'CHROME' LEADS STAR-STUDDED BC PRE-ENTRIES

all of Fame trainer Bob Baffert hung a lofty label on the 33rd Breeders' Cup World Championships, which—considering the source—was no small statement.

"This is probably one of the stronger Breeders' Cup years I've ever seen," said the conditioner who, last season, led over the first Triple Crown winner to contest the event. "This is the year to buy a ticket to be there."

A murderers row of champions, led by
2014 Horse of the Year California Chrome,
two-time Breeders' Cup race winner Beholder,
unbeaten Songbird, defending champions Tepin and
Found, and Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands
(gr. I) winner Nyquist make up an all-star international
cast of 185 of the world's best Thoroughbreds, including
38 from overseas, pre-entered for the 2016 Breeders'
Cup World Championships.

The total number of pre-entries is down from the 200 in 2015, when the event was held at Keeneland for the first time in the track's history.

Triple Crown winner American Pharoah made history with his victory in the Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I) a year ago, but the enduring star power of the 2016 lineup ranks with the best in the event's history. This year's Breeders' Cup features 11 returning or former Breeders' Cup winners: Songbird, Beholder, Found, Catch a Glimpse, Mongolian Saturday, Lady Eli, Tepin, Hit It a Bomb, Runhappy, Wavell Avenue, and Nyquist.

A total of seven races are oversubscribed with more than 14 horses. There are 45 runners who have qualified for automatic starting positions through the Breeders' Cup Challenge Series that are pre-entered.

The Breeders' Cup consists of 13 grade I races with

purses and awards totaling \$28 million and will be held for a record ninth time at Santa Anita Park in Arcadia, Calif., Nov. 4-5. There will be four Breeders' Cup races Friday and nine Breeders' Cup races Saturday.

The \$6 million Classic, which saw its purse increased by \$1 million from last year, had a full field of 14 horses pre-enter, and none carry more stature than champion California Chrome. Unbeaten in six starts this year, the 5-year-old son of Lucky Pulpit has toyed with rivals on two continents, winning the March 26 Dubai World Cup (UAE-I) and barely taking a hard breath during victories in the Aug. 20 TVG Pacific Classic Stakes (gr. I) and Oct. 1 Awesome Again Stakes (gr. I), in the process becoming North America's richest racehorse with earnings of \$13.4 million.

Baffert-trained Arrogate stands as California Chrome's main challenger off his record-setting 13 1/2-length win in the Aug. 27 Travers Stakes (gr. I). Trainer Art Sherman maintains, however, that this California Chrome is unlike any he has encountered.

"The way he's running now he spooks me a bit," Sherman said of California Chrome. "Until you beat him, he's No. 1 in the world, so there you go." BH

SPENDTHRIFT'S BEST LIKELY TO RETIRE AFTER BC

pendthrift Farm's current two best racehorses will likely make their final starts during the Breeders' Cup Nov. 4-5 at Santa Anita Park.

That was the sentiment expressed by Spendthrift general manager Ned Toffey, regarding three-time champion Beholder and recently untouchable sprinter Lord Nelson.

For Beholder, who logs her final timed work Oct. 26 for the Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I), retirement is almost quaranteed.

"We never say never, but right now, that's the plan," Toffey said. "If she wins by 10 lengths, people might change their minds.

"It's been a great run. Everything she's done in the last year has just been gravy, because what she did before was so special."

For Lord Nelson, there isn't wiggle room. The 4-year-old colt, undefeated in 2016 and the likely favorite for the Breeders' Cup Sprint (gr. I), is headed to Spendthrift to begin his stallion career.

"His book isn't totally full, but it's nearly full," Toffey said of Lord Nelson, who Spendthrift purchased in late 2015. The son of Pulpit worked six furlongs in 1:12 flat for trainer Bob Baffert Wednesday. "He's one of the most exciting stallion prospects we've ever had—not only his breeding, but his conformation."

As exciting as Breeders' Cup weekend will be for the Spendthrift connections, their real work begins when Beholder and Lord Nelson are at the Lexington farm. BH

BERNARDINI RULES FASIG-TIPTON FINAL SESSION

arley stallion Bernardini had a big day at the Fasig-Tipton October yearling sale's closing session Oct. 26, with his sons bringing two of the three highest prices of the day as the three-day auction ended on a solid note.

