last every night. It's going to be a long time before we put somebody in that paddock.

"Our longtime devoted employees are deeply saddened by this news, as are the many, many fans who visited Monarchos at our farm. He was such a great horse to be around and had the best of temperament. He will be sorely missed."

The Breeders' Cup Classic favorite breezes Oct. 22 at Los **Alamitos Race Course**

CALIFORNIA CHROME SHARP LATE IN BC DRILL

I hen trainer Art Sherman puts blinkers on California Chrome, it sends a clear signal to the chestnut champion—it's time to get serious.

The 2014 Horse of the Year responded Oct. 22 in a five-furlong drill under regular exercise rider Dihigi Gladney at Los Alamitos Race Course, hitting the wire in 1:00 2/5, athough both Sherman and assistant trainer Alan Sherman both had the work a bit faster at :59 4/5.

According to Los Alamitos clocker Russ Hudak, the Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) favorite covered the first quarter in :25 1/5, ran a half-mile in :48 3/5, and galloped out to six furlongs in 1:13. The Shermans timed his final furlong to the wire in :11 flat.

"That was some last eighth of a mile—he flew the last eighth," Art Sherman said. "It's the last quarter of a mile—that's where the money is made. It gives you that (indication) that he's getting closer. He'll go threequarters next Saturday, and probably go in 1:13 and I'll probably put the blinkers on him again."

The work was California Chrome's second since his standout victory in the Awesome Again (gr. I) and his second to last before the Breeders' Cup Classic, the target the Shermans have been looking toward all year.

"As it gets closer, you get kinda on the bit," Art Sherman said. "Blinkers on, big move." BH

WINSOME WINX LANDS SECOND COX PLATE

s if winning 13 straight group stakes was not enough, supermare Winx delivered the most dominating victory of her career Oct. 21 at Moonee Valley, where she won the W.S. Cox Plate Stakes (Aus-I) for a second straight year.

Winx extended her long stride near the 400-meter mark and quickly opened a clear advantage under jockey Hugh Bowman. Then the 5-year-old daughter of Street Cry punched to another amazing level, drawing off to score by eight lengths in the about 1 1/4-mile race.

The margin of victory is the most decisive in 96 years of the Cox Plate, improving on the seven-length score by Dulcify in 1979 and Sunline in 2000.

Winx becomes the fourth female to win multiple editions of the Cox Plate, joining Sunline, Tranquil Star, and Flight. Winx's combined margin of victory in her two Cox Plate wins is 12 3/4 lengths; her two most impressive wins during her 13-race win streak have both come in the Cox Plate.

After stirring victory, trainer Chris Waller would take no credit.

"It's like a dream, as simple as that," he remarked, adding the long-term goal will be a third straight Cox Plate victory.

"She's just a superior racehorse and it's an honor to be a part of it," Bowman told Racing.com.

For a few strides in the far turn, three of the top contenders lined up across the course. Godolphin Racing's Hartnell, who entered off an easy win in the Yellowglen Turnbull Stakes (Aus-I), struck first. He was quickly joined by multiple group I winner Black Heart Bart, but Winx also was moving.

After racing wide while confidently ridden by Bowman, Winx wasted no time making things a threehorse skirmish, but that battle was quickly decided. After a few strides Black Heart Bart and Winx put away Hartnell, and a stride or two later Winx ended any thoughts of a stretch duel when she glided to the lead to trigger a stretch-long celebration.

"To ride a horse like this, and to come out onto the track prior to the race and have the crowd cheer you on to the track, I was really moved by that," Bowman said. "I had to regather myself when I got down to the start. I've had a bit of an in-and-out afternoon and an in-andout couple of weeks, but to produce a ride this mare is worthy of today, gives me so much pride."

Hartnell held second over Yankee Rose, and should head on to the Nov. 1 Melbourne Cup (Aus-I).

