# WHAT IS TIEA?

The Thoroughbred Industry Employee Awards (TIEA) recognize and reward the outstanding talent, diligence and commitment of the farm and racing stable staff who are at the heart of our sport. TIEA began in 2016, following in the footsteps of similar global Thoroughbred industry award initiatives in England and Ireland, also sponsored by Godolphin. There are now industry award programs in five countries, connected by their shared mission to recognize and reward those who have dedicated their lives to the Thoroughbred industry.

In the US, TIEA is conducted in partnership with The Jockey Club, the National Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, the Thoroughbred Owners' and Breeders' Association and the Breeders' Cup, and with the sponsorship of Godolphin. TIEA has awarded over \$600,000 in prize money to fifty-two finalists and thirty-one winners since 2016.

While prize money is an important aspect of TIEA, the essential goal of this program is to celebrate behind-the-scenes, unsung heroes of the Thoroughbred industry, who otherwise may never have the chance to hold a trophy in our sport.

Each year, nineteen finalists across seven award categories are recognized and \$122,000 in prize money is awarded. These finalists are brought to Lexington, Kentucky for a whirlwind trip including travel, accommodation, a horse farm tour, private dinner, day of racing and the Award Ceremony luncheon.

# CATEGORIES

#### LEADERSHIP AWARD sponsored by Hagyard Equine Medical Institute

An award to an individual in a managerial or supervisory role with more than two employees who displays exceptional leadership qualities, particularly in terms of motivating, mentoring and supporting colleagues in the workplace. **PRIZE** \$7,500 to the winner and \$2,500 to their farm (division) or stable. \$2,500 to each runner-up and \$2,500 to their farm (division) or stable.

#### **DEDICATION TO BREEDING AWARD** sponsored by Hallway Feeds

An award to an individual who has worked a minimum of 10 years in the Thoroughbred breeding industry and shown consistency, reliability and a talent for Thoroughbred breeding horsemanship. Must be a pivotal part of his or her employer's success. **PRIZE** *\$7,500 to the winner and \$2,500 to their farm (division). \$2,500 to each runner-up and \$2,500 to their farm (division).* 

#### **DEDICATION TO RACING AWARD**

An award to an individual who has worked a minimum of 10 years in the Thoroughbred racing industry and shown consistency, reliability, and a talent for Thoroughbred racing horsemanship. Must be a pivotal part of his or her employer's success. **PRIZE** *\$7,500 to the winner and \$2,500 to their stable. \$2,500 to each runner-up and \$2,500 to their stable.* 

#### **KATHERINE MCKEE ADMINISTRATION AWARD** sponsored by Keeneland

An award to an individual who works in an administrative role in the Thoroughbred breeding industry, racing industry, or any supporting sector within the Thoroughbred breeding and racing industry. Must be a pivotal part of his or her employer's success. **PRIZE** \$7,500 to the winner and \$2,500 to their stable/farm. \$2,500 to each runner-up and \$2,500 to their stable/farm.

#### NEW FOR 2021 SUPPORT SERVICES AWARD sponsored by I am Horse Racing

An award to an individual who works in any non-administrative, support service role in the Thoroughbred breeding industry, racing industry, or any supporting sector within the Thoroughbred breeding and racing industry. Must be a pivotal part of his or her employer's success. **PRIZE** \$7,500 to the winner and \$2,500 to their stable/farm. \$2,500 to each runner-up and \$2,500 to their stable/farm.

#### **NEWCOMER AWARD**

An award to an individual who has worked in any area of Thoroughbred breeding and/or racing for less than five years and shown commitment to – and ambition for – a career in the Thoroughbred industry, including a desire to improve and progress their skills and knowledge. **PRIZE** \$2,500 to the winner and \$1,000 to their farm (division) or stable + a 5-day educational tour to Dubai. \$2,000 to each runner-up and \$1,000 to their farm (division) or stable.

#### **COMMUNITY AWARD** sponsored by Churchill Downs

This award recognizes those who have demonstrated an outstanding contribution to the Thoroughbred industry, and in particular, to the greater good of the sport. This could include those who support the breeding and racing staff or have made an outstanding contribution to the wider Thoroughbred community. Nominees for this award do not need to be directly employed in the Thoroughbred industry. **PRIZE** \$7,500 to the winner and \$2,500 to their charity of choice. \$2,500 to the runner-up.