During a week in which consignors and buyers couldn't have asked for better weather for a fall sale—with bountiful sunshine, crisp mornings, and afternoon temperatures in the low 70's—the final numbers were on par with last year.

Fasig-Tipton reported 777 yearlings sold for total receipts of \$25,691,500, compared with \$29,369,300 for 854 head in 2015. Average fell 3.9% to \$33,065 and the median price was down slightly to \$14,500 from \$15,000. The 260 horses that did not sell represented an RNA rate of 25.1%, compared with 30.8% in 2015.

"I think overall we had a solid and consistent marketplace, which is what you're hoping for in October," said Fasig-Tipton president Boyd Browning Jr. "All in all I thought it was a very solid three days. This sale has matured, and provides a real viable alternative for consignors and for buyers who love to come to shop here because consignors are realistic in setting reserves. It is a real good, solid, realistic marketplace. Certainly there was a really strong market for quality individuals."

Browning said one positive was greater trade in the middle and lower ends of the market, with more international buyers at the lower price ranges. He said there was identifiable, increased action from buyers representing Russian interests than what has been present at previous October sales.

Topping the day was a Bernardini colt out of the stakes-winning Smart Strike mare Desert Gazelle

purchased by Stonestreet Stables for \$350,000, the co-highest price of the sale along with a Curlin colt sold during the Oct. 24 opener.

Bred in Kentucky by Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin operation, the colt was consigned by Brookdale Sales as Hip 1034. The colt's third dam is Secret Status, a daughter of A.P. Indy who won two grade I stakes, including the Kentucky Oaks, and

produced Belmont Stakes and Florida Derby (both grade I) runner-up Dunkirk.

John Moynihan, who represented Stonestreet owner Barbara Banke in the transaction, said the buyer could end up racing the colt in partnership.

"He's a beautiful horse," Monyihan said. "I saw him the other day and he was just a really good-looking horse. He's just a really gorgeous horse. He's a little light on the female side, but he's so good on the physical, we thought we'd take the chance. We've had a lot of luck with Bernardini, so we thought we'd take a swing."

Brookdale's Joe Seitz had high praise for the colt.

"I thought this colt was a perfect specimen—a perfect individual. He was extremely athletic, had a great walk, (and) never got tired after all the activity, almost a week being out here," the consignor said. "He's the kind of horse I'm hoping and expecting we'll see on Breeders' Cup weekend either a year or two from now. I'm grateful that he's going to Stonestreet because he'll be in good hands and given every chance in the world to succeed."

Seitz said Brookdale's relationship with Godolphin dates back more than 20 years, when some of the Sheikh's horses were boarded at the Seitz family farm near Versailles, Ky.

"They've been great clients and friends for many years," Seitz said.

The other high-priced Bernardini was a filly purchased by W. D. North Thoroughbreds from Bridie Harrison, agent for Peter Blum Thoroughbreds, for \$280,000, which ranked third on the day.

Named Dancing, the filly consigned as Hip 1013 was produced from the unraced Kingmambo mare Dancing Alone, the dam of grade III winner Dancing Solo. She is from the family of grade I winners Voodoo Dancer and Pool Play.

The filly was bought back for \$370,000 from this

year's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select yearling sale.

Buyer Willy North, who said the filly will be pointed toward a 2017 juvenile sale in Florida, liked the filly's pedigree and the way she handled herself at the sale.

"She looks like she will be precocious," North said. "Her conformation was spectacular. I could not fault the filly anywhere. I think it was a great buy to pinhook."

The day's second-highest-priced transaction was the private purchase of a Tapit colt that initially went through the ring unsold for \$300,000 but was later reported sold to de Meric Sales for that price.

Consigned by South Point Sales as Hip 942, the colt was bought back for \$500,000 from the Saratoga August sale. He was produced from the grade III-winning Cherokee Run mare Cherokee Queen, the winner of 11 races who earned \$628,312.

Late in the session, Midwest Thoroughbreds went to \$285,000 to acquire a Union Rags colt from the Darby Dan consignment. Bred by AJ Suited, the colt, Hip 1214, is a half brother to stakes winner Uncle Lino and produced from Haysee, a full sister to grade I winner Lady Joanne and half sister to four graded winners, including three-time grade I winner Shackleford, the Preakness Stakes (gr. I) winner and first-crop sire.