"He was pretty excited to be there today and I think if he gets a nice trail in the Melbourne Cup (he'd be a chance)," said Godolphin Australia general manager Henry Pulmptre. "It would be quite exciting to have him in it. He stays, but we'll just see how the horse pulls up." BH

ADMIRALS WAR CHEST SPARKLES ON **MD MILLION DAY**

dmirals War Chest became the fifth back-to-back winner of the \$150,000 Maryland Million Classic Oct. 22 at Laurel Park with a dominating gate-to-wire triumph in the 11/8-mile stakes for Maryland-sired horses, on a Maryland Million Day that saw marked increases in handle and attendance.

Total handle on Saturday's 31st Jim McKay Maryland Million card was up 18.5% compared with 2015, and 59.8% compared with 2014. Saturday's program had a total handle of \$4.476 million compared to \$3.778 million last year. Total handle in 2014 was \$2.801 million.

Attendance was 21,722, an increase of 7.4% compared with last year. The crowd witnessed the continued renovation and refurbishing of Laurel. The Maryland Jockey Club has spent more than \$20 million in improvements, including three new barns and upgraded technology.

"It was an incredible day full of exciting racing and memorable events," said Maryland Jockey Club president and general manager Sal Sinatra. "The horses and jockeys put on an incredible show and we want to thank the

horsemen, breeders, and owners for their support."

Sinatra Thoroughbreds Racing's 5-year-old Elusive Charlie gelding Admirals War Chest won the Maryland Classic by 3 1/2 lengths under Taylor Hole. Unlike his 2015 front-running victory, which he scored by a neck, his triumph Saturday was never in doubt.

The 5-2 second choice in a field of six broke alertly and opened a clear lead through a sensible :24.94 first quarter. He picked up the pace for a half-mile in :47.99, and continued to dominate his rivals to the finish, timed in 1:51.28.

"We haven't raced for seven weeks, so I was a little concerned, especially with those two 3-year-olds (Just Jack and Flash McCaul) in there," said owner and breeder Stephen Sinatra. "The horse likes the lead and there were no challengers out there. I was a little concerned when I saw the :47-and-change half. I got a little concerned, but around the seven-eighths pole I relaxed a little because I saw him pull away. That's when I said, 'Oh, my, gosh, he can do it,' and he did."

Bullheaded Boy closed to finish second, 9 1/2 lengths clear of Just Jack, the 4-5 favorite who was unable to make a serious bid.

"My horse ran his race early and we were where we wanted to be," jockey Victor Carrasco said. "The '4' horse

(Admirals War Chest) got away, and when we went after him my horse flattened out a little bit at the end."

Trainer Corby Calazzo was at Belmont Park Saturday, where he saddled Sinatra Thoroughbred Racing's Mecke's Madalyn for a second in the Empire Distaff.

Admiral's War Chest, out of the Polish Numbers mare Cut a Check, earned \$86,940 for his fifth victory in 29 starts.

On the undercard, Michael Cox's Rockin Jojo pulled off a 30-1 upset in the Maryland Million Distaff; Chapel of Chimes won the Maryland Million Distaff Starter Handicap, Greatbullsoffire took the Maryland Million Nursery, Item won the Maryland Million Lassie, Devilish Love took the Maryland Million Ladies, Who Stole My Sock won the Maryland Million Starter Handicap, Phlash Phelps took the Maryland Million Turf Stakes, and Nicaradalic Rocks won the Maryland Million Sprint Handicap. WINSTAR ANNOUNCES 2017 STUD FEES

ioneerof the Nile, sire of 2015 Triple Crown winner American Pharoah and Claiborne Breeders' Futurity (gr. I) victor Classic Empire, will head up WinStar Farm's 22-stallion roster in 2017 for an advertised fee of \$110,000, down slightly from the \$125,000 he commanded this year.

WinStar Farm announced 2017 stud fees for its entire roster Oct. 22. Led by grade I winners Midnight Storm and Classic Empire on the track, Pioneerof the Nile ranks No. 5 among North American sires at the yearling sales this year with a \$255,863 average from from a \$20,000 bred-on fee in 2014.

Perennial top sire Speightstown will remain at \$100,000, having enjoyed another strong year both on the track and in the sale ring, ranking among the top general sires and top juvenile sires in North America. Speightstown is No. 4 by yearling average (\$324,603) among North American sires.