# TIEA IN DETAIL

### **How to Nominate**

- 1) Fill out and submit an online nomination form at tiea.org, by
  - Typing out your nomination in the digital format, OR
  - Attaching a Word or PDF document with your responses, OR
  - Upload an audio or video file, verbally submitting your responses
    - All video and audio files will be transcribed to ensure all nominations are judged through an equal medium
    - Please do not submit an edited video, speak directly to the camera and answer the nomination form questions

  - Your call will be recorded, and your responses transcribed in order for your nomination to be submitted

### Notes on the nomination

The nomination is the most vital part of the selection process. The shortlist judging panel only has the nomination form as reference to the character of the individual and as to why they are deserving of recognition.

Therefore, if you are nominating someone, please be sure to include as much relevant detail as possible and include examples of their dedication. Also, please consider the criteria of the award category in completing the nomination.

The most important part of the nomination is the depth of the content included. Particulars such as grammar, punctuation, etc. are not considered by the judging panel.

### **After Nominations Close**

Following the close of nominating period, all nominations are collected and organized by the TIEA partners. Once completed, the shortlist judging panel is convened.

The shortlist panel is asked to read through every single nomination prior to meeting. They are tasked as a group to select three finalists in each category, as well as the winner and runner-up of the Community Award. Finalists are selected based upon their qualifications in regard to the award category. Each finalist is selected by a majority of the shortlist panel, determined by discussion among the panel. On occasion this is finalized by a blind vote amongst the panel.

Once the shortlist panel has determined the finalists in each category and the Community Award winner and runner-up, a press release is published. While the finalists in each category are notified, every single nominee is sent a certificate commemorating their nomination. The certificate includes the award category they were nominated to as well as the individual who nominated them.

After the finalists have been announced, the TIEA partners begin creating individual highlight videos of each finalist. The goal of these videos is to celebrate these individuals. The TIEA partners also begin to finalize plans for the Awards Ceremony.

Each finalist and a guest are invited to Lexington, Kentucky for 48 hours around the Awards Ceremony. Travel to and accommodation in Lexington is provided. The day before the Awards Ceremony, finalists are offered a chance to tour a local horse farm and invited to join a private dinner with their guests. Each must also participate in an interview with the final judging panel.

The final judging panel will meet with each finalist the day before the Awards Ceremony. This panel is tasked with determining a winner in each category. The final judging panel rely on the criteria of each award category to aid them in this process. In meeting the finalists face-to-face, they have an opportunity to get more in-depth knowledge of each finalist. The winner of each award category is selected by a majority of the final panel, often determined by discussion among them and may be finalized by a blind vote. Once the final judging panel has made their decisions, that information remains private until it is announced at the Awards Ceremony the following day.

The Awards Ceremony is a luncheon event<sup>\*</sup> held exclusively for finalists, their friends and family, TIEA partners, sponsors and select media. The ceremony is hosted by Jill Byrne, with a notable trophy presenter each year. The ceremony format involves Jill describing each category and highlighting each finalist by playing their video. All three finalists are asked to join Jill on stage. After playing all three videos, the category winner is announced.

Each winner receives a trophy, while the runners-up receive a framed certificate. The Community Award winner is highlighted last, often with their nominator having the opportunity to introduce them.

All finalists and their guests are invited to enjoy a day of racing following the ceremony.

### The Judging Panels

Each of the judging panels, both the shortlist and final, are comprised of industry professionals representing various aspects of the sport. Each are volunteers, asked to give an entire day to meet with their respective panel. They are expected to review each nomination, and for the final judging panel each finalist video, in advance of their panel convening. If during the judging process, there is any conflict of interest relating to an individual nomination in a given category, that judge must recuse themselves from voting in that category. In the final judging panel, they would be recused from participating in any of the interviews for that category.

### **Community Award**

The Community Award recognizes individuals who have a charitable aspect to their work. Due to those qualifications, it was determined in the development of TIEA to have the shortlist panel select the winner rather than announce finalists in the category. In 2021, TIEA will also recognize a runner-up in the Community Award Category with a prize of \$2,500. This individual will not be a part of the Awards Ceremony.

### **Prize Money**

Prize money is awarded to all three finalists in each category, and to the winner and runner-up in the Community Award. Prize money is also awarded to the farm/division or stable for each finalist. The genesis behind the idea of awarding money to their teams is to promote support and camaraderie around TIEA. The idea being, if your colleague wins, you win too! TIEA asks that employers work with their finalist to determine how the money will be split amongst their team.

In order to be recognized as an award category finalist or announced as the winner, the individual must partake in the final judging panel interview. Finalists must also be present at the TIEA Ceremony in order to win.