Jim Schenk, Midwest Thoroughbreds' racing manager, said the colt was "well-balanced and very athletic." BH

ondialiste may bypass a rematch with champion Tepin in the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) at Santa Anita Park in favor of the 11/2-mile Breeders' Cup Turf (gr. IT), trainer David O'Meara told Great British Racing International.

Mondialiste finished second to Tepin in the 2015 Mile and finished 11th behind the daughter of Bernstein in the June 14 Queen Anne Stakes (Eng-I) at Royal Ascot.

The 6-year-old son of Galileo is a grade I winner over eight furlongs and won the 11/4-mile Arlington Million (gr. IT) in 2:01.87.

"When he won the Arlington Million, he clocked the third-fastest time in the last 10 years, so the ground was pretty quick and a similar surface at Santa Anita will hold no fears for him," O'Meara said. "We are leaning toward stepping him up to a mile and a half for the Breeders' Cup Turf rather than going again in the Mile. It's a very fast mile and a half at Santa Anita, beginning in a chute,

which is part of the sprint course, so I think that will suit him fine."

Geoff and Sandra Turnbull's Mondialiste finished fourth in the Oct. 8 Shadwell Turf Mile (gr. IT) at Keeneland, beaten 11/2 lengths by expected Mile runner Miss Temple City.

Mondialiste's stablemate Suedois, a group III winner in France, is also pre-entered in the Mile but is likely to run in Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (gr. IT), according to O'Meara, BH



CHARISMATIC PENSIONED TO OLD **FRIENDS**

ual classic winner and 1999 Horse of the Year Charismatic will return to the United States next month from Japan to become a pensioner at Old Friends Thoroughbred retirement center near Georgetown, Ky.

The 20-year-old stallion is coming from JBBA Shizunai Stallion Station, where he has stood since 2002. Plans call for Charismatic to be shipped in late November.

His journey is sponsored mainly by a gift from former owner's Robert and Beverly Lewis' Family Foundation and from Tito's Handmade Vodka.

"This is yet another dream come true," said Old Friends founder and president Michael Blowen. "Charismatic holds such special memories for so many racing fans, so it's particularly meaningful to be able to bring him home."

With Charismatic's arrival, farm to house three Kentucky

Derby (gr. I) winners, all repatriated from Japan by Old Friends. In 2014 the farm welcomed 1997 champion Silver Charm (also owned by the Lewis family) and the following year 2002 winner War Emblem.

"My family and I are so pleased to learn that our Horse of the Year, Charismatic, will be returning from Japan (to join) our beloved Silver Charm at Old Friends," said Beverly Lewis, who campaigned the horse with her late husband. Robert. "Charismatic's star shone very brightly,... We are all looking forward to visiting him when he arrives."

Eric Barlund, a vice president of sales for Tito's, said the company is a staunch supporter of equine charities.

"We are ecstatic we are able to participate in bringing horse racing stars like Charismatic back home, where they can be revered by the public and help raise awareness for the cause," Barlund said.

Bred by Kentucky by Parrish Hill Farm and William Farish, and trained by Hall of Famer D. Wayne Lukas, Charismatic (Summer Squall—Bali Babe, by Drone) had a Cinderella story racing career.

> In February of 1999 the chestnut colt was competing in claiming races at Santa Anita Park, but in April he earned a shot at the Derby by winning the grade Il Coolmore Lexington Stakes at Keeneland. Dismissed at odds of more than 31-1, he collared Cat Thief a sixteenth of a mile from the Churchill Downs wire and held off a surging Menifee to win the Derby by a neck. He went on to win the Preakness by 11/2 lengths and became the Lewis' second Triple Crown contender in two years, with Silver Charm in 1997.

In the Belmont Stakes (gr. I), Charismatic stalked the pace instead of biding his time toward the back of the pack. When he took the lead with a quartermile to go, the record crowd of

over 85,000 began cheering. Suddenly, however, he dropped back and was passed by eventual winner Lemon Drop Kid. Immediately after the wire, jockey Chris Antley pulled the colt up and jumped off. He grabbed the colt's injured left front leg and held it off the ground to prevent any further damage. Charismatic suffered multiple fractures in his leg.

The injuries, while not life threatening, ended his racing career. Charismatic was named the 1999 champion 3-year-old colt, as well as Horse of the Year, and retired with five wins from 17 starts and earnings of \$2,038,064. BH

FOREVER UNBRIDLED, TOM'S READY ALL SET FOR BC

ultiple grade I winner Forever Unbridled and stablemate Tom's Ready were declared "happy and healthy" by trainer Dallas Stewart after each threw down their final works at Churchill Downs Oct. 26 in advance of their expected Breeders' Cup runs.