Distorted Humor was led this year by his 18th grade I winner, Breeders' Cup Sprint (gr. I) contender Joking, as well as Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) contender Ironicus. The former champion freshman sire and champion general sire will stand for \$80,000 in 2017, down from \$100.000 in 2016.

Tiznow will remain at \$60,000 in 2017 after siring his 14th grade I winner this year with Breeders' Cup Mile contender Tourist. He will be joined by More Than Ready, who moves from \$50,000 in 2016 to \$60,000

Pioneerof the Nile will stand for \$110,000 in 2017

for 2017 after siring his 22nd grade I winner globally.

Another mover on the WinStar roster is Tiznow's rising freshman sire Gemologist, who will stand for \$25,000, up from \$15,000 in 2016, after siring multiple top 2-year-olds including undefeated Frizette Stakes (gr. I) winner and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (gr. I) contender Yellow Agate and undefeated Futurity Stakes (gr. III) winner and possible Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I) contender Theory.

WinStar welcomes three new stallions to its roster, led by three-time grade I winner Exaggerator. The classic-winning son of Curlin will stand his first season at stud for a fee of \$30,000.

Outwork, the grade I-winning 3-year-old from the first crop of Uncle Mo, has joined the stallion ranks at WinStar and will stand for a fee of \$15,000, along with Speightstown's leading sprinter/miler son Speightster, who will stand new for \$10,000.

"This year has been another exceptional year for WinStar stallions, and we continue to be extremely proud of their success across the board, both on the racetrack

and in the sales ring," said Elliott Walden. WinStar president and chief executive officer. "There are as many as 25 WinStar-sired horses running in this year's Breeders' Cup, including some of the respective favorites in the Juvenile and Juvenile Fillies with Pioneerof the Nile's Classic Empire and Gemologist's Yellow Agate and, maybe, Theory. So the present and future are both very bright, and our mission is to continue to offer breeders stallions of the highest quality." BH

TEPIN LEADS CASSE WORK CONTINGENT

t was business as usual for Robert Masterson's Tepin the morning of Oct. 22.

In her first serious move since having her eight-race win streak snapped in the Oct. 8 First Lady Stakes (gr. IT) at Keeneland, the reigning champion turf female signaled she was "back to her normal self," according to trainer Mark Casse, when she drilled four furlongs in :48 2/5 over the main track at Churchill Downs in company with 2-year-old stablemate Keep Quiet.

This particular move carried extra weight, given it was Tepin's first major outing since the First Lady second to front-running Photo Call. With Julien Leparoux in the irons, the 5-year-old daughter of Bernstein got her competitive juices firing, staying on even terms down the lane and finishing up about a head in front of her workmate to her inside as she readies for a title defense in the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) at Santa Anita Park.

According assistant trainer Norm Casse's watch, Tepin galloped out to five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 and six in 1:14 1/5, and came home the last three-eigths in :32 2/5.

"I thought she worked extremely well," Mark Casse said. "We gave her a little company and she was on the bit and moving well. We wanted her to do a little something today—not a lot but a little—and I thought it was an 'A' work for sure."

Tepin wheeled back in the First Lady just three weeks after her Sept. 17 Ricoh Woodbine Mile (Can-IT) win, her first start since becoming the first American horse to win the the June 14 Queen Anne Stakes (Eng-IT) at Royal Ascot. Casse feels his stable star got everything she needed to prepare for Breeders' Cup.

"I still thought Tepin ran extremely well," he said. "I was OK (with the loss). Our objective is to win the Breeders' Cup and we feel we gave her her best shot to win the Breeders' Cup. We're confident."

Tepin and the rest of Casse's Breeders' Cup contingent are slated to have their final works at Churchill Oct. 28 and ship to California Oct. 31. Keep Quiet, winner of the Oct. 9 Dixiana Bourbon Stakes (gr. IIIT) at Keeneland, more than held his own against his champion stablemate and will be on that flight as a leading contender for the Nov. 4 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (gr. IT). The son of Elusive City was also clocked in :48 2/5.

