



## **COVID-19 Vaccine Mobile Clinic at the Keeneland Entertainment Center Saturday, February 20, 2021 | 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.**

Thank you for your interest in receiving a COVID-19 vaccine to keep you and others around you safe.

We are seeking people ages 60 and older or people under the age of 60 who have health conditions that make them more likely to get sick from COVID, to receive a COVID-19 vaccine from UK's mobile clinic.

Free COVID-19 testing will also be offered as part of the clinic.

**Health insurance is not necessary for either a vaccine or COVID-19 test.**

### **Where and When:**

- Saturday, Feb. 20 between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- Keeneland Entertainment Center

### **What you need to know:**

- You must register in advance
- You must receive confirmation that you have an appointment
- You will be assigned a time for your appointment; you should arrive about ten minutes prior to your assigned time
- We will return about four weeks later to give you the second (and last) vaccine dose that is required
- Your information is being collected only so we can assure the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention CDC that we are administering doses to our community.

### **How to register for an appointment**

There are three ways you can register to receive a vaccine. Choose the one that works best for you:

2. Send an email to [mobileclinic@uky.edu](mailto:mobileclinic@uky.edu) giving your name, age, race, phone number, address and other pertinent information. We do not need social security number or other proprietary information; **or**
3. Call (859) 562-0838, and someone from the University of Kentucky will assist with registration over the phone.