The Nov. 4 Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I) may be the staunchest pound-for-pound test on the two-day card, with the likes of champions Songbird, Beholder, and Stellar Wind all set to face off.

In her second move since a 2 1/4-length win in the Oct. 1 Beldame Invitational (gr. I) at Belmont Park, Charles Fipke's Forever Unbridled signaled her readiness for that fray when she worked six furlongs from the five-eighths pole in 1:14 2/5, posting splits of :24 4/5, :37, and 1:01 4/5, with a gallop out in 1:28 2/5.

"She's just a really good racehorse. She's been solid all year, as have the other fillies," Stewart said. "We like the way we're doing it. We know it's going to be a great horse race. We're going to be glad we're in there to compete."

Forever Unbridled's final margin of victory in the Beldame was not a true indicator of how easily the 4-year-old daughter of Unbridled's Song handled her competition that day. Given that she is out of 2006 Kentucky Oaks (gr. I) winner Lemons Forever and is a full sister to grade I winner Unbridled Forever—both of whom were trained by Stewart—her acsent in the Distaff ranks is one that emotionally hits her trainer right between the eyes.

"I mean, her mom wins the Oaks. That's as special as can be. The full sister is a grade I winner and it's just as solid a family as there is in the world right now," Stewart said.

Forever Unbridled has not finished worse than third in her last six starts dating back to November of 2015 and she earned her first top-level score when she

captured the April 15 Apple Blossom Handicap (gr. I) at Oaklawn Park.

Meanwhile, a victory in the Nov. 4 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (gr. I) would give Tom's Ready his first grade I score and the first top-level achievement for owners G M B Racing. The 3-year-old son of More Than Ready—who defeated champion Runhappy in the Oct. 1 Ack Ack Handicap (gr. III) at Churchill—tuned up with a fivefurlong move in 1:01 4/5, working in company with Take Charge Nikki.

Tom's Ready broke off about four lengths behind his workmate and clocked splits of :12 3/5, :25, and :37 2/5, with a gallop out in 1:15.

"He has to step it up. We know that," Stewart said. "He's a 3-year-old running against older horses. But he's a very good racehorse. He's a fighter and he looked great today. He's healthy and we're just hoping the race turns out good for them both."

Tom's Ready has won three of 13 starts, including a victory in the June 11 Woody Stephens Stakes (gr. II) at Belmont, and has \$582,047 in earnings. Both he and Forever Unbridled are slated to ship to California Oct. 28. BH

DROSSELMEYER SOLD TO **BRAZILIAN STUD**

rosselmeyer, one of only eight horses to win an American classic and the Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I), has been purchased by Stud TNT and will remain in Brazil to stand stud.

The 9-year-old son of Distorted Humor—Golden Ballet (Moscow Ballet) had been shuttling to Stud TNT for the Southern Hemisphere breeding season since he retired to WinStar Farm in 2012.

Drosselmeyer is a second-crop sire in Brazil, with his first 3-year-olds now competing. His top runner to date is grade III winner Enologo, winner of the Jose Buarque de Macedo-Copa das Nacoes Stakes and third-place finisher in the Jockey Club Brasileiro Stakes (Brz-I) at Gavea.

Drosselmeyer's other first-crop graded stakesplaced performers in Brazil include fillies Kanton and Estella Rossa, and colt King David.

Campaigned by WinStar and trainer Bill Mott, Drosselmeyer earned \$3,728,170 and remains the all-time leading money winner for his champion sire Distorted Humor.

As a 3-year-old, Drosselmeyer captured the the Belmont Stakes (gr. I) and placed in two other graded stakes. At 4 he finished second in the grade I Jockey Club Gold Cup and followed with a win in the 2011 Classic, in which he beat nine grade I winners, including Horse of the Year Havre de Grace and champion Uncle Mo.



Ith superstar mare Winx getting a much-deserved rest following her explosive victory in the group I William Hill W.S. Cox Plate (Aus-I), it will be left to a new cast of players to put the sparkle into Derby Day at Flemington Oct. 29.

An iconic day featuring nine group events, Derby Day is highlighted by four group I contests.