The grin on Leparoux's face after he hopped off Tepin was even more promient after he worked

Breaking off well behind his stablemate, Classic Empire swallowed up workmate Sky Flight to his inside in the lane with a gallop out of 1:15 2/5 in preparation for the Nov. 5 Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I).

Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf (gr. IT) contender Victory to Victory, winner of the Sept. 18 Natalma Stakes (Can-IT) at Woodbine, also turned in her penultimate move, working five furlongs in 1:01 2/5 over the Churchill main track under Florent Geroux, BH

NOT THIS TIME IMPRESSES AT CHURCHILL

rainer Dale Romans has never been one to lack confidence when it comes to his ability to hone special equine talents.

When the Eclipse Award-winning conditioner talks about Albaugh Family Stable's homebred Not This Time, however, he happily concedes that his job has rarely been easier.

"This is a push-button horse," Romans said. "This is one of the first ones I've ever had where it takes almost no thought."

The adjectives were flowing fast and furious from Romans regarding the Iroquois Stakes (gr. III) winner, after Not This Time turned in a visually-impressive fivefurlong work in 1:01 1/5 Oct. 22 at Churchill Downs, his penultimate move in preparation for the Nov. 5 Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I) at Santa Anita Park.

Romans has touted his fair share of runners. including the Albaugh Family's multiple grade I winner

Brody's Cause, who recently retired to stud at Spendthrift Farm. After watching Not This Time move effortlessly under exercise rider Faustino Aguillar with Stonestreet Farms' bloodstock agent John Moynihan among those looking on, Romans said the son of Giant's Causeway had "a different air" than any 2-year-old he's had.

"Today's work was just like all the rest. He was a machine out there," Romans said. "The biggest difference with this horse is, first of all, if you get a good Giant's Causeway, they don't lie to you. We were right about Brody. He was a special horse. But this horse has something different about him. I don't know what it is. From the day he walked off the truck, he's never been sick, never been sore, never had a bad day, never missed a breeze. He's the easiest horse in the barn to train."

Not This Time is a half brother to 2015 Las Vegas Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (gr. I) winner Liam's Map, and has shown similiar brilliance. After breaking his maiden second time out by 10 lengths at Ellis Park Aug. 12, the dark bay colt ran his foes off their feet again the Sept. 17 Iroquois Stakes at Churchill, winning by 8 3/4 lengths despite a less than stellar break.

"He's probably the best-bred horse I've ever had," Romans said of Not This Time. "His brother is standing at Lane's End ... and now he's come along and has done everything we've asked him to do.

"(Jockey) Robby (Albarado) called me driving home from Ellis that day and said 'This horse gave me the chills like two other horses—(champions) Curlin and Mineshaft.' And he's a pretty good judge."

Not This Time is slated to ship to Santa Anita Oct. 23 and will likely have his final work Oct. 29.

"It's an exciting race. This is always one of my favorite races." Romans said. BH

TOURIST, CELESTINE BREEZE AT KEENELAND

day before their scheduled departure from Keeneland for Santa Anita Park and the Breeders' Cup Nov. 4-5, Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) hopeful Tourist and Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (gr. IT) contender Celestine each worked for Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott for the first time since finishing third in their respective races Oct. 8.

Tourist, who completed the trifecta in the Shadwell Turf Mile (gr. IT) behind Miss Temple City and Ironicus, worked in company with Theophilia to his inside. With exercise rider Juan Quintero aboard, he covered four furlongs in :49 with an internal fraction of :24 2/5 and gallop out time of 1:02 1/5.

"We just wanted to see a maintenance half," said Elliott Walden, president and chief executive officer of WinStar Farm, which co-owns the 5-year-old Tourist with Wachtel Stable and Gary Barber. "He's in peak form, so

he doesn't need to do a lot. We're good."

Walden was pleased with the effort by the millionaire and winner of the 2016 Fourstardave (gr. IT) Aug. 20 in the Shadwell Turf Mile. Last year, Tourist finished third in the Shadwell Turf Mile before running eighth in the Breeders' Cup Mile at Keeneland.