Carrying the biggest purse at Aus\$1.5 million (\$1,147,230), is the group I Victoria Derby (Aus-I) for 3-year-olds at 2,500 meters (just more than 11/2

The New Zealand-bred and -trained gelding Sacred Elixir, a group I winner in Australia at 2 and a last-start winner of the Super Vase (Aus-II), is favored.

Pedigree suggests Sacred Elixir should relish the trip, being by Epsom Derby winner Pour Moi, out of a granddaughter of New Zealand Horse of the Year Horlicks. He's also from the family of Melbourne Cup

winner Brew and Australian Derby winner Fiumicino.

The Aus\$1 million (\$764,820) Cantala Stakes (Aus-I) has attracted a lone 3-year-old colt, Seaburge (Sebring), to take on older horses.

The Aus\$500,000 (\$382,410) Myer Classic (Aus-I) at 1,600 meters (about one mile) for fillies and mares, and the Aus\$500,000 Coolmore Stud Stakes (Aus-I) at 1,200 meters (about six furlongs) for 3-year-olds round out what promises to be a memorable day. BH



NOBLE BIRD TAKES ON EIGHT IN **FAYETTE**

I hat one gets from John Oxley's Noble Bird in his race result often depends on what mood the son of Birdstone is in at that moment.

On his better days, the grade I winner can deliver efforts like the 111/4-length clinic he put on in the May 20 Pimlico Special Handicap (gr. III). Other times, he leaves trainer Mark Casse exasperated in the wake of such off-the-board outings as his Mohegan Sun

Metropolitan Handicap (gr. I) run and Whitney Stakes (gr. I) start.

The Noble Bird who turns iockey Julien Leparoux into a happy passenger is the one his connections hope shows up Oct. 29, when he headlines a field of eight entered in the Hagyard Fayette Stakes (gr. II) on the final day of the Keeneland fall meet.

Raw talent has always been something Noble Bird owned in ample supply. Getting the 5-year-old to consistently harness it has been another story. Last June, he defeated fellow grade I winners Lea, Hoppertunity, and Majestic Harbor in the Stephen Foster Handicap (gr. I), but has only won two of eight starts since.

His latest was trademark Noble Bird, a gate-to-wire 11/2-length win in the Oct. 1 Lukas Classic going 11/8 miles at Churchill Downs. With little other true speed in the Fayette field, the chestnut colt should have a clear path to the lead in the early going should he break out of post 2 in good order.

"He's at the top of his game right now," Casse told Keeneland's Tom Leach. "He's kind of (weird). He's very tough to ride. He's kind of moody, but he's doing very well. If he runs his last race, he's going to be tough. If someone gets in his way, he'll run them over."

The 11/8-mile Fayette has a handful of entrants trying to break back into form.

Lael Stables' Divining Rod scored his first graded stakes win at Keeneland last year when he won the Coolmore Lexington Stakes (gr. III) en route to finishing third to eventual Triple Crown winner American Pharoah in the Xpressbet Preakness Stakes (gr. I). Since returning, after being sidelined for nearly a year due to injury, the 4-year-old son of Tapit has notched a pair of allowance victories at Parx Racing.

Grade III winner Kasaqui will test his ability on the main track after six consecutive starts on the grass, with his most recent effort a fifth-place finish in the Oct. 8 Shadwell Turf Mile (gr. IT) at Keeneland.

Hard-knocking graded stakes winner Prayer For Relief is set to make his return to North American racing for the first time since running fourth in the 2015 Donn Handicap (gr. I). The 8-year-old son of Jump Start has been campaigned in Dubai for his last six starts.

Stakes winner Mr. Z, Iron Fist, Chocopologie, and Hawaakom round out the field. BH



NO RAISE IN NYRA SPENDING LIMITS

state financial oversight panel has declined to act on a request from the state-controlled New York Racing Association to raise its discretionary spending limits.

The decision by the Franchise Oversight Board was based on panel members' concerns that NYRA is still dominated by a state-appointed board of directors and not yet back in private hands, as was originally planned for late 2015. Though the staff of the oversight panel recommended approval of the more relaxed purchasing standards, two of its five members raised concerns about the request.

"To me, NYRA, until the situation changes, is basically a state-overseen organization and it ought to follow similar rules," said panel member Steven Newman.

Another member, Elizabeth Garvey, said the procurement rule change may make sense when NYRA returns to private control. But for now, she said, she wanted something "more narrowly tailored" for NYRA.

NYRA had sought to double the threshold for when it must competitively bid out a project from \$50,000 to \$100,000 and to increase its discretionary purchasing to \$99,999.

The board's chairman, Robert Williams, who is also executive director of the New York State Gaming Commission, said the request would be returned to NYRA for revision.

The oversight board, created in 2008 and whose members are appointed by the governor and legislative leaders, has the authority to approve or reject all purchasing policies at NYRA.

NYRA was taken over, at the insistence of Gov. Andrew Cuomo, in 2012 for what was supposed to be a three-year period. Under another extension Cuomo and lawmakers approved earlier this year, the NYRA board will remain in state hands until sometime in 2017.

The requested change in procurement policies tabled by the board was not the only tough talk coming from the oversight panel. In a brief discussion not on the board's agenda, the members also talked about the recent settlement between the federal government and NYRA, in which the racing corporation will pay a \$150,000 fine for the dumping of polluted wastewater at Aqueduct Racetrack.

James Towne, a board member, called the payment "a complete waste of money" and said NYRA should now be required to report to the oversight group on environmental assessments at its three tracks. He said such reviews by a private company would have cost less than the penalty NYRA is paying the federal aovernment.

The board did approve another step in the process to permit a number of major capital improvements at NYRA's Saratoga Race Course, a multi-year program that includes a new clubhouse, barns, and other renovations and new construction.

The board Oct. 25 approved what is known as a "findings statement" of an environmental impact study of the Saratoga projects, though Williams cautioned that individual projects for the track are still subject to final review by the franchise oversight panel and a state parks and historic preservation agency. BREEDERS' CUP'S FIRST HEROINE: MIESQUE

arly in the history of the Breeders' Cup World Championships, Stavros Niarchos' marvelous homebred Miesque set a standard that very few have been able to match. She was the first two-time winner of any event: back-to-back runnings of the Breeders' Cup Mile (gr. IT) in 1987-88.

A lengthy, well-made bay daughter of Niarchos' champion miler Nureyev, Miesque was bred for the distance. She took the Prix Marcel Boussac (Fr-I) over Longchamp's mile at 2 and won three of her four starts on her way to a French championship.

At 3, the mile became her métier, as she won four of her five starts at the distance heading into the Breeders Cup at Hollywood Park: the General Accident One Thousand Guineas, the Dubai Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French One Thousand Guineas), the Prix du Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard Jacques Le Marois, and the Prix du Moulin de Longchamp Ecurie Fustok (all aroup I).

A second in the Queen Elizabeth II Stakes was her only fall from grace.

In only a few years, the Breeders' Cup became what founder John Gaines envisioned—a truly international event—and Miesque's connections were keen to test the deep waters of competition by shipping their star from France to California.

A field of 14 assembled for the fourth race at Hollywood Park Nov. 21. On a firm turf course, Miesque set a course record by outperforming her wellcredentialed rivals by 3 1/2 lengths in a course record 1:32 4/5.

At year's end she not only wore the World Championships Mile crown but year-end titles in England, France, and the U.S.

Kept in training at 4, Miesque enjoyed an abbreviated season: She started only three times from May through September, winning twice in group I company, and bringing her total group/grade I tally to

nine. Her only defeat was on the soft turf at Longchamp, where she narrowly lost to Soviet Star (Nureyev) in the Prix du Moulin.

Churchill Downs hosted the Breeders' Cup in 1988. Miesque, along with her trainer Francois Boutin and regular rider Freddy Head, accepted the invitation to the party.

On a cold, gray, rain-soaked turf—not her favorite surface—Miesque once again proved best in an equally easy victory, with her 11 rivals strung from four to 33 lengths behind her.

Again she earned an Eclipse Award as U.S. champion turf female.

Although no longer in Breeders' Cup competition, she continues to be a part of Breeders' Cup tradition.

Retired to the life of a broodmare, she became part of the Niarchos family's U.S. breeding operation, and from 14 foals, all by U.S. sires, she produced five stakes winners, three of whom exerted their own influences on the Breeders' Cup.

Her first foal, and an excellent miler in his own right, Kingmambo (Mr. Prospector) is the broodmare sire of Midday (Oasis Dream), who won the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf (gr. IT) in 2009.

Her third foal, grade III winner Miesque's Son (Mr. Prospector) sired 2006 Mile winner Miesque's Approval. Stakes winner Moon Is Up (Woodman), her fourth foal, is the granddam of 2014 Mile winner Karakontie (Bernstein). BH