"He ran the best figure in the (2016 Shadwell Turf Mile) and was wide—just got beat (less than a length)," Walden said. "That's kind of the nature of the beast with turf racing. You typically have close finishes, so he needs to catch a break in the Breeders' Cup and get a good, clean trip. He's in with a big chance."

With Quintero aboard in the next set, Celestine, third in the First Lady (gr. IT), worked three furlongs in :36 2/5. Keeneland clockers caught her in :12 3/5, :36 2/5, and out in :48 4/5.

The 4-year-old Scat Daddy filly, who won the June 11 Just a Game (gr. IT) at Belmont Park for owner Phaedrus Flights, is pointed at the 61/2-furlong Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint, a race that marks a cut back in distance.

"(Last year) she won a seven-furlong race at

Belmont, and she showed a lot of speed at Gulfstream when she broke her maiden and won a little overnight stakes," Mott assistant Rodolphe Brisset said. "We feel pretty comfortable shortening her up. She bounced back really, really good from the (First Lady). The breeze today was very good. We really didn't want to do too much."

Brisset said Tourist and Celestine will have another work at Santa Anita before the Breeders' Cup.

Celestine is cataloged as a racing or broodmare prospect in the Nov. 8 opening session of Keeneland's November breeding stock sale. BH

ROYAL POSSE SKIPS TO EMPIRE CLASSIC SCORE

ichael Dub, Bethlehem Stables, and Gary Aisquith's Royal Posse continued to make hay in the New York-bred ranks Oct. 22 at Belmont Park with a sloppy score in the \$300,000 Empire Classic Handicap.

Favored Governor Malibu weaved through traffic in an attempt to make a last-to-first closing run, but Royal Posse had opened up such a large lead in the stretch that any rallying effort was fruitless.

A 5-year-old Posse gelding trained by Rudy Rodriguez, Royal Posse made a four-wide move in the Belmont turn and held a narrow advantage at the quarter pole, then easily pulled away from the pack.

Four lengths on top with a furlong to run, he cruised home under Irad Ortiz Jr. to win by 3 1/2 lengths and finished the one-turn 11/8 miles in 1:52.15.

Wake Up in Malibu set the pace, with Hit It Once More applying pressure a half-length behind with fractions of :24.45 and :48.61 through a half-mile. Hit It Once More then took over, but Royal Posse loomed.

"We got a good trip. He broke sharp and was very

game today," Ortiz said. "He put me in there and from the three-eighths pole we were rolling. He's a runner. He's doing so good, and Rudy is doing such a great job with him and keeping his momentum. He loves the mud. It wasn't a problem for him at all."

The Empire Classic follows clear victories for Royal Posse in the Aug. 7 Alydar Stakes and the Sept. 2 Evan Shipman Stakes, both going 11/8 miles at Saratoga Race Course.

"He loves the slop," Rodriguez said. "He's a very honest horse. He always trained good and we're just very blessed to have him in the barn. I didn't have much concern with the track conditions because he won in Florida on a sloppy and sealed track and he's a very game horse."

Governor Malibu came in 3 3/4 lengths ahead of defending Empire Classic winner Empire Dreams.

"It just took a long time to get him in the race today and I was riding him," said Governor Malibu's jockey, Joel Rosario. "He put a little run in at the end but, by then, he was too far away from me."

The winner paid \$7.90, \$3.40, and \$2.50 across the board. Governor Malibu brought \$2.70 and \$2.10, while Empire Dreams delivered \$2.30.

Pax in Terra finished fourth, followed by Hit It Once

More, Good Luck Gus, Clifton Pleasure, and Wake Up in Malibu, to complete the order of finish.

Bred by Richard Troncone and Richard Troncone Jr., out of the Cryptoclearance mare Struckbylightning, Royal Posse now has a 10-10-0 record from 33 starts. In 2016, he hasn't finished worse than second in seven starts, all in stakes company.

Other winners on the Saturday card featuring eight New York-bred stakes were Quezon in the Iroquois, Breakin the Fever in the Hudson. Bonita Bianca in the Maid of the Mist, Brother O'Connell in the Mohawk, Pat On the Back in the Sleepy Hollow, Bar of Gold in the Empire Distaff, and Old Harbor in the Ticonderoga. BH

LIGHTSTREAM STRIDES TO **RAVEN RUN VICTORY**

rainer Brian Lynch doesn't have to look too far back to appreciate the strides Lightstream has made in a brief period of time.

Eight months after breaking her maiden first time out, Up Hill Stable's and Head of Plains Partners' Harlan's Holiday filly earned her second graded stakes victory in just her sixth start when she came with a sweeping move on the far outside to capture the \$250,000 Lexus Raven Run (gr. II) by 1 1/4 lengths over 40-1 shot Malibu Stacy Oct. 22 at Keeneland.

Unraced as a 2-year-old, Lightstream has been a quick study since winning a seven-furlong maiden test at Gulfstream Park March 6. The 3-year-old has raced exclusively in stakes company since, including a win in the April 17 Adena Springs Beaumont Stakes (gr. III) in her second start, and was beaten just three-quarters of a length by Paola Queen in the Aug. 6 Test Stakes (gr. I) at Saratoga Race Course.

"It wasn't that long ago that she was a maiden in Florida, so we've tried not to overdo it with her," Lynch said. "We're looking to have her around for another couple of years, so we've tried to pick the right spots for her. And she's shown up every time.

"I thought after the Test ... if we gave her the right amount of time, the Raven Run would be ideal for her. She may have one more start before the year is over, but I'd be inclined to give her a little rest and get ready for next year."

The challenge of breaking from the far outside in the 12-horse Raven Run field was rendered moot by Lightstream, as she had clear running in eighth down the backside behind Sophia's Song, while previously unbeaten Lucy N Ethel was pressed by Curlin's Approval through fractions of :22.50 and :45.30. The bay filly was still eighth as the field came off the final

turn, but jockey Julien Leparoux confidently roused Lightstream down the middle of the stretch, first wearing down eventual third-place finisher Coniah en route to hitting the wire in 1:22.68 for seven furlongs over a fast track.

"When I rode her the first time (in March), I loved her and I thought she ran a big race," Leparoux said. "Today it was a big field, but she handled it very good. She broke like usual—sat back and made one run. I knew we were going to have speed."

Lightstream paid \$6.80, \$4.20, and \$3.20 across the board. Malibu Stacy brought \$28.00 and \$15.80, while Coniah delivered \$11.20 for show.

Curlin's Approval came in fourth, with Grace's Treasure, Southern Girl, Takrees, Covey Trace, Sophia's Song, Bellamentary, Ma Can Do It, and Lucy N Ethel following. Lucy N Ethel faded after setting the early pace to suffer her first defeat in five starts.

Bred in Kentucky by Ann Marie Farm, Lightstream is out of the Arch mare North Beach and improved her record to four wins from six starts for \$457.000 in earnings. BH



FASIG-TIPTON OCTOBER GROUNDS ACTIVE

s potential buyers went about the business of inspecting horses on the Fasig-Tipton sales grounds Oct. 22, there were indications that the yearling auction season could end on a solid note with the sale's company's October sale.

The Oct. 24-26 auction, with daily sessions beginning at 10 a.m. EDT, brings down the curtain on the yearling sales that have resulted in slight declines in cumulative average and median prices, indicators of a stable marketplace. More than 1,250 yearlings are on offer at Fasig-Tipton, down 15.4% from the 1,485 cataloged a year ago.

"There is more interest in this sale than we have seen in the past," Fasig-Tipton president and chief executive officer Boyd Browning Jr. said, basing his assessment on pre-sale credit requests and overall inquiries with sale personnel. "People are still looking for horses to buy."

With the recent hot and dry weather giving way to more seasonable temperatures in the mid-40s, following some much-needed rain, it was a cool start to the day Saturday. Buyers and sellers wanted to get their sales work out of the way before going cross-town to

Keeneland for the afternoon races.

Browning said the October sale has continued to grow into a venue in which buyers, especially trainers and pinhookers buying to resell their purchases as 2-yearolds, have confidence in the caliber of horses on offer.

"People want to be associated with success, both at the sales and on the track," Browning said. "Fortunately, the October sale yearlings have been performing well on the track."

According to Fasig-Tipton, horses sold in October have won or placed in more than 190 stakes in 2016. Among the 12 October

sale alumni that have won stakes since Sept. 1 are grade II winners Irish Jasper, Free Rose, and Calgary Cat, and grade III victors La Coronel and Caren.

South Point Sales hopes Hip 942, a son of Tapit bought back for \$500,000 when offered at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select yearling sale, could follow in those hoofprints. The chestnut colt was produced from the grade III-winning Cherokee Run mare Cherokee Queen, an 11-race winner who earned \$628,312 and is the dam of stakes-placed Entertainer.

"It was a head-scratcher why he didn't sell at Saratoga," said South Point's Mike Recio. "He was shown over and over. But I think he will stack up well and be in the upper-crust here. He catalogs well and his physical is going to carry him to the top. The owner is a commercial breeder and the horse is here to sell."

Recio is also expecting a solid sale, buoved by the activity Saturday at his consignment, which is housed in the temporary tents erected by Fasig-Tipton since the number of yearlings in the sale exceeds the operation's barn capacity.

"I think it is going to be very similar to the (Keeneland) September sale," Recio said. "A lot of pinhookers didn't get their orders filled in other sales. I think there is going to be a lot of value, especially in the \$20,000-40,000 (range) where a lot of horses will fall through the cracks." BH

PREDICTING PROGENY AVERAGE WINNING DISTANCES


oday I provide empirical evidence on a relationship I've discussed in previous columns, the correlation between observed average winning distance of a stallion's runners (AWD) and the weighted average of the AWDs by the stallion's sire, damsire, and the sire of his granddam.

I explained in the June 5 BloodHorse Daily this year that a stallion's sire, dam sire, and sire of his maternal granddam provide 50%, 25%, and 12.5%, respectively, of the runner's DNA, and I posited that the distance proclivities as reflected by the AWDs of sire, damsire, and granddam sire predict the AWD of a stallion. Diagram 1 depicts these relationships, where the smoother blue line reports predicted AWDs for each of 47 "proven" U.S. stallions standing for \$10,000 or more.

For 19 of 47 stallions, information on the AWDs of the sire of the maternal granddam was unavailable. For these 19, the sire and damsire AWDs were used in predicting the AWDs of the stallion in question. The AWD of the sire of the stallion of interest was given twice as much weight as that of the damsire in the calculations; the sire was weighted as if it provided two-thirds of the stallion's DNA, and the damsire was weighted as if

it produced one-third of the DNA.



This approach accounts for 75% of the DNA of a stallion in question (rather than 87.5% if the sire of the granddam were also included), and as logic suggests, turned out to be less reliable in predicting AWD than when the sire of the maternal granddam was also considered.


The red line reports the actual AWDs of the stallions. Because DNA passes from one generation to another somewhat randomly, actual AWDs are likely to be more variable than predicted AWDs. Moreover, because environment plays a role in determining a runner's preferred racing distance (the "nature vs. nurture" question), actual AWD is even more random.

Diagram 2 shows that the actual AWDs and predicted AWDs are correlated, but with variability. The average deviation of the stallions' AWDs from predicted AWDs is 42/100ths of a furlong, or 92 yards.

Predicted AWDs typically exceed actual AWDs. This is explained in part because 2-year-olds' shortdistance wins pull the AWDs of active sires down more than they affect long-retired stallions' AWDs. The more important explanation of the divergence is that runners by older stallions raced at longer distances. One of many examples is the Jockey Club Gold Cup run at two miles from 1921 to 1975, 11/2 miles from 1976 to 1989, and 1 1/4 miles since 1990.

Some notable results: Successful Appeal's predicted AWD is lowest at 6.63 furlongs (actual AWD = 6.69). Lemon Drop Kid's and Temple City's predicted AWDs are highest at 8.17 and 8.16. Temple

> City's actual AWD is only 7.01; that will increase. The greatest actual/predicted AWD divergence is that of Giant's Causeway. He's bred to be a miler and ran best at seven/ eight furlongs but has the highest actual AWD of any successful U.S. stallion. BH
